### **ACLAIM**

**Acclamation** – Aris (Danroad)

THE NATIONAL STUD • Fee £9,500 LF

**Aclaim** will have his first two-year-olds running for him this year and members of his first crop are in the hands of such as Richard Hannon, Clive Cox, Karl Burke, Richard Fahey, Ken Condon and Andrew Balding.

His first crop passed their first test with flying colours in the sale ring last autumn, selling for up to 145,000gns and he will have plenty of representatives in the coming seasons, having covered over 325 mares in his first three seasons.

Winner of his sole start at two, the son of **Acclamation** also scored on his three-year-old debut and earned his first black type on his third start when placed in the Gr.3 Lacken Stakes. A Listed winner at Newbury over 7f in September, he ended his season with a first Group victory in the Gr.2 Challenge Stakes. At four, he finished runner-up in the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest, beaten only half a length, and ended his career on a high, triumphing first in the Gr.2 Park Stakes and following up with an impressive victory in the Gr.1 Prix de la Forêt at Chantilly.

A half-brother to two winners, he is out of the Listed-placed winner **Aris** (**Danroad**), a three-parts-sister to the Gr.1 Irish 1,000 Guineas heroine **Again** (**Danehill Dancer**), also successful in the Gr.1 Moyglare Stud Stakes and dam of the Gr.1-placed **Delphinia** and Listed winner and sire **Indian Maharaja**, from the top family of leading sire **Montjeu**.

**Kodiac** – Lady Lucia (Royal Applause)


### WHITSBURY MANOR STUD • Fee £5,000 1st Oct SLF

**Adaay** made a perfect start to his stallion career when his very first runner became his first winner, **Doctor Strange** striking in Italy in May. The colt went on to add a conditions contest to his tally and also earned black-type when placed in the Gr.3 Premio Primi Passi in July.

**Doctor Strange** was the first of 24 individual winners for his sire. The group amassed 35 wins between them, giving their sire a winner-to-runner strike rate of 38 per cent. Other black-type performers included the Listed-placed **Furlong Factor** and **Tea Dance**, who was twice Listed-placed. **Adaay** also enjoyed success at the sales last year, with his breeze-up horses selling for up to 155,000gns – **Sir Maxi**, who won twice and was placed on his other two runs – while his yearlings sold for up to ten times his stud fee.

A son of **Kodiac**, who made a good start as a sire of sires last year, **Adaay** was himself a 240,000gns purchase at the Tattersalls Craven Breeze-Up. He was quick off the mark, defeating **Kodi Bear** in a Newbury maiden a month later. Listed-placed at two, he returned at three to defeat Gr.1 winners **Limato** and **Jungle Cat** in the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes and Listed Carnarvon Stakes respectively, and later triumphed in the Gr.2 Hungerford Stakes, beating **Coulsty**. As a four-year-old he was placed in both the Gr.2 Park Stakes and Gr.3 Criterion Stakes.

### **ALHEBAYEB**


**Dark Angel** – Miss Indigo (Indian Ridge) **TARA STUD •** Fee €3,000 1st Oct SLF

**Alhebayeb** enjoyed another good year on the track in 2020, including **Lustown Baba**'s impressive victory in the Listed Testimonial Stakes at the Curragh.

He boasts a near 50 per cent winners-to-runners ratio, six of whom have turned into Stakes performers, including the Gr.3 Premio Guido Berardelli winner **Aurelius In Love**, the Listed Prix Francois Mathet scorer and Gr.3 Grand Prix de Vichy-placed **Talk Or Listen**, as well as **Abama**, who landed the Listed Prix Zeddaan, and **Cathkin Peak**, who won the Listed Eddie Logan Stakes at Santa Anita in the US.

A precious type, **Alhebayeb**, a winner of the Gr.2 July Stakes at Newmarket, is getting a good mix of two-year-old winners and progressive horses, as seen by the above, and that could be a positive sign that even better things are to come in 2021.

He is a half-brother to the Listed Scarbrough Stakes winner and Gr.3 Sprint Stakes-placed **Humidor** (**Camacho**), who was also fourth in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes. They are out of the **Indian Ridge** mare **Miss Indigo**, a half-sister to the Listed Pretty Polly Stakes winner and Gr.2 Ribblesdale Stakes-placed **Musetta** (**Cadeaux Genereux**). The third dam, the Gr.3 (then) Premio Omenoni winner **Massorah** (**Habitat**), produced the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 Turf Mile Stakes second **Vanderlin** (**Halling**).



### **ALMANAARA**

Shamardal – Midnight Angel (Machiavellian)

New to the stallion ranks this spring is the grey **Almanaara**, a half-brother to the Gr.1-winning juvenile and leading sire **Dark Angel**, sire of seven Gr.1 winners to date.

Their dam, a daughter of **Machiavellian** (broodmare sire of **Shamardal** himself, plus Gr.1 winners such as **Zoffany**, **Territories**, **Victoire Pisa** and **Al Wukair**), has also produced a Stakes-winning sprinter and is out of the **Night Shift** mare **Night At Sea**, a 5f Listed winner. The next two dams are by the dual Classic and Middle Park Stakes winner **Right Tack** and the Lockinge Stakes and Queen Elizabeth II Stakes winner **Sovereign Path**.

His sire **Shamardal**, an unbeaten two-year-old and dual Classic winner, is responsible for 26 Gr.1 winners to date and his proven stallion sons are headed by **Lope De Vega** (already the sire of 12 Gr.1 winners himself). He also has the likes of **Pinatubo**, **Blue Point** and **Earthlight** to follow on in the coming years.

A 370,000gns yearling, **Almanaara** started his racing career in Ireland, finishing placed at two and easily winning a maiden over just short of a mile at three. He then transferred to Doug Watson in the UAE, winning two valuable handicaps over 6f on dirt and a 5f handicap on turf at Meydan last January, defeating the Gr.2-winning sprinter **Caspian Prince** in the latter.

**Ardad** has a first crop of 91 juveniles that will hit the racecourse this season, representing top juvenile trainers such as Richard Hannon, Simon and Ed Crisford, Karl Burke, Clive Cox and his own trainer John Gosden, who described him as: "very good-looking. There's a lot of **Kodiac** about him."

The son of **Kodiac** was a £170,000 sales-topping Goffs UK Breeze-Up Sale purchase and made a further impact in the sale ring last year as a sire. Top breeze-up consignor Robson Aguiar purchased five of his offspring at the yearling sales, while Peter and Ross Doyle Bloodstock purchased a further four. Simon Sweeting of Overbury Stud reported: "We're hearing very good things. They've got great attitudes and great movement – just like him."

**Ardad** was the best Royal Ascot two-year-old by **Kodiac** and rated the equal of his sire's 2020 Gr.1 Prix Morny winner **Campanelle**. Winner of his first two starts, including the Listed Windsor Castle Stakes in a faster time than **Profitable** and **Cotai Glory** in the Gr.1 King's Stand on the same afternoon, he progressed to win the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes.

He is the first foal out of a half-sister to the dual Stakes winner and dual Group-placed **Ruby Rocket** (**Indian Rocket**), dam of the Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye winner **Maarek**, and the Stakes-winning dam of Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes-placed **Mystery Smiles**.

### **AUSTRIAN SCHOOL**

**Teofilo** – Swiss Roll (Entrepreneur)

**CLONGIFFEN STUD •** Fee €3,000

**Austrian School** began his stallion career last year at Clongiffen Stud and will be welcoming his first foals in the coming weeks.

Trained by Mark Johnston, he was precocious enough to make a winning debut over 1m at two and he followed up in novice company that autumn, making all to score over 1m2f. He returned at three to win on debut again, taking a 1m6f handicap at Chelmsford before winning a competitive handicap at Chester just a week later. In a busy three-year-old season, he earned black type twice when placed in both the Listed Glasgow Stakes and Listed Noel Murless Stakes, and was also placed a further five times in handicap company. At four, he made it a hat-trick of winning seasonal debuts when scoring by six lengths in a Musselburgh handicap over 1m6f and he put up a strong performance to finish third in the Gr.3 Henry II Stakes. On his final start, he was runner-up in the Listed Jockey Club Rose Bowl Stakes over 2m.

He has illustrious siblings under both codes, being a half-brother to the dual Grand National victor **Tiger Roll** (**Authorized**) and to **Ahzeemah** (**Dubawi**), whose victories include the Gr.2 Lonsdale Cup and the Gr.2 Nad Al Sheba Trophy, as well as finishing runner-up in the Gr.1 Irish St Leger. Their dam is the Listed-placed **Swiss Roll** (**Entrepreneur**).



### **AWTAAD**

**Cape Cross** – Asheerah (Shamardal)

### **DERRINSTOWN STUD • Fee €10,000 1st Jan SLF**

The first season with runners is a nervous time for stallion masters but **Awtaad** passed his first test with flying colours. The son of **Cape Cross** was represented by 14 individual winners for a winners-to-runners strike rate of 25 per cent. Those first winners were headed by **Ebeko**, who scored at Leopardstown for Paddy Twomey and went on to land the Listed Zuma Beach Stakes at Santa Anita when transferred to Peter Miller. He was also represented by **A Taad Moody**, who was placed in the Listed Ingabelle Stakes. Those early results meant that his second crop were much in demand at the yearling sales, selling for up to 80,000gns, with trainers investing in his progeny as well as agents, while he attracted another classy book of mares last season. Given **Awtaad**'s own race record, it is reasonable to expect even more to come from his runners this year.

Having broken his maiden over 7f by two lengths at two, **Awtaad** returned at three in March to win again over 7f, before stepping up to Listed class to win the Tetrarch Stakes. Pitched into top-level company next time out in the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas, he showed a powerful turn of foot to take the lead over two furlongs out and stay on well to defeat the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas victor **Galileo Gold** by two and a half lengths. Third in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes, he went on to win the Gr.2 Boomerang Stakes.

Gestüt Auenquelle stands the only son of **Kodiac** in Germany and **Best Solution** has already had his first foals on the ground this season.

Off the mark at his second attempt as a juvenile, he won the Gr.3 Autumn Stakes over 1m at Newmarket before finishing runner-up to subsequent Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero and sire **Waldgeist** in the Gr.1 Critérium de Saint-Cloud. Runner-up in the Gr.1 Grosser Dallmayr-Preis at three, he also won the Gr.3 St Simon Stakes before registering a quartet of back-to-back victories at four in the Gr.2 Princess of Wales's Stakes, Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Berlin, Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Baden and Gr.1 Caulfield Cup. He retired to stud last year with nine victories and seven places from 25 starts, and with earnings of over £2.5m.

He is the second foal out of the **Kingmambo** mare **Al Andalyya**, who is a half-sister to the Gr.2 Prix Hocquart-placed **Cape Clear Island**, also known as **Gorgeous King**. They are out of the Gr.3-placed **Kushnarenkovo** (**Sadler's Wells**), a full-sister to the Gr.1 St Leger hero and sire **Brian Boru** and the Listed winner **Kitty O'Shea**, dam of the Gr.1-placed producer **Kissable** (dam of Gr.1 American Oaks-placed **Amandine**), and a half-sister to the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf runner-up and sire **Sea Moon** (**Beat Hollow**) and the dam of Gr.1 Derby winner and sire **Workforce**.



### **BOBBY'S KITTEN**


**Kitten's Joy** – Celestial Wood (Forestry)

LANWADES STUD • Fee £7,000 1st Oct SLF

**Bobby's Kitten**, a son of the top-class sire **Kitten's Joy**, enjoyed a fine start to his stud career at Lanwades last season with 12 individual first-crop winners, headed by the Gr.2 Beresford Stakes runner-up **Monaasib**, who already has an official rating of 109.

**Bobby's Kitten** was a high-class two-year-old who won the Gr.3 Pilgrim Stakes and was third in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. The following season after being Gr.1-placed again in the Woodbine Mile, he became the only three-year-old ever to win the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint, beating **No Nay Never** by half a length. Briefly transferred to Dermot Weld's yard, he won his only Irish start, the Listed Cork Stakes, by over eight lengths.

