A'A LI

Society Rock – Motion Lass (Motivator)

NEWSELLS PARK STUD • Fee £7,500 1st Oct SLF

Royal Ascot-winning two-year-old **A'Ali** will stand his first season at Newsells Park Stud this year. He was initially due to stand at Robert and Catherine Dallas' Meadow Farm Stud, but after the Newsells team saw him parade at the National Stud in December they were so impressed they purchased a significant share in the multiple Group winner.

He is the best son of Champion European First Season Sire **Society Rock** and was a lightning fast juvenile. He won the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes at Royal Ascot on his second start and followed up the following month by winning he Gr.2 Prix Robert Papin at Deauville, and he also collected the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes that September. At three he won the Gr.3 Sprint Stakes at Sandown and followed up in the Gr.2 Sapphire Stakes at the Curragh, before finishing fourth to **Battaash** and the older horses in the Gr.1 Nunthope Stakes.

Jockey Frankie Dettori said: "A'Ali was a top-class sprinter and certainly one of the fastest two-year-olds I have ridden. He travelled very well in his races and had push-button acceleration, which made my life easy."

He is out of a placed **Motivator** half-sister to Gr.3 Darley Stakes winner and Gr.1 Coronation Cup-placed **Enforcer** (**Efisio**) and the Stakes-placed **Canaveral** (**Cape Cross**). The second dam **Willowy Mood** (**Will Win**) was a Gr.3 winner in the US and also ran third in the Gr.1 Mother Goose Stakes.



AFFAIRE SOLITAIRE

Danehill Dancer – Arlesienne (Alzao)

HARAS D'ANNEBAULT • Fee €3,500 LF

Affaire Solitare is relocating from Italy to Haras d'Annebault this season, having spent three years at Allevamento Razza Ticino, and he will be the only son of **Danehill Dancer** standing in France.

From a crop of just seven foals in his first crop last year, he has had seven runners and two winners, including maiden winner **Say The Truth**, trained by Gian Marco Pala, with every prospect of improvement at three.

Affaire Solitare was second on his only start at two behind subsequent Stakes winner **Wire To Wire** and broke his maiden at three. He won a further two races at four and was placed in two Listed races before his Gr.3 victory in the Prix Exbury and he finished his season with a second to **Al Kazeem** in the Gr.2 Prix d'Harcourt. Tough and consistent, the following year he was placed a further twice in those same Group races.

From a leading Wildenstein family, he is a half-brother to Listed winner and multiple Group-placed sire **Aizavoski** (**Monsun**), Stakes winner **Andromeda Galaxy** (**Peintre Celebre**) and the Stakes-placed **Altamira** (**Peintre Celebre**), the dam of Gr.1 Prix du Moulin runner-up **Akatea** (**Shamardal**). They are out of the Listed scorer **Arlesienne** (**Alzao**), who is a full-sister to Gr.1 Beverly D Stakes and Gr.1 Diana Handicap winner **Angara**.

ALKUMAIT

Showcasing – Suelita (Dutch Art)

CASTLEFIELD STUD • Fee €5,000 1st Oct terms

Gr.2-winning juvenile **Alkumait** joins the growing roster at Castlefield Stud in Co. Kilkenny this season. The son of **Showcasing** was trained by Marcus Tregoning for Shadwell, who purchased him for 220,000gns at Tattersalls Book 1 from Baroda Stud and was bred at the home of his sire at Whitsbury Manor Stud. He was a smart two-year-old, winning on his second start over six furlongs at Goodwood by an impressive two and a quarter lengths and taking the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes at Newbury in a record time.

Owners Capital Bloodstock are going to support him with some of their best mares and are also offering an impressive bonus scheme of €100,000 to breeders who support the Groupwinning sprinter. The bonus is for the first horse from his first crop to become a black-type winner as a juvenile. It covers Ireland, Britain, France and the US, and the breeder will receive €50,000 and the trainer and owner will each receive €25,000.

Alkumait is a half-brother to Listed Committed Stakes winner The Broghie Man (Cityscape) and Listed-placed Gloves Lynch (Mukhadram), out of the winning Dutch Art mare Suelita. She is a half-sister to Gr.3 Cornwallis Stakes runner-up Outer Space (Acclamation) and to the dam of Gr.2 Lowther Stakes scorer Living In The Past (Bungle Inthejungle). The second dam is a half-sister to Gr.3 Pinnacle Stakes winner and EP Taylor Stakes-placed Moment In Time (Tiger Hill).



ALSON


Areion – Assisi (Galileo)

GESTUET FAEHRHOF • Fee €6,000 SLF

Gr.1-winning juvenile and Classic-placed **Alson** retires to Gestüt Fährhof for his first season at stud in 2022. The wellbred son of multiple Champion sire **Areion** was precocious and talented and is from an excellent German family.

