A'ALI

Society Rock – Motion Lass (Motivator) NEWSELLS PARK STUD • Fee £7,500 1st Oct SLF

Royal Ascot-winning two-year-old **A'Ali** will stand his first season at Newsells Park Stud this year. He was initially due to stand at Meadow Farm Stud, but after the Newsells team saw him parade at the National Stud in December they were so impressed that they purchased a significant share in the multiple Group winner.

He is the best son of Champion European First Season Sire **Society Rock** and was a lightning fast juvenile. He won the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes at Royal Ascot on his second start and followed up the following month by winning the Gr.2 Prix Robert Papin at Deauville, and he also collected the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes that September. At three he won the Gr.3 Sprint Stakes at Sandown and followed up in the Gr.2 Sapphire Stakes at the Curragh, before finishing fourth to **Battaash** and the older horses in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes.

Jockey Frankie Dettori said: "**A'Ali** was a top-class sprinter and certainly one of the fastest two-year-olds I have ridden. He travelled very well in his races and had push-button acceleration, which made my life easy. I was lucky enough to ride both **Mehmas** and **Ardad**, and **A'Ali** must have a top chance of replicating their success at stud."

He is out of a placed **Motivator** half-sister to Gr.3 Darley Stakes winner and Gr.1 Coronation Cup-placed **Enforcer** (**Efisio**) and the Stakes-placed **Canaveral** (**Cape Cross**). The second dam **Willowy Mood** (**Will Win**) was a Gr.3 winner in the US and also ran third in the Gr.1 Mother Goose Stakes.



AFFAIRE SOLITAIRE


Danehill Dancer – Arlesienne (Alzao) HARAS D'ANNEBAULT • Fee €3,500 LF

Affaire Solitare is relocating from Italy to Haras d'Annebault this season, having spent three years at Allevamento Razza Ticino, and he will be the only son of **Danehill Dancer** standing in France.

From a crop of just seven foals in his first crop last year, he has had seven runners and two winners, including maiden winner **Say The Truth**, trained by Gian Marco Pala, with every prospect of improvement at three.

Affaire Solitare was second on his only start at two behind subsequent Stakes winner Wire To Wire and broke his maiden at three. He won a further two races at four and was placed in two Listed races before his Gr.3 victory in the Prix Exbury and he finished his season with a second to **AI Kazeem** in the Gr.2 Prix d'Harcourt. Tough and consistent, the following year he was placed a further twice in those same Group races.

From a leading Wildenstein family, he is a half-brother to Listed winner and multiple Group-placed sire **Aizavoski** (**Monsun**), Stakes winner **Andromeda Galaxy** (**Peintre Celebre**) and the Stakes-placed **Altamira** (**Peintre Celebre**), the dam of Gr.1 Prix du Moulin runner-up **Akatea** (**Shamardal**). They are out of the Listed scorer **Arlesienne** (**Alzao**), who is a full-sister to Gr.1 Beverly D Stakes and Gr.1 Diana Handicap winner **Angara**.

ALHEBAYEB

Dark Angel – Miss Indigo (Indian Ridge) TARA STUD • Fee €3,000 1st Oct terms

Alhebayeb (Dark Angel) enjoyed another good year on the track in 2021, with Stakes winner **Cathkin Peak** flying the flag. The three-year-old ran second in the Gr.2 Twilight Derby and third in the Gr.1 Hollywood Derby in the US for Philip d'Amato, while Listed scorer **Talk Or Listen** recorded a career best when coming second in the Gr.2 Dinner Party Stakes. He boasts a 47 per cent lifetime winners to runners ratio and his progeny have earned over €3 million in prize money. The sire of five Stakes winner, these also include the Gr.3 Premio Guido Berardelli winner **Aurelius In Love**, Listed Testimonial Stakes winner **Lustown Baba** and **Abama**, who landed the Listed Prix Zeddaan.

A precious type, **Alhebayeb** won on debut in June, was second in the Listed Windsor Castle Stakes at Royal Ascot before landing the Gr.2 July Stakes, and he also came second in the Gr.3 Horris Hill Stakes that year. He is a half-brother to the Listed Scarbrough Stakes winner and Gr.3 Sprint Stakesplaced **Humidor (Camacho**), who was also fourth in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes. They are out of **Miss Indigo (Indian Ridge**), a half-sister to the Listed Pretty Polly Stakes winner and Gr.2 Ribblesdale Stakes-placed **Musetta (Cadeaux Genereux**). The third dam, the Gr.3 (then) Premio Omenoni winner **Massorah (Habitat**), produced the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 Turf Mile Stakes second **Vanderlin (Halling**).



ALKUMAIT

Showcasing – Suelita (Dutch Art) CASTLEFIELD STUD • Fee €5,000 1st Oct terms

Gr.2-winning juvenile **Alkumait** joins the growing roster at Castlefield Stud in Co. Kilkenny this season. The son of **Showcasing** was trained by Marcus Tregoning for Shadwell, which purchased him for 220,000gns at Tattersalls Book 1 from Baroda Stud and was bred at the home of his sire at Whitsbury Manor Stud. He was a smart two-year-old, winning on his second start over six furlongs at Goodwood by an impressive two and a quarter lengths and taking the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes at Newbury in a record time.

Owners Capital Bloodstock are going to support him with some of their best mares and are also offering an impressive bonus scheme of $\leq 100,000$ to breeders who support the Group-winning sprinter. The bonus is for the first horse from his first crop to become a black-type winner as a juvenile. It covers Ireland, Britain, France and the US, and the breeder will receive $\leq 50,000$ and the trainer and owner will each receive $\leq 25,000$.