He is a full-brother to the Gr.2 American Turf Stakes and Gr.2 National Racing Museum of Racing Hall of Fame Stakes winner **Camelot Kitten**, out of the triple winner **Celestial Woods** (**Forestry**). She is a half-sister to the winning dam of the Argentinian champion and multiple Gr.1 winner **Sixties Song** (**Sixties Icon**). The third dam produced a trio of Gr.1-winning sires in Turf Classic Stakes victor **Wild Event**, Arlington Million Stakes scorer **Paradise Creek** and Manhattan Handicap winner **Forbidden Apple**, while her daughters produced triple Gr.1 winner and sire **David Junior** and the Gr.1 Las Virgenes Stakes heroine **Eden's Moon**.



### **BOW CREEK**

**Shamardal** – Beneventa (Most Welcome)

HARAS DU LOGIS • Fee €4,000 1st Oct SLF

**Bow Creek**, a son of the much-missed outstanding sire **Shamardal**, was represented by his first winners last season and they should progress to better things with time, just as their hard-knocking sire did.

**Bow Creek**, who will stand at an unchanged fee for the 2021 breeding season, won a Chester maiden over seven and a half furlongs as a two-year-old and added the Listed International Trial Stakes at the beginning of his three-year-old season before rounding that campaign off in great style with wins in both the Gr.2 Celebration Mile, in a time faster than **Cape Cross** and **Raven's Pass**, and the Gr.2 Boomerang Mile at Leopardstown on Irish Champions Weekend. He then moved to Australia, where he won the Gr.2 Peter Young Stakes before retiring to stud.

A half-brother to the Gr.3 Lexus Stakes and Gr.3 Craven Plate-placed **Dare To Dream** (**Danehill Dancer**), he is one of eight successful offspring of the Gr.3 (then) Dahlia Stakes winner **Beneventa** (**Most Welcome**), who also won the Listed Snowdrop Stakes and Listed Aphrodite Stakes. Her dam, the dual winner **Dara Dee** (**Dara Monarch**), is a half-sister to the Gr.3 Brownstown Stakes winner and Gr.2 (then) Pretty Polly Stakes-placed **Bay Empress** (**Empery**) and **Jus'Chillin'** (**Elbio**), dam of the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes winner **Orizaba** (**Orpen**).

### **BURATINO**

**Exceed And Excel** – Bergamask (Kingmambo) KILDANGAN STUD • Fee €5,000 1st Oct SLF

Off the mark with plenty of performers from his first crop last season, **Buratino**'s offspring were topped by Gr.2 Beresford Stakes-placed **Snapraeterea**, as well as the valuable sales race performers Tinochio and The Blue Panther.

Picking up two victories and a placing in his first three starts, the son of **Exceed And Excel** was runner-up at Listed level before winning both the Listed Woodcote Stakes and Gr.2 Coventry Stakes, beating Air Force Blue in the latter. Following a brief break he returned to finish third in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes and was then runner-up to **Shalaa** in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes. The speedy juvenile won the Coventry faster than **Calyx** and the Woodcote faster than Pinatubo.

He is the best of five winners out of the Listed-placed Bergamask (Kingmambo), who is a half-sister to a Stakesplaced performer by **Street Cry**, out of the Listed winner and Gr.3 Meld Stakes-placed Adonesque (Sadler's Wells). She is a half-sister to the Champion Two-Year-Old in Ireland. dual Gr.1 scorer and champion sire **Danehill Dancer**, the Gr.3 winner and Gr.2 Lowther Stakes-placed Unilateral (Rock Of Gibraltar) and the Stakes victor and Gr.2 Prix Robert Papin runner-up and sire Colossus (Danehill). This is the further family of the Group-winning sires Mr Greeley, Street Sense and Vekoma.

### **CABLE BAY**

*Invincible Spirit* – Rose De France (Diktat)

HIGHCLERE STUD • Fee £8,000 Special Terms

**Cable Bay** burst on to the scene as Champion First Season Sire in the UK and Ireland in 2019, with his flagbearer **Liberty Beach** winning the Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes.

Last season was a little more understated, but he nevertheless showed he is no one-hit wonder as, along with his star filly placing in the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes and Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye, Jouska, who had been third in the Gr.3 Cornwallis Stakes the previous season, landed the Listed Boadicea Stakes, while his second-crop son Lanegash was second in the Listed Flying Scotsman Stakes. To date, Cable **Bay** has sired a total of 11 black-type performers from just two crops to race.

His returns on the track have seen his progeny suitably in demand in the sales ring. In 2020, 20 of his 21 yearlings found a buyer, the highest priced of which was a full-brother to the aforementioned Lanegash, who was bought by Stroud Coleman Bloodstock for 150,000gns.

Along with his impressive stud record, breeders have been given extra incentive to use his services in 2021, with new 50/50 terms, whereby 50 per cent of the covering fee is payable on 1st October and the other 50 per cent is payable if and when the resulting foal reaches its target price in the sales ring; or Euros 4Euros, which offers **Cable Bay** at €8,000 for non-UK European breeders who are travelling mares.



### **CAMACHO**

**Danehill** – Arabesque (Zafonic)

YEOMANSTOWN STUD • Fee €5,000 1st Oct

That **Camacho** is one of the best-value sires around is hardly news. The beautifully-bred son of **Danehill** has amassed a tally of 29 Stakes performers during his stud career, headed by the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches heroine **Teppal** and top juvenile Signora Cabello, and with his fee now at €5,000, he is certain to be inundated by breeders this year.

In 2020, he added further Stakes winners to his scorecard. including the Gr.3 Athasi Stakes winner With Thanks, as well as **Illegal Smile**, a Stakes winner in the US, the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes-placed Imperial Force, Gr.3-placed Aunty Bridy, who was purchased for 410,000gns at the Tattersalls December Mare Sale, and Listed-placed Secret Time. Last year also saw the sire record his second-highest tally of individual winners as well, with his 75 winners just behind the 79 he recorded in 2019.

As well as getting results on the track, **Camacho** is also a solid source of sales success. His yearlings last year sold for up to 77,000gns, a great return on the €7,500 at which they were conceived, while his breeze-up horses sold for up to 50,000gns.

A half-brother to the leading sire **Showcasing**, as well as the Stakes-placed Bouvardia and Tendu, out of a Listed winner, from a strong Juddmonte family, **Camacho** won the Listed (then) Sandy Lane Stakes and was Gr.3-placed over 7f.

### **CAPPELLA SANSEVERO**

**Showcasing** – Madam President (Royal Applause)

STARFIELD STUD • Fee €4,000 1st Oct FFFR

Standing at Starfield Stud under the Compas Stallions banner is **Cappella Sansevero**, a high-class two-year-old by top sire **Showcasing**.

He had his first runners in 2019 and made a bright start to life at stud, hitting double figures for winners, which were headed up by the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes scorer Pierre Lapin, and this year has had his fee reduced slightly.

Cappella Sansevero won his first three starts on the track, culminating in the Listed (then) Marble Hill Stakes, all before being placed second in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot. He was later third in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes over 6f at the Curragh and highlighted his career when winning the Gr.3 Round Tower Stakes over course and distance.

He is out of the winning Royal Applause mare Madam President, a half-sister to the Gr.2 Ribblesdale Stakes runner-up **Eldalil** (**Singspiel**) and the dam of the Gr.2 Wise Dan Stakes winner and Gr.1 Turf Classic Stakes second Factor This (The Factor). The third dam, Much Too Risky (Bustino), produced the Gr.2 Princess of Wales's Stakes and Gr.3 Gordon Richards Stakes winner and sire Little Rock and the Gr.2 Prix de Pomone winner and dual Gr.1-placed Whitewater Affair (Machiavellian). The latter produced the Japanese champion Victoire Pisa, a triple Gr.1 winner and successful sire.



### **CHARMING THOUGHT**


**Oasis Dream** – Annabelle's Charm (Indian Ridge)

DALHAM HALL STUD • Fee £4,000 1st Oct SLF

Last season saw the first runners by Darley's Charming **Thought** hit the track, eight of whom were successful, headed by the useful-looking **Charterhouse**. John Joseph Murphy's charge was second on debut and ran fourth in the Gr.3 Tyros Stakes before getting off the mark in a sevenfurlong Curragh maiden. He was then pitched into Gr.1 company for the National Stakes and Middle Park Stakes, where he was far from disgraced. He holds an official rating of 105 and it would be no surprise if he became his sire's first Stakes winner in 2021.

From a very classy family, he is out of the Listed Dick Hern Stakes winner and dual Gr.3-placed Annabelle's Charm (Indian Ridge). Her dam is a full-sister to the Gr.1 winners and sires **Aristotle** and **Ballingarry**, and a half-sister to the Gr.1-winning sire **Starborough** and to the dam of the outstanding multiple Gr.1 winner St Nicholas Abbey.

As a son of **Selkirk**, the Gr.1 winner **Cityscape** is that rarest of beasts these days – an outcross, making him an attractive option for all mares.

A winner at two and runner-up in the Gr.2 Royal Lodge Stakes, **Cityscape** went on to win five Stakes contests over 1m-1m1f from three to six, culminating in the Gr.1 Dubai Duty Free as a six-year-old, and was Gr.1-placed a further six times. From a classy Juddmonte family, he is a half-brother to the Gr.2 winner and multiple Gr.1-placed Bated Breath, who enjoyed a stand-out season last year with his runners and stands for more than three times Cityscape's fee.

**Cityscape** made an immediate impact at stud, siring three Gr.3 winners in his first crop - Dan's Dream, Give And Take and the Gr.1-placed Hong Kong miler Ka Ying Star - for a Group winners to runners strike rate of 7.5 per cent. That success resulted in his best book of mares, the progeny of which are yearlings this year. His shuttle trips to South America have also resulted in success, with his Southern Hemisphere progeny led by the Gr.1 winners Top One Scape and Top One City.

Last year, he was also represented in Britain by the Listed winner **Urban Icon**, who was later purchased for 320,000gns at the Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training Sale, while his yearlings sold for up to six times his stud fee.

HARAS DU LOGIS • Fee €7.000 1st Oct SLF

The oldest crop by the high-class **Cloth Of Stars** are yearlings and his first foals sold for up to €75,000 last year. Having covered more than 270 mares in his first two seasons at stud, the son of **Sea The Stars** is sure to be a popular draw again this year.

A Gr.1 performer in each of his four seasons of racing, **Cloth Of Stars** retired with a Timeform rating of 132. Twice a winner at two, including of the Gr.3 Prix des Chênes, he was also twice Group-placed, including when runner-up in the Gr.1 Critérium de Saint-Cloud. At three, he triumphed in both the Gr.2 Prix Greffulhe and Gr.3 Prix La Force and was third in the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris. He went on to run up a sequence of three Group victories, culminating in the Gr.1 Prix Ganay, at four and rounded off his season when runner-up to **Enable** in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. Group-placed four times at five, including three at Gr.1 level, he was once gain placed in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, when he was the first colt home behind **Enable** and **Sea Of Class**. He retired the winner of seven of his 20 races and was placed a further ten times.

He hails from a top-class family, being out of a **Kingmambo** full-sister to the Gr.1 Oaks heroine **Light Shift**, dam of the dual Gr.1 winner **Ulysses**, and half-sister to Gr.1 winner **Shiva**, also a black-type producer, and Gr.2 winners **Limnos** and **Burning Sunset**.

### **COACH HOUSE**

Oasis Dream – Lesson In Humility (Mujadil)

CHAPEL STUD • Fee £2,500 1st Oct LFFR

**Coach House** (**Oasis Dream**) continues to be a good source of speedy precocious types, very much in the mould of their sire who was himself a classy juvenile.

Among his leading progeny are the Listed Redcar Two Year Old Trophy winner **Summer Sands**, who also finished third in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes, and the Listed-placed **The Cruising Lord**, as well as a number of multiple winners, including **Dancing Rave**, who struck seven times from 5f-1m.

**Coach House** made his debut as a two-year-old in April, beaten only half a length in a 5f maiden at the Curragh. He broke his maiden the following month at the second time of asking, when charging home by six and a half lengths over the minimum trip at Tipperary and registered the biggest win of his career later in May when triumphing in the Listed (then) Marble Hill Stakes. Pitched into Group company next time, he acquitted himself well when finishing runner-up to **No Nay Never** in the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes, with successful sire **Coulsty** among those in arrears. On what would be his final start, he finished third in the Gr.2 Railway Stakes over 6f, retiring with a record of two wins and three places from five starts.

