BAAEED

Sea The Stars – Aghareed (Kingmambo)

NUNNERY STUD • Fee £80,000 1st Oct SLF

There is a new global superstar among the British stallion ranks in 2023 in the shape of the exceptional **Baaeed**. The Shadwell homebred son of **Sea The Stars**, a six-time Gr.1 winner, was the highest-rated turf horse in the world in a decade, displaying an unmatched cruising speed and a trademark turn of foot across two seasons of racing.

Unraced at two, he was patiently handled by William Haggas, who took him to maiden, novice, Listed and Gr.3 wins before tackling Gr.1 company, where he would stay for the remainder of his career. He won the Prix du Moulin and then defeated champion **Palace Pier** in the Queen Elizabeth II to complete an unbeaten debut season. He returned at four and extended his Gr.1-winning run, triumphing in the Lockinge Stakes, Queen Anne Stakes and Sussex Stakes before making a much-anticipated step up to a mile and a quarter in scintillating style, with a six and a half-length romp in the Juddmonte International, a victory which earned him a rating of 135, the equal of his legendary sire.

Baaeed is a full-brother to the Gr.1 Coronation Cup winner **Hukum**, out of **Aghareed** (**Kingmambo**), a daughter of the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf and Gr.1 Flower Bowl Invitational winner **Lahudood** (**Singspiel**). His fifth dam is the great **Height Of Fashion**, whom Sheikh Hamdan bought from The Queen back in 1982.

BAYSIDE BOY

New Bay – Alava (Anabaa)

BALLYLINCH STUD • €15,000

Joining his sire **New Bay** at Ballylinch Stud for the 2023 breeding season is the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes winner **Bayside Boy**, a 200,000gns purchase by Richard Ryan at Book 2 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale.

A high-class juvenile, the Roger Varian-trained colt was an impressive debut winner at Newbury, before defeating **Reach For The Moon** in the Gr.2 Champagne Stakes at Doncaster and coming third in both the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes and Gr.1 Futurity Trophy. At three, he earned the biggest victory of his career when storming past the fourtime Gr.1 winner **Modern Games** in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes over 1m at Ascot on British Champions Day. Also behind him that day were the triple Gr.1-winning filly **Inspiral**, Gr.1 victor **The Revenant** and dual Gr.2 winner and Gr.1-placed **Jadoomi**.

The most precocious son of **New Bay**, he is out of the Listed victress **Alava** (**Anabaa**) and is a half-brother to the dual Gr.2 Huxley Stakes scorer **Forest Ranger** (**Lawman**) and the Listed-placed **Home Cummins** (**Rip Van Winkle**). The extended pedigree includes the US Gr.1 winner **Passing Shot** (**A P Indy**) and the Gr.1 Prix du Cadran victor and sire **Bannaby** (**Dyhim Diamond**).



BELARDO

Lope De Vega – Danaskaya (Danehill)

BEARSTONE STUD • Fee £6,500 1st Oct SLF

Recently moved from Kildangan in Ireland to Bearstone in Britain, European champion **Belardo** has enjoyed an excellent start at stud, with six Group winners and 17 black-type horses from his first three crops, yet he is now covering at less than half of the fee that he was commanding in 2018.

His progeny have shown their versatility by excelling all around the world. His two biggest achievers in 2022 may have raced in the US, **Bellabel** landing the Gr.2 San Clemente Stakes and **Gold Phoenix** lifting the Gr.2 Del Mar Handicap, but he has also done well in Australia, Hong Kong and New Zealand, not to mention Europe where **Isabella Giles** was his initial standard bearer, scoring in both Gr.2 and Gr.3 company, while he has also enjoyed notable victories in Ireland and France. He has had particular success with fillies, all of his Group winners to date bar **Gold Phoenix** being of the fairer sex.

His sales statistics have held up pretty well too. His colt out of the Listed-placed **Verglas** mare **Petits Potins** made 125,000gns at Book 1 of the 2022 Tattersalls October Yearling Sale.

A top-class juvenile, **Belardo** won the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes and maintained his form through to the age of four, when he landed the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes. By leading intentional sire **Lope De Vega**, he is out of the Irish Champion Two-Year-Old Filly **Danaskaya** (**Danehill**).