Trained as a juvenile by Jean-Pierre Carvalho for owner/breeder Gestüt Schlenderhan, he won over six furlongs on debut in June and collected the Gr.3 Preis Zukunftsrennen on his fourth outing. He was second to **Victor Ludorum** in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardère before beating **Armory** to win the Gr.1 Critérium International. He switched to André Fabre for his three-year-old campaign and ran third on his first start for the stable in the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains, behind **Victor Ludorum**, won the Listed Prix Matchem over 1400m later in the season, and finished second in the Gr.3 Prix Perth.

Alson is a half-brother to Classic winner Ancient Spirit (Invincible Spirit), who won the Gr.2 Mehl Mülhens-Rennen (2,000 Guineas), out of the dual winner Assisi (Galileo). She is a half-sister to Gr.3 winner Amazona (Dubawi) and the dam of Champion German Older Stayer Apadanah (Holy Roman Emperor). The second dam, Amarette (Monsun), won the Gr.1 Preis der Diana and is a half-sister to Stakeswinning dam of Champion Almandin (Monsun).



BANGKOK

Australia – Tanaghum (Darshaan)

CHAPEL STUD • Fee £3,000 1st Oct FFR

Gr.2 winner **Bangkok**, the first son of **Australia** to stand at stud in the UK, retires to Chapel Studthis year as a dual-purpose prospect. Bred by Barronstown Stud, he was a 500,000gns Book 1 yearling and raced in the colours of King Power. Trained by Andrew Balding, he was second on debut as a juvenile to **Sangarius**. He won on debut at three over a mile and a quarter at Doncaster and then won the Gr.3 Classic Trial, beating **Technician** by a length and a quarter. He disappointed in the Gr.1 Derby, but he returned to run second to Japan in the Gr.2 King Edward VII Stakes at Ascot, before finishing off the year with a neck second in the Gr.3 Strensall Stakes and runner-up in the Qatar Derby at Doha. The following year he won the Listed Winter Derby Trial Stakes and was placed in the Gr.3 Winter Derby, but his best run came at five when he won the Gr.2 York Stakes.

By the well-bred Champion Australia, he also brings great blood from his dam side. He is a half-brother to Gr.1 winner Matterhorn (Raven's Pass), Stakes winners Tactic (Sadler's Wells) and Yaazy (Teofilo), as well as the Listed-placed Zahoo (Nayef) and the dam of Ribchester (Iffraaj). His Stakes-placed dam Tanaghum is by leading broodmare sire Darshaan and is out of the Champion Filly Mehtaaf, who is a half-sister to Champion Sprinter and sire **Elnadim**. It is also the further family of Mondialist, Intello and Shaman, and goes back to Fall Aspen.



BORN TO SEA

Invincible Spirit – Urban Sea (Miswaki)

HARAS DE LA HETRAIE • Fee €4,500 LF

Born To Sea has moved north from Haras des Faunes to Haras de la Hêtraie for the 2022 season. The son of **Invincible Spirit** will stand as a dual-purpose prospect, having already sired a number of high-level runners over jumps, including Gradedwinning hurdlers A Wave Of The Sea, Aspire Tower and My Mate Mozzie. He is the sire of six Stakes winners the Flat, including Gr.3 winner and Classic-placed Sea Of Grace. Australian Gr.3 scorer Shared Ambition and Listed winners, Naval Warfare, Born With Pride, Il Decamerone and Sea King.

Born To Sea won the Listed Blenheim Stakes on debut at two and was second to Camelot (Montjeu) in the Gr.1 Irish Derby. He started his stud career at Rathasker Stud in 2013, moved to Gilltown in 2015 and relocated to France in 2019. He was very popular during his three seasons at Haras de Faunes and covered 360 mares during this time.

The half-brother to Galileo and Sea The Stars is also a halfbrother to Black Sam Bellamy, who is the sire of multiple Gr.1-winning hurdler **Galop Marin**. They are out of the great producer and Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner **Urban Sea** (Miswaki) and this is also the immediate family of sires Masterstroke (Monsun), who was a Gr.2 winner and placed in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, and Masar (New Approach), who landed the Gr.1 Derby and stands at Darley's Dalham Hall Stud, and has his first yearlings this year.