Alkumait is a half-brother to Listed Committed Stakes winner The Broghie Man (Cityscape) and Listed-placed Gloves Lynch (Mukhadram), out of the winning Dutch Art mare Suelita. She is a half-sister to Gr.3 Cornwallis Stakes runner-up Outer Space (Acclamation) and to the dam of Gr.2 Lowther Stakes scorer Living In The Past (Bungle Inthejungle). The second dam is a half-sister to Gr.3 Pinnacle Stakes winner and EP Taylor Stakes-placed Moment In Time (Tiger Hill).

ALMANAARA

Shamardal – Midnight Angel (Machiavellian) MICKLEY STUD • Fee £3,000 1st Oct SLF

The first foals are due this year for Mickley Stud's **Almanaara**, a winning **Shamardal** half-brother to the Gr.1-winning juvenile and leading sire **Dark Angel** (Acclamation).

Their dam, a daughter of Champion European Two-Year-Old and leading sire **Machiavellian** (broodmare sire of **Shamardal** himself, plus Gr.1 winners such as **Zoffany**, **Territories, Victoire Pisa** and **Al Wukair**), has also produced a Stakes-winning sprinter **Angel's Pursuit** (**Pastoral Pursuits**), who was also second in the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes. The second dam, **Night At Sea** (**Night Shift**), a five-furlong Listed winner, is the dam of eight winners, including the US Stakes-placed **Vikings Bay** (**Intikhab**). The next two dams are by the dual Classic and Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes winner **Right Tack** and the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes and Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes winner **Sovereign Path**.

Bred by Malih L Al Basti, **Almanaara** was a 370,000gns yearling and started his racing career in Ireland for Shadwell. He was placed at two for Dermot Weld and easily won a maiden over just short of a mile at three. He then transferred to Doug Watson in the UAE, winning two valuable races over six furlongs on dirt and a five-furlong handicap on turf at Meydan, defeating the Gr.2-winning sprinter **Caspian Prince** in the latter.


ALSON

Areion – Assisi (Galileo) GESTUT FAHRHOF • Fee €6,000 SLF

Gr.1-winning juvenile and Classic-placed **Alson** retires to Gestüt Fährhof for his first season at stud in 2022. The wellbred son of multiple Champion sire **Areion** was precocious and talented and is from an excellent German family.

Trained as a juvenile by Jean-Pierre Carvalho for owner/ breeder Gestüt Schlenderhan, he won over six furlongs on debut in June and collected the Gr.3 Preis Zukunftsrennen on his fourth outing. He was second to **Victor Ludorum** in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardère before beating **Armory** to win the Gr.1 Critérium International. He switched to André Fabre for his three-year-old campaign and ran third on his first start for the stable in the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains, behind **Victor Ludorum**, won the Listed Prix Matchem over 1400m later in the season, and finished second in the Gr.3 Prix Perth.

Alson is a half-brother to Classic winner Ancient Spirit (Invincible Spirit), who won the Gr.2 Mehl Mülhens-Rennen (2,000 Guineas), out of the dual winner Assisi (Galileo). She is a half-sister to Gr.3 winner Amazona (Dubawi) and the dam of Champion German Older Stayer Apadanah (Holy Roman Emperor). The second dam, Amarette (Monsun), won the Gr.1 Preis der Diana and is a half-sister to Stakeswinning dam of Champion Almandin (Monsun).



BANGKOK

Australia – Tanaghum (Darshaan) CHAPEL STUD • Fee £3,000 1st Oct FFR

Gr.2 winner **Bangkok**, the first son of **Australia** to stand at stud in the UK, retires to Chapel Stud this year as a dual-purpose prospect. Bred by Barronstown Stud, he was a 500,000gns Book 1 yearling and raced in the colours of King Power. Trained by Andrew Balding, he was second on debut as a juvenile to **Sangarius**. He won on debut at three over a mile and a quarter at Doncaster and then won the Gr.3 Classic Trial, beating **Technician** by a length and a quarter. He disappointed in the Gr.1 Derby, but he returned to run second to Japan in the Gr.2 King Edward VII Stakes at Ascot, before finishing off the year with a neck second in the Gr.3 Strensall Stakes and runner-up in the Qatar Derby at Doha. The following year he won the Listed Winter Derby Trial Stakes and was placed in the Gr.3 Winter Derby, but his best run came at five when he won the Gr.2 York Stakes.

By the well-bred Champion **Australia**, he also brings great blood from his dam side. He is a half-brother to Gr.1 winner **Matterhorn** (**Raven's Pass**), Stakes winners **Tactic** (**Sadler's Wells**) and **Yaazy** (**Teofilo**), as well as the Listed-placed **Zahoo** (**Nayef**) and the dam of **Ribchester** (**Iffraaj**). His Stakesplaced dam **Tanaghum** is by leading broodmare sire **Darshaan** and is out of the Champion Filly **Mehtaaf**, who is a half-sister to Champion Sprinter and sire **Elnadim**. It is also the further family of **Mondialist**, **Intello** and **Shaman**, and goes back to **Fall Aspen**.