He is a half-brother to **Tiger Moth** (**Galileo**), placed in both the Gr.1 Irish Derby and Gr.1 Melbourne Cup last year, from a high-class family.



### **DARIYAN**

**Shamardal** – Daryakana (Selkirk)

HARAS DE BONNEVAL • Fee €8,000

**Dariyan** was unraced as a two-year-old and so it is encouraging for the young sire that he breached the double-figure mark for first-crop winners last season and, better still, that two of them, **Mu Kurkum** and **Princesse De Saba**, were placed in the Gr.3 Prix des Chênes and Gr.3 Prix du Bois respectively.

The son of **Shamardal** hails from an outstanding middle-distance family, nurtured in recent years by the Aga Khan, as one of three Stakes winners and Group performers out of **Daryakana** (**Selkirk**), a top-class racemare who won the Gr.1 Hong Kong Vase. Further back in the family, the names of numerous outstanding racehorses can be found, such as the young sire **Almanzor** and Classic winner **Darjina** (**Zamindar**), as well as the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club winner and sire **Darsi**, to name but three.

It is therefore no surprise that **Dariyan**, although a son of **Shamardal**, often thought of as a speed influence but a winner of the Prix du Jockey Club himself, was a progressive sort. A winner of a 2000m maiden and a 2400m conditions race at Saint-Cloud as a three-year-old, he went on to land the Gr.2 Prix Eugène Adam before ending his debut season with a third-placed finish in the Gr.1 Hong Kong Vase. At four, he took his form to another level again, winning the Gr.1 Prix Ganay and running second in the Gr.1 Prix d'Ispahan.

As a triple Gr.1 winner by the perennial champion sire **Galileo** from an outstanding stallion's pedigree, **Decorated Knight** is a popular draw for breeders.

He retired to the Irish National Stud in 2018 as the winner of eight races, including the Gr.1 Jebel Hatta, Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup and Gr.1 Irish Champion Stakes, with earnings of over €1.5 million and an official rating of 120. The chesnut, who is out of a full-sister to the legendary sire **Giant's Causeway** and blue hen **You'resothrilling** (**Storm Cat**), dam of Gr.1 winners **Gleneagles**, **Happily** and **Marvellous** (all also by **Galileo**), awaits his first runners in the coming months. His first crop of two-year-olds are in training with the likes of John Gosden, Mark Johnston, Sir Mark Prescott, Roger Charlton, Roger Varian, Richard Hannon, Amy Murphy, Kevin Philippart de Foy, Archie Watson, Marco Botti, Andrew Slattery and Adrian Keatley.

Just in case his race record, breeding and pedigree weren't enough of an incentive for breeders to avail of his services, the Irish National Stud recently announced that anyone using the son of **Galileo** in 2021 would receive a free return nomination to him in 2022. Having covered 123 mares in 2020, his biggest book to date, 2021 looks sure to be even busier for **Decorated Knight**.


**Kyllachy** – Poetical (Croco Rouge)

At a reduced fee of just €2,000, the Irish National Stud's Gr.2-winning two-year-old **Dragon Pulse** (**Kyllachy**) has already proved a source of smart performers who are tough and reliable over a variety of distances. He has sired the winners of almost 400 races, with a winners-to-runners ratio of 50 per cent and prize money of more than £4m. The sire of 14 Stakes horses, his best progeny are the Gr.3-winning juvenile and triple Listed scorer **Aethos**, Listed winner and Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes runner-up **Legendary Lunch**, the Gr.3-placed Listed winner I'll Have Another and last year's dual Stakes-winning two-year-old **Wealth Of Love**, plus the Group-placed juveniles **Magical Fire** and **Light My Fire**.

A high-class two-year-old, **Dragon Pulse** broke his maiden over 6f in July before beating future Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes victor **Parish Hall** with a decisive victory in the Gr.2 Futurity Stakes. Closing his juvenile campaign with a fast-finishing second behind subsequent Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas hero **Power** in the Gr.1 National Stakes, he also defeated the dual Gr.1 winner and French Champion Two-Year-Old **Dabirsim** in the Gr.3 Prix de Fontainebleau on his three-year-old debut.

A €120,000 yearling from the family of Gr.1-winning sire **Hayil** and the dual Gr.1-winning Champion Two-Year-Old and sire **Shalaa**, **Dragon Pulse** is one of two winners out of the Gr.3-placed **Croco Rouge** mare **Poetical**.



### **DSCHINGIS SECRET**

**Soldier Hollow** – Divya (Platini)

HARAS DE SAINT ARNOULT • Fee €5,000 LF

2021 is an important year for **Dschingis Secret**, whose oldest crop are now yearlings and will face their first test in sale rings later this year.

The son of **Soldier Hollow** was placed as a juvenile in Germany but showed marked improvement with age and distance. Having broken his maiden over 2200m at Düsseldorf on his three-year-old debut, he went on to be Stakes-placed three times in quick succession, culminating in third place in the Gr.1 Deutsches Derby when beaten only half a length. He registered his breakthrough Group success later that year when triumphing by seven lengths in the Gr.3 St Leger Italiano over 2800m. Better was to come as a fouryear-old when he notched up victories in the Gr.2 Gerling-Preis and Gr.2 Grosser Hansa-Preis, before defeating **Hawkbill** to triumph in the Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Berlin and then going on to beat **Cloth Of Stars** and land the Gr.2 Prix Foy. Returning to the track at five, he repeated his success in the Gr.2 Grosser Hansa-Preis and also finished runner-up to the subsequent Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe victor Waldgeist in the Gr.2 Grand Prix de Chantilly.

He is a full-brother to Gr.1 Deutsches Derby runner-up and Gr.3 winner **Destino**, as well as the Group-placed **Diana Storm** and **Dschingis First**. His winning dam is a full-sister to the Gr.3 winner and black-type producer **Deva** (**Platini**).

An early son of **War Front** to join the stallion ranks in Britain, **Due Diligence** had great success with his first crop of two-year-olds.



**Scat Daddy** – Great Venue (Unbridled's Song)

YEOMANSTOWN STUD • Fee €6,000 1st Oct

**El Kabeir,** a son of the much-missed sire sensation **Scat Daddy**, will see his first runners hit the track in the forthcoming season.

His first yearlings were well received in the sales ring last autumn, with a filly out of Listed Tipperary Stakes winner **Promised Money**, by another Yeomanstown Stud sire **Dark Angel**, fetching 180,000gns from White Birch Farm and Demi O'Byrne, and Peter Brant's operation also went to 125,000gns to secure a colt out of **Prequel**, an unraced full-sister to the Gr.2 July Stakes winner and sire **Alhebayeb**, again by **Dark Angel**. Others sold for as much as 85,000gns and, in all, they averaged over 24,000gns, triple the fee at which they were conceived.

A high-class runner in the US, **El Kabeir** won the Gr.2 Kentucky Jockey Club Stakes at Churchill Downs at two and added the Listed City of Laurel Stakes and the Gr.3 Gotham Stakes at three, as well as being placed in the Gr.1 Wood Memorial Stakes.

He is out of the unraced **Unbridled's Song** mare **Great Venue**, who is a half-sister to the dual Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 Hopeful Stakes-placed sire **Too Much Bling** (**Rubiano**), as well as the Listed winners **Ready For Roses** (**More Than Ready**), **Barnsy** (**Langfuhr**) and **Littlebitabling** (**Carson City**).

A 1,600,000gns yearling, bred by Floors Farming, he is out of the unbeaten Champion Two-Year-Old Filly **Attraction** (**Efisio**), who went on to win two Classics and three other Gr.1s over a mile. **Elarqam** is a half-brother to seven other winners, headed by the Gr.3 winner and sire **Fountain Of Youth** (**Oasis Dream**) and the dual Gr.3-placed **Cushion** (**Galileo**).



Eqtidaar's dam, an Acclamation half-sister to the Group-winning two-year-old Dolled Up, won at two and has also produced the Classic-placed Gr.2 winner and sire Massaat and last year's Gr.3-winning juvenile Mujbar, while the French Classic winner Precieuse is descended from his winning grandam.

After retiring to Newsells Park Stud, **Equiano** moved last year to the Irish National Stud, where he will cover for the first time this coming spring.

The son of **Acclamation** was a winner up to 7f, but his biggest victories came over the minimum trip when he won two editions of Royal Ascot's 5f Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes, as well as the 5f Gr.3 Palace House Stakes, and his eight places included a second in the Gr.1 July Cup over a furlong further.

He is a half-brother to Stakes winners by **Pivotal** and **Oasis Dream**, and he shares his grandam with the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1-placed **Va Bank**.

**Equiano** has already sired 29 Stakes horses, headed by the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint winner **Belvoir Bay** and the high-class sprinter **The Tin Man**, whose nine victories, all over 6f, include the Gr.1 British Champions Sprint, Gr.1 Diamond Jubilee Stakes and Gr.1 Sprint Cup. **Medicine Jack** won the Gr.2 Railway Stakes and was third in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes at two, while **Equilateral** has scored at Listed level and beat all bar **Battaash** in last year's Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes. Of **Equiano**'s clutch of Gr.3 winners, **Strath Burn**, beaten a short head in the Gr.1 Sprint Cup, has sired winners himself from limited opportunities, and **Dakota Gold** has won 13 times to date, including the Gr.3 Bengough Stakes and five Listed races and was successful on his last three starts of 2020.



### **ESTIDHKAAR**

**Dark Angel** – Danetime Out (Danetime)

TARA STUD • Fee €5,000 1st Oct

The Markus Klug-trained filly **Belcarra**, a Listed winner at Hannover in October, and the Luciano Vitabile-trained colt **The King Geremia**, who was Listed-placed in Italy in August, were among the first crop of runners by **Estidhkaar**. His winners of 2020 also included the dual French winner **Forefront** and the Lambourn-trained filly **Rania**, who also scored twice.

His yearlings have made up to 140,000gns, and his placed son **Arqoob** changed hands for 65,000gns last autumn at the Tattersalls Horses in Training Sale.

A £200,000 Doncaster yearling, **Estidhkaar** is a year-younger half-brother to **Toormore** (**Arakan**), a Gr.1 winner at two who won five other Pattern races. Their dam was unraced, but is a granddaughter of Gr.3 winner **Peace Girl** (**Dominion**), second dam of Gr.3 winner **Hawridge Prince**.

Trained by Richard Hannon, **Estidhkaar** won three in a row as a juvenile, starting with a Newbury maiden, the Gr.2 Superlative Stakes, which he won by an impressive four and a half lengths, and the Gr.2 Champagne Stakes at Doncaster. He finished second behind the subsequent champion **Muhaarar** in the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes at three and rounded off his racing career with a Listed victory of Group quality over 1m at Newmarket.

### **FAR ABOVE**

**Farhh** – Dorraar (Shamardal)

STARFIELD STUD • Fee €6,000

**Far Above** may have raced only five times, but that was all it took to show himself as a sprinter right out of the top drawer.

The son of **Farhh** was a six-figure breeze-up purchase but made his winning debut as a three-year-old, successful in the well-regarded Alex Scott Maiden Stakes over 7f at Newmarket. He was stepped up into Listed company next time out but met with his only defeat, before bouncing back to winning form in style at Windsor, cruising home five lengths in front in a 6f novice contest. The time was ripe for a return to Stakes company and he was pitched into the Listed Prix Kistena over 1200m at Deauville, showing plenty of early speed before staying on well to claim victory. That was the colt's final start at three and he would race only once more, returning at four to defeat a field of classy sprinters and triumph in the Gr.3 Palace House Stakes, a race with a good reputation as a proving ground for sires. In his only start over 5f, Far Above hit the front with three furlongs to go and stayed on well to win.

He is out of the 7f-winning **Shamardal** mare **Dorraar**, a half-sister to five winners and out of **Dorrati**, an unraced daughter of **Dubai Millennium**. She is a half-sister to the dual Gr.1 winner **Nahrain** (**Selkirk**), who went on to produce the outstanding **Benbatl** (**Dubawi**), as well as the dual Listed winner **Baharah** (**Elusive Quality**).



### **FASCINATING ROCK**

**Fastnet Rock** – Miss Polaris (Polar Falcon)

BALLYLINCH STUD • Fee €5,000

A dual Gr.1-winning son of top international sire **Fastnet Rock**, **Fascinating Rock** made a solid start with his first crop of two-year-olds last season. His winners included the debut scorer **Forbidden Beauty** and the triple winner **Killer Mamba** from limited runners. A progressive type himself who ran only once at two, his progeny will no doubt improve as they mature, with recent US scorer **Earls Rock**, an impressive three-year-old winner at Santa Anita this month, an early example.