BURATINO

Exceed And Excel – Bergamask (Kingmambo) **HEDGHOLME STUD** • Fee £3.000

Gr.2 Coventry Stakes winner **Buratino** relocates from Kildangan Stud to Hedgeholme and will be the only son of **Exceed And Excel** at stud in Britain. Represented by his first runners in 2020, he had 14 winners, including the Groupplaced **Snapraeterea**, who ran third in the Gr.2 Beresford Stakes, as well as the Stakes-placed **Run For Me** and **Macasai**. He had an even better year last year, with a further 36 winners, a strike rate of 41 per cent winners to runners, while **Snapraeterea** became his first Stakes winner, taking out the Listed Owenstown Stud Stakes and Listed Platinum Stakes, as well as running third in the Gr.3 Gallinule Stakes.

Picking up two victories and a place in his first three starts, **Buratino** was runner-up at Listed level before winning both the Listed Woodcote Stakes and Gr.2 Coventry Stakes, beating **Air Force Blue** in the latter. Following a brief break he returned to finish third in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes and was then runner-up to **Shalaa** in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes. The speedy juvenile won the Coventry in a time faster than **Calyx** and the Woodcote faster than **Pinatubo**.

He is out of the Listed-placed **Bergamask** (**Kingmambo**), who is out of a half-sister to Champion Sire **Danehill Dancer**, (**Danehill**), while this is the further family of sires **Mr Greeley** (**Gone West**) and **Street Sense** (**Street Cry**).

DEE EX BEE

Farhh – Dubai Sunrise (Seeking The Gold)

ARCTIC TACK STUD • Fee €3,500 (filly concession)

New to stud this year, Gr.1 Derby runner-up and high-class older stayer **Dee Ex Bee** joins the roster at Arctic Tack Stud. The son of **Farhh** was also a dual winner at two and is out of a sister to **Dubai Millennium**. He won over seven furlongs as a two-year-old and stayed up to 16 furlongs on a variety of going, beating 11 Gr.1 winners. He boasts 15 stallions in his first three generations and is free of **Sadler's Wells** blood.

Trained by Mark Johnston, he won on debut at Goodwood, was placed in the Listed Ascendant Stakes and collected a conditions event at Epsom before running second to **Kew Gardens** in the Listed (then) Zetland Stakes. At three he was placed twice in Stakes company, then ran second to **Masar** in the Gr.1 Derby and was five lengths behind **Latrobe** in the Irish equivalent. He was then placed in the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris, Gr.3 Gordon Stakes, Gr.1 St Leger and Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Bayern. He returned at four to win the Gr.3 Sagaro Stakes and backed up in the Gr.3 Henry II Stakes before finding only **Stradivarius** too good in the Gr.1 Gold Cup, Gr.1 Goodwood Cup and Gr.2 Lonsdale Cup. He signed off that year with a third place in the Gr.1 Prix du Cadran.

He is out of a full-sister to the great **Dubai Millennium** (**Seeking The Gold**) and his second dam **Colorado Dancer** (**Shareef Dancer**) was a dual Group winner and placed twice at Gr.1 level. The third dam is the great **Fall Aspen** (**Pretense**).

DREAM AHEAD

Diktat – Land Of Dreams (Cadeaux Genereux)

BEARSTONE STUD • Fee £7,500 1st Oct SLF

An exciting new addition to Bearstone Stud is the sire of its homebred Gr.1 winner Glass Slippers in Dream Ahead (Diktat). Globtrotting speedster Glass Slippers took the Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye, Gr.1 Flying Five Stakes and Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint in the blue and white colours of Bearstone Stud. She is one of four Gr.1 winners for the sire, namely Gr.1 Prix Jacques Le Marois winner and Haras de Bouquetot sire Al Wukair, Gr.1 British Champion Sprint Stakes hero and sire **Donjuan Triumphant** and Gr.1 Haydock Sprint Cup Stakes and Gr.1 Diamond Jubilee Stakes winner Dream Of Dreams.

Dream Ahead retired to Ballylinch Stud in Ireland in 2012 and relocated to Haras de Grandcamp in 2017, so this is the first time that he will be available to British breeders. On the track he was a dual Gr.1-winning juvenile, taking the Gr.1 Prix Morny and Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes, and he added another trio to the tally at three when landing the Gr.1 July Cup, Gr.1 Haydock Sprint Cup and Gr.1 Prix de la Forêt.

He is a half-brother to Group-placed Into The Dark and Bin Battuta, as well as to the dam of dual Gr.1 winner Fairyland and Group winner and Classic-placed Now Or Later. They are out of the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes winner Land Of Dreams (Cadeaux Genereux), and their grandam Sahara Star (Green Desert) won the Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes.



"The relaunch of Dream Ahead in the British market in 2022 following five years in Ireland and four seasons in Normandy is interesting, especially as his new custodians Bearstone Stud are pitching him at just £7,500. That's a very fair price for a proven sire whose CV includes Group 1 winners Al Wukair, Donjuan Triumphant, Dream Of Dreams and Glass Slippers, and whose stock still commands plenty of respect in the marketplace."

