RACING PREVIEW

OVERSEAS CHALLENGE FOR GR.1 PRIX ROTHSCHILD

Seven fillies and mares go to post for the Gr.1 Prix Rothschild over the straight mile at Deauville today.

Overseas raiders have won six of the last ten renewals, so it is no surprise to see a strong team assembled from both Ireland and the UK, which is headed by **Saffron Beach (New Bay)**. Jane Chapple-Hyam's stable star was an impressive winner of the Gr.2 Duke of Cambridge Stakes last time. She did so whilst carrying a five-pound penalty for her victory in the Gr.1 Sun Chariot Stakes last year.

Kenella (Kendargent) finished last of the seven runners in that Duke of Cambridge, but has won the Listed Prix Goldikova since, while the Christopher Head-trained **Sibila Spain (Frankel)** got upset in the stalls at the Royal Meeting and was withdrawn as a result. She may have something to prove at present, having finished last of five in the Gr.1 Falmouth Stakes last month. Her final start on home soil was in the Gr.2 Prix du Muguet in May, where she came from last to first to win.

There are two Irish fillies making the trip, headed by the Aidan O'Brien-trained **Tenebrism**. The daughter of **Caravaggio** bounced back to form when taking the Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat last

month. The lightly-raced three-year-old has now won twice at the top level from just five career starts, having won the Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes on her second and final juvenile start. She is joined by Paddy Twomey's **Pearls Galore (Invincible Spirit)**, who was bred just 40 minutes drive away in Haras de Saint Pair. The five-year-old

has twice finished runner-up at the highest level and arrives here having won the Gr.2 Lanwades Stud Stakes in May, before finishing second to **Order Of Australia** in the Gr.2 Minstrel Stakes last time after a short break.

The John Gosden-trained **Elusive Kate** started the dominance of the raiding party in 2012. Prior to that, the race was won four years in a row by the brilliant and much-lamented **Goldikova**. Today, her four-year-old daughter **Goldistyle (Dubawi)** will need a career-best to keep up the family tradition, though arrives here on the back of a close-up fourth-place finish in the Gr.3 Prix Bertrand du Breuil, having won in Listed company on her return.

The field is completed by the Francis-Henri Graffard-trained three-year-old **Malavath (Mehmas)**, who began her season with a smooth victory in the Gr.3 Prix Imprudence and was well-fancied for the Gr.1 1,000 Guineas, where she trailed in tenth. She has finished fifth of six in the Gr.3 Prix du Palais-Royal since, but the form of her second in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf on her final juvenile start last season has worked out well.

USA

MASTER PIECE RUNS AWAY WITH EDDIE READ STAKES

The Chilean-bred **Master Piece (Mastercraftsman)** pulled off an upset in the \$252,500 Gr.2 Eddie Read Stakes at Del Mar on

Sunday, winning by an impressive three and a quarter lengths.

The Michael McCarthy-trained six-year-old was drawn widest, in post ten, with two scratches, and was subsequently ridden off the pace by Abel Cedillo. He did well to angle out **Master Piece** at the top of the straight before coming home strongly to win comfortably at the line from the Philip d'Amato-trained pair **Hong Kong Harry (Es Que Love)** and **Cathkin Peak (Albehayeb)**.

Already Gr.2-placed under the care of Michael McCarthy, this was a first victory for **Master Piece** since winning an allowance race last April when with Chad Brown. Connections will be now be hoping this victory can prove a springboard for further Stakes success.

Owned by F Diaz-Valdes, Baalbek Corp and Don Alberto Stable and bred by Haras Don Alberto, he is a half-brother to two winners, out of the Chilean Gr.3 winner **Torre Laguna (Proud Citizen)**.

ROCKEMPEROR PROVES BEST IN BOWLING GREEN STAKE

Chad Brown's six-year-old **Rockemperor (Holy Roman Emperor)** got the better of the Brad Cox-trained **Arklow (Arch)** in an exciting finish to Sunday's \$250,000 Gr.2 Bowling Green Stakes at Saratoga.

