A'ALI

Society Rock – Motion Lass (Motivator) NEWSELLS PARK STUD • Fee £5,000 1st Oct SLF

Triple Gr.2-winning two-year-old A'Ali remains at Newsells Park Stud and covered 116 mares in his first book last year.

By European Champion First-Season Sire Society Rock, the sire of multiple Stakes performers, including the Gr.1 winner and sire **Unfortunately**, he is the only horse in the last 20 years to have won both the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes and Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes, whilst between those victories he also won the Gr.2 Prix Robert Papin.

In his three-year-old season he won a further two Stakes races over the minimum trip, the Gr.3 Sprint Stakes at Sandown and the Gr.2 Sapphire Stakes at the Curragh, followed by a fourth-placed finish in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes behind Battaash.

Bred by Tally-Ho Stud, he fetched £135,000 at the Goffs UK Breeze-Up Sale and went on to earn over £225,000 in his career. The ultra-fast juvenile is a half-brother to the precocious four-time winner **Slowmo** (**Kodiac**) and the winning three-year-old **Heartbreak Lass** (**Cotai Glory**), out of the placed Motivator mare Motion Lass. She is a halfsister to the Gr.3 Darley Stakes winner and dual Gr.1-placed **Enforcer** (**Efisio**). This is also the family of the dual US Gr.3 winner Willowy Mood (Will Win).



ACLAIM

Acclamation – Aris (Danroad) MANTON PARK • Fee £10,000

Having left The National Stud, Aclaim will now reside at his owner's Manton Park for a fee of £10,000 this year.

His first crop included last year's Gr.1 1,000 Guineas heroine Cachet, as well as the Listed winner Royal Aclaim, and he is the first and only son of **Acclamation** to sire a UK Classic winner. Amongst the book of mares covered last year are a Champion Three-Year-Old Filly, the dam of a Champion Two-Year-Old and the dam of a Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes winner, whilst his progeny twice fetched over 200,000gns in the sales ring.

During his career, he won on seven separate occasions, at two, three and four, with the biggest win coming on his last ever appearance, in the Gr.1 Prix de la Foret. He was also placed in the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest, between two Gr.2 wins over 7f. Having won on a variety of going, and over 6f, 7f and 1m, he was the epitome of versatility.

He is out of the Listed-placed winner Aris (Danroad), a half-sister to the Gr.1 Irish 1,000 Guineas winner and Gr.1 Moyglare Stud Stakes winner Again (Danehill Dancer; dam of the Listed winner and dual Gr.1-placed **Delphinia** and the Listed-winning sire Indian Maharaja) and the Gr.3-placed winnner Arkadina (Danehill; dam of the Gr.3 winner Guilty **Twelve** and the Listed scorer **Ilternas**). He is also from the family of the multiple Gr.1-winner and influential sire Montjeu (Sadler's Wells).

ALKUMAIT

Showcasing – Suelita (Dutch Art)

CASTLEFIELD STUD • Fee €5,000

With his first foals due this year, Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes victor **Alkumait** is entering his second season standing at Castlefield Stud in Ireland for an unchanged fee of €5,000. A half-brother to impressive Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes hero and 2023 Classic hope **Chaldean** (**Frankel**), the son of **Showcasing** covered over 100 mares in his first season and his pedigree is clearly in demand, as his half-sister foal by **Kingman** was purchased for 1,000,000gns at Tattersalls last year.

The Whitsbury Manor Stud-bred colt raced on four occasions as a two-year-old, landing his maiden snugly at Goodwood in July before scoring a career highlight in the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes. Trained by Marcus Tregoning, he only raced once at three, as his racing career was put on hold due to a leg injury, before being acquired by Capital Bloodstock and retired to stud.

The five-year-old was a 150,000gns purchase as a foal and Shadwell went to 220,000gns to buy the son of accomplished broodmare **Suelita** as a yearling. The winning daughter of **Dutch Art** is now responsible for five black-type performers, including the dual Listed scorer **The Broghie Man**, and she is a half-sister to the dam of Gr.2 Lowther Stakes winner **Living In The Past**. The second dam is **Venoge**, an unraced daughter of **Green Desert** and a half-sister to Gr.3 Pinnacle Stakes winner **Moment In Time**

AWTAAD

Cape Cross – Asheerah (Shamardal)

DERRINSTOWN STUD • Fee **€5,000** 1st Jan **SLF**

Classic-winning miler **Awtaad** has sired 12 Flat Stakes performers so far and enjoyed a fine end to last season when siring two Gr.2 winners on Arc weekend courtesy of **Anmaat** in the Prix Dollar and **Al Qareem** in the Prix Chaudenay. He has also sired Gr.3 Desmond Stakes and Sandringham Stakes winner **Create Belief** and fellow Gr.3 winner **Diamil**.

The son of **Cape Cross** had 35 yearlings sell last year, which were well received, having fetched 120,000gns, €90,000 and €87,000 etc. Bred by Shadwell Estate Company and trained by Kevin Prendergast, he won five times throughout a ninerace career, which saw him win as a two-year-old, before winning three successive races at three. This culminated with an impressive victory in the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas, beating Newmarket Classic winner **Galileo Gold** and three-time Gr.1 winner **Air Force Blue**. He then went on to be placed in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes before landing the Gr.2 Boomerang Stakes on his penultimate start.

He is a half-brother to the Listed winner and Gr.3-placed **Mehnah** (**Frankel**) and the Gr.3-placed winner **Alghabrah** (**Tamayuz**), amongst others, and is out of the Listed-placed winner **Asheerah** (**Shamardal**). She is a half-sister to the dual Gr.3-placed juvenile winner **Aaraas** (**Haafhd**; dam of the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 Derby-placed **Madhmoon**), out of the Listed winner and Gr.3-placed **Adaala** (**Sahm**).



BANGKOK

Australia – Tanaghum (Darshaan)

CHAPEL STUD • Fee £3,000 1st Oct FFR

The impeccably-bred **Bangkok** was a sound, durable and classy performer on the racecourse prior to his retirement to Chapel Stud in Worcestershire in late 2021.

A 500,000gns yearling purchase, he had the precocity to be beaten just a neck by the subsequent Gr.3 scorer **Sangarius** (**Kingman**) in a Newmarket maiden in the August of his juvenile season. **Bangkok** went on to win black-type races in each of the next three seasons and proved his versatility and fine temperament by racing on fast turf, soft turf, all-weather and dirt in Britain as well as three different countries in the Arabian Gulf. His longevity is underlined by the fact that his two Pattern victories, in the Gr.3 Classic Trial and the Gr.2 York Stakes, were achieved more than two years apart and he retired with a bank roll of £628,696.

He is a half-brother to five different Stakes horses headed by the Gr.1 victor **Matterhorn** (**Raven's Pass**) and the Gr.2 scorer **The Foxes** (**Churchill**), not to mention to the dam of the World Champion Three-Year-Old Miler and sire **Ribchester** (**Iffraaj**). His second dam, the Classic heroine **Mehthaaf** (**Nureyev**), was also a Champion Three-Year-Old before producing two Stakes horses, while his third dam **Elle Seule** (**Exclusive Native**) won in Gr.2 company prior to producing nine other winners, including the two-time Champion Sprinter **Elnadim** (**Danzig**).

Lope De Vega – Danaskaya (Danehill)

BEARSTONE STUD • Fee £6,500 1st Oct SLF

Recently moved from Kildangan in Ireland to Bearstone in Britain, European champion **Belardo** has enjoyed an excellent start at stud, with six Group winners and 17 black-type horses from his first three crops, yet he is now covering at less than half of the fee that he was commanding in 2018.