DSCHINGIS SECRET

Soldier Hollow – Divya (Platini)

HARAS DE MONTAIGU

Fee **€4,000 LF** • **€2,500 LF** for NH mares

German Horse of the Year Dschingis Secret has relocated from Haras de Saint Arnoult to the nearby Haras de Montaigu this year, ahead of his first two-year-old crop hitting the track. The Gr.1-winning son of leading German sire Soldier Hollow also comes from a solid German family and is a fullbrother to four Group winners, including Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Deutsches Derby runner-up and sire **Destino**.

Trained by Markus Klug, he was placed over a mile as a juvenile and ran solid races to be placed three times in Stakes company at three, including half a length third to Isfahan (Lord Of England) in the Gr.1 Deutsches Derby, before winning the Gr.3 St Leger Italiano. He then went from strength to strength, taking out two Gr.2s before his crowning moment in the Gr.1 Preis von Berlin, beating Hawkbill (Kitten's Joy). He followed up with victory in the Gr.2 Prix Foy, beating **Cloth** Of Stars (Sea The Stars), ran sixth behind Enable (Nathaniel) in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and was only beaten half a length in the Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Bayern. He raced on at five and was second to Waldgeist (Galileo) in the Gr.2 Grand Prix de Chantilly before landing the Gr.2 Grosser Hansa-Preis.

Montaigu is also offering a bonus system for all foals conceived in 2022, with €10,000 to the breeder of a Gr.1 winner and €5,000 to the breeder of a Gr.2 or Gr.3 winner.



FLINTSHIRE

Dansili – Dance Routine (Sadler's Wells)

HARAS DE MONTAIGU • Fee €6,500 LF

After seven years at Hill 'N' Dale Farms in Kentucky, five-time Gr.1 winner **Flintshire** has relocated to Haras de Montaigu for 2022. Bred and raced by Juddmonte, the son of **Dansili** won over \$9.5 million on the track and has produced Group performers from his first crop. His progeny to date include unbeaten Juddmonte juvenile **Verbal**, who won the Gr.3 Cecil B DeMille Stakes on his second start and looks a smart prospect for this year, and Gr.3 Prix Noailles scorer **Cheshire Academy**, who was only four lengths behind **St Mark's Basilica** in the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club, as well as Listed winner **Runaway Rumour**, who also placed in the Gr.2 Sands Point Stakes and Gr.2 Lake Placid Stakes.

Flintshire was unraced at two, won on debut at three and landed the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris later that year. Ultra consistent at the top level, he was only out of the first two twice on his next 18 starts. He travelled around the world and recorded victories on three continents. He was crowned Champion Older Horse in Europe in 2014 with four Gr.1 places and victory in the Gr.1 Hong Kong Vase. The following year he won the Gr.1 Sword Dancer Stakes at Saratoga and at six he added two further Gr.1s in the Manhattan Stakes and a second Sword Dancer. He is out of Gr.2 scorer Dance Routine (Sadler's Wells), who is a full-sister to the dam of Champion Enable and a half-sister to Gr.3 winner and sire Apsis.

JAPAN

Galileo – Shastye (Danehill)

GESTUT ETZEAN • Fee €11,000 1st Oct terms

Group-winning two-year-old and dual Gr.1 winner **Japan** retires to stud this year. The son of **Galileo** is a full-brother to dual Gr.1 winner **Mogul**, Gr.3 winner **Sir Isaac Newton** and Gr.2 scorer and Gr.1-placed **Secret Gesture**, and is the highest-rated offspring to date out of **Shastye** (**Danehill**).

Trained by Aidan O'Brien, he won the Gr.2 Beresford Stakes on his third start as a juvenile. He was only beaten half a length by **Anthony Van Dyck (Galileo)** in the Gr.1 Derby and followed up with wins in the Gr.2 King Edward VII Stakes, beating **Bangkok** (**Australia**) by four and a half lengths, before landing two Gr.1s on the bounce in the Grand Prix de Paris and the Juddmonte International Stakes, beating Champion **Crystal Ocean (Sea The Stars)**. He finished that season with a fourth place in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. He raced on at four and five, collecting the Gr.3 Ormonde Stakes and Gr.3 Meld Stakes, as well as being placed a further six times in Gr.1 company.

Bred by Newsells Park Stud, he was purchased by MV Magnier for 1,300,000gns at Tattersalls Book 1. Rated 122, he was one point ahead of his brother **Mogul**, who won the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris as well as taking Gr.1 Hong Kong Vase and retired to Coolmore's Beeches Stud this year. His second dam **Saganexa** (**Sagace**) was the Champion Older Mare in Italy and she produced Gr.1 winners and sires **Sagamix** (**Linamix**) and **Sagacity** (**Highest Honor**).