A dual Gr.3 winner over 1m2f at three, he secured a Listed victory over 1m and a third Gr.3 success over 1m2f at four, before finishing second in the Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup, in front of Gr.1 winners **Postponed**, **The Grey Gatsby** and **Parish Hall**. He rounded off his four-year-old campaign with a comfortable Gr.3 win over 1m4f and victory in a top-class renewal of the Gr.1 Champion Stakes, defeating five Gr.1 winners. He again finished ahead of his Champion Stakes runner-up **Found** when going one better to land the Tattersalls Gold Cup as a five-year-old.

He is out of the winning **Polar Falcon** mare **Miss Polaris**, a full-sister to the Listed scorer **Euro Falcon**. This is the family of Gr.2 winners **Gothenberg** and **Nancy From Nairobi** and, further back, the top-class Japanese runners **Cesario**, **Epiphaneia** and **Saturnalia**.



### **FIGHTING IRISH**

**Camelot** – Ouixotic (Pivotal)

HARAS D'ANNEBAULT • Fee €3,000 LF

A new addition to the Haras d'Annebault stallion roster is the Classic-placed Gr.2 juvenile winner **Fighting Irish**, the only 6f Group winner by top young sire **Camelot**.

At two, after breaking his maiden over 6f in July, he easily made all to land a nursery before quickening up smartly to win the Gr.2 Critérium de Maisons-Laffitte, in which he beat the triple Gr.2-placed juvenile **Nebo**, who won the Gr.3 Horris Hill Stakes on his next start. Third in the Gr.2 Mehl-Mülhens-Rennen over 1600m at three, he also finished ahead of the Gr.1-winning juveniles **Sioux Nation** and **Unfortunately** in the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup, when less than three lengths behind the winner.

A €50,000 foal and a £70,000 yearling bred by Kilcarn Stud, Fighting Irish is a half-brother to three winners, out of the unraced Pivotal mare Quixotic, a full-sister to Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes winner and sire Virtual and a half-sister to the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes victor and Gr.1-placed sire Iceman (Polar Falcon). From the top-class Cheveley Park Stud family of Gr.1 2,000 Guineas winner and sire Entrepreneur and Gr.1 Coronation Stakes heroine Exclusive (dam of Gr.1 Matron Stakes scorer Echelon, herself dam of the dual Gr.1-winning miler Integral), the Stakes-placed second dam Virtuous (Exit To Nowhere) is also half-sister to the grandam of Classic-placed Gr.1 E P Taylor Stakes heroine Lahaleeb.



### **FLAG OF HONOUR**

**Galileo** – Hawala (Warning)


NATIONAL STUD • Fee £3,000 LF

The first foals are now due by the Gr.1 Irish St Leger winner Flag Of Honour, one of nearly 90 Gr.1 winners by his all-conquering sire Galileo.

Trained by Aidan O'Brien, he won twice as a juvenile, including the Gr.3 Eyrefield Stakes. He landed a hat-trick of wins at three, winning the Gr.2 Curragh Cup, Gr.3 Irish St Leger Trial (beating subsequent Gr.1 Melbourne Cup winner **Twilight Payment**) and then the Gr.1 Irish St Leger, in which he again defeated **Twilight Payment**, as well as Gr.1 Irish Derby winner **Latrobe**. At four he finished second three times behind the seven-time Gr.1 heroine **Magical**, including in the Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup and Gr.2 Mooresbridge Stakes.

Retired to The National Stud last year, primarily as a National Hunt sire, he attracted a select first book of mares, which included the dams of the Graded-winning hurdlers **Hawk High** and **Stoney Mountain**, and a half-sister to Gr.1 St Leger winner and sire **Brian Boru**.

Flag Of Honour is a half-brother to three other Group/ Listed winners, including the sires Air Chief Marshal (sire of Gr.1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud winner Mont Ormel) and Misu Bond, plus the Classic-placed Foxtrot Romeo. Their dam, by Warning, is a half-sister to two black-type winners, the third dam won three Listed races and the fourth dam is the third dam of Gr.1 Cheltenham Gold Cup winner Sizing John.



### **FLASH GORDON**

**Kodiac** – Oasis Sunset (Oasis Dream)

MEELIN STUD • Fee €1,500

New to stud this year is **Flash Gordon**, a Group-placed son of **Kodiac**, who is now making an impact as a sire of sires with his sons **Adaay**, **Coulsty**, **Kodi Bear** and **Prince Of Lir** all doing well with their first runners last year.

Unraced at two, **Flash Gordon** made a winning debut in April at three, triumphing over 6f at Naas by three lengths. Next time out, he earned his first black type when third in the Listed Tetrarch Stakes over 7f. Jumped up into Group class on his third start, he again acquitted himself well, finishing third in the Gr.3 Lacken Stakes to the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed **So Perfect** and Gr.3 winner **Gustavus Weston**. He returned at four to earn further black type when placed in the Listed Sole Power Sprint Stakes over 5f at Naas behind the classy sprinter **Make A Challenge**.

A 220,000gns yearling, he was bred by Gigginstown House Stud out of the juvenile winner **Oasis Sunset** (**Oasis Dream**). She is a half-sister to the Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes heroine **Seazun** (**Zieten**), who went on to finish fourth in the Gr.1 1,000 Guineas at both Newmarket and the Curragh, and the Gr.3-placed duo **Albertinelli** (**Danehill**) and **Albert Einstein** (**Danehill**), as well as the Listed-placed **Mahogany** (**Orpen**). Another half-sister is the dam of the high-class middle distance performer and sire **Universal** (**Dubawi**).

High Chaparral – Polished Gem (Danehill)

Free Eagle made a solid start to his stallion career with 12 juvenile winners in 2019, for a winners-to-runners strike rate of 29 per cent. Even better was to come last year when his tally went to 32 winners and a strike rate of 35 per cent. His winners last year were headed by Khalifa Sat, winner of the Listed Cocked Hat Stakes before finishing runner-up in the Gr.1 Derby, while Auxilia was Listed-placed, adding to the Listed success of Justifier in 2019, who is now racing in Hong Kong as Beauty Smile.

He recorded his first Group success when landing the Gr.3 Hampton Court Stakes at Royal Ascot by four and a half lengths, finished third next time out in the Gr.1 Belmont Invitational Derby Stakes and was beaten only a short head in the Gr.2 Prix Niel. He returned at four to finish third in Gr.3 company in the US and the H H The Amir Trophy in Doha and continued on his travels all season, racing in six countries in all in 2019, including when recording a well-deserved Gr.2 victory in the Moonee Valley Gold Cup in Australia. He was later sold to continue his career in Qatar, before his return to stud in Ireland this year.

He is a half-brother to the Gr.2 Beresford Stakes victor and sire **David Livingston** (**Galileo**), also placed in the Gr.1 National Stakes, out of an unraced **Indian Ridge** half-sister to the outstanding middle-distance performer and sire **High Chaparral**. That day he quickened up in style to defeat six Stakes winners, including dual Gr.1 winner **Borderlescott**, the Gr.1-placed dual Gr.2 winner **Muthmir** and Gr.2 scorer **Blaine**.

The first foal out of the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 runner-up Infallible (Pivotal), a daughter of the Stakes-winning Cadeaux Genereux mare Irresistible, Intrinsic is a half-brother to the Gr.1 Falmouth Stakes heroine Veracious (Frankel), the dual Gr.2-victor Mutakayyef (Sea The Stars) and Gr.3 scorer Intimation (Dubawi). This is also the high-class family of Gr.1 winner and sire Garswood and the Gr.1-placed juveniles Parliament Square and True Mason.

*Invincible Spirit* – Rajeem (Diktat)


YEOMANSTOWN STUD • Fee €7,500 1st Oct

Having retired to stud last season, the first foals have already arrived for Yeomanstown Stud's young sire **Invincible Army**.

With over 90 per cent fertility, the six-year-old son of **Invincible Spirit** shares the same sire as **Kingman** and **I Am Invincible** and had 60 Group and Stakes producers and performers in his first book.

Runner-up by a short head on his debut to subsequent Gr.1 Derby hero and sire **Masar**, **Invincible Army** won by five lengths next time out. Finishing runner-up in both the Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes and Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes, he won the Gr.3 Sirenia Stakes before finishing the season as runner-up in the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes. Winning the Gr.3 Pavilion Stakes on seasonal debut at three, beating subsequent Gr.1 winner and sire Eqtidaar, he won his first two black-type races at four, topped by the Gr.2 Duke of York Stakes. He went on to land the Gr.3 Chipchase Stakes and finished third in the Gr.1 Flying Five Stakes and fourth in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye in the final two starts of his career.

A Group winner in each of his racing seasons, over varying surfaces and going, he is the best produce to date out of the Gr.1 Falmouth Stakes heroine **Rajeem** (**Diktat**), who is a half-sister to the dams of five black-type performers, topped by the Group winner **Dandhu**. She is out of a placed full-sister to the Gr.1 Prix Morny winner **Hoh Magic** (**Cadeaux Genereux**).



### **JACK HOBBS**

**Halling** – Swain's Gold (Swain)

With the retirement of the legendary 11-time UK champion sire **Kayf Tara**, there are some big shoes to fill at Overbury Stud, but **Jack Hobbs**, the highest-rated horse to retire straight to the National Hunt ranks in Britain since **Kayf Tara**, has great appeal to Flat breeders and jumps alike

He was runner-up in the Gr.1 Derby to stablemate **Golden Horn**, but gained his Classic victory next time out when a dominant five-length winner of the Gr.1 Irish Derby. Timeform subsequently rated him no less than 129 and he went on to add the Gr.1 Dubai Sheema Classic to his CV as a five-year-old, beating a high-class field which included three other Gr.1 winners, having twice been placed in the Gr.1 Champion Stakes.

He has covered over 400 mares in his first three seasons at Overbury Stud, with his first foals making up to and in excess of ten times his covering fee. "He's been very popular with the Elite Mares Scheme", commented Overbury's Simon Sweeting, "and the quality of mares he's being sent is sure to give him every chance of making a great impact."

### **JAMES GARFIELD**


**Exceed And Excel** – Whazzat (Daylami)

RATHBARRY STUD • Fee €4,000

The well-bred **James Garfield**, whose first crop arrived last year, set a new juvenile track record when winning the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes at Newbury. That was his sixth outing of 2017, by which time he had already won a Doncaster maiden by six lengths and been beaten just a nose in the Gr.3 Acomb Stakes. He started his Classic campaign with a defeat of subsequent Gr.1 winner **Expert Eye** in the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes, but was deemed not to have stayed when unplaced in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, though he was only just over four lengths adrift of the winner. Dropped back in trip afterwards, he was a half-length second in the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest, defeating Gr.1 winners **The Tin Man**, **Librisa Breeze** and **Brando**.

He is by **Exceed And Excel**, who has sired 16 Gr.1 winners and whose stallion sons **Excelebration**, **Helmet** and **Sidestep** are among those who have sired Gr.1 winners themselves.

His dam **Whazzat** (**Daylami**) was a Listed winner at two and is a half-sister to the 1600m Gr.3 winner **Whazzis** (**Desert Prince**) and to the dam of the four-time Gr.1 winner **Uni**. His grandam is a **Generous** half-sister to Gr.1 Prix de Diane winner **Rafha** (**Kris**), dam of **Invincible Spirit** and **Kodiac** amongst others, as well as to the dams of Gr.1 winners **Chinese White** and **Pride Of Dubai** and to the third dam of the champion **Pinatubo**.



### **JIMMY TWO TIMES**

**Kendargent** – Steel Woman (Anabaa)

HARAS DE MONTAIGU • Fee €4,000 LF

**Jimmy Two Times** began his stud career in Germany and moves to France this year to join the roster at Haras de Montaigu as his oldest crop become yearlings.