CATURRA

Mehmas – Shoshoni Wind (Sleeping Indian)

OVERBURY STUD • Fee £6,500 1st Oct SLF

One of two new additions to the six-strong Overbury Stud roster this year is the four-year-old **Caturra**, who was bred by Tally-Ho Stud, commanded a 110,000gns fee at Book 2 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale and was raced by Saeed bin Mohammed Al Qassimi.

Trained by Clive Cox, the precocious son of **Mehmas** raced eight times as a two-year-old, winning a Bath novice before running mid-division in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes. He then won the Listed Rose Bowl Stakes and, having finished a close second in the Listed Julia Graves Roses Stakes, added the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes, beating fellow stallion **Armor**. On his final two-year-old start, he was fifth, beaten a length and a half, in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes. As a three-year-old, the colt contested Gr.1 sprints like the Flying Five Stakes and the Prix de l'Abbaye, and was third in the Gr.2 King George Stakes at Goodwood over the minimum trip.

He is a half-brother to the Listed-placed **Sir Arthur Dayne** (**Sir Prancealot**), out of the Listed Empress Stakes-placed **Shoshoni Wind** (**Sleeping Indian**). The extended pedigree includes the likes of the Gr.1 St Leger and Gr.1 Gold Cup winner and sire **Classic Cliche** (**Salse**), the Gr.1 Prix Vermeille and Gr.1 Yorkshire Oaks victress and champion **My Emma** (**Marju**) and the 2022 Gr.1 National Stakes victor **Al Riffa** (**Wootton Bassett**).

CHARMING THOUGHT

Oasis Dream – Annabelle's Charm (Indian Ridge)


MARCH HARE STUD • Fee £3.000

A 625,000gns Tattersalls yearling and new to March Hare Stud in Surrey this year, **Charming Thought** (**Oasis Dream**) was at his best as a juvenile, when his three victories from four runs included a game success in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes, leaving dual Gr.2 winner **Ivawood** and subsequent Champion Sprinter **Muhaarar** filling the places.

His dam was a Listed winner over 1m and a close second in a Gr.3 over 2000m, and has produced five other winners by five different sires. His second dam is a **Sadler's Wells** full-sister to Gr.1 winners and sires **Aristotle** and **Ballingarry**, and half-sister to the Gr.1 winner and sire **Starborough** and to the dam of the multiple Gr.1 winner **St Nicholas Abbey**.

From modestly-sized crops to date, he has sired plenty of multiple winners, among them the Listed-winning miler Charterhouse (out of a Royal Applause mare), the five-time scorer Totally Charming (out of a Pivotal mare), the five-time 5f winner Triple Jaye (dam by Tamayuz), the four-time 7f winner Sky Blue Thinking (out of a Daylami mare) and Fircombe Hall (dam by Kodiac), winner of four 6f races.

His son **Lightning Warrior** (out of an **Inchinor** mare) was unbeaten in three runs at two in 2021, including a five-length victory in a Newmarket sales race, and on 2nd January this year his daughter **Amy C** (out of an **Exceed And Excel** mare) won the Gr.3 Las Cienagas Stakes over 6½ at Santa Anita.



DABIRSIM

Hat Trick – Rumored (Royal Academy)

HARAS DE MONTAIGU • Fee €8,000 LF

Dabirsim switches to Haras de Montaigu for the 2023 breeding season, following Haras de Grandcamp's decision to close its stallion division, but his fee remains unchanged.

The son of **Hat Trick**, himself a son of **Sunday Silence**, was the number two leading sire in France by individual winners last season with 61, two behind **Siyouni**. In all, his progeny won 91 races in France in 2022, collecting €2,031,090 in prize money. His 24 Stakes performers to date are headed by the Gr.3 Albany Stakes winner **Different League**, who was subsequently purchased for 1,500,000gns and has two colts by **Galileo**, and the Gr.3 Prix Imprudence winner and Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches runner-up **Coeur De Beaute**.

The joint European Champion Two-Year-Old of 2011, **Dabirsim** was unbeaten in his debut season, claiming the Gr.1 Prix Morny and Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere, as well as the Gr.3 Prix de Cabourg.

He is out of the **Royal Academy** mare **Rumored**, a half-sister to the dam of the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes winner and sire **Arizona**. The second dam is the Italian Champion Three-Year-Old Filly and Gr.1 (then) Oaks d'Italia heroine **Bright Generation** (**Rainbow Quest**), a half-sister to the dam of the excellent producer **Holy Moon** (**Hernando**), herself the dam of the supremely talented Classic winner **Sea Of Class**.