His progeny have shown their versatility by excelling all around the world. His two biggest achievers in 2022 may have raced in the US, **Bellabel** landing the Gr.2 San Clemente Stakes and **Gold Phoenix** lifting the Gr.2 Del Mar Handicap, but he has also done well in Australia, Hong Kong and New Zealand, not to mention Europe where **Isabella Giles** was his initial standard bearer, scoring in both Gr.2 and Gr.3 company, while he has also enjoyed notable victories in Ireland and France. He has had particular success with fillies, all of his Group winners to date bar **Gold Phoenix** being of the fairer sex.

His sales statistics have held up pretty well too. His colt out of the Listed-placed **Verglas** mare **Petits Potins** made 125,000gns at Book 1 of the 2022 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale.

A top-class juvenile, **Belardo** won the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes and maintained his form through to the age of four, when he landed the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes. By leading international sire **Lope De Vega**, he is out of the Irish Champion Two-Year-Old Filly **Danaskaya** (**Danehill**).

The son of US Champion Sire **Kitten's Joy**, who has sired the likes of Gr.1 heroes **Roaring Lion**, **Hawkbill**, **Kameko** and **Oscar Performance**, a successful US first crop sire in 2022. Lanwades Stud's Gr.1 Breeder's Cup Turf Sprint victor **Bobby's Kitten** will see his fourth crop hit the track this year. Already the sire of triple Group winner **Sandrine**, Gr.2-placed winner **Monaasib** and the dual Gr.3-placed winner in the US **Kitty Kitana**, the 12-year-old offers European breeders an outcross sprinter/miler stallion at good value.

A winner of six races at two, three and five years, as well as Graded Stakes at two and three, **Bobby's Kitten** was trained in the US by Chad Brown, winning two of his four starts as a juvenile and finishing third in the other two, including behind **Outstrip** in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. His victory at three in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint saw him beat Champion Two-Year-Old Sire **No Nay Never**. He raced on at five, landing the Listed Cork Stakes by eight and a half lengths for new trainer Dermot Weld.

Top juvenile **Buratino** will once again stand at Hedgeholme Stud having moved there from Kildangan last year.

He has produced many smart performers to date, including the dual Listed winner and Gr.2-placed **Snapraeterea** and the Gr.3-placed filly **Spring Feeling**.

During his racing career with Mark Johnston, **Buratino** won four times as a two-year-old, including on debut, and went on to win the Listed Woodcote Stakes in a faster time than **Pinatubo** and the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot, beating that season's champion juvenile **Air Force Blue**.

By Exceed And Excel, he is one of five winners out of the Listed-placed three-time winner Bergamask (Kingmambo), a half-sister to the Listed-placed five-time winner Busker (Street Cry) and the juvenile winner Alderney (Elusive Quality; dam of the dual Japanese Listed scorer Dover). They are out of the Listed winner and Gr.3-placed Adonesque (Sadler's Wells), a half-sister to the Gr.1 National Stakes and Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes winner and Champion Sire Danehill Dancer (Danehill), the Gr.3 winner and Gr.2-placed Unilateral (Rock Of Gibraltar), the Listed winner and Gr.2-placed sire Colossus (Danehill) and the dam of the Listed scorer Curly. They are out of the Sharpen Up mare Mira Adonde.

Mehmas – Shoshoni Wind (Sleeping Indian)

OVERBURY STUD • Fee £6,500 1st Oct SLF

One of two new additions to the six-strong Overbury Stud roster this year is the four-year-old **Caturra**, who commanded a 110,000gns fee at the Tattersalls October Yearling Book 2 Sale. He was bred by Tally-Ho Stud and bought by Richard Brown of Blandford Bloodstock, just like his stud companion **Ardad**.

Trained by Clive Cox, he is one of the fastest sons of **Mehmas**, the Champion First-Crop Sire in 2020 and broke his maiden in May at two, just like his sire. He later emulated **Ardad** by winning the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes over 5f, defeating fellow stallion **Armor**, and will begin at the same fee as **Ardad** (**Kodiac**), who has already sired the triple Gr.1 scorer **Perfect Power**. **Caturra** is rated higher than his sire over the minimum trip and ran a quicker time than **Battaash** at the same age (three-year-olds) in the Gr.2 King George Stakes over 5f at Goodwood.

He is out of the Listed-placed **Shoshoni Wind** and, like **Mehmas**, possesses a pedigree that is free from **Danzig** blood and contains Classic performers. The extended family includes the likes of the Gr.1 St Leger and Gr.1 Gold Cup winner and sire **Classic Cliche (Salse)**, the Gr.1 Prix Vermeille and Gr.1 Yorkshire Oaks victrix and champion **My Emma (Marju)** and the 2022 Gr.1 National Stakes victor **Al Riffa (Wootton Bassett)**.

CENTURY DREAM

Cape Cross – Salacia (Echo Of Light)

NORTON GROVE STUD • Fee £3,000

Talented miler **Century Dream** will stand his second season at Norton Grove Stud this year with his first crop now foals. Trained by Simon and Ed Crisford, his racing career spanned six seasons when he won ten races, including the Gr.2 Celebration Mile and Gr.3 Diomed Stakes on two occasions. He also won as a juvenile before being placed in a further eight Group races over a mile, including in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes behind **Roaring Lion**. He beat horses such as Classic winner **Victor Ludorum** and multiple Gr.1 winners **Zaaki, Laurens, Addeybb** and **Rhododendron** during his career and accumulated earnings of over £545,000.

Bred by Rabbah Bloodstock Limited, he is by top-class older miler and hugely successful sire of sires **Cape Cross** and is a half-brother to the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes hero and Classic-placed sire **King Of Change** (**Farhh**), out of the winning **Echo Of Light** mare **Salacia**. She is a half-sister to several winners out of the Gr.3 winner and Gr.2-placed **Neptune's Bride** (**Bering**), a half-sister to the Gr.2 scorer **Sea Dart** (**Diesis**).

Described as an "incredibly tough and consistent performer" by trainer Simon Crisford, he looks to be an exciting stallion on the roster at Norton Grove Stud.

Sea The Stars – Strawberry Fledge (Kingmambo)

HARAS DU LOGIS • Fee €7,000 1st Oct SLF

The high-class middle distance performer Cloth Of Stars (Sea The Stars) had his first crop of two-year-olds last year, which included the winners Birr Castle, I Am Sovereign and Laafi. His colt out of Nicole (Dashing Blade) sold for €125,000 at the 2022 Goffs Orby Sale, while a colt out of Aiglonne (Silver Hawk) commanded €120,000 at Arqana.

Trained by Andre Fabre, the colt was unbeaten in his first two starts as a two-year-old, winning the Gr.3 Prix des Chenes over 1m at Longchamp in the process. He finished the season as a Gr.1-placed juvenile as runner-up in the Criterium de Saint-Cloud. A Gr.2 winner at three, he returned as a four-year-old to win the Gr.1 Prix Ganay over 1m2½f at Saint-Cloud, defeating **Zarak**, before being placed in consecutive renewals of the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe.

He is out of the **Kingmambo** mare **Strawberry Fledge**, a full-sister to the Gr.1 Oaks heroine **Light Shift** (dam of the dual Gr.1 winner and sire **Ulysses**) and a half-sister to the Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup victrix **Shiva** (**Hector Protector**; grandam of the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed **Piz Badile**), the dual Gr.2 scorer **Limnos** (**Hector Protector**) and the Listed winner and Gr.2-placed **Burning Sunset** (**Caerleon**). His third dam is the Gr.1 Prix Vermeille winner and champion **Northern Trick** (**Northern Dancer**).