KOOL KOMPANY

Jeremy – Absolutely Cool (Indian Ridge)

CLONGIFFEN STUD • Fee €2,000

Multiple Group winner **Kool Kompany** is relocating to Clongiffen Stud in Ireland after spending his first four seasons at stud in Spain, where he has had two juvenile winners from eight runners. He offers breeders a dual-purpose option as a dual Group-winning juvenile sprinter that also won up to a mile and a son of leading National Hunt sire **Jeremy**, as well as a full-brother to Gr.1-performing hurdler **Prussian Eagle**.

Trained by Richard Hannon, he won his first three starts as a two-year-old, including the Listed Rochestown Stakes. He continued to progress through the season and was a two-length winner of the Gr.2 Railway Stakes and he doubled up the following month with victory in the Gr.2 Prix Robert Papin, before a good second in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes. At three, he started with a win in the Gr.3 Craven Stakes over a mile, was unplaced in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas and Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup, but finished his time in the UK with a second in the Gr.3 Thoroughbred Stakes. He then transferred to Chris Waller in Australia, with his best run a fourth in the Gr.2 Ajax Stakes, but returned to Hannon as a five-year-old and won the Listed Doncaster Mile.

He is a half-brother to the high-class juvenile hurdler **Prussian Eagle** and Listed-placed duo of **Koolasice** (**Kodiac**) and **Ridge City** (**Elusive Quality**). They are out of a placed **Indian Ridge** daughter of Gr.3 C L Weld Park Stakes-placed **Absolute Glee** (**Kenmare**).

Gr.1 Deutsches Derby winner and Champion German Three-Year-Old **Laccario** (**Scalo**) is retiring to stud this year at Haras d'Annebault as a dual-purpose sire.

Beaten only a head on his only start at two by subsequent Group winner **Quian**, he was unbeaten in his first four starts at three. He started out winning a conditions at Cologne, stepped up to take the Listed Derby-Trial and then the Gr.2 Union-Rennen before his Deutsches Derby win. He was placed behind **Ghaiyyath** in the Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Baden and completed his season with a nose second to **Itobo** in the Gr.3 Preis der Deutschen Einheit. He relocated to the US as a four-year-old and ran second to multiple Gr.1 winner **Channel Maker** in the Gr.1 Joe Hirsch Turf Classic Stakes and second to Gr.1 winner **Arklow** in the Gr.2 Hollywood Turf Cup Stakes.

He is out of the winning **Lomitas** mare **Laccata**, who is a half-sister to the dams of Stakes winners **Lucarelli** and **Laviva** (both by **High Chaparral**), as well as the Stakes-placed **Love Happens** (**Motivator**). The second dam **La Donna** (**Shirley Heights**) was third in the Gr.2 (then) Preis der Diana and is a half-sister to the Champion German Three-Year-Old and sire **Lando** (**Acatenango**) and Gr.1 Deutsches Derby winner and sire **Laroche** (**Nebos**), as well as to the dam of Gr.1 (then) Gran Premio del Jockey Club winner **Lovelyn** (**Tiger Hill**).

Top stayer **Leading Light** has joined the British stallion ranks this year at Dunraven Stud from Coolmore's Grange Stud, where he had stood since retiring in 2015. He won again on debut at four in the Gr.3 Vintage Crop Stakes before his second Gr.1 victory in the Gold Cup at Ascot, and he also won the Gr.3 Irish St Leger Trial Stakes before running second to **Brown Panther** in the Gr.1 Irish St Leger Stakes.

He is out of the Gr.3 (then) Queen Mary and Gr.3 Fred Darling Stakes winner **Dance Parade** (**Gone West**) and is a full-brother to Gr.3 Swinton Handicap Hurdle winner **John Constable**, among seven winners.

LOPE Y FERNANDEZ

Lope De Vega – Black Dahlia (Dansili)

THE NATIONAL STUD • Fee £8,500

An exciting edition to The National Stud roster this year is European Champion 3YO Sprinter **Lope Y Fernandez**, who is standing in partnership with Whitsbury Manor Stud and Nick Bradley Racing. This good-looking son of **Lope De Vega** was a E900,000 Arqana yearling and he is sure to be well supported by his connections.