The son of **Kendargent** earned his place at stud with a teak-tough race record. Twice successful at two, he ended his juvenile season when placed 2nd in Listed company. He returned at three to finish runner-up by a head to the subsequent Gr.1 winner **Quiet Reflection** in the Gr.3 Prix Sigy over 1200m and went on to score his first Group victory later that season, when successful in the Gr.3 Prix de la Porte Maillot. Third in the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest next time out, he returned at four to win the Gr.3 Prix Edmond Blanc on debut. Having been privately purchased by Godolphin, he carried the royal blue colours to victory on his next start in the Gr.2 Prix du Muguet, and was later Group-placed five times as a five-year-old, from 1400m-1600m on ground ranging from good to heavy.

A half-brother to three winners, he is out of the juvenile winner **Steel Woman**, a daughter of **Anabaa** and a half-sister herself to six winners, out of the German Gr.3 winner **Saperlipoupette** (**Highest Honor**), also Gr.2-placed in Italy. **Kendargent** has long enjoyed a reputation as a successful sire and he is proving himself as a good sire of sires as well, with such as **Goken**.



### KING OF CHANGE

**Farhh** – Salacia (Echo Of Light)

**DERRINSTOWN STUD •** Fee €7,000 1st Jan SLF

Fresh on the roster this season is **King Of Change** (**Farhh**), who never finished outside the first two in all six starts during his two-year career. Runner-up in two starts as a juvenile, he won on seasonal debut at three over an extended mile at Nottingham, before finishing runner-up to **Magna Grecia** in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas. Having won the Listed Fortune Stakes, he then ended his career on a high with Gr.1 glory in the Queen Elizabeth II Stakes, beating eight Gr.1 winners, including the Classic winners **Magna Grecia** and **Phoenix Of Spain**, as well as the globe-trotting **Benbatl**. The new recruit is a son of **Farhh**, who has achieved an enviable 15 per cent Stakes winners and ten per cent Group winners from his first two crops.

He is a half-brother to the classy **Century Dream** (**Cape Cross**), who won the Gr.2 Celebration Mile and the Gr.3 Diomed Stakes twice, as well as being placed in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes. They are out of a winning daughter of **Echo Of Light**, a son of **Dubai Millennium** whose stud career was cut short. **Salacia**'s first four foals are all winners and she is a half-sister to a trio of black type-placed siblings, out of the Gr.3 Prix Fille de l'Air winner and US Gr.2 runner-up **Neptune's Bride** (**Bering**). The third dam is the Gr.3 Prix de Ris-Orangis winner and dual Gr.2-placed **Wedding Of The Sea** (**Blushing Groom**).



### **KODI BEAR**

**Kodiac** – Hawattef (Mujtahid)

2020 was a strong year for first season sires, with the recordbreaking **Mehmas** in command, but the 18 individual winners sired by **Kodi Bear** saw the son of **Kodiac** become the second-leading Irish-based first-crop sire.

His record is not just one of quantity – there was plenty of quality in his runners as well. The Listed victor **Cobh** became his sire's first Stakes winner and went on to be placed in the Gr.2 Royal Lodge Stakes, while **Measure Of Magic** was placed in the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes and **Broxi**, **Mystery Angel** and **Scarlet Bear** were all placed at Gr.3 level, the latter in both the Firth of Clyde Stakes and the Dick Poole Fillies' Stakes before selling for 155,000gns at the Tattersalls December Mare Sale. Unsurprisingly, **Kodi Bear**'s second crop of yearlings found plenty of friends in the sale ring, selling for up to £110,000.

A tough and talented juvenile himself, **Kodi Bear** trained on into a high-class miler. Successful in the Listed Winkfield Stakes, he finished runner-up to **Belardo** in the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes and returned at three to triumph in both the Gr.2 Celebration Mile and the Gr.3 Sovereign Stakes, as well as the Listed Midsummer Stakes.

He is a half-brother to the winning dam of two Stakes winners in Italy, while his further family includes the top miler **Esoterique** and high-class juvenile **Cool Creek**.

### **KUROSHIO**

**Exceed And Excel** – Arctic Drift (Gone West)

**Kuroshio** made an immediate impact with his first crop of Northern Hemisphere juveniles, achieving a strike rate of 43 per cent black-type performers to runners in 2018, from a limited number of representatives. Those first runners are headed by **Kurious**, winner of the Gr.3 Sprint Stakes in 2019 and purchased for 900,000gns at last year's Tattersalls December Mare Sale. That first crop also included the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes runner-up **Dunkerron**, the Gr.3-placed **Siculi** and the Listed-placed **Daphinia**.

Since taking up stud duties under the Compas Stallions banner in 2019, **Kuroshio** has been well supported, covering over 220 mares in the last two seasons.

By the all-conquering speed source **Exceed And Excel**, the Australian-bred **Kuroshio** was himself a high-class juvenile, recording his biggest success in the Gr.3 Blue Diamond Prelude. He trained on well at three, landing the Gr.2 McEwan Stakes over 1000m at Moonee Valley and was also placed in the Gr.2 Schillaci Stakes at Caulfield, also over the minimum trip.

He is a full-brother to the Gr.3 winner **Believe'N'Succeed**, dam of the Gr.1 Derby victor **Anthony Van Dyck** (**Galileo**) and the Gr.1 Railway Stakes winner **Bounding** (**Lonhro**), out of a winning **Gone West** daughter of the dual US Gr.1 winner **November Snow** (**Storm Cat**).

**No Nay Never** – Theann (Rock Of Gibraltar)

Proving popular on debut at stud last year, Highclere Stud's **Land Force** covered a quality book of 155 mares and will have his first foals arriving this season.

The son of **No Nay Never** was a €350,000 Goffs Orby graduate who got off the mark at the second attempt as a juvenile by over two lengths, before gaining a Stakes place on his third start. Third in the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes on his first attempt in Group company, he landed the Listed Tipperary Stakes before claiming victory in the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes. In his penultimate start at two, he was fourth in the Gr.1 Prix Morny.

His eight-start juvenile campaign was managed by Aidan O'Brien before he switched to Paul Snowden for one start in Australia and returned to the UK to stand at stud.

Land Force is a half-brother to the Gr.1 First Lady Stakes and Gr.1 Rodeo Drive Stakes heroine Photo Call (Galileo), out of the Gr.3 Summer Stakes winner Theann (Rock Of Gibraltar). She is a daughter of the dual Gr.2 winner Cassandra Go (Indian Ridge), who also produced the triple Gr.1 winner and Irish 1,000 Guineas heroine Halfway To Heaven (Pivotal), dam of the seven-time Gr.1 heroine Magical and triple Gr.1 scorer Rhododendron, and the Gr.3 winner Tickled Pink (Invincible Spirit), amongst others. This is the immediate family of Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas runner-up and sire Verglas.



Lightly-raced but unbeaten at two and three, **Lightning Spear** also won his first two races at four before stepping into Group company and, of his remaining 23 races, 19 were at Gr.1 level and the other four were in Gr.2s.

He won three times more, collecting Goodwood's Gr.2 Celebration Mile in 2016 and 2017 and picked up his biggest win when beating the likes of **Expert Eye** and **Lord Glitters** in the Gr.1 Sussex Stakes in 2018. He was also placed eight times, including when a short-head second in the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes, when beaten three quarters of a length in the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes and when beaten one and a half lengths in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes, in which he still finished in front of Classic winners **Awtaad**, **Galileo Gold** and **Jet Setting**.

The Gr.1-placed Stakes-winning juvenile **Luck Of The Kitten**, a US-bred by leading American turf sire **Kitten's Joy**, returns to Centro Equino Arcadia in Italy following two seasons at Haras d'Annebault in France, having initially stood his first season there in 2018. His first crop, conceived in Italy, are now two-year-olds and hopes are high they can make their mark on the racecourse this year, followed by their sire's French-bred crops.

Trained by Wesley Ward and campaigned exclusively on turf, he broke his maiden over 1m in August 2014 and stepped up from a runner-up effort in Listed company next time to readily land the Zuma Beach Stakes. An excellent second in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf behind **Hootenanny**, in which he defeated a trio of Graded winners, he was also runner-up in the Gr.3 Transylvania Stakes at three.

Bred and raced by Kenneth and Sarah Ramsey, he is a full-brother to five winners, headed by the dual Gr.3-placed triple Stakes victor **Empire Builder**, out of the Stakes-placed dual turf winner **Anura** (**Giant's Causeway**). The German Listed-placed second dam **Shastri** (**Alleged**) is a half-sister to the Gr.1-placed Gr.2 winner **State Shinto** (**Pleasant Colony**), out of the US Gr.2 heroine **Sha Tha** (**Mr Prospector**), also runner-up in the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches and third in the Gr.1 Prix Marcel Boussac.



### MARKAZ

**Dark Angel** – Folga (Atraf)

**DERRINSTOWN STUD •** Fee €3,000 1st Jan SLF

**Markaz** was a winner in each of his three seasons' racing, with ten of his starts being over 7f and the remaining nine at a furlong less.

He was successful at Ascot as a two-year-old and then finished second three times, including in Newmarket's Gr.3 Somerville Tattersall Stakes. At three he landed the Gr.3 Criterion Stakes, scoring by the best part of two lengths, and finished second in the Gr.2 Park Stakes, fourth (beaten just over two lengths) in the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes and fifth, though only just over a length behind the winner, in the Gr.2 Challenge Stakes. At four he won the Gr.3 Chipchase Stakes, finished second in Germany's top sprint, the Gr.2 (then) Goldene Peitsche, and was beaten two and a half lengths in the Gr.2 Hungerford Stakes.

The son of **Dark Angel** had his first runners last year and, after realising up to €76,000 at the 2019 yearling sales, they included ten winners in several different countries. Last season's Richard Hannon-trained dual winner **Mark Of The Man** was later sold for 75,000gns at Tattersalls.

**Markaz** is a full-brother to **Mecca's Angel**, a winner of ten races, including two editions of the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes. Their dam is a Listed-placed half-sister to French Listed scorer **Desert Kaya** (**Bikala**), out of the Gr.3-winning **Belfort** mare **Desert Dawn**.



### **MAYSON**

**Invincible Spirit** – Mayleaf (Pivotal)

CHEVELEY PARK STUD • Fee £4,000 1st Oct SLF

2020 was a landmark year for **Mayson**, who celebrated his first top-level scorer when **Oxted** emulated his sire by triumphing in the Gr.1 July Cup. He was also responsible for the Listed Prix Moonlight Cloud winner **Maystar** and a trio of Listed-placed performers, including the juvenile **Country Carnival**.

He has already carved himself a niche as a solid producer of speedy, talented types, with his previous flagbearers including the Gr.1 Prix Morny third **True Mason**, as well as the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes third **Global Applause**, Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes third **May Girl** and the twice Gr.3-placed pair **Dance Diva** and **Laugh A Minute**.

**Mayson**'s sale yearlings last year sold for up to more than seven times the fee at which they were conceived, while his breeze-up horses last year achieved up to six times their conception fee.

A son of the successful sire of sires **Invincible Spirit**, he was himself a classy juvenile performer, breaking his maiden by five lengths over 5f in June, before landing a valuable conditions contest and finishing runner-up in Listed company. Listed-placed at three, he achieved his Stakes breakthrough at four when triumphing first in the Listed (then) Abernant Stakes and then the Gr.3 Palace House Stakes, before winning the July Cup by five lengths.


### **MILLOWITSCH**

**Sehrezad** – Muriel (Fath)

GESTÜT RÖTTGEN • Fee €3,000 1st Oct FR

**Millowitsch** has an exciting year ahead of him as his first crop are now yearlings. A winner on debut at two, he won three of his four starts as a juvenile, finishing third in Gr.3 company on his only other outing. He returned at three to land the Gr.3 Dr Busch Memorial over 1700m and finished fourth in the Gr.2 Mehl-Mülhens-Rennen on his only other start that season. He resumed winning ways at four in a Listed contest over 1600m and added two further Gr.3 victories to his tally that season, over 1200m and 1700m respectively. At five, he triumphed in a further pair of Gr.3 races, winning over 1600m at Düsseldorf on his seasonal debut and also claiming the Silberne Peitsche at Baden-Baden over 1200m. In addition to his victories, he was also placed in Group company on a further five occasions from 1200m to 1600m.