Shamardal – Daryakana (Selkirk)

HARAS DE BONNEVAL • Fee €5,000

Dariyan broke new ground in 2022 with his first Pattern success thanks to the Gr.3 Prix La Force triumph of **Mister Saint Paul**, who had also displayed high-class form as a juvenile the previous season when landing the Listed Prix Isonomy. Other **Dariyan** offspring twice went close to further high-profile victories, first when **Galaxie Gold** was beaten by a head in the Gr.2 Prix Hocquart and then when **Elizar** found just one too good for him in the Gr.3 Kent Stakes in the US. His two-year-old cohort was led by **Reve De Vallarsa**, who won twice and finished second on his other two starts, making him a fine prospect for 2023.

Dariyan is a son of **Shamardal** and hails from an outstanding middle-distance bloodline. He is one of three Stakes winners out of the Gr.1 Hong Kong Vase victor **Daryakana** (**Selkirk**). It is the family of **Almanzor** (**Wootton Bassett**) and Classic winner **Darjina** (**Zamindar**), as well as the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club winner and sire **Darsi**.

It is therefore no surprise that, although a son of **Shamardal**, often thought of as a speed influence but a winner of the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club, he was a progressive sort. A winner over both 2000m and 2400m early in his three-year-old season, he went on to land the Gr.2 Prix Eugene Adam and run third in the Gr.1 Hong Kong Vase. At four, he gained Gr.1 glory in the Prix Ganay and ran second in the Gr.1 Prix d'Ispahan.

DECORATED KNIGHT

Galileo – Pearling (Storm Cat)

IRISH NATIONAL STUD • Fee **€5,000** 1st Oct

The evidence of his first two crops of racing age suggests that **Decorated Knight** has a successful stallion career in front of him. His winner-to-runners ratio is running at above 40 per cent and his three-year-olds for 2023 include both the Listed Denford Stakes runner-up Ferrari Queen and **Knockhill**, who had two next-time-out Ascot winners in behind when scoring at Sandown on his only start. **Decorated Knight** progeny are expected to improve with time, as he progressed into a three-time Gr.1 winner at five. His sales statistics are also positive; three of his yearlings fetched €50,000 or more during last year and his career foal average remains above the £35,000 mark.

A son of **Galileo**, he retired to the Irish National Stud in 2018 as the winner of eight races, including the Gr.1 Jebel Hatta, Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup and Gr.1 Irish Champion Stakes, with earnings of over €1.5 million and an official rating of 120.

He is out of a full-sister to both the legendary sire **Giant's** Causeway and to the blue hen You'resothrilling (Storm Cat), dam of the Gr.1 winners Gleneagles, Joan Of Arc, Happily and Marvellous (all by Galileo). You'resothrilling is also a half-sister to **Love Only Me** (**Sadler's Wells**), dam of the Gr.2-winner and sire Storm The Stars (Sea The Stars), who was placed in both the Gr.1 Derby and its Irish equivalent.

Diktat – Land Of Dreams (Cadeaux Genereux)

BEARSTONE STUD • Fee £7,500 1st Oct SLF

Dream Ahead embarks on his second season at Bearstone Stud since exchanging Normandy for Shropshire and his move across the Channel has clearly captured breeders' imaginations, as he covered 100 mares in 2022. The son of Diktat offers excellent value at £7,500 as the sire four toplevel winners, including Bearstone's own Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye, Gr.1 Flying Five Stakes and Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint heroine Glass Slippers and Gr.1 Sprint Cup and Gr.1 Diamond Jubilee Stakes winner **Dream Of Dreams**. In total, he has sired no less than 23 Stakes winners from eight crops of racing age between Ballylinch Stud and Haras de Grandcamp.

An outstanding racehorse, **Dream Ahead** was one of the highest-rated two-year-olds of all time, reaching a mark of 128 after a nine-length win in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes. He had previously won the Gr.1 Prix Morny on just his second start and went on at three to add three more Gr.1 wins in the July Cup, Sprint Cup and Prix de la Foret.

His pedigree is all about speed, as he is a half-brother to the dam of the Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes and Gr.1 Flying Five Stakes winner Fairyland (Kodiac), out of the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes winner Land Of Dreams (Cadeaux **Genereux**). The second dam **Sahara Star** (**Green Desert**) won the Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes, while the third dam Vaigly Star (Star Appeal) was second in the Gr.1 July Cup.



DUBAWI LEGEND

Dubawi – Lovely Pass (Raven's Pass)

STARFIELD STUD • Fee €6,500

Dubawi Legend was one of the best two-year-olds of his generation. He found just the outstanding unbeaten Champion Two-Year-Old Colt **Native Trail** (**Oasis Dream**) too strong for him in one of the world's ultimate stallion-making races, the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes, where those behind him included the 2022 Gr.1 winner and fellow freshman sire **Bayside Boy** (**New Bay**).

As a three-year-old, he went on to prove himself a highclass sprinter, finishing third to the subsequent brilliant Gr.1 Haydock Sprint Cup victor **Minzaal** (**Mehmas**) in the Gr.3 Hackwood Stakes, with the Gr.2 winner **Rohaan** (**Mayson**) back in fourth place, before travelling over to Germany to land that nation's top 1200m event, the Gr.3 Goldene Peitsche at Baden-Baden comfortably.

His pedigree page is littered with black type. His dam, the Listed UAE 1,000 Guineas heroine **Lovely Pass** (**Raven's Pass**), was precocious enough to be placed at Royal Ascot as a two-year-old. She went on to produce four winners from her first four runners, including **Golden Pass** (**Golden Horn**), who triumphed at Listed level and was Gr.2-placed. The second dam is the 2003 Champion Older Female Miler **Macadamia** (**Classic Cliche**), winner of the Gr.2 (then) Falmouth Stakes and second in the Gr.2 (then) Sun Chariot Stakes.



DUE DILIGENCE

War Front – Bema (Pulpit)

WHITSBURY MANOR STUD • Fee £5,000 1st Oct SLF

Top-class sprinter **Due Diligence** (**War Front**) produced three black-type winners from his first crop, while his 2022 yearling average was over £21,000 from an £8,500 fee.

His first crop included Group-winning two-year-olds **Good Vibes**, who landed the Gr.3 Cornwallis Stakes and Listed Marygate Stakes, and **Streamline**, who took the Gr.3 Sirenia Stakes, as well as Listed scorer and Gr.2-placed **Sir Boris**. Meanwhile, another son **Diligent Harry** has placed twice at Gr.3 level.

His progeny continued to be in demand in the sales ring last year, the highlight being a colt from the family of the Group-performing sprinters **Stepper Point** (**Kyllachy**) and **Lady In France** (**Showcasing**), who sold for 70,000gns to A C Elliott.

A winner over five and a half furlongs in America as a juvenile, **Due Diligence** transferred to Aidan O'Brien the following year and, after landing a Premier Handicap, took the Listed (then) Lacken Stakes, before running second to **Slade Power** in the Gr.1 Diamond Jubilee Stakes.

By War Front, he is out of US Stakes winner Bema (Pupit), who has also produced Group-placed Ocasta and the dam of Listed-placed Bobby On Fleek (Frost Giant), while the further family includes the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas runner-up and sire Tip Two Win (Dark Angel).