DUBAWI LEGEND

Dubawi – Lovely Pass (Raven's Pass)

STARFIELD STUD • Fee €6,500

Dubawi Legend was one of the best two-year-olds of his generation. He found just the outstanding unbeaten Champion Two-Year-Old Colt **Native Trail (Oasis Dream)** too strong for him in one of the world's ultimate stallion-making races, the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes, where those behind him included the 2022 Gr.1 scorer and fellow freshman sire **Bayside Boy (New Bay)**.

As a three-year-old, he went on to prove himself a highclass sprinter, finishing third to the subsequent brilliant Gr.1 Haydock Sprint Cup victor **Minzaal (Mehmas)** in the Gr.3 Hackwood Stakes, with the Gr.2 winner **Rohaan (Mayson)** back in fourth place, before travelling over to Germany to land that nation's top 1200m event, the Gr.3 Goldene Peitsche at Baden-Baden comfortably.

His pedigree page is littered with black type. His dam, the Listed UAE 1,000 Guineas heroine **Lovely Pass** (**Raven's Pass**), was precocious enough to be placed at Royal Ascot as a two-year-old. She went on to produce four winners from her first four runners, including **Golden Pass** (**Golden Horn**), who triumphed at Listed level and was Gr.2-placed. The second dam is the 2003 Champion Older Female Miler **Macadamia** (**Classic Cliche**), winner of the Gr.2 (then) Falmouth Stakes and second in the Gr.2 (then) Sun Chariot Stakes.

FRAMMASSONE

Fraam – Iberian Dancer (El Gran Senor)

BATSFORD STUD • Fee £2,000 1st Oct LFFR

Relocating to Gloucestershire for the 2023 season, **Frammassone** joins **Harbour Law**, **Swiss Spirit** and **Passing Glance** at Batsford Stud. The 18-year-old will command a fee of £2,000.

A winner of 16 races, including three at the highest level over hurdles, **Frammassone** retired to Park House Stud in Ireland in 2013, where he stood for a private fee for seven seasons. He then moved to Peel Hall Stud in Cheshire for three seasons. A quick glance at his statistics show a 50 per cent winners to runners ratio over each of the last three seasons, which includes Galway Blazers Handicap Chase winner **Gabbys Cross**, who holds an entry in Thursday's Thyestes Chase at Gowran Park, and **Lively Citizen**, who finished runner-up in the Gr.3 Imperial Cup Handicap Hurdle, all this from limited opportunities.

He is a half-brother to seven winners, including the Listed St Hugh's Stakes third **Brenda Meova** (**Dr Fong**), out of the **El Gran Senor** mare **Iberian Dancer**, a winning half-sister to the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed **Sharp Singer** (**The Minstrel**) and the Listed winners **Tejabo** (**Deputy Minister**) and **Late Request** (**Hurry Up Blue**).

GALILEO GOLD

Paco Boy – Galicuix (Galileo)

HARAS DE BOUQUETOT • Fee €7,000 LF

Switching to France after five seasons at Tally-Ho Stud, Classic winner and Gr.1 sire **Galileo Gold** joins the ninestrong roster at Haras de Bouquetot in Normandy.

Boasting a 41 per cent winners to runners ratio in Europe in 2022, which included four black-type winners, the son of **Paco Boy** has shown his worth as a sire. His first crop yielded Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes winner **Ebro River** and Gr.3 Prix Six Perfections winner **Oscula**, who ended her debut season with a third-placed effort in the Gr.1 Prix Marcel Boussac and went on to win two further Gr.3 races at three. They are joined by Listed Hyde Stakes winner **The Wizard Of Eye**, Listed Empress Fillies' Stakes winner **System**, German Listed winner **Goldana** and American Stakes winner **Maglev** as his six black-type winners to date, while **Hellomydarlin** was Gr.3-placed and **Sister Bridget** was Listed-placed.

Winner of the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes and third in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere as a two-year-old, **Galileo Gold** gave Al Shaqab Racing and Hugo Palmer a first Classic win when triumphing in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas at Newmarket. Second in the Irish equivalent, he won the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes before losing out by a neck in the Gr.1 Sussex Stakes.