BATHYRHON

Monsun – Be My Lady (Be My Guest) HARAS DE LA HETRAIE • Fee €3,800 LF

Dual-purpose sire **Bathyrhon** is excelling with his National Hunt horses, with black-type in his first two crops, making him the top French first and second season National Hunt sire. The son of **Monsun** is out of the **Be My Guest** mare **Be My Lady** and, as well as siring a handful of winners on the Flat, is responsible for Gr.1 Gran Criterium d'Autunno winner **Isatis De L'Ecu**, as well as Gr.3-winning three-year-old hurdler **Bathyscaphe** and Listed-placed juvenile hurdler **Igloo D'Estruval**.

Bathyrhon is an outcross to **Sadler's Wells** and has been popular at stud, covering 120 mares in 2021. On the track, he won at three and four over nine furlongs to a mile seven, including the Gr.2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier and Gr.3 Prix Gladiateur. He also ran second, beaten only a neck, in the Gr.1 Prix du Cadran.

Standing 16.2h, he is by leading sire **Monsun** and is a fullbrother to Stakes winner **Beiramar** (dam of Gr.2 Prix Cahudenary-placed **Iskanderhon**) and Gr.2 Diana Trial runner-up **Bolivia**, as well as to the dam of the Listed winner **Belloccio**. They are out of the winning **Be My Lady** (**Be My Guest**), a half-sister to the German Champion Older Miler and sire **Banyumanik** (**Perugino**) and to the dam of Gradedwinning hurdler **Babawi**. The third dam is the German Champion Three-Year-Old Filly **Indigene** (**Hard To Beat**).

BELARDO

Lope De Vega – Danaskaya (Danehill) KILDANGAN STUD • Fee €9,000 1st Oct SLF

European Champion **Belardo** has enjoyed an excellent start at stud with three Group winners and a strike rate of five per cent Stakes winners to runners from his first crop. He is now the sire of ten Stakes horses, including the former Jessica Harrington-trained **Bellabel** from his second crop, who won in Ireland before being exported to America, where she added a Stakes success to her juvenile tally. He has had particular success with fillies, all of his Group winners to date being of the fairer sex. These include Gr.2 Rockfel Stakes and Gr.3 Prestige Stakes winner **Isabella Giles**, Gr.3 Prix Miesque scorer **Lullaby Moon** and Gr.3 Weld Park Stakes winner **Elysium**, who added the Listed Garnet Stakes last year.

A top-class juvenile, **Belardo** won the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes and at three he was less than two lengths fourth to **Gleneagles** in the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas and less than a length second to **Solo** in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes. He opened his four-year-old account with a win in the Listed Doncaster Mile Stakes before landing the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes and running second in the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes.

By French Champion Three-Year-Old **Lope De Vega**, he is out of the Irish Champion Two-Year-Old Filly **Danaskaya** (**Danehill**), who is also the dam of Gr.3 scorer **Berling** (**Montjeu**), and it is the further family of Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye winner **Kistena** (**Miswaki**).

Bobby's Kitten enjoyed another good year on the track with his second crop of juveniles, headed by Gr.2 Duchess of Cambridge Stakes and Gr.3 Albany Stakes winner **Sandrine**, who also ran second in the Gr.2 Lowther Stakes and third in the Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes. He also had the Listed-placed juvenile **Fighting King** in Italy and the unbeaten 2yo **Heat Of The Moment**. His other Group horses include Gr.2 Beresford Stakes runner-up **Monaasib**, whose full-sister made 67,000gns at Book 2 to Archwill Bloodstock in 2021.

By top-class **Kitten's Joy**, he was a high-class two-year-old who won the Gr.3 Pilgrim Stakes and was third in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. The following season, after being Gr.1-placed again in the Woodbine Mile, he became the only three-year-old ever to win the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint, beating **No Nay Never** by half a length. Briefly transferred to Dermot Weld's yard, he won his only Irish start, the Listed Cork Stakes, by over eight lengths.

He is a full-brother to Gr.2 winner **Camelot Kitten**, out of **Celestial Woods** (Forestry), who is a half-sister to the dam of Argentinian Champion and multiple Gr.1 winner **Sixties Song** (**Sixties Icon**). The third dam produced three Gr.1-winning sires in **Wild Event**, **Paradise Creek** and **Forbidden Apple**, and her daughters produced triple Gr.1 winner and sire **David Junior** and Gr.1 Las Virgenes Stakes heroine **Eden's Moon**.

BORN TO SEA

Invincible Spirit – Urban Sea (Miswaki) HARAS DE LA HÊTRAIE • Fee €4,500 LF

Born To Sea has moved north from Haras des Faunes to Haras de la Hêtraie for the 2022 season. The son of **Invincible Spirit** will stand as a dual-purpose prospect, having already sired a number of high-level runners over jumps, including Gradedwinning hurdlers **A Wave Of The Sea**, **Aspire Tower** and **My Mate Mozzie**. He is the sire of six Stakes winners on the Flat, including Gr.3 winner and Classic-placed **Sea Of Grace**, Australian Gr.3 scorer **Shared Ambition** and Listed winners, **Naval Warfare, Born With Pride, Il Decamerone** and **Sea King**.

Born To Sea won the Listed Blenheim Stakes on debut at two and was second to **Camelot** (**Montjeu**) in the Gr.1 Irish Derby. He started his stud career at Rathasker Stud in 2013, moved to Gilltown in 2015 and relocated to France in 2019. He was very popular during his three seasons at Haras de Faunes and covered 360 mares during this time.