Bred by Shadwell Estate Company and trained by Sir Michael Stoute, **Eqtidaar** won on debut and was fourth in the Gr.3 Sirenia Stakes on his only other start as a juvenile. He finished runner-up to **Invincible Army** in the Gr.3 Pavilion Stakes on his seasonal reappearance at three, before going on to win the Commonwealth Cup at Royal Ascot, beating **Sands Of Mali**, with **Invincible Army**, **Unfortunately**, **Speak In Colours** and **Sioux Nation** further down the field.



Dual Gr.1-winning sprinter **Equiano** is embarking on his second season at the Irish National Stud after relocating from Newsells Park Stud in 2021. Last year his yearlings fetched up to €62,000 and averaged over £15,000.

Equiano has already sired 31 Stakes horses, headed by the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint winner **Belvoir Bay** and the high-class sprinter **The Tin Man**, whose nine victories include the Gr.1 British Champions Sprint, Gr.1 Diamond Jubilee Stakes and Gr.1 Sprint Cup. **Medicine Jack** won the Gr.2 Railway Stakes and was third in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes at two, while the Gr.2 Meydan Sprint Stakes victor **Equilateral** also finished second in the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes and **Gustavus Weston** won three times in Pattern company, including in the Gr.2 Greenlands Stakes. Of **Equiano**'s clutch of Gr.3 winners, **Strath Burn**, beaten a short head in the Gr.1 Sprint Cup, has sired winners himself from limited opportunities, while **Dakota Gold** has won 15 times to date, including the Gr.3 Bengough Stakes and five Listed races.

With only two British-based freshman sires producing more individual winners in 2022 than **Expert Eye** and with his average yearling sale prices just over four-times his stud fee, the Gr.1-winning son of **Acclamation** offers breeders good value for money standing at £7,500.

The Banstead Manor resident won on his first start as a juvenile, before landing the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes in impressive style. He returned a runner-up at three in the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes and then went one place better in the Gr.3 Jersey Stakes at Royal Ascot, where he trounced the 21-runner field to win by the biggest margin this century. He was not out of the places on his final five starts, including finishing second and third respectively in the Gr.1 Sussex Stakes and Gr.1 Prix du Moulin. His career highlight came on his final start in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Mile, where he beat Gr.1 winners **One Master, Clemmie, Lightning Spear** and **Happily**.

The eight-year-old is a fourth generation Juddmonte homebred; his dam, **Exemplify** (**Dansili**), is a half-sister to the multiple Gr.1-winning champion juvenile **Special Duty** (**Hennessy**). His grandam is a full-sister to the seven-time US Gr.1 dirt winner **Sightseek** (**Distant View**) and a half-sister to dual Gr.1 scorer **Tates Creek** (**Rahy**). Talented sprinter **Far Above** covered over 250 mares in his first two books and will remain at Starfield Stud this year. The son of **Farhh** was undefeated over 5f and 6f, winning on debut over 7f, before going on to score in Listed company over 6f and then following up with an excellent performance in the Gr.3 Palace House Stakes over 5f before his career was cut short through injury.

He cost 105,000gns as a breezer, was held in high regard by trainer James Tate and, despite only seeing a racecourse on five occasions, garnered a Timeform rating of 122, a higher figure than **Invincible Spirit**, **Kodiac**, **No Nay Never**, **Dark Angel** and **Showcasing** all achieved.

He is the sole runner out of the winning **Shamardal** mare **Dorraar**, a half-sister to several winners out of the **Dubai Millenium** mare **Dorrati**. Golden Horn has relocated to Overbury Stud this season, having spent the past seven years at Dalham Hall Stud, and is making an impact both on the Flat and over Jumps.

Bred by Anthony Oppenheimer, the son of **Cape Cross** won his only start at two before winning four Gr.1 races at three, including the Derby and Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, and finished the year as Champion Three-Year-Old Colt in Europe.

He is the sire of 31 Stakes performers on the Flat, including the Gr.2 winner and dual Gr.1-placed **Botanik**, the Gr.3-winning juvenile **West End Girl** and the Listed winner **Haskoy**, who finished second in the Gr.1 St Leger before being demoted. The median Timeform rating of his progeny aged three and up is an impressive 88, on par with **Kingman**, **Lope De Vega** and **Night Of Thunder**. His best in the National Hunt sphere include Gr.2 Leamington Novices' Hurdle winner **Stag Horn**, Gr.1 Tolworth Novices' Hurdle third **Nemean Lion** and Gerry Feilden Handicap Hurdle winner and Gr.3 County Handicap Hurdle second **First Street**.

He is from a family saturated in black type, being out of **Fleche D'Or** (**Dubai Destination**), a half-sister to the Gr.1 Coronation Stakes heroine **Rebecca Sharp** (**Machiavellian**), the Gr.3 winner **Mystic Knight** (**Caerleon**) and the Listed winner and dual Gr.2-placed **Hidden Hope** (**Daylami**; dam of the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 Oaks-placed **Frankly Darling**).

Champion Sprinter **Harry Angel** produced five black-type performers from his first-crop of two-year-olds in 2022, including Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes runner-up **Marshman** and Australian Listed scorer **Arkansaw Kid**. Standing at Darley's Dalham Hall Stud for a fee of £10,000, only **Sioux Nation** and **Havana Grey** had more winners by a first-crop sire in Europe than the son of **Dark Angel**.

Trained by Clive Cox, he won the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes on his second start as a juvenile and was only out of the top two once in six starts as a three-year-old, including victories at the highest level in the Gr.1 July Cup and Gr.1 Sprint Cup, where he beat **Blue Point** and **Tasleet**. He was also a close runner-up to **Caravaggio**, whom he later beat at Newmarket, in the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup. He completed his racing career by finishing second in the Gr.1 British Champions Sprint Stakes at four.

Bred by Ballyphilip Stud under the banner of CBS Bloodstock, which also bred another sprinting star in **Battaash**, the nine-year-old is a half-brother to Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes winner **Pierre Lapin** (**Cappella Sansevero**) and is out of a half-sister to dual Gr.1 scorer in Hong Kong **Xtension** (**Xaar**), as well as the dams of Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes winner **Supremacy** (**Mehmas**) and Listed winner and last year's Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye runner-up **White Lavender** (**Heeraat**).

Proven Gr.1 sire **Havana Gold** is a new addition to this year's '10k and under' and remains at Tweenhills Farm and Stud.

The son of **Teofilo** was the leading British sire of twoyear-olds in 2021 and has sired 27 Stakes performers, whilst his son **Havana Grey** was crowned British Champion First-Season Sire last year. Amongst his four Group winners so far are the afformentioned Gr.1 Flying Five Stakes winner **Havana Grey**, the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes winner **El Caballo** and the Gr.3 scorers **Treasuring** and **Tabdeed**. On top of that, he has sired 11 other Stakes winners so far.

A winner at two and three, **Havana Gold** won his first four completed starts, winning both the Listed Ascendant Stakes and Gr.3 Somerville Tattersall Stakes in the process. He is out of the dual Gr.3 winner and Gr.2 (then) Flying Five Stakes-placed **Jessica's Dream** (**Desert Style**), a half-sister to the Listed winner and Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes and Gr.1 Prix du Moulin-placed **Majors Cast** (**Victory Note**).

Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas winner **Indian Haven** is standing his second season at Chapel Stud this year. The son of **Indian Ridge** offers breeders the chance to access the Byerley Turk line and he is the only Classic-winning son of this line at stud. He retired to the Irish National Stud in 2005 and remained there until 2012, when he was moved to the UK to stand at David Bond's Withyslade Farm near Salisbury.