He is out of **Galicuix**, a **Galileo** half-sister to the dual Gr.1-winning sprinter **Goldream** (**Oasis Dream**), from the family of sires **Montjeu** and **Aclaim**.

GOLDEN HORN

Cape Cross – Fleche D'Or (Dubai Destination)

OVERBURY STUD • Fee £8,000 SLF

Golden Horn has relocated to Overbury Stud this season, having spent the past seven years at Dalham Hall Stud, and is making an impact both on the Flat and over Jumps.

Bred by Anthony Oppenheimer, the son of **Cape Cross** won his only start at two before winning four Gr.1 races at three, including the Derby and Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, and finished the year as Champion Three-Year-Old Colt in Europe.

He is the sire of 31 Stakes performers on the Flat, including the Gr.2 winner and dual Gr.1-placed **Botanik**, the Gr.3-winning juvenile **West End Girl** and the Listed winner **Haskoy**, who finished second in the Gr.1 St Leger before being demoted. The median Timeform rating of his progeny aged three and up is an impressive 88, on par with **Kingman**, **Lope De Vega** and **Night Of Thunder**. His best in the National Hunt sphere include Gr.2 Leamington Novices' Hurdle winner **Stag Horn**, Gr.1 Tolworth Novices' Hurdle third **Nemean Lion** and Gerry Feilden Handicap Hurdle winner and Gr.3 County Handicap Hurdle second **First Street**.

He is from a family saturated in black type, being out of **Fleche D'Or** (**Dubai Destination**), a half-sister to the Gr.1 Coronation Stakes heroine **Rebecca Sharp** (**Machiavellian**), the Gr.3 winner **Mystic Knight** (**Caerleon**) and the Listed winner and dual Gr.2-placed **Hidden Hope** (**Daylami**; dam of the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 Oaks-placed **Frankly Darling**).



KING OF CHANGE

Farhh – Salacia (Echo Of Light)

STARFIELD STUD • €6,000

A new addition to the Starfield Stud roster for the 2023 breeding season is the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes hero **King Of Change**, who previously spent two years at Shadwell's Derrinstown Stud.

He raced just twice at two, finishing runner-up on both occasions, but was a much better three-year-old. After an easy success at Nottingham in April, the son of **Farhh** ran a mighty race in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, finishing second to the Gr.1-winning juvenile **Magna Grecia**. Behind **King Of Change** that day were the were the Gr.1 winners **Ten Sovereigns**, **Advertise** and **Emaraaty Ana**, as well as the Gr.1 Derby runner-up **Madhmoon**. After a Listed success at Sandown in September, he would reverse the form with **Magna Grecia** in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes at Ascot, defeating the Gr.1 scorer **The Revenant** by a length and a quarter.

He is a half-brother to the Gr.2 Celebration Mile winner and Gr.1-placed **Century Dream** (**Cape Cross**), and they are out of the winner **Salacia** (**Echo Of Light**). His grandam **Neptune's Bride** (**Bering**) was a Gr.3 winner and Gr.2-placed in France, and the family also includes the Gr.2 International Stakes scorer **Sea Dart** (**Diesis**). A colt foal from **King Of Change**'s first crop sold for €50,000 at the Goffs November Foal Sale.

MEKHTAAL

Sea The Stars – Aiglonne (Silver Hawk)

KNOCKMULLEN HOUSE STUD • Fee POA

Mekhtaal, a Gr.1-winning son of **Sea The Stars**, is a new addition to Knockmullen House Stud, located at New Ross in County Wexford, joining **Silas Marner** on the roster for the 2023 breeding season.

Trained by Jean-Claude Rouget, **Mekhtaal**, a €300,000 yearling, was unraced at two, but made a winning debut at three over 2000m at Saint-Cloud before going on to land the Gr.2 Prix Hocquart, meriting his place in the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club among France's best three-year-old colts. On his seasonal reappearance at four, he was second to Gr.1 winner **Cloth Of Stars** in the Hocquart before dropping back to 1800m to land the Gr.1 Prix d'Ispahan. He continued racing at five across the Atlantic for Graham Motion and was second in the Gr.1 Northern Dancer Turf Stakes.