Flavien Prat was in no hurry aboard the 2/1 market leader as he dropped **Rockemperor** in behind his four rivals early on. However, he made good progress turning in and picked up the lead inside the final half-furlong before showing a good attitude to fend off the challenge of the eight-year-old **Arklow** and score by half a length.

Despite being beaten on his previous four starts, connections reported that **Rockemperor** had been working well in the lead up to Sunday's race and he made the most of a slight drop in class and relished the firm going.

He was sold for €50,000 at the Arqana August Yearling Sale before being bought by Trainer Simone Brogi for €12,000 at the Arqana Breeze-Up Sale. He left Brogi's yard in 2019 to join Chad Brown's barn, where he has won three times, including a Gr.1 success in the Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Stakes at Belmont Park last October.

Owned by Madaket Stables LLC, Michael Dubb, Wonder Stables, Michael Kisber and Michael Caruso, and bred by Haras du Mezeray S A, he is one of three winners out of the Listed-placed winner **Motivation (Muhtathir)**. Further back, his third dam, the unraced **Nijinsky's Best (Nijinsky)**, produced three winners, including the multiple US Gr.1 winner and sire **Yagli (Jade Hunter)**.

THIS WEEK'S MAIDENS WHO CAUGHT THE EYE

The EBF maiden for colts and geldings over 6f on good ground at Goodwood on Tuesday was a solid contest and **Mischief Magic (Exceed And Excel)** improved on his debut third over course and distance to make most on the stands' rail - headed for a furlong by an unplaced outsider at half way - to win handily by a length and a half. He will likely head for a Stakes race before long, perhaps via a novice or conditions race.

Dermot Weld used to be the man to follow at Galway, but he has not been quite so prolific in recent years and his horses in general have not been in that good form, but **Tahiya (Siyouni)** went through the EBF fillies' maiden over 7f on good to soft at Ballybrit on Tuesday smoothly and only needed mild urging to go on a furlong out and score by over five lengths. The race was not that strong, but she looked pretty good.

The ground had gone to good to firm by Thursday at Goodwood, but that proved no problem to **Sparkling Beauty (Oasis Dream)**, who improved considerably on her debut to come from a handy position and win an EBF fillies' maiden over 7f by three and a half lengths, despite being somewhat keen. Richard Hughes has put her in the Gr.1 Moyglare Stud Stakes and she will presumably head up in class. The Gr.3 Sweet Solera Stakes might come too soon and the Gr.3 Prestige Stakes is relatively close to the Moyglare, but there are few domestic alternatives at Stakes level.

Three-year-old **Haskoy (Golden Horn)** has clearly taken time to come to hand, but, after being slowly away, she was soon on an even keel in a novice over 1m4f at Wolverhampton on Friday and powered clear of a decent field for the time of year to win by seven lengths. The race was won by none other than **Trueshan (Planteur)** in 2019 and more will heard of this filly in a higher grade.

Another three-year-old filly making her debut impressed on Friday, this time in a fillies' novice over 1m on good to firm at Newmarket. **Laurel (Kingman)** bowled along behind the leaders, found a small gap by the rail inside the final furlong and won by three lengths. The second ran perhaps a bit below her rating of 95, but not by much, and the form overall looked very fair, so it would be no surprise to see this filly competing this year and next in Stakes races if all stays well.

Kingman is having a rare old time of it in maidens at the moment and his two-year-old daughter **Commissioning**, like the

Flying Honours (Sea The Stars) had run to a high level when fourth on debut at Newmarket, though slightly disappointing in a way, as he was evens favourite, but he made no mistake in an EBF novice over 7f at Sandown Park on Wednesday, leading from the gate and then handy, before going on and winning by over nine lengths. Even though the race, won last year by **El Bodegon (Kodiac)** with **Hoo Ya Mal (Territories)** in third, was not that hot on the day, it was still quite a performance. He is in the Gr.1 National Stakes, but by then he might well want 1m, but the Gr.3 Solario Stakes over this course and distance in early September could be a suitable target.

filly above from the Gosden yard, got her career off to the best possible start at Newmarket the following day in an EBF fillies' novice over 7f, coming from the back of the eight runners to take over one furlong out and win by three and a half lengths. She holds no smart entries as yet, but that can soon change and Frankie Dettori thought she would be running over 1m by the end of the year. She would be a possible for the Prestige on the way.