He is the sire of four Stakes winners, including Group winners **Aspen Darlin**, who won the Gr.3 Firth of Clyde Stakes, and **Ashram**, winner of the Gr.3 Somerville Tattersall Stakes and Listed Dubai Duty Free Cup, as well as Italian Listed scorer **Tellovoi** and Listed Wolferton Handicap winner **Beachfire**. He is also the sire of seven further Stakes performers and has recorded 90 winners from 200 runners, with a strike rate of 45 per cent winners to runners.

Trained by Paul D'Arcy, **Indian Haven** won on debut in the July of his juvenile campaign. He was stepped straight into Group company and ran sixth in the Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes and was only beaten three lengths in the Gr.2 Champagne Stakes. He won the Listed European Free Handicap on his return at three and went on to land the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas. He is a half-brother to Gr.1 winner and Champion Italian Two-Year-Old Colt and sire **Count Dubois** (**Zafonic**), out of the dual Gr.2 winner **Madame Dubois** (**Legend Of France**).



INVINCIBLE ARMY

Invincible Spirit – Rajeem (Diktat)
YEOMANSTOWN STUD • Fee €7,500

Standing for his fourth season at Yeomanstown Stud is the top-class sprinter **Invincible Army**, who had his first yearlings sell last year.

Five of his yearlings were sold for 100,000gns or more at the Tattersalls October Yearling Sales, highlighted by a 140,000gns colt out of **Fancy Feathers** (**Redback**), purchased by SackvilleDonald. Overall, his yearlings averaged in excess of five times his covering fee, which was €10,000 when conceived.

Trained by James Tate, the son of **Invincible Spirit** broke his maiden as a two-year-old at Newmarket, running away from the field to win easily by five lengths over 6f. Later that season, he won the Gr.3 Sirenia Stakes over 6f at Kempton on the all weather, defeating the Shadwell stallion **Eqtidaar** in the process. At three, he confirmed this form by once again defeating his rival in the Gr.3 Pavilion Stakes over 6f at Ascot, while he raced on at four to decisively claim the Gr.2 Duke of York over 6f at York by two and a quarter lengths.

Out of the **Diktat** mare **Rajeem**, who won the Gr.1 Falmouth Stakes at Newmarket, he is a full-brother to the Listed Committed Stakes winner and Gr.3-placed **New York City**. The family also includes the Gr.1 Prix Morny heroine **Hoh Magic** (**Cadeaux Genereux**) and the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1-placed sire **Crimson Beau** (**High Line**).



JAMES GARFIELD

Exceed And Excel – Whazzat (Daylami)


RATHBARRY STUD • Fee €4,000

The precocious **James Garfield** (**Exceed And Excel**) had his first crop of two-year-olds last year, in which he produced two black-type performers. Bred by Stetchworth and Middle Park Studs Ltd, he was owned during his racing career by the Gredley family and trained by George Scott.

A high-class two-year-old, the colt won the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes over 6f at Newbury, defeating the favourite **Invincible Army** by three quarters of a length. He opened his account at three with a victory in the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes over 7f at Newbury, before coming second in the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest over 6½f at Deauville, beaten just half a length.

His first crop has been headlined by the filly **Maria Branwell**, who won the Listed National Stakes over 5f at Sandown and finished third in the Gr.2 Queen Mary Stakes at Royal Ascot. Another filly, **Lady Bullet**, broke her maiden over 6f at Ripon before coming third in the Listed Blenheim Stakes at Fairyhouse.

He is from an extensive black-type family, which includes the likes of the Classic heroine **Rafha** (**Kris**), dam of the Gr.1 winner and sire **Invincible Spirit** and the outstanding twoyear-old sire **Kodiac**, and grandam of the Gr.3 scorer and Gr.1-placed sire **Gustav Klimt**. Other family members include the multiple Gr.1 winners **Uni** and **Pride Of Dubai**.



KING OF CHANGE

Farhh – Salacia (Echo Of Light)

STARFIELD STUD • Fee €6,000

A new addition to the Starfield Stud roster for the 2023 breeding season is the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes hero **King Of Change**, who previously spent two years at Shadwell's Derrinstown Stud.

He raced just twice at two, finishing runner-up on both occasions, but was a much better three-year-old. After an easy success at Nottingham in April, the son of **Farhh** ran a mighty race in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, finishing second to the Gr.1-winning juvenile **Magna Grecia**. Behind **King Of Change** that day were the were the Gr.1 winners **Ten Sovereigns**, **Advertise** and **Emaraaty Ana**, as well as the Gr.1 Derby runner-up **Madhmoon**. After a Listed success at Sandown in September, he would reverse the form with **Magna Grecia** in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes at Ascot, defeating the Gr.1 scorer **The Revenant** by a length and a quarter.

He is a half-brother to the Gr.2 Celebration Mile winner and Gr.1-placed **Century Dream** (**Cape Cross**), and they are out of the winner **Salacia** (**Echo Of Light**). His grandam **Neptune's Bride** (**Bering**) was a Gr.3 winner and Gr.2-placed in France, and the family also includes the Gr.2 International Stakes scorer **Sea Dart** (**Diesis**). A colt foal from **King Of Change's** first crop sold for €50,000 at the Goffs November Foal Sale.

KUROSHIO

Exceed And Excel – Arctic Drift (Gone West)

STARFIELD STUD • Fee €5,000

Kuroshio had his first runners since returning from Australia last year and they were headed by Michael O'Callaghan's **Gozen**, who was arguably an unlucky second in the Gr.3 Staffordstown Stud Stakes and is being targeted at the Gr.1 Irish 1,000 Guineas. Others to show promise from this crop include the Irish EBF Auction Series Race Final winner **Panic Alarm** and the Timeform-rated 92 winner **Dontspoilasale**.

Previously, **Kuroshio** had sired Gr.1 The Goodwood winner **Savatoxl** and Gr.3 Thoroughbred Breeders Stakes winner **La Rocque** in Australia and Gr.3 Sprint Stakes winner **Kurious**, subsequently sold for 900,000gns, as well as four other black-type performers, in Britain.

A smart two-year-old, **Kuroshio** won the Gr.3 Blue Diamond Prelude two months before competing in Australia's premier juvenile race, the Gr.1 Golden Slipper. The son of **Exceed And Excel** trained on at three as well, winning the Gr.2 Mitty's McEwen Stakes.

It is hard for stallions to make a big impression even before their first runners hit the racecourse but **Land Force** is doing his best. His initial tranche of yearlings went down extremely well in the auction ring, averaging over £36,000 from a big sample size of 70 sales graduates, which represents a handy return on his first-crop conception fee of £6,500.

He boasts both the form on the track and the bloodlines to suggest that he can make up into a successful sire. Injury meant that he only managed one full season on the course before becoming the first son of the highflying young stallion **No Nay Never** to begin a breeding career. He packed eight starts into his juvenile career and showed both toughness and quality to be placed at Royal Ascot before winning both a Tipperary Listed contest and the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes at Glorious Goodwood.

His pedigree is difficult to criticise. His dam **Theann** (**Rock Of Gibraltar**) was successful in the Gr.3 Summer Stakes prior to producing the dual Gr.1 scorer **Photo Call** (**Galileo**), as well as three other winners. The second dam **Cassandra Go** was a top-class sprinter, lifting both the Gr.2 (then) King's Stand Stakes and the Gr.2 Temple Stakes, but an even better broodmare, producing ten winners, headed by the three-time Gr.1 winner **Halfway To Heaven** (**Pivotal**), herself a producer of two multiple Gr.1-winning daughters.