Much the best son of few foals by his triple Group-winning sire **Sehrezad**, he is a half-brother to the Gr.3-placed **Ming Jung (Kallisto)** and the Listed-placed **Maha Kumari (Soldier Hollow)**. Their dam, the **Fath** mare **Muriel**, was a smart performer in a light career, finishing placed in the Gr.3 Silberne Peitsche and in Listed company, and winning at two over 1200m. She is a half-sister to **Gifted Girl (Azamour)**, a Listed winner who was Gr.1-placed in the Beverly D Stakes in the US. Their unraced dam is a half-sister to the Gr.1 Irish Oaks heroine **Margarula (Doyoun)**.



### **MONDIALISTE**

**Galileo** – Occupandiste (Kaldoun)

HARAS D'ANNEBAULT • Fee €4,000 LF

After standing his first three seasons at Elwick Stud, **Mondialiste**, a dual Gr.1-winning son of **Galileo** from an outstanding Gr.1 family, switches to Haras d'Annebault.

His eagerly anticipated first crop of two-year-olds will hit the track this season off the back of encouraging sales results last year, with his yearlings selling for up to 60,000gns and £47.000.

Unraced at two and third in the Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat at three for André Fabre, **Mondialiste** developed into a high-class Gr.1 performer with a potent turn of foot over a number of seasons for David O'Meara, winning four Stakes races from 1m to 1m2f and finishing Group-placed a further four times. His biggest victories were in the Gr.1 Woodbine Mile Stakes and the Gr.1 Arlington Million, but he was also a fast-finishing second in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Mile and twice runner-up in the Gr.2 York Stakes.

The outstanding sprinter **Muhaarar** (**Oasis Dream**) enjoyed a great season last year, recording Group success with both his first and second crops.

His first-crop runners, now four-year-olds, include the beautifully-bred **Paix**, successful in the Gr.3 Prix du Lutèce, the Gr.3 Musidora Stakes runner-up **Albaflora** and the Gr.3 Brownstown Stakes runner-up **Unforgetable**, later purchased for 320,000gns by Japanese interests at the Tattersalls December Mare Sale. His juvenile performers included the Gr.3 Horris Hill Stakes winner **Mujbar**, as well as **Baradar**, who scored twice and finished third in the Gr.1 Futurity Trophy, the Gr.2 Rockfel Stakes third **Alba Rose** and **Giuliana**, who was third in the Gr.3 Anglesey Stakes.

He has enjoyed strong support from breeders since his retirement, covering top-class mares in each of his seasons at stud and that quality is also reflected in the sale ring, where his yearlings sold for up to €210,000 last year.

He made a fast start to his own racing career, breaking his maiden by four lengths on debut in May and went on to win the Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes, before finishing third in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes. 
Invincible Spirit – Angel Falls (Kingmambo)

A €280,000 Arqana August Yearling Sale graduate and the French Champion Two-Year-Old Colt of 2016, **National Defense** made an eye-catching debut when scoring by six lengths at Deauville, then was third in Chantilly's Gr.3 Prix des Chênes. He bounced back four weeks later on the same course when making all and quickening well in the closing stages to take the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardère by four and a half lengths. He ended his first campaign with a Timeform rating of 118p and, at three, finished second behind subsequent Gr.1 winner **Al Wukair** in the Gr.3 Prix Djebel.

He is one of 20 Gr.1 winners to date by Invincible Spirit, whose stallion sons include Kingman, I Am Invincible, Lawman and Mayson, all sires of Gr.1 winners. A half-brother to two Stakes horses, he is out of a Kingmambo half-sister to three black-type winners and his next two dams were Group winners. The Gr.1 winners and sires Epaulette and Helmet are listed under his fourth dam, as is the Gr.1-winning filly Anna Monda, and he descends from the German champion Anna Paola, also ancestress of Classic winner Billesdon Brook and the five-time Gr.1-winning hurdler Annie Power.

His first runners will hit the track this season and they were headed at last year's sales by a €75,000 Goffs Orby Sale filly from the family of **Phantom Gold**.



### **OUTSTRIP**

Exceed And Excel – Asi Siempre (El Prado)

DALHAM HALL STUD • Fee £4,000 1st Oct SLF


With 23 winners from his first crop of juveniles, **Outstrip**'s offspring are topped by a quartet of black-type performers, headed by the Gr.2 Prix Greffulhe winner **Gold Trip**, who was also third in the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris and fourth in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe.

His other performers include the Gr.3 Florida Oaks winner **Outburst**, the Listed National Stakes scorer **Flippa The Strippa** and the dual German Listed-placed **La La Land**. His yearlings also achieved up to €50,000 last year at the Arqana October Yearling Sale.

The grey son of **Exceed And Excel** won or was placed in all five juvenile starts, including winning the Gr.2 Champagne Stakes by three lengths, beating **The Grey Gatsby** and **Cable Bay**, and the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf by half a length, beating **Bobby's Kitten**. He was also runner-up in the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes by a neck and third in the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes. At three he was third in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes and fourth in the Gr.1 Sussex Stakes.

He is the second foal and winner out of the Gr.1 Spinster Stakes heroine **Asi Siempre** (**El Prado**), who is out of an unraced half-sister to the Gr.3 (then) Norfolk Stakes winner and sire **Magic Mirror** (**Nureyev**) and Group-placed sires **Sun Worship** (**Nonoalco**) and **The Miller** (**Mill Reef**), the latter was third in the Irish St Leger.

**Pearl Secret**, who was represented by his first winners last season, is perhaps the best chance the **Byerley Turk** line has of survival, and he stands at a slightly reduced fee for the 2021 season.

The son of the successful stallion **Compton Place**, who was himself by **Indian Ridge**, was a hard-knocking sort who won at two and added the Listed Scurry Stakes at three. At four he was third in the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes at Royal Ascot and continued to race for two more seasons, being placed second in the Gr.2 Temple Stakes over five furlongs at Haydock before going one better the following year. He also won the Listed Beverley Bullet, as well as running fourth in the King's Stand Stakes again and in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye at Longchamp.

Bred by Whitsbury Manor Stud and Pigeon House Stud, he is out of the **Rossini** mare **Our Little Secret**, who won the Listed City Wall Stakes over the minimum trip and is out of **Sports Post Lady**, who is a half-sister to the 1000m Gr.3 Premio Omenoni winner **Palacegate Episode** (**Drumalis**) and the dam of the Gr.1 Prix Morny and Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes winner and multiple Gr.1 sire **Dutch Art**. More recent members of the family include **Monarch Of Egypt** (**American Pharoah**), who was second in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes.



### **PLANTEUR**

**Danehill Dancer** – Plante Rare (Giant's Causeway)

CHAPEL STUD • Fee £3,000 1st Oct LFFR

The highest-earning son of **Danehill Dancer**, **Planteur**, amassed over £2.2m from his 12 Stakes victories and placings. His career was highlighted with a Gr.1 Prix Ganay victory and runner-up finishes in the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris, Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club and Gr.1 Prix d'Ispahan, twice, as well as third in the Gr.1 Dubai World Cup.

Standing at Haras de Bouquetot for his first five seasons, he switched to Haras du Grand Courgeon for 2019 and 2020 before relocating over the English Channel to Chapel Stud.

His progeny have achieved success under both codes and last October his four-year-old son **Trueshan** claimed an impressive seven and a half-length victory in the Gr.2 British Champions Long Distance Cup. The timely update ahead of his first British season is the highlight of seven black-type winners under both codes and five black-type-placed performers on the Flat to date. Although there were no yearlings on offer at public auction last year, his Listed-placed daughter **Golconda** lit up the sale ring at the Tattersalls December Sale, selling to Gerrardstown House Stud for 210,000gns in foal to **Justify**.

The sire is a half-brother to the dam of **Persian King**, the triple Gr.1 scorer, including the Poule d'Essai des Poulains, who has retired to stand at Haras d'Etreham this season and is from the immediate family of the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club and Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner and sire **Peintre Celebre**.



### **POMELLATO**

**Big Shuffle** – Passata (Polar Falcon)

HARAS D'ANNEBAULT • Fee €3,500 LF

Pomellato, a son of leading German sprint sire Big Shuffle boasts an impressive 56 per cent lifetime winners to runners ratio, with an even more impressive 11 per cent black-type horses to runners. These include Pom Malpic, from his first crop of juveniles since returning to France, placed in the Listed Prix La Flèche last year. He also has the Listed winner and Gr.2-placed Kamellata and the multiple Gr.3-placed Another Party, while Flavin is a Graded winner in the National Hunt sphere, landing the Gr.3 Grand Prix de la Ville de Nice. His current juveniles are in training with the like of Nicolas Clement, Alain de Royer Dupré and Henri-Alex Pantall.

Lightly-raced, **Pomellato** won three of his four starts, all of which were as a two-year-old, including the Gr.3 Zukunfts-Rennen and the Gr.2 Critérium de Maisons-Laffitte, while his only defeat came when a close fourth in the Gr.1 (then) Gran Criterium, earning him German Champion Two-Year-Old Colt honours.

A half-brother to the Gr.3 St Leger Italiano winner **Parivash** (**Singspiel**) and a full-brother to the Listed-placed Pom Pom Pom, dam of the Listed scorer **Paloma Ohe** (**Rio De La Plata**), he is out of the winning **Polar Falcon** mare **Passata**. She is a daughter of the Gr.3 Furstenberg Rennen winner **Premier Amour** (**Salmon Leap**), who was also third in the Gr.1 Prix de Diane.




From only a small book of foals from his first crop, **Protectionist** was rewarded with two black-type performers last season.

**Milka** was runner-up in a 1600m Listed race at Düsseldorf in August, while **Amazing Grace** was runner-up in the Listed Winterkönigin Trial over 1500m in soft going at Cologne in September before backing that up with a further placing the following month over 1600m and in similar conditions in the Gr.3 Preis der Winterkönigin at Baden-Baden.

His yearlings achieved highs of €85,000 and €75,000 at the BBAG Premier Yearling Sale last year, having been knocked down to Stall Salzburg and Australian Bloodstock.

Rajasinghe had his first foals go through the sales ring last year and they achieved excellent results. The six that were offered were all sold, at an average of 29,500gns, nearly ten times what his covering fee will be in 2021. The top price was the 50,000gns Phil Cunningham gave for a colt out of Bakoura (Green Desert), whose two runners to date are winners, while Redpender Stud almost matched that when giving 46,000gns for a colt out of Louya (Verglas), who is already the dam of a winner.

Rajasinghe was a precious sort who made a winning debut at Newcastle in May as a two-year-old and landed the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot next time out, clocking the fastest time ever recorded for a two-year-old over six furlongs at Ascot. He was a good third in the Gr.2 July Stakes on his next start.

He is out of the Listed-placed Bunditten (Soviet Star), who was fourth in the Gr.2 Queen Mary Stakes at the Royal Meeting. Including Rajasinghe, she has produced eight winners, notably the Listed-placed Kurland (Kheleyf), who was also fourth in the Queen Mary Stakes. The second dam is the dual Listed winner and Gr.3 Prix Eclipse-placed Felicita (Catrail), who comes from the family of the multiple Gr.2winning Australian sprinter Super Cash and Batavian, a Gr.2 winner and Gr.1-placed in New Zealand.

Raven's Pass dips below the €10,000 mark for the first time in his stud career in 2021. A promising juvenile debut at Newbury, where he finished third after a slow start and didn't get much room when it mattered, was followed by a game victory over 7f at Newmarket (subsequent Gr.1 winner **Ventura Storm** finished third). He was pitched into Pattern company next time and, despite being slowly away, ran on well to win the Gr.3 Acomb Stakes, also over 7f. Sadly, injury prevented him from running again.

He retired to Sumbe, Montfort et Préaux in 2018 and was a popular new recruit, covering a first book of 152 mares. The resulting crop of yearlings sold well last autumn, reaching prices of up to €70,000 and €65,000 at Arqana, and were snapped up by astute buyers such as MAB Agency, Guy Petit, Rabbah Bloodstock and Oceanic Bloodstock. His first crop of two-year-olds are in training with the likes of Clive Cox, Jean-Claude Rouget, the Botti brothers, Pascal Bary, Cedric Boutin, Pia Brandt and Fabrice Chappet.

A son of **Galileo**, he is a full-brother to US Gr.2 winner **Call To Mind** and a three-parts-brother to Gr.3 winner **Learn By Heart**. Their dam **Memory** (**Danehill Dancer**) beat subsequent Gr.1 winners **Margot Did** in the Gr.3 Albany Stakes and **Hooray** in the Gr.2 Cherry Hinton Stakes, and his next three dams all earned black type.