The half-brother to **Galileo** and **Sea The Stars** is also a halfbrother to **Black Sam Bellamy**, who is the sire of multiple Gr.1winning hurdler **Galop Marin**. They are out of the great producer and Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner **Urban Sea** (**Miswaki**) and this is also the immediate family of sires **Masterstroke** (**Monsun**), who was a Gr.2 winner and placed in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, and **Masar** (**New Approach**), who landed the Gr.1 Derby and stands at Darley's Dalham Hall Stud, and has his first yearlings this year.

BOSCACCIO

Mount Nelson – Bianca De Medici (Medicean) KNOCKHOUSE STUD • Fee O/A

An exciting edition to the Knockhouse Stud roster in Co Kilkenny for the 2022 season, **Boscaccio** is a son of **Mount Nelson** who won the Gr.2 Union-Rennen, as had **Novellist** and **Sea The Moon**.

Trained in Germany by Peter Schiergen, **Boscaccio** won on his only start at two over a mile at Hannover and at three he completed a Stakes race double over eleven furlongs, winning the Listed Hannover Derby Trial and the Union-Rennen, beating Gr.1 winner **Dschingis Secret** and Gr.1placed **Savoir Vivre**, which set him up to be sent off as favourite for the Gr.1 Deutsches Derby. He disappointed in the Classic and only managed to come eighth, with the horses he beat above finishing second and third behind **Isfahan**. He also won the Preis von Deauville as a four-yearold over nine furlongs at Hoppegarten. Gr.1-winning jockey Dennis Schiergen rode him in all his starts and said: *"Boscaccio was the best three-year-old in Germany (and) one of the best horses l've ridden."*

Boscaccio is out of the winning **Medicean** mare **Bianca De Medici**, who is a half-sister to Listed winner **Thunder Teddington** (**Halling**). His second dam is a placed **Anabaa** full-sister to Stakes winner and Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Mile Stakes-placed **Tsigane** and to the dam of Champion **Treve** (**Motivator**).



BURATINO

Exceed And Excel – Bergamask (Kingmambo) HEDGHOLME STUD • Fee £3,000 1st Oct

Gr.2 Coventry Stakes winner **Buratino** relocates from Kildangan Stud to Hedgeholme and will be the only son of **Exceed And Excel** at stud in Britain. Represented by his first runners in 2020, he had 14 winners, including the Groupplaced **Snapraeterea**, who ran third in the Gr.2 Beresford Stakes, as well as the Stakes-placed **Run For Me** and **Macasai**. He had an even better year last year, with a further 36 winners, a strike rate of 41 per cent winners to runners, while **Snapraeterea** became his first Stakes winner, taking out the Listed Owenstown Stud Stakes and Listed Platinum Stakes, as well as running third in the Gr.3 Gallinule Stakes.





Proven Gr.1 sire **Cityscape** added another three Gr.1 winners in Argentina last year, including the 2,000 Guineas winner. The son of **Selkirk** had an excellent first crop of three-yearolds in Britain, including Gr.3 Fred Darling Stakes winner **Dan's Dream** and Gr.3 Musidora Stakes winner **Give And Take**, which means that his biggest and best crop to date are due to hit the track as two-year-olds this year.

He also produced the Hong Kong millionnaire **Ka Ying Star**, who was sold for £1million and earned over £2million on the track, as well as Listed winner **Urban Icon**, who was then sold for 320,000gns. 

Dariyan enjoyed a good year on the track last year with his first three-year-olds and also continued to hit the mark with his juveniles. These were headed by two-year-old **Mister Saint Paul**, who was placed on his first few starts and broke his maiden in the Listed Prix Isonomy. The sire of two black-type horses and ten individual winners from his first runners in 2020, he added another 28 last year, with 44 per cent winners to runners and 76 per cent runners winning or placed. Three-year-old **Dary Ci** also snatched black type in the Listed Prix de la Seine and the Gr.3-placed juvenile **Princesse De Saba** gained more black-type as a three-year-old.

The son of **Shamardal** hails from an outstanding middledistance family and is one of three Stakes winners and Group performers out of Gr.1 Hong Kong Vase winner **Daryakana** (**Selkirk**). It is also the further family of **Almanzor** (**Wootton Bassett**) and Classic winner **Darjina** (**Zamindar**), as well as the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club winner and sire **Darsi**.

It is therefore no surprise that, although a son of **Shamardal**, often thought of as a speed influence but a winner of the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club, he was a progressive sort. He was then placed in the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris, Gr.3 Gordon Stakes, Gr.1 St Leger and Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Bayern. He returned at four to win the Gr.3 Sagaro Stakes and backed up in the Gr.3 Henry II Stakes before finding only Stradivarius too good in the Gr.1 Gold Cup, Gr.1 Goodwood Cup and Gr.2 Lonsdale Cup. 



Globetrotting speedster **Glass Slippers** took the Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye, Gr.1 Flying Five Stakes and Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint in the blue and white colours of Bearstone Stud. She is one of four Gr.1 winners for the sire, namely Gr.1 Prix Jacques Le Marois winner and Haras de Bouquetot sire **Al Wukair**, Gr.1 British Champion Sprint Stakes hero and sire **Donjuan Triumphant** and Gr.1 Haydock Sprint Cup Stakes and Gr.1 Diamond Jubilee Stakes winner **Dream Of Dreams**.

Dream Ahead retired to Ballylinch Stud in Ireland in 2012 and relocated to Haras de Grandcamp in 2017, so this is the first time that he will be available to British breeders. On the track he was a dual Gr.1-winning juvenile, taking the Gr.1 Prix Morny and Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes, and he added another trio to the tally at three when landing the Gr.1 July Cup, Gr.1 Haydock Sprint Cup and Gr.1 Prix de La Forêt.