Pivotal – Atlantic Destiny (Royal Academy)

TWEENHILLS • Fee £5,000 1st Oct SLF

Gr.1 Sussex Stakes hero **Lightning Spear** will remain at Tweenhills Farm and Stud this year at an unchanged fee, having produced an outstanding 63 per cent winners to runners with his first two-year-olds.

The son of **Pivotal** was an ever-present in Gr.1 races over a mile throughout his career, and as well as his Goodwood triumph, was placed on six other occasions at the top level.

Although he improved with age, he won his only start at two before winning his next three races, tasting his first defeat at the hands of **Arod** in the Gr.2 Summer Mile. He would go on to beat the likes of **Toormore**, **Ervedya**, **Amazing Maria**, **Kodi Bear**, **Belardo**, **Awtaad**, **Galileo Gold**, **Addeybb**, **Expert Eye**, **Lord Glitters** and **Laurens**.

Bred by Newsells Park Stud, he is a half-brother to the Listed winner **Ocean War** (**Dalakhani**), out of fellow Listed scorer **Atlantic Destiny** (**Royal Academy**). She is a half-sister to the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cupplaced **Make No Mistake** (**Darshaan**) and the dam of the Gr.3-placed nine-time winner **Invincible Force**. His third dam produced the Gr.3-placed winner **Regal Step** and the Listed-placed winner **Faten** (both by **Northern Dancer**), amongst others.

A career-best performance came later that season when he finished a length and a half runner-up to World Champion Miler **Palace Pier** in the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes at Royal Ascot.

His first book of mares included half-sisters to **Showcasing**, **Kodi Bear** and **Subjectivist**, as well as the dam of the Gr.1 winners **Crackerjack King**, **Jakkalberry** and **Awelmarduk**. His fertility is also encouraging, with over 90 per cent of visiting mares in foal.

Having your mare covered by **Make Believe** gives you the opportunity to turn €10,000 into £10 million. A far-fetched prospect many might say, but the **Makfi** stallion has done it before; his best progeny **Mishriff**, who is part of his 2017 first crop conceived at double his current fee, recently retired to stud with a career bankroll of just shy of £12 million following a glittering four seasons of action on some of the word's biggest stages and victories in the Saudi Cup, the Gr.1 Sheema Classic, the Gr.1 Juddmonte International and the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club.

Make Believe had six other black-type horses in 2022, headed by the mare **Believe In Love**, who took her Patternrace tally to three by landing the Gr.3 Bronte Cup. His other standard bearers include a second triple Gr.3 winner in **Rose Of Kildare** and the Gr.3 Prix Chloe heroine **Noticeable Grace**.

He has a strong pedigree, as he is closely related to the US Gr.1 scorer **Dubawi Heights** and his dam is a half-sister to the Gr.1-winning sprinter **Tante Rose**. His performances on the track bore out those bloodlines: he won four of his seven starts and landed the Gr.1 Prix de la Foret over seven furlongs, having previously proved his ability to stay a mile with a three-length romp in the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains.

A Shadwell homebred, **Massaat** won on his second start at two and then ran second to **Air Force Blue** in the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes. He returned at three to run second to **Galileo Gold** in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, but didn't stay in the Gr.1 Derby. Dropped back to 7f the following year he was an impressive winner of the Gr.2 Hungerford Stakes and was also placed in the Gr.1 Prix du Moulin and Gr.2 Challenge Stakes. He is a half-brother to Gr.1-winning sprinter and young sire **Eqtidaar** (**Invincible Spirit**) and Gr.3 scorer **Mujbar** (**Muhaarar**).

Mattmu was born and raised at Bearstone Stud and, having stood at the Shropshire farm in 2018, he returned in 2022 after the success of his only crop, which was small in number. This includes the Listed-placed **Favourite Child** and the dual winner **Mattice**, who finished a close-up third in the Ayr Bronze Cup. Overall, he achieved 50 per cent winners to runners. Standing at just £2,000, **Mattmu** offers a real chance for those breeding on a budget to upgrade their mares. He covered 28 mares last year, which represents his biggest book to date.

Kept busy as a two-year-old, he raced nine times in his juvenile campaign, winning on four occasions. This culminated with victories in the Listed Rockingham Stakes and Gr.2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte. 

Dual European Champion **Postponed** produced his first Stakes performer last year courtesy of **Almohandesah**, who finished runner-up to Classic winner **Cachet** in the Gr.3 Nell Gwyn Stakes.

Postponed's progeny fetched plenty in the sales ring too, with Chris Waller going to 180,000gns and 130,000gns to secure two of his sons at the Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training Sale last year, whilst the median Timeform rating for his three-year-old winners stood at 91.

A winner at two, three, four and five, **Postponed** was runner-up in the £500,000 Tattersalls Millions 2YO Trophy as a juvenile before taking his form to another level the following year for Luca Cumani, when he won the Gr.2 Great Voltigeur Stakes impressively. Other progeny include the ultra-fast Gr.3 winners **Mitbaahy** and **Miramar**. He has enjoyed sustained market support too, with his yearlings having fetched up to 150,000gns last year.

He is a half-brother to the Gr.3 winner **Ridge Ranger** (**Bushranger**) and the Gr.3-placed winners **Crafty Madam** (**Mastercraftsman**) and **Danidh Dubai** (**Noverre**). They are amongst ten winners from as many runners out of the three-time winner **Dani Ridge** (**Indian Ridge**), a full-sister to the Gr.3 Diomed Stakes winner **Blomberg**.

'From small acorns mighty oaks grow,' is the saying and, after the exceptional start that **Rajasinghe** made with his compact first crop on the racecourse last year, he looks sure to be much more popular with mare owners this time around, especially given his recession-busting covering fee.

Ten of his offspring made it to the track in 2022 and no less than eight were successful for a remarkable 80 per cent winners-to-runners ratio. Pick of the bunch was **Waiting At Night**, who got his sire off the mark at the first attempt in a Wolverhampton maiden in early May and went on to run with credit in both the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes and the Gr.2 July Stakes, prior to finishing second in the Listed Pat Eddery Stakes at Ascot in July.

Others to catch the eye were the dual scorer **Hougoumont** and the triple winner **Talamanca**. Toughness was a common attribute, as four of the ten managed eight or more starts.

There is not much sales ring evidence to go on at this early stage, but his 14 foals to have change hands at auction so far have returned a healthy average price of £16,087.

By dual Royal Ascot hero **Choisir**, the sire of top sire **Starspangledbanner**, who was also a Royal Ascot winner, **Rajasinghe** is out of the Listed-placed **Bunditten** (**Soviet Star**). He himself won the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes in a record time at the Royal Meeting in 2017.



RAVEN'S PASS

Elusive Quality – Ascutney (Lord At War)

KILDANGAN STUD • Fee €7,500 1st Oct SLF

Last year saw Champion Three-Year-Old Miler **Raven's Pass** add further Gr.1 laurels to his stud record, with Flying Five Stakes winner **Romantic Proposal** regaining the winning thread. He has had other winners at the top level, such as Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere winner **Royal Marine**, Al Maktoum Challenge R3 winner **Matterhorn** and the Japanese sire **Tower Of London**.

The son of **Elusive Quality** is a proven sire with eight per cent Stakes winners to runners. His progeny continue to fetch plenty in the sales ring too, with last year's results including a €120,000 two-year-old and a 75,000gns yearling.