Jim Bolger gave two-year-old gelding **Serious Challenge (Fracas)** his introduction at Galway last Tuesday and he finished third. The idiosyncratic Master of Coolcullen decided to turn him out again on Saturday in an EBF maiden over an extended 1m on

soft and he showed himself to be suitably tough, getting a bump on the home turn but still battling to victory by three quarters of a length from the long odds-on **Hiawatha (Camelot)**, with six lengths back to the third. He is likely to head for the Gr.2 Futurity Stakes and, on this showing, anyone who takes him on will know they have had a battle.

The following race was a three and up maiden over the same trip and it was a solid contest for the time of year, won by **Saraquel (Dark Angel)**, who had shown a very fair level of form in two previous starts and had had a break of two months or so. She only saw a gap a furlong out after travelling well, but still was nearly three lengths to the good at the line. He is not too far off Stakes class.

Although there was quite a close finish to the EBF maiden over 7f on good to firm at Goodwood on Saturday, **The Foxes (Churchill)** still looks a decent prospect after he won by a neck on his third start. Fourth on debut, he was well held in the Listed Chesham Stakes, to the mortification of his trainer Andrew Balding, who still has great faith in his charge and is planning to go for a Stakes race again, justifiably, as he is still developing.

The ground was good to soft at Thirsk on Saturday for an EBF maiden over 5f and the support for the filly **Eternal Class (Night Of Thunder)** was not misplaced, as she came from mid-division to win without having to be asked for very much by a length and a half. There was talk of the Gr.2 Lowther Stakes, which would be quite an ask and the owner Steve Parkin already has the favourite for the race, but clearly she is well thought of in her powerful yard.

Frankness (Frankel) will likely come into her own next year, but she was good enough to come from the box seat and take

over a furlong out to win an EBF novice over 7f on good to soft at Chester on Sunday on her second start by nearly four lengths. It would be by no means impossible she could land black type against her own sex this season, especially in the autumn, given she can clearly handle the surface.

There were EBF maidens over 1m for each sex at Naas yesterday on good to soft. **Gan Teorainn (Saxon Warrior)** had run to a fair level when second on debut at Down Royal and she improved on that, travelling well and looking ever better the further she went, winning by two and a half lengths. She holds entries in the Gr.2 Debutante Stakes and Gr.1 Moyglare Stud Stakes and Jim Bolger never lacks for ambition, though it will be quite a jump.

The colts' and geldings' equivalent went to the debutant **Denmark (Camelot)**, who came from mid-division and, despite being rather green (and unseating Ryan Moore after the line), won by over three lengths. He holds smart entries, though he would have to grow up quickly to take up an entry in the Futurity, for which Aidan O'Brien would have more fancied entrants. He may be one for later in the season, though Ballydoyle is rarely afraid to roll the dice, and he is getting quotes for the Gr.1 Derby next year.

Swingalong (Showcasing) looked very ordinary on her first two runs but improved considerably to make all in an EBF fillies' novice over 6f on good to soft at Ripon yesterday and score by six lengths. A filly rated 75 was nearly eight lengths away in fourth, so this was a useful display and she might go on to better things.

Liberty Island (Duramente), unhurried in the early stages, was switched to the outside in the last 400m and flashed home three lengths clear in the 1600m newcomers' race at Niigata on Saturday. The straight is slightly downhill but she clocked the last 600m in an eye-catching 31.4 seconds under mild urgings by jockey Yuga Kawada. She is the second foal and winner out of dual Australian Gr.1 winner **Yankee Rose (All American)**, who was bought for A\$10,000 as a yearling by Darby Racing. She earned more than A\$2m and was purchased privately by Katsumi Yoshida. Her first foal, the three-year-old filly **Romneya (Deep Impact)**, a ¥210m purchase at the JRHA Select Foal Sale, won on debut and is not far off Stakes level. **Yankee Rose's** third foal, a yearling colt by **Lord Kanaloa**, has been purchased for ¥370m by