His half-brother **Democrate** (**Dalakhani**) also won the Hocquart, and he is also a sibling to Gr.3 Prix Thomas Bryon winner and Gr.1-placed **Normandy Bridge** (**Le Havre**) and the dual US Gr.3 winner **Aigue Marine** (**Galileo**), as well as two other black-type horses. They are all out of the Gr.3 Prix Fille de l'Air winner **Aiglonne** (**Silver Hawk**), a half-sister to the dam of the Gr.1 Prix Saint-Alary winner **Germance** (**Silver Hawk**). This is the family of the Gr.1 (then) Derby Italiano winner and sire **White Muzzle** and the Gr.1 Dubai World Cup winner and sire **Almutawakel**.

MIDNIGHTS LEGACY

Midnight Legend – Giving (Generous)
ALNE PARK STUD • Fee £3,000

Midnights Legacy, the only stallion at stud by leading National Hunt sire Midnight Legend, is set to commence stud duties in 2023 at the Skelton family-run Alne Park Stud. The six-year-old was bred by David and Kathleen Holmes, who stood his sire Midnight Legend at their own Pitchall Stud until his death in 2016. The popular son of Night Shift is responsible for 28 National Hunt black-type winners, including Gr.1 Cheltenham Gold Cup hero Sizing John, as well as Midnight Shadow, Mercian Prince, Midnight Chase and Seeyouatmidnight.

Whilst **Midnights Legacy** did not gain any black type, he was a useful dual-purpose performer for Alan King, winning five times on the Flat, including back-to-back renewals of the Northern Dancer Handicap at Epsom on Derby Day. He scored three times over fences and gained a mark of 125, including a seven-length victory on his final racecourse appearance at Fontwell last September.

He is a half-brother to Listed juvenile hurdle winner **Giving Glances** (**Passing Glance**). His dam **Giving** (**Generous**) was a winner at two and is a half-sister to the French Listed Flat winner and dual Gr.1-placed **Lethals Lady** (**Rudimentary**). The family includes multiple Gr.1 Jumps winner **Katchit** (**Kalanisi**) and Gr.2-placed **Burn The Breeze** (**Beat Hollow**).



MINZAAL


Mehmas – Pardoven (Clodovil)

DERRINSTOWN STUD • Fee €15,000 1st Jan SLF

Joining Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas winner **Awtaad** at Derrinstown Stud for 2023 is fellow top-flight winner **Minzaal**, a son of sire sensation **Mehmas**.

Trained by Owen Burrows for Shadwell, **Minzaal** was a smart two-year-old, winning the Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes and running third in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes from four starts. An injury-hit three-year-old season restricted him to just two runs, but he showed he still possessed all his talent when third in the Gr.1 British Champions Sprint Stakes. He returned at four and won the Gr.3 Hackwood Stakes before beating all but **Highfield Princess** in the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest. He did not have to wait long for his top-level breakthrough, however, running out the near four-length winner of the Gr.1 Sprint Cup from the previous year's winner **Emaraaty Ana** less than a month later.

From the prolific **Mehmas** – **Acclamation** sire line, **Minzaal** also brings in a pair of breed-shapers to his pedigree, being out of **Pardoven** (**Clodovil**), a granddaughter of both **Danehill** and **Sadler's Wells**. The second dam **Dancing Prize** is a full-sister to Gr.1 Fillies' Mile second **Dance To The Top**, dam of the Gr.2 winner and dual Gr.1-placed **Bankable** (**Medicean**), and a half-sister to the dual Listed winner and Gr.1-placed **Polar Bear** (**Polar Falcon**). The third dam won the Gr.3 (then) Premio Chiusura.



NAVAL CROWN

Dubawi – Come Alive (Dansili)

KILDANGAN STUD • Fee €15,000 1st Oct SLF

New to Darley's Kildangan Stud in 2023 is last year's Gr.1 Platinum Jubilee hero **Naval Crown**, a son of the newlycrowned Champion Sire **Dubawi**, who now has six sons on the Darley roster.

A smart performer at two, he finished third in two Gr.3 contests, including when running Go Athletico and Sealiway to a length and a neck in the Gr.3 Prix La Rochette. He began his three-year-old season in Meydan, where he was victorious in the Listed Meydan Classic, before finishing a neck second to **Tactical** in a Listed contest at Newmarket. He followed up by finishing fourth in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas and then second in the Gr.3 Jersey Stakes behind Creative Force. He had a great start as a four-year-old, winning the Gr.2 Al Fahidi Fort and finishing fourth in the Gr.1 Al Quoz Sprint. His return to British soil then produced the best result of his career when he landed the Gr.1 Platinum Jubilee Stakes, beating no less than 11 Gr.1 winners, including Highfield Princess, Kinross, Alcohol Free, Campanelle and Minzaal. He followed up by finishing second to the prolific **Alcohol Free** in the Gr.1 July Cup.