Trained by Aidan O'Brien, he won at the Curragh on debut over seven furlongs in June, before being placed twice behind Champion **Pinatubo** in the UK, and he then landed the Gr.2 Round Tower Stakes when dropped back to six furlongs back at the Curragh. Classic-placed on his return when third to **Siskin** in the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas, he was consistent at the top level with two places in France when getting within a length of **Pinatubo** and then **Space Blues**, and he finished the year in Keeneland when a length behind **Order Of Australia** in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Mile. Returning at four, he picked up the Listed Heritage Stakes at Leopardstown and went on to run a length and a half second to World Champion Miler **Palace Pier** in the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes at Ascot.

He is out of Listed-placed **Black Dahlia** (**Dansili**), who has also produced the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes winner and German Champion Older Miler **Dark Vision** (**Dream Ahead**) and Listed-placed **Al Hayyah** (**Lope De Vega**).



LUCKY VEGA

Lope De Vega – Queen Of Carthage (Cape Cross)

IRISH NATIONAL STUD • Fee €15,000 1st Oct terms

Gr.1-winning juvenile and Classic-placed **Lucky Vega** joins the roster at the Irish National Stud this year for his first Northern Hemisphere season, having spent the winter standing at Yulong Investments' Nagambie Farm in Australia, where the son of **Lope De Vega** covered 114 mares.

Trained by Jessica Harrington for Zhang Yuesheng, **Lucky Vega** was top-class juvenile, winning on debut at Naas and then running second in the Gr.2 Railway Stakes before taking the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes in style, beating the likes of six-time Gr.1 winner **St Mark's Bascilica (Siyouni)** by over three lengths. After a disrupted passage in the Gr.1 National Stakes, he ran on well for fifth and finished the season with a second to **Supremacy (Mehmas)** in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes. Returning at three, he went straight for the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas and was only beaten half a length in third by **Poetic Flare (Dawn Approach)** and he then ran fourth on heavy ground to **Mac Swiney (New Approach)** in the Irish equivalent. His final run came in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes, when he was second to **Poetic Flare**.

Lucky Vega is one of three winners out of the unraced **Queen Of Carthage (Cape Cross)**. She is a daughter of Gr.1 Prix de l'Opéra winner **Satwa Queen (Muhtathir)**, who is a half-sister Gr.1 Critérium de Saint-Cloud winner and sire **Spadoun (Kaldoun)**.



MATTMU

Indesatchel – Katie Boo (Namid)

BEARSTONE STUD • Fee £2,500 1st Oct SLF

Gr.2-winning sprinter **Mattmu** (**Indesatchel**) is returning home to Bearstone Stud in 2022, where he was born and raised, and spent his first year at stud in 2018. Successful in the Gr.2 Critérium de Maisons-Laffitte and Gr.3 Phoenix Sprint, he was also third in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes, beating six Gr.1 winners, including **Sole Power**, **Goldream**, **Profitable**, **Astaire**, **Maarek** and **Move In Time**, and was crowned joint Champion 3yo Sprinter of 2015.

He has done well from a small first crop of just seven foals and appears to be significantly upgrading his mares. His first two-year-olds recorded a strike rate of 40 per cent (two winners from five runners) with average earnings of £15,040, compared to 17 per cent and £1,134 for their siblings by other stallions. These also include the Karl Burke-trained **Favourite Child**, who was only beaten a head in second in the Listed Critérium de Vitesse at Longchamp at the end of last year.

He is out of two-year-old winner **Katie Boo** (**Namid**), who won six races from two to six and is a half-sister to Stakes winner **Maldron Prom** *aka* **Super Alloy** (**Kheleyf**) and Stakes-placed **Penthouse Serenade** (**Val Royal**). The second dam **Misty Peak** (**Sri Pekan**) ran third in the Listed Silver Flash Stakes and is a half-sister to Listed Ballycullen Stakes runner-up **Golly Gosh** (**Danehill**).



MR SCARAMANGA

Sir Percy – Lulla (Oasis Dream)

LM STALLIONS • Fee £1,000 1st Oct terms

New to the March Hare Stud roster in Dorset this year, under the LM Stallions banner, is **Mr Scaramanga**, who is the first son of Gr.1 Derby winner **Sir Percy** to go to stud.

Tough and consistent, he won from two to six, starting with a six-furlong maiden in the May of his juvenile campaign for Richard Hannon. He then ran second to **Churchill** in the Listed Chesham Stakes, was placed in the Gr.2 Superlative Stakes and was second to **Escobar** in the Listed Washington Singer Stakes within the space of three months. As a newly turned three-year-old he was taken to the Emir's Sword Festival in Qatar to contest the valuable Gr.2d Al Biddah Mile at Doha, which he duly won in style for Simon Dow. He returned to the UK to run second in the Listed International Trial Stakes, gaining an official rating of 105. During his five-year career, he won or was placed in 17 of his 55 starts for career earnings of £196,754.