The 1800m newcomers' race at Niigata on Sunday turned into a 600m dash and **Danon Tornado (Heart's Cry)** won narrowly by a nose from the front-runner **Shazzan (Lord Kanaloa)**, clocking the last 600m in 32.4 seconds. His dam **She Will Reign (Manhattan Rain)** has story similar to **Yankee Rose**. She was purchased for just A\$20,000 by Darby Racing and turned into a top performer in Australia. **She Will Reign** banked more than A\$3.2m for her owners and topped her career winning the Gr.1 Golden Slipper, the most important Australian race for juveniles, and landed the Gr.1 Moir Stakes in her three-year-old campaign. She gained a place in the inaugural running of the The Everest. **She Will Reign** has been purchased privately by Katsumi Yoshida and **Danon Tornado** is her first foal, followed by a yearling filly by **Satono Diamond** and a colt foal by **Real Steel**. Very much like **Yankee Rose**, **She Will Reign's** pedigree has been boosted by her younger half-brother **Time To Reign (Time For War)** winning the Gr.2 Silver Slipper.

Silver Duke (Silver State), who ran third on debut, had a wide but safe trip and got the job done in good style in the 1800m maiden at Niigata on Saturday. His dam **Vanadis (Rock Of**

Gibraltar) won on debut at two at the same venue but was retired after she ran unplaced in the Gr.3 Niigata Nisai Stakes, just her second start. She is from the only Japanese crop delivered by **Rock of Gibraltar** and has returned two NRA winners from her previous four foals. **Vanadis** is a half-sister to **Rhein Kraft (End Sweep)**, who won the Classic Gr.1 Oka Sho and the Gr.1 NHK Mile Cup and finished second in the Gr.1 Shuka Sho over 2000m and the Takamatsunomiya Kinen over 1200m. The second dam, the unplaced **Must Be Loved (Sunday Silence)**, produced the US Gr.2 scorer **Florentino (Swept Overboard)** and the Gr.3 winner **Admire Royal (King Kamehameha)**. **Must Be Loved** is a full-sister to the Gr.1 winner and sire **Admire Max**.

He is the third winner overall on the JRA circuit and the first on grass for the US sprinter **Mind Your Biscuits (Posse)**, who landed the Gr.1 Dubai Golden Shaheen twice and has a first crop of 103 foals sired at a fee of ¥2m. The dam **Zarema (Dance In The Dark)** won the Gr.3 Autumn Handicap and clinched several other Group places for more than ¥231m; she has returned three other winners. The second dam **Shenck (Zafonic)** highlighted her career winning the Classic Gr.3 Premio Regina Elena and turned into a fine broodmare for Shadai

She has plenty of room for improvement and could turn into a Stakes performer. Her dam **Palestrina (Medaglia D'Oro)** won once in the US and has been purchased in foal to **Night of Thunder** for 30,000gns by Ever Union Shokai at the 2016 Tattersalls December Mare Sale from the Godolphin draft. She has produced another winner in Japan from three previous foals. The second dam is the Gr.2 Prix de Sandringham winner and Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches and Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup-placed **Maiden Tower (Groom Dancer)**. She delivered six winners, including the Listed Prix de Turenne winner and Gr.2 Grand Prix de Deauville-placed **Penglai Pavillon (Monsun)**.

The Industry's Young Bloods



Name: ALICE HAYNES • Age: 31 • Trainer

MARTIN STEVENS chats to the young and highly talented trainer Alice Haynes

It's not just the fact that Alice Haynes has already racked up so many winners, including several at Stakes level, that makes the flying start she has made to her training career so impressive.

It's also that so many of her charges arrive at the racecourse so beautifully turned out with impeccable manners and generally seem to be straightforward souls in the way they run.

That Haynes should be capable of such expert preparation is hardly surprising, though, as although she joined the ranks of public trainers only last year, she has a CV steeped in good horsemanship.