# **RELIABLE MAN**

**Dalakhani** – On Fair Stage (Sadler's Wells)

GESTÜT RÖTTGEN • Fee €6,500 1st Oct SLF

Having spent the last three seasons in France, **Reliable Man** returns to Gestüt Röttgen, where he successfully began his stallion career.

The son of **Dalakhani** enjoyed another memorable year in 2020, siring five Stakes winners and 13 black-type performers, headed by the Gr.1 Kingston Town Classic heroine **Inspirational Girl**, conceived while her sire was on shuttle duties in New Zealand and one of a trio of Southern Hemisphere top-level scorers for their sire. He also sired a quartet of Stakes winners in Europe, including three winners in Germany, among them the Gr.3-placed duo **Adrian** and **Moonlight Man**, as well as **Quiet Times**, who enjoyed Listed success at Deauville in December.

**Reliable Man** continues to be a popular draw in the sale ring as well, with his yearlings selling for up to €95,000 last year, an impressive return on the €7,000 at which that crop was conceived.

It is little surprise that **Reliable Man** has such strong cross-hemisphere appeal, having scored at the highest level both sides of the equator. Having made a winning debut in April as a three-year-old in France, he triumphed in the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club on only his third start and was also placed in the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris. Sent to continue his career in Australia, he landed the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth Stakes at five.





# **RIVER BOYNE**


**Dandy Man** – Clytha (Mark Of Esteem)

New to Tara Stud this spring is **River Boyne**, who was bred by Limestone and Tara Studs and started his racing career with Gordon Elliott. He moved to Jeff Mullins in California late in his first season, winning a Santa Anita turf maiden by five lengths and followed up by winning his first two three-year-old outings, including a 1m Stakes race. Campaigned in Stakes company thereafter, he won a Gr.3 over an extended mile at Del Mar that August and later scored twice at Gr.2 level at Santa Anita, finishing a close second in the Gr.1 Hollywood Derby in between. Graded-placed three times at four, he picked up another Gr.3 success along with his biggest victory last year at five, landing the Gr.1 Frank E Kilroe Mile. That day he gave weight to and defeated dual Gr.1 winner Got Stormy, with another top-level winner, **Next Shares**, back in third. In all, he won or finished in the frame in 16 of his 18 runs in Group/Listed company.

He is one of three Gr.1 winners by his popular sire **Dandy Man** and his dam has produced four other winners by four different sires. She is a daughter of **Mark Of Esteem** (also broodmare sire of Classic/Gr.1 winners such as **Avenir Certain**, **Treasure Beach** and **Crystal Ocean**) and is a half-sister to the 1m Group winner **Ventiquattrofogli** and three other Stakes horses. The family descends from the Gr.2 (then) Coronation Stakes winner **Sutton Place**.

# **ROYAL LYTHAM**

**Gleneagles** – Gotlandia (Anabaa)

**CLONGIFFEN STUD •** Fee **€4,000** 

The high-class Gr.1-placed and Gr.2-winning two-year-old **Royal Lytham** retires to stand at Clongiffen Stud as the only son of promising young sire **Gleneagles** at stud in Ireland.

Trained by Aidan O'Brien, he unleashed a classy turn of foot to score on debut in a 5½f Navan maiden in early June, before reappearing just ten days later when a running-on seventh in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot. An athletic and progressive type, he improved again on his next start, quickening up impressively from well off the pace to land the Gr.2 July Stakes, a race also won by last year's Champion First Season Sire sensation **Mehmas**. He rounded off his juvenile campaign with a fine third in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes, rallying late and displaying a good attitude on unsuitably soft ground to finish just a length behind subsequent Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas victor **Siskin**, despite his saddle slipping when exiting the stalls.

A €180,000 Arqana yearling bred in France by Haras du Logis Saint Germain, **Royal Lytham** is a half-brother to two winners, out of the Listed winner and Gr.3 runner-up **Gotlandia** (**Anabaa**), a half-sister to the Stakes-placed **Gaiete** (**Kentucky Dynamite**). His winning second dam **Grenade** (**Bering**) is a full-sister to the Gr.1 Fillies' Mile heroine **Glorosia**, herself the dam of the Gr.2-placed German Stakes scorer **Gentle Tiger**.

# **RUMBLE INTHEJUNGLE**

**Bungle Inthejungle** – Guana (Dark Angel)

The fast and precocious Gr.3-winning juvenile **Rumble Inthejungle**, a son of promising young sire **Bungle Inthejungle**, starts his stallion career at Norman Court Stud.

An eye-catching debut winner over 5f in May, on his second start, he displayed plenty of speed to finish fourth in the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes. On his next start he unleashed a potent turn of foot from off the pace to secure an impressive victory in the Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes, with subsequent Gr.2 winner and multiple Gr.1-placed sprinter **Soldier's Call** back in third. # **SCHIAPARELLI**

**Monsun** – Sacarina (Old Vic)

Overbury Stud's **Schiaparelli** is now firmly established as a superior sire of high-class National Hunt performers. **Ronald Pump** finished second in the Gr.1 Drinmore Novice Chase at Fairyhouse and Gr.1 Stayers' Hurdle at the Cheltenham Festival last season. This term he was runner-up in the Gr.1 Hatton's Grace Hurdle on his second start.

Further Festival success was achieved by his impressive daughter **Indefatigable**, who won the Martin Pipe Conditional Jockeys' Handicap Hurdle, and **Whatmore** made the frame in one of the novice chases. **Schiaparelli** achieved sales prices up to £42,000 last year and has further promising bumper performers rising through the ranks.

During his own racing career he won at the top level five times, including the Gr.1 Deutsches Derby and Gr.3 Deutsches St Leger, as well as being twice Gr.1-placed, including in the Prix Royal-Oak. He is a full-brother to the Deutsches Derby hero and sire **Samum** and the Gr.1 Preis der Diana heroine and producer **Salve Regina**, as well as the unraced dam of the Deutsches Derby scorer and sire **Sea The Moon**.



# **SEABHAC**

**Scat Daddy** – Curlin Hawk (Curlin)

HARAS DE SAINT ARNOULT • Fee €5,000 LF


**Seabhac**, whose first crop of foals arrived last year, is by the dual Gr.1 winner **Scat Daddy**, sire of five Royal Ascot winners, as well as the unbeaten **Justify**, and his next four sires were also all Gr.1 winners at two.

**Seabhac** himself, a \$170,000 purchase at the Keeneland September Yearling Sale, was a Gr.3 winner on turf at two, landing the Gr.3 Pilgrim Stakes over an extended mile at Belmont Park. He scored readily from the favourite **Voting Control**, who went on to finish third in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf.

His trainer Todd Pletcher, who also trained **Scat Daddy**, said: "**Seabhac** was a very forward-training juvenile who reminded me of his sire at two. A \$1,100,000 yearling, he was a very precocious and high-class two-year-old for Aidan O'Brien, who was second to subsequent Gr.1 winner **Skitter Scatter**, also by **Scat Daddy**, on his debut in April. He also won twice over 5f, including his maiden by seven and a half lengths in the same month and the Listed Rochestown Stakes, all before coming third in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot. A real speed merchant, races could hardly be run fast enough for him and he highlighted his career back down over the minimum trip in the autumn of his debut season with a stunning victory in the Gr.3 Cornwallis Stakes at Newmarket, scything through the field to come from last to first from a furlong and a half out and win well, and he returned to win the Listed Cork Stakes over an extended 5f on his first start at three.

Bred by Anderson Farms in Canada, he is out of **Orchard Beach**, who is by the world-class sire **Tapit** and a half-sister to the Gr.3 Hollywood Juvenile Championship Stakes winner **Necessary Evil (Harlan's Holiday)**. His grandam, **Song And Danz**, and third dam, **Danzig Til Dawn**, are also by leading US sires in **Unbridled's Song** and **Danzig** respectively.



# **SHAMAN**


**Shamardal** – Only Green (Green Desert)

YEOMANSTOWN STUD • Fee €6,000 1st Oct

Bred by Wertheimer and Frère, **Shaman** is the newest recruit on the roster at Yeomanstown Stud for this season.

The five-year-old son of the now deceased **Shamardal** got off the mark at the first attempt as a juvenile before finishing runner-up in a Listed race and placed in the Gr.3 Prix des Chenes. At three he landed a Listed race and the Gr.3 Prix La Force on his first two starts of the season before finishing runner-up to **Persian King** in the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and fifth in a competitive renewal of the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes. Following a 54-day break he was second to **Romanised** in the Gr.1 Prix Jacques Le Marois and ended the season with third place in the Gr.2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein. In a brief campaign last term he won the Gr.2 Prix d'Harcourt, beating both **Way To Paris** and **Sottsass**, and finished third in the Gr.1 Prix Ganay.

He is a half-brother to a triple Listed winner and the winning dam of the Gr.3-placed My Kurkum, both by Smart Strike, out of the dual Listed scorer and Gr.3-placed Only Green (Green Desert). She is a half-sister to the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest and Gr.1 Prix de la Forêt heroine Occupandiste (Kaldoun), dam of the dual Gr.1 hero and sire Mondialiste and the Gr.2 winner and dual Gr.1-placed producer Impressionnante, dam herself of the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club winner and sire Intello.



# **SIR PERCY**

Mark Of Esteem – Percy's Lass I (Blakeney)


LANWADES STUD • Fee £7,000 1st Oct SLF

Lanwades Stud's evergreen Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes and Gr.1 Derby hero **Sir Percy** was also runner-up in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas and has sired 49 Stakes performers to date, with progeny earnings of over £9m.

These are topped by two Gr.1 winners, while **Berkshire Rocco** was runner-up in the Gr.2 Queen's Vase and the Gr.1 St Leger, the latter by a mere neck, before claiming a Stakes win last season. **Percy's Lad** was unbeaten in two starts last year as a juvenile prior to finishing second in the Gr.3 Horris Hill Stakes. Other black type performers in 2020 included the Gr.3 Robert J Frankel Stakes-placed **Never Be Enough**, while the Gr.3 Prix d'Aumale and Gr.1 Prix Marcel Boussac-placed **Flighty Lady** added a further two Group placings to her cv.

With his yearlings in demand last autumn, two colts achieved a high of 150,000gns at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale Book 2, when knocked down to Stroud Coleman Bloodstock and A C Elliott/Spicer Thoroughbreds. His yearlings at Book 2 averaged £112,875 in 2020, over 16 times his 2018 fee.

The son of **Mark Of Esteem** is a full-brother to the winning dam of triple Group winner and Gr.1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud runner-up **Mikhail Glinka** and the Gr.1-winning hurdler **Chicago**, amongst others. This is the family of Gr.1 winners **Braiswick**, **Favoletta**, **Olympic Glory**, **Rule Of Law**, **Teenoso**, **Prince Bishop**, **Ashayer** and **Give Thanks**, amongst others.

# **SIXTIES ICON**

Sixties Icon has proved a versatile sire, with winners from 5f to 2m and on all types of going. His three top-level winners have all come from his shuttle stints to Argentina, where the majority of races are over short trips of up to 1600m and are mostly held on dirt.

That said, his top son **Sixties Song**, now at stud himself, won his three Gr.1 races over 2400m, Crazy Icon was a topflight winner over 2000m and Hennie Six landed her Gr.1 over 1600m. The British-bred Nancy From Nairobi was a Gr.2 winner over 1m at Santa Anita, the Irish-foaled Sixties **Groove** won his Gr.2 over 2400m at Eagle Farm in Australia and, of Sixties Icon's Gr.3 winners in Europe, Chilworth Icon won his at two, Epsom Icon landed hers at three and Czabo hers at four. His Czech-trained son Nagano Gold has been a terrific servant to connections, winning Listed races in France and finishing a close second in the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud and Gr.2 Hardwicke Stakes.

By dual Classic winner **Galileo**, out of Gr.1 Oaks winner **Love Divine (Diesis)**, and from the family of dual Gr.1 winner and sire **Legal Case**, **Sixties Icon** was a Classic winner himself, defeating ten rivals in the Gr.1 St Leger the year it was held at York. He won seven other races from three to five, including the Gr.2 Jockey Club Stakes and four Gr.3 contests.