He is a half-brother to Group-placed **Into The Dark** and **Bin Battuta**, as well as to the dam of dual Gr.1 winner **Fairyland** and Group winner and Classic-placed **Now Or Later**. They are out of the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes winner **Land Of Dreams (Cadeaux Genereux)**, and their grandam **Sahara Star (Green Desert)** won the Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes.

Soldier Hollow – Divya (Platini) HARAS DE MONTAIGU Fee €4,000 LF • €2,500 LF for NH mares

German Horse of the Year Dschingis Secret has relocated from Haras de Saint Arnoult to the nearby Haras de Montaigu this year, ahead of his first two-year-old crop hitting the track. The Gr.1-winning son of leading German sire Soldier Hollow also comes from a solid German family and is a fullbrother to four Group winners, including Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Deutsches Derby runner-up and sire Destino.

Trained by Markus Klug, he was placed over a mile as a juvenile and ran solid races to be placed three times in Stakes company at three, including half a length third to Isfahan (Lord Of England) in the Gr.1 Deutsches Derby, before winning the Gr.3 St Leger Italiano. He then went from strength to strength, taking out two Gr.2s before his crowning moment in the Gr.1 Preis von Berlin, beating Hawkbill (Kitten's Joy). He followed up with victory in the Gr.2 Prix Foy, beating **Cloth** Of Stars (Sea The Stars), ran sixth behind Enable (Nathaniel) in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and was only beaten half a length in the Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Bayern. He raced on at five and was second to Waldgeist (Galileo) in the Gr.2 Grand Prix de Chantilly before landing the Gr.2 Grosser Hansa-Preis.

Montaigu is also offering a bonus system for all foals conceived in 2022, with €10,000 to the breeder of a Gr.1 winner and €5,000 to the breeder of a Gr.2 or Gr.3 winner.

Top-class sprinter **Due Diligence** (War Front) hit the track running with his first few crops, with a number of Groupwinning sprinters and he is shaping up to be a solid sire, with his strongest crops yet to run.

El Kabeir made an excellent start to his stud career, topped by Italian Champion Two-Year-Old **Don Chicco**, who won the Gr.2 Gran Criterium and is heading for the Guineas. The son of **Scat Daddy** notched up three Stakes winners, which also included Listed winners Masekela, who won the Denford Stakes and placed in the Gr.2 Superlative Stakes, and **Sa Filonzana**, as well as a further two Group-placed runners. **Harrow** ran third in the Gr.3 Somerville Tattersall Stakes, while **Rerouting** was third in the Gr.3 Solario Stakes. He finished the year with 16 individual winners from 54 runners.

His yearlings continued to be popular and made up to 130,000gns last year for a colt and £90,000 for a filly, averaging £28,500.

A high-class runner in the US, El Kabeir won the Gr.2 Kentucky Jockey Club Stakes at Churchill Downs at two and added the Listed City of Laurel Stakes and the Gr.3 Gotham Stakes at three, as well as being placed in the Gr.1 Wood Memorial Stakes. 

Elusive Pimpernel (Elusive Quality) continues to cover large books, with over 400 mares in the last two seasons, and he is producing the goods on the Flat and over jumps. His winners on the level from last year include the 88-rated **Espouse** and 107-rated stayer Ever Present, who won a valuable Premier Handicap at Leopardstown in September for Jessica Harrington. He is also responsible for Listed winners **Elegant** Rose and Elusive Beauty, who were also placed in the Gr.3 Park Express Stakes and Gr.3 Grangecon Stud Stakes respectively, while his yearlings fetched up to €55,000 last year. His Graded winners over obstacles include Gr.1-placed Coeur Sublime, as well as Exit Poll and Soviet Pimpernel, and his Gr.2-placed horses include, Cusp Of Carabelli, Elusive Belle, Ex Patriot and Jungle Junction.

A dual juvenile winner, including in the Gr.3 Acomb Stakes, Elusive Pimpernel was runner-up in the Gr.1 Racing Post Trophy on his final start that term and claimed the Gr.3 Craven Stakes in a two-race three-year-old campaign. At four he claimed a further two Stakes placings before retiring to stud in 2012. He is a half-brother to the Gr.3 Strensall Stakes scorer and sire Palavicini (Giant's Causeway) and the Stakes winner and Gr.3-placed Prince Gagarin (Dubawi). This is the immediate family of the Gr.1 Irish Oaks heroine **Snow Fairy**, the Gr.1 winner and sire **Avonbridge** and Group winner and sire **Big Bad Bob**.



EQTIDAAR

Invincible Spirit – Madany (Acclamation) NUNNERY STUD • Fee £5,000 1st Jan SLF

Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup hero **Eqtidaar** will be represented by his first yearlings this year, with a crop of around 50 registered foals. The son of **Invincible Spirit** had 22 of those offered at public auction last year and recorded a top price of 55,000gns, for a half-sister to Stakes winner **Fashion Queen** (Aqlaam) which was sold to Redpender Stud, and they averaged nearly £12,000. His first crop will also include a half-brother to Stakes winner **Aqlaam Vision** (Aqlaam) and half-sisters to high-class performers **Red Tea** (Sakhee) and **Stormbringer** (**Dutch Art**).

Trained by Sir Michael Stoute, **Eqtidaar** won on debut and was fourth in the Gr.3 Sirenia Stakes on his only other start as a juvenile. He ran second on his return at three to **Invincible Army** in the Gr.3 Pavilion Stakes, on soft, before going on to win the Commonwealth Cup at Royal Ascot, beating **Sands Of Mali**, with **Invincible Army**, **Unfortunately**, **Speak In Colours** and **Sioux Nation** further down the field.