Hailing from a pony club and eventing background, she started her working life with Henrietta Knight and then moving to Mick Channon, before spending some time in Australia and returning to Britain to join David Simcock as an apprentice jockey, riding 11 winners.

She later got into pre-training and educated horses for a host of top Newmarket operations, including Roger Varian, William Haggas and Blue Diamond Stud, before being bitten by the training bug.

"Henrietta Knight and Mick Channon are about as different as you can get when it comes to training, but working with them both was good because you get to see two ends of the spectrum," says Haynes. *"With Henrietta you learn that every horse is different and you have to adapt their training accordingly, whereas at Mick's the horses are a bit like soldiers – some can take it and some stay down, and you find out their mentality that way."*

"Both approaches have their merits and I like to think I've taken a bit from everyone I've worked with and blended it into my own way of doing things now."

Regarding the pre-training side of things, she adds: *"I love breaking in horses and getting to know all their traits. We broke most of the yearlings we bought last year and I think it's a big advantage when you get to know what they're all about at that young age."*

No one can say that Haynes didn't have the experience to embark on a career as a trainer, then, and she also showed no shortage of determination in making the dream a reality.

"I just gathered a few horses and owners together, and set off from there," she says. *"People thought I was mad doing it in the middle of Covid, but you've got to start somewhere and the timing felt right. I also struggled to find a yard at first, but Mick*



Ryan's was empty, so I approached him and we came to an arrangement and I'm still training here now."

"I've also got some boxes licensed in a second yard, basically the other half of Simon Pearce's, and it's great. Both yards are in conjunction at the bottom of Warren Hill, so it works really well."

Haynes has 38 horses in her care at present, with room for 45 or 50. Such is the excellent start she has made, one suspects that it won't be long before she hits full capacity.

She sent out 20 winners in her rookie season in 2021, including **Mr Professor (Profitable)**, who scored a hat-trick that took in the Listed Silver Tankard Stakes at Pontefract, **Josies Kid (Ardad)**, who landed a competitive nursery at York, and **Gin O'Clock (Kodi Bear)**, who bolted up in a Chelmsford novice stakes. **Hollow Steel (Cotai Glory)** and **Smart Connection (Dutch Art)** also won two races each.

Haynes has already hit the 30-winner mark this year and there are plenty of classy performers among them. **Lady Hollywood (Havana Grey)** looks a top-notch after winning the Listed Marwell Stakes at Naas by clear water, while **Strong Power (Kodiac)** notched a treble of sprint handicaps on the all-weather and has improved around 30lb in the space of a year.

Haynes is keen not to expand too quickly, though, and is keenly aware of those disloyal owners that Sir Mark Prescott amusingly refers to as 'flockers' – going from one exciting new trainer to another and never leaving their horses anywhere for long.

"I'd like to get to around 60 horses, but I don't necessarily want to play the numbers game," she says. "I'm more interested in quality, and ensuring I still know the horses we've got inside and out, and believing that they're all capable of winning races. At the moment it doesn't even matter if they're Class 2 or Class 6 winners. It's all about getting your name out there and keeping owners happy."

"I want to pick up one or two new owners here and there, of course, but not necessarily ten in one go. You've got to be aware of what's going on, and you can see the owners who seem to move from yard to yard. I'm pleased to say most of the owners who started with me are still here now. We're growing together."

A high-profile owner who got on board with Haynes early and is still a fellow traveller is Amo Racing and its associated operation Omnihorse. It owns the Stakes scorers **Lady Hollywood** and **Mr Professor** and several of the trainer's other useful winners such as **Fix You (Night Of Thunder)**, **Girl Magic (Havana Grey)** and **Remarkable Force (Acclamation)**.

"Amo Racing is a fantastic connection, they've been great supporters and I'd like to think I'm doing them justice," says Haynes. "It all took off when their horse **Mr Professor** came to me from Joe Tuite's with a very good rating and we won two handicaps and then the Listed race with him. I bought a couple of yearlings after that and **Kia** [Joorabchian, Amo Racing founder] asked if there was anything I really liked, so I sold him one and it's grown from there, all on results."