Smooth Daddy is a son of the late-lamented Scat Daddy, sire of the unbeaten champion Justify, as well as Royal Ascot winners Caravaggio, Lady Aurelia, No Nay Never, Acapulco and Sioux Nation. The next four sires, Johannesburg, Hennessy, Storm Cat and Storm Bird, were all Gr.1 winners at two, which should bode well for his own first crop next year.

His dam was a multiple Stakes winner of ten races in the US and has produced two other Stakes horses. The Gr.1winning two-year-old **Sioux Nation**, also by **Scat Daddy**, is listed under his Stakes-placed third dam, who is by Raise A Native, and Classic winners Secreto and Caracolero come under his Stakes-placed fourth dam.

Smooth Daddy was trained by Thomas Albertrani and won four races from an extended mile to 1m2f. He was also placed 12 times, including twice in Graded company as a three-year-old, for earnings of nearly \$500,000. His victories came at Gulfstream Park, Saratoga and twice at Belmont Park, and included the 1m1f Gr.3 Fort Marcy Stakes, a race in which he had finished second 12 months earlier. In the 2017 renewal, he got the better of the multiple Group/Graded winners Time Test and Messi, both of whom were placed at

# **SOMMERABEND**

**Shamardal** – Sommernacht (Monsun)



**Sommerabend** begins his seventh season at Haras de Saint Arnoult and, with his fee remaining unchanged at €4,500 when most are falling, it is clear that his stock is continuing to rise.

That should come as no surprise as, from relatively small crops, he boasts a 46 per cent winners to runners ratio, many of whom are speedy. Of his winners to date, **Santurin** was third in the Gr.2 Mehl-Mülhens Rennen, while his very first winner **Tudo Bem** was a close fourth in the Gr.3 Prix du Bois over 1000m.

**Sommerabend** was himself unraced at two and won his sole start at three. At four, he progressed to win the Listed Grand Prix Anjou-Bretagne and the Gr.2 Grosse Europa Meile, as well as being placed in the Gr.3 Prix du Pin and the Gr.3 Prix Perth. He continued to race until he was seven, winning twice more at Listed level, as well as landing the Gr.3 Prix Edmond Blanc and Gr.2 Prix du Muguet.

He is by the outstanding **Shamardal** and is a half-brother to the Gr.3 Baden Wurttemberg Trophy winner **Sommertag** (**Tiger Hill**) and two other Stakes performers, out of the Listed winner and Gr.3 Premio Primi Passi runner-up **Sommernacht** (**Monsun**). She hails from the family of Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Berlin winner **Sirius** (**Dashing Blade**) and Gr.1 Hollywood Turf Cup winner **Sanagas** (**Lomitas**).



# **SON OF REST**

**Pivotal** – Hightime Heroine (Danetime)

MEELIN STUD • Fee €3,000

The classy sprinter **Son Of Rest** takes up stallion duties at Meelin Stud this year, looking to add to his sire **Pivotal's** fine record at stud.

Trained by Fozzy Stack, he proved himself a tough performer over five seasons of racing. Second on debut in August at two, he was pitched straight into Gr.1 company next time out, acquitting himself well to finish fourth in the Gr.1 National Stakes. He broke his maiden first time out at three, hacking up by six and a half lengths over 5f at Cork, and went on to land a valuable 5f handicap at the Curragh before finishing third to Caravaggio in the Gr.2 (then) Flying Five Stakes and being beaten only a neck when second in Listed company at the end of the season. He returned at four to be Listed-placed over an extended 5f and went on to finish a fast-closing second in the Gr.1 Flying Five Stakes behind Havana Grey. Next time out, he contested the ultracompetitive Ayr Gold Cup and dead-heated for victory with Baron Bolt, with the pair four lengths clear of the thirdplaced Flying Pursuit.

Bred by Cheveley Park Stud, **Son Of Rest** is out of **Hightime Heroine** (**Danetime**), who scored over 6f and has also produced two other multiple winners. She is a half-sister to the Listed winner **Pepita** (**Sir Prancealot**) and the Listed winner and Gr.1-placed **Redolent** (**Redback**).

Haras de Saint Arnoult's grey stallion **Stormy River** continues to produce the goods with 21 Stakes performers to date over both codes. These are headed by the Gr.2 Critérium de Maisons-Laffitte and Gr.3 Prix Eclipse winner **Sans Equivoque**, the Gr.3 Prix de Psyché winner and Gr.2 Prix de la Nonette runner-up **Leaupartie**, the Gr.3 Prix du Lys and Listed winner **Remus De La Tour**. as well as the triple Stakes scorer **Tara River**.

The son of **Verglas** was a juvenile winner and runner-up in the Gr.1 Critérium International and started off his three-year-old campaign with victories in the Listed (then) Prix Djebel and Gr.3 Prix de Fontainebleau. He was third, within three quarters of a length of the winner, in the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and runner-up in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes before winning the Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat. In a further three Gr.1 starts he finished runner-up in the Prix du Moulin and fourth in both the Prix Jacques Le Marois and Prix de la Forêt. In his final season he added the Gr.3 Prix Messidor to his cv, along with a placing in the Gr.1 Prix d'Ispahan at a very soft Longchamp.



Bred by La Lumierè Partnership and racing in the Cheveley Park Stud silks, having been purchased for 100,000gns at the Tattersalls December Foal Sale, **Threat** retires to Haras du Mont Goubert this year.

The four-year-old son of **Footstepsinthesand** got off the mark on debut at two over 5f in early May. After finishing runner-up in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes and Gr.2 Richmond Stakes, he went on to triumph in the Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes and Gr.2 Champagne Stakes. Finishing the season with a creditable fifth in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes, he opened his light campaign last year with the same position in a high-class renewal of the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes.

He is the second foal out of the unplaced Flare Of Firelight (Birdstone), who is a half-sister to the Listed winner and Gr.2 Prix Corrida runner-up That Which Is Not (Elusive Quality) and the dams of the Group-placed pair Radiantly and Eltezam. They are out of the Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup heroine Shiva (Hector Protector), who was also runner-up in the Gr.1 Champion Stakes and third in the Gr.1 Eclipse Stakes. **Tiberian** made headlines around the world during his racing career, as the son of a teaser who took his owners around the globe and he will write the next chapter this spring with the arrival of his first foals.

By the German Gr.3 winner **Tiberius Caesar**, who served as the teaser stallion at Haras du Logis, as well as covering a handful of mares on his own account, **Tiberian** was a high-class campaigner, displaying his talent and grit over five seasons of racing

Having broken his maiden over 3000m in August at three, he went on to be second in the Gr.2 Prix Chaudenay two months later. At four, he was beaten a short neck in the Gr.2 Prix du Conseil de Paris, and as a five-year-old, twice defeated the subsequent Gr.1 winner **Talismanic**, including in the Gr.3 Prix d'Hedouville, before adding the Gr.3 Prix de Reux and Gr.2 Grand Prix de Deauville to his tally, then contesting the Gr.1 Melbourne Cup, finishing seventh. At six and seven, he continued to contest Stakes races on a regular basis and retired with a record of six wins and five places from 30 starts.

**Tiberian** is out of the Listed-placed winner **Toamasina** (**Marju**), a half-sister to the Stakes-placed **Lady Weasley** (**Zieten**) out of a winning half-sister to the Gr.1 Deutsches Derby victor **All My Dreams**, as well as the dam of the Gr.1 Beverly D Stakes heroine **I'm A Dreamer** (**Noverre**).



# **TIME TEST**

**Dubawi** – Passage Of Time (Dansili)

NATIONAL STUD • Fee £8,500 1st Oct SLF

The National Stud's **Time Test** has his first runners this season and they will be under the tutelage of trainers such as Karl Burke, Richard Fahey, William Haggas, Richard Hannon and Roger Varian.

The nine-year-old is a son of **Dubawi**, the same sire as of the young stallions **Night Of Thunder** and **New Bay**, who are making their mark at stud. His yearlings achieved up to 150,000gns and 120,000gns at last year's Tattersalls October Yearling Sale Book 2, when selling to Blandford Bloodstock and Shadwell Estate Company respectively, and he covered a book of 125 mares last season.

Finishing in the first two past the post in three juvenile starts, **Time Test** scored his third victory on his second three-year-old start in the Gr.3 Tercentenary Stakes, before finishing fourth in the Gr.1 Juddmonte International Stakes. Winning the Gr.2 Joel Stakes on his final start that season, he gained a further two Group wins in the Gr.3 Brigadier Gerard Stakes and Gr.2 York Stakes at four, as well as a Gr.1-placing in the Eclipse Stakes. Switching to Chad Brown for his final season, he finished runner-up in three Graded races, two at top level, including the Manhattan Stakes.

He is out of the Gr.1 heroine **Passage Of Time (Dansili)**, who is a half-sister to the Gr.1-winning producer **Timepiece** (**Zamindar**), from the family of Gr.1 hero and sire **Twice Over**.



# **TWILIGHT SON**

**Kyllachy** – Twilight Mistress (Bin Ajwaad)

CHEVELEY PARK STUD • Fee £5,000 1st Oct SLF

Twilight Son enjoyed a successful first season with his runners, his daughter Aria Importante ending up as one of Italy's leading juveniles. She won her first four starts, which included the Gr.3 Premio Primi Passi and Listed Premio Eupili by an aggregate of 13 lengths, before finding only one too good in October's Gr.2 Gran Criterium. The Irish-trained Grammata was Listed-placed at Naas, while Winning Star and Charlie's Jamboree were multiple winners at two, the former already successful again in 2021.

Unbeaten in two runs at two, **Twilight Son** also landed his first three races at three, including a valuable 6f handicap at York and then the Gr.1 Sprint Cup at Haydock Park, after which only Muhaarar finished in front of him in the Gr.1 British Champions Sprint. He picked up a second Gr.1 success at four in the Diamond Jubilee Stakes, with five other toplevel winners among his defeated opponents.

His first crop of yearlings realised up to 130,000gns and a daughter of his was sold for 210,000gns at the breeze-up sales. His second-crop yearlings made up to 70,000gns for a colt from the family of **Showcasing** and **Camacho**, and £62,000 for a colt out of a half-sister to five Group/Listed winners.

One of three Gr.1-winning sprinters by Kyllachy, he is a halfbrother to two black-type winners and from the family of the Group-winning two-year-olds On Tiptoes and Violette.

Ultra was the French Champion Two-Year-Old of 2015, when his unbeaten season comprised a debut win at Clairefontaine (with subsequent Gr.1 winner Mont Ormel back in third), a defeat of subsequent Gr.2 winner Royal Julius at Longchamp and then victory in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardère. In that 1600m contest, he landed the spoils in a record time, leaving Classic/Gr.1 winners Galileo Gold, Johannes Vermeer and Ventura Storm behind him. Sadly, he was only lightly raced thereafter, but still showed plenty of ability at four.

**Monsun** sired plenty of handsome and capable sons, not least **Ultra**'s sire, the triple Gr.1 winner and World Champion Manduro, who was responsible for five other Gr.1 winners. A half-brother to Gr.3 winner Synopsis (In The Wings), Ultra is out of the Nashwan mare Epitome, whose Gr.2-winning dam Proskona (Mr Prospector) produced a Gr.2 winner and is the third dam of dual Gr.1 winner and sire Act One. The many Pattern winners under the third dam Konafa (Damascus) include Gr.1 winners Hector Protector, Bosra Sham, Shanghai, Ciro, Red Giant, Passinetti and the Hong Kong stars California Memory and Golden Sixty.

**Ultra** will have his first runners this season, having been supported by many of the major commercial French breeders, and has juveniles in training with the likes of Rod Collet, Yann Barberot, Joanna Hughes and Frederic Rossi.

Stepping up into top-level company next time out, he was beaten less than three lengths in the Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat on his final start at three. On his sole start at four, he finished runner-up over 1600m at Deauville. He retired with a record of four victories and two places from seven starts.

He is regally bred, being a son of the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches heroine **Torrestrella (Orpen)**, who has also produced **Intilaaq (Dynaformer)**, successful in the Gr.3 Rose of Lancaster Stakes, and the Italian Gr.3 winner **Farmah**. Their dam is a half-sister to the Listed-placed **Torrealta (In The Wings)**, grandam of the Group-placed trio **Scalambra**, **Assiro** and **Heuristique**.