Mr Scaramanga is out of the winning Oasis Dream mare Lulla, while his second dam is Gr.2 (then) King's Stand winner Dominica and his third dam Dominio landed the Listed St Hugh's Stakes and was runner-up in the Gr.2 Temple Stakes. She is the ancestress of Gr.3 Cornwallis Stakes winner Abel Handy (Arcano), the Gr.3 Fred Darling Stakes winner and Gr.1-placed Rimth (Oasis Dream) and Listed Marygate Stakes winner Delizia (Dark Angel).


Kodiac – Chibola (Roy)

IRISH NATIONAL STUD • Fee €6,000 1st Oct terms

Royal Ascot-winning two-year-old **Nando Parrado** retires to the Irish National Stud this year. The son of **Kodiac** was a fairly expensive foal at 165,000gns and was bought by top judge and pinhooker Paul McCartan of Ballyphilip Stud. He was re-offered as a yearling but bought back at 200,000gns, as McCartan thought too highly of the colt to let him go, being by a top sire, with outstanding looks and with his first three dams Gr.1 performers or Gr.1 producers.

He is out of Argentinian mare **Chibola** (**Roy**), who won at Gr.3 level and was Gr.1 placed, and has produced the Listed Ben Marshall Stakes-placed **Muntadab** (**Invincible Spirit**). She is a full-sister to Gr.1-winning two-year-old sprinter **Chollo** and the Argentinian Champion Three-Year-Old and Derby winner **Cheyenne** (**Pepenador**) features under the third dam.

Named after a survivor of the 1972 Andes plane crash, **Nando Parrado** raced in McCartan's wife's name, Marie, and was trained by Clive Cox. Sent off as 150-1 on his second start in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes, he put up a fine performance with a strong finish to win by a length. He was runner-up in Gr.1s on his next two starts, when second to **Campanelle** (**Kodiac**) in the Gr.1 Prix Morny and only found **Sealiway** (**Galiway**) too good in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardère. He returned at three to run fourth in the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes and the Listed Heron Stakes.



ROSEMAN

Kingman – Go Lovely Rose (Pivotal)
LM STALLIONS • Fee £5,500

Joining the increasing number of stallions under the LM Stallions banner at March Hare Stud in Dorset this year is the highly-regarded **Roseman**, a son of Champion **Kingman** (**Invincible Spirit**), who recorded a gallant head second to **The Revenant** (**Dubawi**) in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes, with the pair over three lengths clear of Champion **Palace Pier** (**Kingman**) in third. He was also a dual winner the previous season at three when he took out the Listed Ben Marshall Stakes at Newmarket, beating **Century Dream**, **Accidental Agent** and **Mitchum Swagger**. He finished his career on a Timeform mark of 125, with other performances including a fourth in the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes to **Circus Maximus**, when he was ahead of Gr.1 winners **Mohaather**, **Mustashry** and **Billesdon Brook**.

Trainer Roger Varian said: "Roseman was a very talented high-class individual and blessed with an exceptional temperament along with a huge amount of ability."

He is a half-brother to the Gr.1 Futurity Stakes-placed **Barader** (**Muhaarar**) and Gr.3-placed **Game Zone** (**Hurricane Run**). They are out of the French three-year-old winner **Go Lovely Rose** (**Pivotal**), who is a full-sister to Champion **Immortal Verse** (dam of Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes winner **Tenebrism**), from the family of Champion and sire **Last Tycoon**.

He was a high-class juvenile for Aidan O'Brien and he won on debut at Navan in June and landed the Gr.2 July Stakes at Newmarket, before running a length third to subsequent Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas-winner **Siskin** in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes at the Curragh, when jockey Donnacha O'Brien reported his saddle slipped when leaving the stalls.

The trainer said: "Royal Lytham was a very precocious, tough, hardy, fast colt. He showed all those qualities winning the July Stakes."

He is one of three winners out of French Listed winner and Gr.2 Prix de la Grotte runner-up **Gotlandia** (**Anabaa**) and his winning second dam is a full-sister to Gr.1 Fillies' Mile winner **Glorosia** (**Bering**), while his third dam **Green City** (**Green Dancer**) was second in the Gr.3 Prix Fille de l'Air.

Royal Lytham hails from the first crop of **Gleneagles**, who recorded his best year to date on the track in 2021 with 11 Group/Stakes winners and his first Gr.1 winner in the form of the John and Thady Gosden-trained Gr.1 Prix de Royallieu heroine **Loving Dream**.