The best result of all has come from **Lady Hollywood**, who was bought by Amo Racing associate Robson Aguiar from the Goffs Sportsman's Yearling Sale for €25,000 and went unsold at the Tattersalls Craven Breeze-Up Sale at 58,000gns.

"She's just such an easy filly to work with," says Haynes. "Since the first day I had her you'd never have thought that she had been a breeze-up horse. She's not the biggest – not the smallest either – but the main thing is she just has a great mind and takes everything in her stride. If I had ten like her I'd be very happy indeed."

Plans call for **Lady Hollywood** to contest the Gr.3 Prix d'Arenberg at Longchamp in early September, with the back-up plan of the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes at Doncaster a week later. Her trainer is confident she will take the step up in class in her stride.

"We were thinking when she went to Ireland that she'd probably finish second to **Mauiewowie (Night Of Thunder)**, as Ger Lyons said she was her best two-year-old filly, but she improved again and won convincingly, and has gone up to a mark of 103 and I don't think we've reached her ceiling of ability yet," says Haynes.

"Those French sprints often break up a bit, as they don't seem to have as many of those speedier types over there, so she should go well in the Prix d'Arenberg. We're sticking with five, or five and a half, furlongs with her for now. She has such a good mind it's tempting to try her at six, as I'm sure she'd settle, but while she's doing so well at five we won't change the winning formula."

Lady Hollywood provided flying first-season sire **Havana Grey** with his first Stakes winner at Naas and **Girl Magic** isn't a bad advert for him either, so Haynes is prepared for his progeny rising out of her budget at this year's yearling sales. But, thinking on her feet, she's spied an opportunity nevertheless.

"The price of the **Havana Greys** will go up massively," she says. "I was recently introduced to Ed Harper, so I'll be sure to approach him again to see if he has anything for me after training the sire's first Stakes winner! Sometimes that's the way it happens, you have a bit of luck like that and it's a way of getting half a foot in the door and being able to shake someone's hand."

Haynes is naturally delighted to have **Lady Hollywood** and plenty of other sharp juveniles flying the flag for her at the moment, but she is also a little wary about being pigeonholed as a two-year-old trainer.

"The most important thing for me now is to get my name out there and, if that's by winning with two-year-olds that's absolutely fine," she says, "But I don't want to be stamped as a trainer of precocious juveniles in the long run, and I don't think I will be as I'd like to think we've got a nice bunch to go into next year with."

"I suppose a big part of it for me is about learning patience. Some horses just aren't ready to run now and you've got to have those owners who are prepared to wait for those later maturing ones with you, whether that's until the latter part of the year or even early next year if that's what it takes."

Haynes is also a nimble thinker when it comes to sourcing stock, but then she has to be when she knows that she's not going to be able to afford the most prized horses on the market.

"I've bought some older horses from the horses-in-training sales, sometimes after seeing them race against runners you're involved with and just thinking to yourself 'oh I'd love to get hold of that, and give it a change of scenery or trip,'" she says.

"**Strong Power (Kodiac)** would be a good example of that. He had looked a bit regressive and lost his way for George Scott, but for some reason I'd earmarked him and put him in my tracker, so when I saw him go through the sale I thought I'd try and buy him."

"He cost 24,000gns, which was the maximum I had for him, and even George said he thought I'd paid too much. I can't claim it was a change of scenery that improved him, as it's all Newmarket, but sometimes just a different style of training can make a horse click."

Strong Power finished second in a valuable Chelmsford handicap on his last outing and is a name to watch out for on the all-weather next winter when he will, all things being equal, be aimed at more big handicaps and perhaps even Listed contests.

Of course, much of Haynes's ammunition so far has been untried stock. On that score, she continues: "I bought a few yearlings last year and I've been fortunate enough to buy a few

breezers as well. Obviously I haven't had the sorts of orders to be able to afford the *creme de la creme* when it comes to pedigrees, or the lots with the quickest times at the breeze-ups.

"I've been able to get the odd really well-bred horse when they've been a bit crooked, because that's what makes them affordable to someone like me, so it's all about doing your homework and making sure you've seen all those horses in order for a bargain to fall into your hands. I have to buy on spec and find an owner afterwards, but I think that's the best way sometimes.