By sire of sires **Invincible Spirit**, he is a half-brother to Gr.2 Hungerford Stakes winner, Gr.1 2,000 Guineas runner-up and first season sire **Massaat** (**Teofilo**), as well as Gr.3 Horris Hill Stakes scorer **Mujbar** (**Muhaarar**). They are out of twoyear-old winner **Madany** (**Acclamation**) and this is the further family of Gr.1 performers **Precieuse** (**Tamayuz**) and **Scottish** (**Teofilo**).

EQUIANO

Acclamation – Entente Cordiale (Ela-Mana-Mou) IRISH NATIONAL STUD • Fee €2,000 (in advance of covering)

Dual Gr.1-winning sprinter **Equiano** is embarking on his second season at the Irish National Stud after relocating from Newsells Park last year. The move proved fruitful, with a 50 per cent increase in his book to 65 mares.

Equiano has already sired 31 Stakes horses, headed by the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint winner **Belvoir Bay** and the high-class sprinter **The Tin Man**, whose nine victories include the Gr.1 British Champions Sprint, Gr.1 Diamond Jubilee Stakes and Gr.1 Sprint Cup. **Medicine Jack** won the Gr.2 Railway Stakes and was third in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes at two, while last year's Gr.2 winner **Equilateral** previously beat all bar **Battaash** in the Gr.1 King's Stand. **Gustavus Weston** added a further two Group races last year, including the Gr.2 Greenlands Stakes, and **Apollo One** landed the Listed Spring Cup. Of **Equiano**'s clutch of Gr.3 winners, **Strath Burn**, beaten a short head in the Gr.1 Sprint Cup, has sired winners himself from limited opportunities, while **Dakota Gold** has won 13 times to date, including the Gr.3 Bengough Stakes and five Listed races.

The speedy son of **Acclamation** won two editions of Royal Ascot's Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes, as well as the Gr.3 Palace House Stakes, and his eight places included a second in the Gr.1 July Cup. He is a half-brother to Stakes winners by **Pivotal** and **Oasis Dream**, and he shares his grandam with the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1-placed **Va Bank**.

EXPERT EYE

Acclamation – Exemplify (Dansili) BANSTEAD MANOR STUD • Fee £10,000 SLF

The first two-year-olds by Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Mile winner **Expert Eye** hit the track this year and they were well received at the yearling sales. They made up to 290,000gns and averaged £44,000, over double his initial fee. Juddmonte bought two fillies and top judges such as Peter & Ross Doyle, Joe Foley, Andrew Balding, Freddy Tylicki, Kenny McPeek and breeze-up consignors Oak Tree Farm and Church Farm/Horse Park Stud each paid over €70,000 to get their hands on his progeny. He is well represented with 97 in his first crop and looks to follow in the footsteps of other sons of **Acclamation** that are top two-year-old sires, such as **Dark Angel** and **Mehmas**.

Expert Eye was a very good two-year-old, winning on debut at Newbury in June and following up with a stunning performance in the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes at Goodwood, where he ran out an impressive four and a half length winner. This was described by Timeform as *"arguably the most striking performance by a two-year-old in a Pattern race all year."* At three he ran second in the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes on his return, was a wide margin winner of the Gr.3 Jersey Stakes (by the biggest winning margin this century) and culminated in victory in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Mile, achieving a Timeform rating of 124.

He is a fourth generation Juddmonte homebred from the family of Champion 2YO Filly in Europe and dual Classic winner, **Special Duty** and seven-time Gr.1 winner **Sightseek**.

The speedy Gr.3 Palace House Stakes winner **Far Above**, who was undefeated over sprint trips in his five-race career, is welcoming his first foals this year. He covered a strong book of over 140 mares in his first season, which included 80 per cent sisters/daughters of Stakes horses.

The son of **Farhh** was a six-figure breeze-up purchase and made his debut for James Tate in April of his three-year-old year, when he landed a seven-furlong maiden at Newmarket. Pitched over course and distance into the Listed King Charles II Stakes, he came fourth, the only defeat of his career, to Gr.1-placed **Jash**. Dropped back to six furlongs, he was an impressive five-length winner of a novice at Windsor, before being sent to France, where he landed the Listed Prix Kistena, also over six furlongs. He returned to Newmarket on his only start at four and showed his speed over the minimum trip in the stallion-making Gr.3 Palace House Stakes. He was given a Timeform rating of 122, which is higher than **Invincible Spirit, Kodiac, Dark Angel, No Nay Never** and **Showcasing**.

His winning dam **Dorraar** (**Shamardal**) is a half-sister to five winners and is out of **Dorrati**, an unraced daughter of **Dubai Millennium**. She is a half-sister to the dual Gr.1 winner **Nahrain** (**Selkirk**), dam of the outstanding **Benbatl** (**Dubawi**), and to the dam of last year's Gr.2 Railway Stakes winner and Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint runner-up **Go Bears Go**.

Classic-placed Gr.2 juvenile winner **Fighting Irish**, the only six-furlong Group winner by top young sire **Camelot**, covered his first book of mares last year and his foals are now due. Haras d'Annebault is also offering a breeders' incentive, whereby a €50,000 bonus will be paid to the breeder of his first Group winner in Britain, Ireland or France.