Mehmas – Triggers Broom (Arcano)

He raced a further three times at three but did not reach the same heights. Speaking about the colt, Cox said: "**Supremacy** is just pure class. His talent was clear to see early on with a blistering turn of foot and, coupled with his wonderful laid-back attitude, he was an absolute pleasure to train. I really look forward to having a few of his progeny at Beechdown Stables in the years to come."

He is out of a half-sister to Gr.1 Champions' Mile winner and sire **Xtension** (**Xaar**) and to the dam of dual Gr.1-winning sprinter and sire **Harry Angel** (**Dark Angel**), and it is the further family of US Gr.1 winner and sire **Stephen Got Even** (**A P Indy**).

That feat was also completed by **Turgeon** (**Caro**), who ended up as a leading sire of French jumpers. The son **Mastercraftsman** will stand as a dual-purpose prospect, with his sire having been responsible for Champions **Alpha Centauri**, **Amazing Maria**, **The Grey Gatsby**, **Kingston Hill**, **A Racing Beauty**, **Off Limits** and **Discoveries**, as well as being the sire of five National Hunt Group winners, including Gr.1 scorer **Metier**.

Technician was third on his only juvenile start behind **Space Blues** (**Dubawi**) at Nottingham. He won on debut at three and then ran second in the Gr.3 Classic Trial to **Bangkok** (**Australia**) before landing his first Stakes race in the Listed Prix Ridgeway on his first trip to France. He stepped up to take the Gr.3 Geoffrey Freer Stakes and returned to France to top his career with the Prix Chaudenay and Prix Royal-Oak.

He is a half-brother to Gr.3 Atalanta Stakes-placed **Water Hole**, out of a **Sadler's Wells** American Stakes winner, who is a full-sister to Gr.2 winner and sire **Crimson Tide** and Group winners **Tamarind** and **Pharatta** (**Fairy King**; grandam of Gr.1 winner and sire **Recoletos**). It is the further family of dual Gr.1 Derby winner **Shahrastani** (**Nijinsky**).

Flying two-year-old **Ubettabelieveit** joins the roster at Mickley Stud for the coming season. The top-class juvenile is by leading two-year-old sire **Kodiac**, who has had an excellent time recently with his sons at stud, including **Ardad**, **Coulsty**, and **Kodi Bear**, and he also won the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes, just like leading young sire **Ardad**.

Trained by Nigel Tinkler, **Ubettabelieveit** broke his maiden by three and a half lengths at Doncaster in June and followed up with a decisive win in the Listed National Stakes. He ran too free when upped to six furlongs in the Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes, but bounced back to land the Flying Childers, beating Gr.1 winner **Winter Power** and Group winners **Sacred**, **Steel Bull** and **Ventura Tormenta**. He finished off the season in America, running a close third in the Gr.2 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint. Tinkler commented: "**Ubettabelieveit** has got such a fantastic turn of speed and a great attitude."

New to the UK for 2022, **Walzertakt** is relocating from France as his first crop turn four. The high-class stayer is a half-brother to Gr.1 Deutsches Derby winner **Wiener Walzer** and, by a leading National Hunt influence in **Montjeu** out of a **Kingmambo** mare, he is bred on the same cross as **Camelot**. From ten runners to date, **Walzertakt** has already recorded two hurdle winners. **Santa Clarita** and **Wal Cassandre**.



An exciting edition to Gestüt Röttgen this year is Gr.1 Deutsches Derby winner **Windstoss** (**Shirocco**), a half-brother to fellow Derby winner **Weltstar** (**Soldier Hollow**), from a strong German family.

Trained by Markus Klug, he won over a mile as a two-year-old and was a two and a half length winner of the Listed Derby-Trial on his return at three before he landed the Deutsches Derby. He doubled up at elite level two months later when landing the Gr.1 Preis von Europa. Tough and consistent, he raced on at four, five, six and seven, recording multiple further places at Group level, including third to **Cracksman** in the Gr.1 Coronation Cup and in the Gr.1 Preis von Europa, as well as seconds in the Gr.2 Carl Jaspers-Preis and Gr.2 Grosser Hansa-Preis.

By a son of Monsun in Shirocco, he is a half-brother to Derby winner Weltstar, out of Wellenspiel (Sternkonig), who is a half-sister to Gr.1 Preis von Europa winner Well Made (Mondrian). The second dam, Well Known (Konigsstuhl), was the top filly on the German Free Handicap. She is also the dam of Stakes winner Weichsel (Soldier Hollow) and the Groupplaced Whisperer (Spectrum) and Wellola (Lomitas; dam of Listed winner Wasir), as well as Listed-placed Wellanca (Acatenango). The third dam Well Proved (Prince Ippi) won the Gr.3 Schwarzgold Rennen and produced four Stakes horses.