A precious juvenile, **Raven's Pass** won his first three races at two, including a wide-margin success in the Gr.3 Solario Stakes. He was then beaten by multiple Gr.1 winner **New Approach** in the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes. A run of fine efforts in defeat followed at the top level; a fourth-placed finish in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas proceeded a hat-trick of runner-up places, before winning three times in succession to finish his career, including the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes and the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Classic. He is out of Gr.3 winner **Ascutney** (**Lord At War**) and is a full-brother to the dam of the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches heroine **Castle Lady**. It is also the family of the US Gr.1 winner **No Matter What** and the European Champion Two-Year-Old Filly **Rainbow View**.

HARAS DU LOGIS • Fee €7,500 1st Oct SLF

Making the move to France after five seasons at Kildangan Stud in Ireland is **Ribchester**, the European Champion Miler of 2016 and 2017.

A Gr.2 winner of the Gimcrack Stakes at two, the son of **Iffraaj** was third in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas and beaten a neck and a short head in the Gr.1 Sussex Stakes before landing the Gr.1 Prix Jacques Le Marois later that season. He added the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes and Gr.1 Prix du Moulin to his record at four and was placed in four other Gr.1s, including second places in the Sussex Stakes and Queen Elizabeth II Stakes.

From the **Elle Seule** branch of the **Fall Aspen** family, he has Classic winner **Mehthaaf** (**Nureyev**) as his third dam and is out of a half-sister to Gr.1 winner **Matterhorn** and three other Group winners.

From two crops to race, he has sired October's Gr.3 Prix Perth winner **Facteur Cheval**, Australian Gr.3-winning juvenile **Krakarib**, the Listed winner and Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup runner-up **Flaming Rib**, the Keeneland Stakes-winning sprinter **Ruthin**, and Listed winners **Snooze N You Lose** and **Championofmyheart**.

He has sired 46 individual winners of 83 races for earnings close to €1.5 million and will be standing this spring at his most competitive fee to date.

Beginning his second year at Irish Emerald Stud is the Gr.2-winning and Gr.1-placed juvenile **Royal Lytham**, who will stand for €2,500 this season.

The precocious son of **Gleneagles** was a debut winner at Navan over 5½f in June, which booked his ticket to contest the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot. Just a month after his debut, the colt was sent to Newmarket where he won the Gr.2 July Stakes over 6f on the July Course, defeating the likes of **Platinum Star**, odds-on favourite **Visinari** and **Guildsman**. His victory that day was in a faster time than high-class performers like **Tactical**, **Advertise**, **Shalaa**, **Anjal**, **Alhebayeb**, **Noverre** and **Green Desert**. On his final start at two, he was third in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes over 6f at the Curragh, beaten just a length by the subsequent Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas winner **Siskin**.

Bred in France by SARL Haras du Logis Saint Germain, Royal Lytham was purchased for €180,000 by MV Magnier at the Arqana August Yearling Sale. He is out of the French Listed winner and Gr.3-placed Gotlandia (Anabaa), whose own dam is a full-sister to the Gr.1 Fillies' Mile heroine Glorosia (Bering). He was the first Group winner for his quadruple Gr.1-winning sire, conceived from his first crop, and is a grandson of the legendary sire of sires Galileo.

The son of **Shamardal** has been well supported by breeders from Ireland and abroad, including his own breeder the Wertheimer brothers, as well as Anna Sundstrom, Ringfort, Baroda, Norelands, Kildaragh and Owenstown Studs.

Shaman got off the mark at the first attempt as a juvenile before finishing runner-up in a Listed race and placed in the Gr.3 Prix des Chenes. At three he landed a Listed race plus the Gr.3 Prix La Force before finishing runner-up to **Persian King** in the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains and fifth in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes. He then finished second in the Gr.1 Prix Jacques Le Marois and third in the Gr.2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein. His 2020 campaign saw him lift the Gr.2 Prix d'Harcourt, beating both **Way To Paris** and **Sottsass**, and finish third in the Gr.1 Prix Ganay.

He is a half-brother to a triple Listed winner **Green Sweet** (**Smart Strike**) and the Listed-placed **Situveux** (**Siyouni**) and is out of the dual Listed scorer and Gr.3-placed **Only Green** (**Green Desert**). She is a half-sister to the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest and Gr.1 Prix de la Foret heroine **Occupandiste** (**Kaldoun**), and it is the family of the Gr.1 winners and sires **Mondialiste** and **Intello**, both by **Galileo**.

STRADIVARIUS

Sea The Stars – Private Life (Bering)
THE NATIONAL STUD • Fee £10.000

Patrons of the National Stud in Newmarket in 2023 have the opportunity to breed to, not only one of the most popular horses in recent years, but one of the outstanding stayers of the modern era, **Stradivarius**.

A bastion of consistency and soundness, the son of **Sea The Stars** racked up a huge fan base in his seven seasons of racing, in which he finished out of the first three just five times in 35 starts. His 20 wins, 18 of which were at Group level and seven at Gr.1 level, yielded prize money earnings of over £3.4m, not including two Weatherbys Hamilton Stayers' Million bonuses, and an official rating of 125. He won the Gr.1 Goodwood Cup four times and the Gr.1 Gold Cup and Gr.2 Yorkshire Cup three times.

A stayer with a turn of foot, **Stradivarius** goes against the modern trend somewhat, but those who value toughness and durability have been given an extra incentive to avail of his services by his owner-breeder Bjorn Nielsen. The breeder of any Gr.1 winner in Britain, France or Ireland from his first crop will receive a £250,000 bonus, while the breeders of any Gr.2 or Gr.3 winners will each be rewarded with £100,000. Additionally, the breeders of his first ten two-year-old winners, Germany included, will each receive a bonus of £25,000.



SUPREMACY

Mehmas – Triggers Broom (Arcano)

YEOMANSTOWN STUD • Fee €10,000

The high-class juvenile sprinter **Supremacy** will embark on his second year at stud, once again standing at Yeomanstown for the 2023 breeding season.

The precocious son of the Champion First-Crop Sire in 2020 **Mehmas** broke his maiden at Windsor in July of his two-year-old season, easily dispatching a ten-runner field by three and three-quarter lengths over 6f. Next up was the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes over 6f at York, where he was even more impressive, defeating the favourite **Yazaman** by four lengths. Trainer Clive Cox then elected to elevate his colt into Gr.1 company, which proved no issue, as **Supremacy** added a Middle Park Stakes win to his collection of victories, defeating a strong field which included the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes victor **Lucky Vega**, who was subsequently third in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, and **Minzaal**, who won the Gr.1 Sprint Cup Stakes over 6f at Haydock last year.

He is out of the **Arcano** mare **Triggers Broom**, a half-sister to the dual Gr.1 winner in Hong Kong and sire **Xtension** (**Xaar**) and the dam of the Gr.1 Sprint Cup Stakes and Gr.1 July Cup winner, champion and sire **Harry Angel** (**Dark Angel**), whose first crop of runners yielded five black-type performers last season. Other family members include the Listed winner and last season's Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye runner-up **White Lavender** (**Heeraat**).


Showcasing – Bird Key (Cadeaux Genereux)

NUNNERY STUD • Fee £6,000 1st Jan SLF

Tasleet enjoyed a fine season with his first crop last year, siring Gr.2 Coventry Stakes winner **Bradsell** as well as 14 other individual winners. He remains on the Nunnery Stud roster at a slightly increased fee of £6,000.