At two, after breaking his maiden over six furlongs in July, he easily made all to land a nursery before quickening up smartly to win the Gr.2 Critérium de Maisons-Laffitte, in which he beat the triple Gr.2-placed juvenile **Nebo**, who won the Gr.3 Horris Hill Stakes on his next start. Third in the Gr.2 Mehl-Mülhens-Rennen over 1600m at three, he also finished ahead of the Gr.1winning juveniles **Sioux Nation** and **Unfortunately** in the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup, when beaten less than three lengths.

Fighting Irish is out of the unraced **Quixotic** (**Pivotal**), who is a full-sister to Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes winner and sire **Virtual** and a half-sister to Gr.2 Coventry Stakes victor and Gr.1-placed sire **Iceman** (**Polar Falcon**). From the top-class Cheveley Park Stud family of Gr.1 2,000 Guineas winner and sire **Entrepreneur** and Gr.1 Coronation Stakes heroine **Exclusive** (dam of Gr.1 Matron Stakes scorer **Echelon**, herself dam of the dual Gr.1 winner **Integral**), the Stakes-placed second dam **Virtuous** (**Exit To Nowhere**) is also half-sister to the grandam of Classicplaced Gr.1 E P Taylor Stakes heroine **Lahaleeb**.

Offered by Mill House Stud, the Marchborn bay was out of a placed **Shantou** half-sister to Gr.1winning hurdler **Dedigout** (**Bob Back**), whilst Mickley Stud offered the only filly at public auction, which was sold to Denise O'Brien's Clonbonny Stud.

Bred and raced by Juddmonte, the son of **Dansili** won over \$9.5 million on the track and has produced Group performers from his first crop. His progeny to date include unbeaten Juddmonte juvenile **Verbal**, who won the Gr.3 Cecil B DeMille Stakes on his second start and looks a smart prospect for this year, and Gr.3 Prix Noailles scorer **Cheshire Academy**, who was only four lengths behind **St Mark's Basilica** in the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club, as well as Listed winner **Runaway Rumour**, who also placed in the Gr.2 Sands Point Stakes and Gr.2 Lake Placid Stakes.





He returned at three to take the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes from **Expert Eye** and finished half a length second to **Polydream** in the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest. In total he defeated 33 individual Group winners, including six individual Gr.1 winners.

He is out of a Stakes-winning Royal Ascot two-year-old **Whazzat** (**Daylami**) and is from the immediate stallion producing family of **Pinatubo**, **Invincible Spirit** and **Kodiac**.





Gr.2-winning sprinter **Mattmu** (**Indesatchel**) is returning home to Bearstone Stud in 2022, where he was born and raised, and spent his first year at stud in 2018. Successful in the Gr.2 Critérium de Maisons-Laffitte and Gr.3 Phoenix Sprint, he was also third in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes, beating six Gr.1 winners, including **Sole Power**, **Goldream**, **Profitable**, **Astaire**, **Maarek** and **Move In Time**, and was crowned joint Champion 3YO Sprinter of 2015.

He has done well from a small first crop of just seven foals and appears to be significantly upgrading his mares. Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Classic winner and European Champion Miler **Raven's Pass** is a tried and tested Gr.1 sire that boasts 8.4 per cent Stakes winners to runners. He is the sire of four top level winners, headed by **Tower Of London**, who now stands at Darley Japan. **Romantic Proposal** was the latest to add to the tally when taking out the Gr.1 Flying Five Stakes in September, while **Matterhorn** was the five and a half-length winner of a Gr.1 at Meydan before being fatally injured on his next start. He is also responsible for Gr.1-winning two-year-old **Royal Marine**, who landed the Prix Jean-Luc Lagardère.

His stock continues to be in demand in the sales ring, with two yearlings making \in 50,000 a piece last year, a breeze-up horse making \notin 75,000 and his foals making up to \notin 20,000.

A top-class colt at two and three, **Raven's Pass** won the Gr.3 Solario Stakes and was third to **New Approach** in the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes. A Gr.1 winner in both hemispheres, **Reliable Man** enjoyed yet another outstanding year in 2021, siring 17 Group/Stakes horses, including European Group-winning juvenile **Ardakan**. His 45 black-type performers also included four-year-old **Miami Bound**, who was placed in the Gr.1 Sydney Cup and Gr.1 Tancred Stakes, having been conceived during his shuttle duties to Westbury Stud in New Zealand. He is responsible for three Gr.1 winners and eight Gr.1 performers to date. The son of **Dalakhani** also continues to be popular in the sales ring, with yearlings selling for up to €220,000 last year, with an average of over €40,000, which is an excellent return on his fee of €9,000 at the time of conception.

It is little surprise that **Reliable Man** has such strong crosshemisphere appeal, having scored at the highest level both sides of the equator. 

Unplaced in two further starts over six furlongs, he was back in the winner's enclosure when dropped back to the minimum trip and landed the Gr.3 Cornwallis Stakes. He returned at three to beat his elders in the Listed Cork Stakes and ran a good fourth to **Mabs Cross** in the Gr.3 Palace House Stakes, when slowly away and running on at the finish to go down by just over two lengths. 



Sixties Icon (**Galileo**) has proved a versatile sire, with winners from five furlongs to two miles and on all types of going. His three top-level winners have all come from his shuttle stints to Argentina, where the majority of races are over short trips of up to 1600m and are mostly held on dirt.