"I managed to buy a **Kodiak** colt out of **Angelic Guest**, a **Dark Angel** full-sister to **Sovereign Debt**, at the yearling sales last year. I did all my homework, had a good look at him and saw he had a little bit of a curb on a hock, and still thought I'd never be able to afford him. But when he went through the ring he had no bid and so I managed to get him for £16,000.

"I'm happy to take well-bred horses like that who aren't 100% perfect. I'd never be able to afford them otherwise and, at the end of the day, is any horse completely without fault? I don't think so. Look at Mark Johnston; he half closes his eyes to conformation."

New Hope Bullet, a two-year-old **New Bay** filly sent out by Haynes to compile some very useful form behind good horses and to win two races, most recently a decent nursery at Chelmsford, makes for another interesting case study in sourcing stock.

"She's not the biggest filly and the dam hadn't done all that much, but the owners were all out for a **New Bay** and so I tried

to steer them in the best direction I could," says the trainer about the 40,000gns purchase from the Tattersalls Craven Breeze-Up Sale in April. "If she was a hand bigger she probably would've been double the price, but what she lacks in size she makes up for in attitude.

"She's a real terrier and we have to keep a lid on her at home, but her work has always been very good. She had hit a disappointing run but won well recently and will go on from that."

As you will no doubt have noticed throughout the course of this interview, there really is a startlingly high number of good horses to talk about in a training career that started only at the end of February last year. So the crunch question is where does Haynes see herself in another 18 months?

"I was pinching myself when we managed to get a Stakes winner in our first year with **Mr Professor**, not just for myself but for the whole team – we'd never dreamt of that," she says. "This year we wanted to raise the bar higher again, and with **Lady Hollywood** we've already managed to match that Stakes winner.

"So I suppose I'd love to see us have a Group winner by the end of the year, and then God knows what the aim will be for 2023. I'd love to get to 50 winners though, that would have to be the target.

"Either way, it's all about keeping on improving and working together as a team to do that. If we mess up and have a bad day, we'll try and work out why and move on from it, and do our best not to do it again."

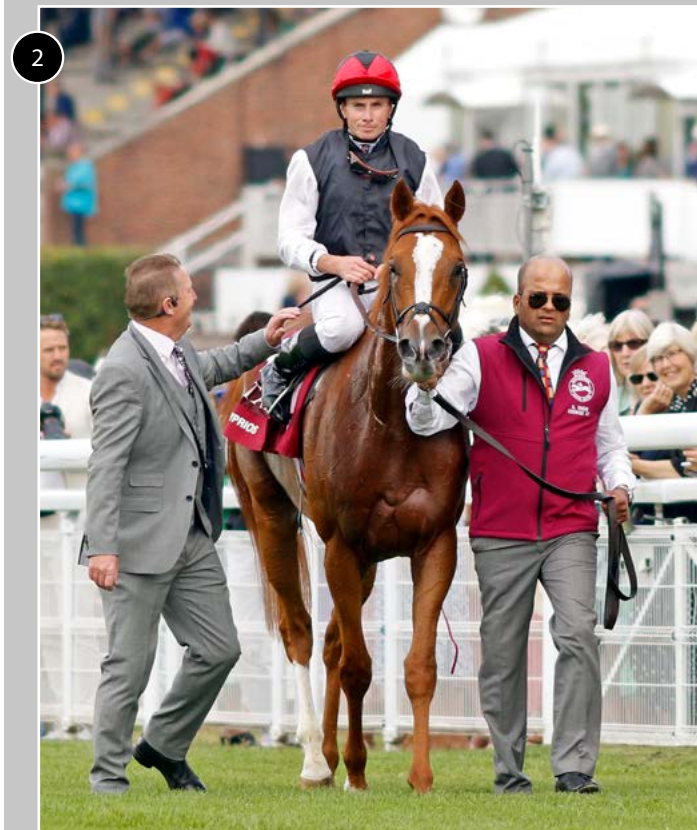