The son of **Showcasing** won three time as a juvenile, winning the Listed Rose Bowl Stakes before taking out the valuable DBS Premier Yearling Stakes at York's Ebor meeting. He got off to the best start in his Classic season when winning the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes and took his form to a new level the following year, when he won the Gr.2 Duke of York Stakes and finished runner-up in three Gr.1 contests, the Diamond Jubilee Stakes, the July Cup and the British Champions' Sprint Stakes. By sire of sires **Invincible Spirit**, he is the sire of 18 Flat Stakes performers himself, headed by the Gr.1 Prix de l'Opera and Gr.1 E P Taylor Stakes winner **Rougir**, bought for \in 3 million, the Gr.2 winner **Berkeley Square** and the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Derby-placed **Hoo Ya Mal**, who sold for £1.2 million last June. Many of **Territories**'s fourth-crop yearlings fetched three-figure prices last autumn, with many top trainers involved with purchases.

A maiden winner at two, **Territories** also finished runner-up in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere, before reappearing as a three-year-old with a win in the Gr.3 Prix de Fontainebleau and a runner-up spot behind **Gleneagles** in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas. He then followed up that effort with a fine win in the Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat before only finding multiple Gr.1 winner **Esoterique** too good in the Gr.1 Prix Jacques Le Marois. He then was Group-placed twice at four.

He is one of six winners out of the Listed-placed juvenile winner **Taranto** (**Machiavellian**). The second dam, the Gr.3 scorer **Magna Graecia** (**Warning**), is a half-sister to fellow Gr.3 winner **Graikos** (**Rainbow Quest**) and the Listed scorer **Parthenon** (**Dubai Destination**). The fourth dam is the Gr.1 Irish Oaks heroine **Helen Street** (**Troy**), dam of the dual Gr.1 winner and successful sire **Street Cry**.

All-conquering both on the track and in the breeding sheds in his native land, **Deep Impact** has made a big impression in Europe from very limited chances thanks to the likes of the dual Gr.1-winning Classic hero **Saxon Warrior**, the triple Gr.1 Oaks winner **Snowfall** and the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club victor **Study Of Man. Saxon Warrior** has made a fine start to his stallion career by producing the US Gr.1 winner **Victoria Road** and **Tosen Stardom**, who will be shuttling from Woodside Park Stud in Australia, will become Ireland's second **Deep Impact** sire.

Tosen Stardom's first Southern Hemisphere crop recently turned three and includes the exciting **Shuriken**, a fast-finishing fourth in Gr.2 company on his last 2022 run. Trained by Nigel Tinkler, **Ubettabelieveit** notched a decisive victory in the Listed National Stakes prior to landing the Flying Childers, beating Gr.1 winner **Winter Power** and Group winners **Sacred**, **Steel Bull** and **Ventura Tormenta**. He ended the season in America with a close third in the Gr.2 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint. Tinkler said: "**Ubettabelieveit** has got such a fantastic turn of speed and a great attitude."

He was very popular in his first season at stud, covering 98 mares, including four Stakes winners.

He is a half-brother to the Gr.3 Supreme Stakes and Gr.3 Oak Tree Stakes winner **Tropical Paradise** (**Verglas**) and to the Stakes winners **Harlem Shake** (**Moss Vale**) and **Shenanigans** (**Arcano**), out of the two-year-old winner **Ladylishandra** (**Mujadil**). 
The coming year could be a breakthrough season for **Ulysses**, as he looks to have an outstanding Classic contender in the shape of **Holloway Boy**. Despite being a tall colt with plenty of scope for physical improvement, this 60,000gns yearling purchase became the first two-year-old in over a quarter of a century to make a winning debut at Royal Ascot when lifting the Listed Chesham Stakes.

Although not winning again, **Holloway Boy** showed stacks of ability when placed in all four of his subsequent starts (every one in Pattern company). His final outing, when third in the Gr.1 Futurity Trophy, was particularly praiseworthy.

Ulysses's other top performers of 2022 were the Gr.3 Ballysax Stakes hero and the Gr.1 Irish Derby runner-up **Piz Badile**, and the Gr.3 Princess Royal Stakes second **Peripatetic**.

A choicely-bred son of **Galileo** and the Gr.1 Oaks heroine **Light Shift**, he was the leading UK-based second-crop sire by percentage of black-type winners to runners in 2022. His yearlings continued to be in demand, with prices including 170,000gns, 150,000gns and €150,000.

He landed the Gr.3 Gordon Stakes in the middle of his three-year-old campaign but really came into his own at four, when his two Gr.1 wins were the Eclipse Stakes and the Juddmonte International.

Society Rock – Unfortunate (Komaite)

SPRINGFIELD HOUSE STUD • Fee €3,500

The high-class sprinter **Unfortunately** will begin his fourth season at Springfield House Stud, after siring eight individual juvenile winners in his first crop of runners.

This crop was headlined by the quadruple-winning filly **Perdika**, who has won over both 6f and 7f, the dual 5f winner **Looking For Lynda**, and the promising unbeaten **Always Tomorrow**, who broke his maiden on debut over 5f at Wolverhampton in September.

Trained by Karl Burke, the son of **Society Rock** was the Champion Two-Year-Old in France in 2017, after victories in the Gr.2 Prix Robert Papin over 1100m at Maisons-Laffitte and the Gr.1 Prix Morny over 1200m at Deauville, where he defeated the likes of **Havana Grey**, **Different League** and **Tantheem** in the fastest time the race had seen for ten years. At three, he claimed the Gr.3 Renaissance Stakes over 6f at Naas on the his final start, defeating the full-brother to **American Pharoah**, **St Patrick's Day**, by half a length, with the triple Gr.1 winner **Gordon Lord Byron** back in fourth.

He is a half-brother to the Gr.2 Temple stakes victrix **Look Busy** (**Danetime**; dam of the dual Listed scorer and Gr.1-placed **Keep Busy** and the grandam of the Listed Prix Zeddaan winner **Honey Sweet**), out of the dual winner **Unfortunate** (**Komaite**). The family also includes the dual Gr.3 victor and sire **Singing Seven** (**Balliol**).

Washington DC will remain at Bearstone Stud in 2023, where he will stand for a slightly reduced fee of £3,000.

Amongst his first crop last year, was the black-type performer **Washington Heights**, who was placed in Listed company and finished runner-up in a valuable sales race at York's Ebor meeting.

Washington DC was a high-class sprinter himself for Aidan O'Brien, winning the Listed Windsor Castle Stakes as a juvenile before finishing runner-up in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes. He went on to win the Gr.3 Phoenix Sprint Stakes, as well as three Listed sprints, and was also placed in the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup, Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye and Gr.2 Temple Stakes, when beaten just a head by **Battaash**.

The son of **Zoffany** received a pedigree update last season, courtesy of his Gr.2 Futurity Stakes-winning half-brother **Aesop's Fables** (**No Nay Never**), while he is also a half-brother to the Gr.3 Chester Vase-placed juvenile winner **Sandhurst** (**Galileo**). 
Frankel – Without You Babe (Lemon Drop Kid)

Without Parole's first foals sold for an average of just over £28,000 last year, four-times greater than his 2023 stud fee, and the Gr.1-winning son of **Frankel** is now heading into his third season at Newsells Park Stud. As his sire's highest rated miler and sole Gr.1-winning miler at stud in Europe, the eight-year-old offers breeders excellent value at £7,000.

His dam is the Gunthers' unraced **Lemon Drop Kid** mare **Without You Babe**, a half-sister to dual Gr.1 hero and multiple Gr.1-placed **Stay Thirsty**, Gr.3 winner and four-time Gr.1-placed **Andromeda's Hero** and Stakes scorer and Gr.1-placed **Superfly**.