That said, his top son **Sixties Song**, now at stud himself, won his three Gr.1 races over 2400m, **Crazy Icon** was a top-flight winner over 2000m and **Hennie Six** landed her Gr.1 over 1600m. The British-bred **Nancy From Nairobi** was a Gr.2 winner over a mile at Santa Anita, the Irish-foaled **Sixties Groove** won his Gr.2 over 2400m at Eagle Farm in Australia and, of **Sixties Icon**'s Gr.3 winners in Europe, **Chilworth Icon** won his at two, **Epsom Icon** landed hers at three and **Czabo** hers at four. His Czech-trained son **Nagano Gold** has been a terrific servant to connections, winning Listed races in France and finishing a close second in the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud and Gr.2 Hardwicke Stakes, and he was also placed in the Listed Prix du Carrousel last year.

By dual Classic winner **Galileo**, out of Gr.1 Oaks winner **Love Divine** (**Diesis**), and from the family of dual Gr.1 winner and sire **Legal Case**, **Sixties Icon** was a Classic winner himself, defeating ten rivals in the Gr.1 St Leger the year it was held at York. He won seven other races from three to five, including the Gr.2 Jockey Club Stakes and four Gr.3 contests.




SMOOTH DADDY

The first two-year-olds by Smooth Daddy are set to hit the track this season and they were well received at the sales last year. His first yearlings made up to £120,000 at the Tattersalls Ireland September Yearling Sale for a colt that was knocked down to Mark and Charlie Johnston. The colt is out of a halfsister to Stakes winner **Surfside Tiara**, who is by **Smooth** Daddy's sire Scat Daddy, from the family of European Champion Two-Year-Old Air Force Blue. Speaking of the colt, Charlie Johnston said: "He's a cracking individual, a real standout with a great walk on him. A real active, strong type and he looks a runner." Overall his yearlings averaged over £18,000 and were also purchased by top breeze-up consignors such as Con Marnane and Robson Aguiar.

Smooth Daddy was a tough and consistent Group winner on the turf in the US. His best run was the winning the ninefurlong Gr.3 Fort Macy Stakes at Belmont Park, where he beat promising young sire Time Test and the Gr.1-placed Messi. Overall he won or was placed in 22 of his 31 starts, including five Graded races from three to six. His dam was a multiple Stakes winner of ten races in the US and has produced two other Stakes horses. The Gr.1-winning two-year-old Sioux Nation, also by Scat Daddy, is listed under his Stakes-placed third dam, who is by Raise A Native, and Classic winners Secreto and Caracolero come under his Stakes-placed fourth dam.

Gleneagles – Remember You (Invincible Spirit) MARCH HARE STUD • Fee £2,000 1st Oct terms

Royal Ascot-winning two-year-old Southern Hills is entering his second season at stud and his first foals are hitting the ground this year. The son of **Gleneagles** was out of the gates early and showed his speed over the minimum trip at the Royal Meeting.

Trained by Aidan O'Brien, he was pitched straight into Listed company in the May of his juvenile campaign and came fifth behind Siskin in the Listed Marble Hill Stakes at the Curragh. He was turned back out again the following week and ran a neck second to Air Force Jet in a five-furlong maiden at Navan, but he broke his maiden in style in the Listed Windsor Castle Stakes on the big stage at Ascot. O'Brien said: "He was a very fast, precocious and genuine horse."

By Champion Gleneagles, who enjoyed a stellar season last year with 11 Group/Stakes winners including Loving Dream, who became his first Gr.1 winner, Southern Hills is out of Gr.3 Round Tower Stakes runner-up Remember You (Invincible Spirit), who is also the dam of Gr.3-placed I Remember You (Australia). The second dam, Miss Dela (King's Best), is a half-sister to Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Critérium International Stakes-placed Governor Brown (Kingmambo) and Listed winner Hataab (Woodman), as well as to the dam of New Zealand Gr.1 winner Sword Of Osman (Savabeel).



The son of **Invincible Spirit** originally retired to Whitsbury Manor Stud and was a leading first season sire in England and Ireland by winners to runners, and he relocated to Batsford Stud in 2019, so his first crop of juveniles conceived at his new home are due to hit the track this year.

Trained by John Gosden for owner and breeder Lordship Stud, **Swiss Spirit** won on his second start at two and was third in the Listed Rockingham Stakes. At three he was second in the Tattersalls Millions 3YO Sprint before beating Lethal Force to win the Listed Carnarvon Stakes, and later that year he also landed the Gr.3 World Trophy, beating Gr.1 winner Kingsgate Native. The following year he was second by a neck to the same rival in the Gr.2 Temple Stakes and ran second to Moviesta in the Gr.2 King George Stakes. Swiss Spirit is out of Listed winner and Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes runner-up Swiss Lake (Indian Ridge), who is the dam of three other Stakes winners, including two Stakes producers. His Stakes-placed second dam **Blue Iris** (**Petong**), also produced Listed-placed Dubai Princess (Dubai Destination), and it is the further family of Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes runner-up Anita's Prince, speedster Maarek and promising young sire Ardad.

The first runners by the speedy and precocious **Tasleet** are set to hit the track this year and are housed with some astute pinhookers and trainers in Robson Aguiar, Archie Watson, Karl Burke, Dave Loughnane, Con Marane and Johnny Murtagh, having made up to 80,000gns at the sales last year.

Having covered a good book of mares, the sale topper was a half-brother to Gr.2 winner **Gustavus Weston** (**Equiano**) which was bought by Star Bloodstock during Tattersalls Book 2, where two other colts made 75,000gns when selling to McKeever Bloodstock and Kern Lillingston, while Aguiar paid the same for a filly. 