He is the first foal out of the Stakes-winning **Dansili** mare **Come Alive**, herself a daughter of the Gr.2-placed juvenile **Portrayal** (**Saint Ballado**). His extended family includes the likes of the smart Gr.2 winner and sire **Wareed**.

Monsun – Crystal Maze (Gone West)

ALNE PARK STUD • Fee £3,000

Having left The Beeches Stud in Ireland, **Ocovango** will take up duties at Alne Park Stud this year. He is the sire of several recent National Hunt Stakes performers, including Gr.1 Lawlor's of Naas Novice Hurdle winner and leading Cheltenham Festival prospect **Champ Kiely**, as well as the dual Gr.3-winning hurdler **Langer Dan**.

A winner on debut as a two-year-old, **Ocovango** went on to win his next two starts at three, including taking out the Gr.2 Prix Greffulhe, before a fifth-placed effort in the Gr.1 Derby at Epsom. He was then placed in the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris and went on to be placed in Stakes company again as a four-year-old.

By leading Jumps sire of sires Monsun, he is a half-brother to three winners, out of the unraced Gone West mare Crystal Maze. She is a half-sister to the Listed winner Firnas (Dubawi) and the Listed-placed multiple winners Treasury Devil (Bernardini), High End (Dubawi), Crystal Moment (Distorted Humor) and Crystany (Green Desert). They are out of the Gr.1 Fillies' Mile heroine and Classic-placed Crystal Music (Nureyev), who is also a half-sister to several Stakes winners, including the Gr.3 scorer and dual Gr.2-placed Dubai Success (Sadler's Wells) and the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Prix Marcel Boussac-placed Solar Crystal (Alzao; dam of the Gr.1 Racing Post Trophy-placed juvenile winner Feared In Flight).

Ardad – Sagely (Frozen Power)

DALHAM HALL STUD • Fee £15,000 1st Oct SLF

The only new recruit to Dalham Hall Stud in 2023 is the triple Gr.1 winner and Champion Two-Year-Old in France **Perfect Power**.

The son of **Ardad**, and grandson of **Kodiac**, was one of Europe's leading two-year-olds in 2021. His first big win came at Royal Ascot when getting up on the line to deny **Go Bears Go** in the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes and, although he was below par at Goodwood next time out, he bounced back to win the Gr.1 Prix Morny under Christophe Soumillon, who would become his regular partner. Signing off his debut season a month later, he added his second top-flight win in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes at Newmarket. Sent down the Classic route at three, he won the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes, but finished mid-division in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, before returning to sprinting and winning the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup, his second victory at the Royal Meeting.

He is out of **Sagely** (**Frozen Power**), a half-sister to the Listed-placed **Sagaciously** (**Lawman**; dam of the Listed winner and Gr.3-placed **Epic Poet**). The third dam **Saga D'Ouilly** (**Linamix**) is a half-sister to the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner and sire **Sagamix** and the Gr.1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud winner and sire **Sagacity**, and this is also the family of Gr.1 winners and sires **Sageburg**, **Japan** and **Mogul**.

RIBCHESTER

Iffraaj – Mujarah (Marju)

HARAS DU LOGIS • Fee €7,500 1st Oct SLF

Making the move to France after five seasons at Kildangan Stud in Ireland is **Ribchester**, the European Champion Miler of 2016 and 2017.

A Gr.2 winner of the Gimcrack Stakes at two, the son of **Iffraaj** was third in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas and beaten a neck and a short head in the Gr.1 Sussex Stakes before landing the Gr.1 Prix Jacques Le Marois later that season. He added the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes and Gr.1 Prix du Moulin to his record at four and was placed in four other Gr.1s, including second places in the Sussex Stakes and Queen Elizabeth II Stakes.

From the **Elle Seule** branch of the **Fall Aspen** family, he has Classic winner **Mehthaaf** (**Nureyev**) as his third dam and is out of a half-sister to Gr.1 winner **Matterhorn** and three other Group winners.

From two crops to race, he has sired October's Gr.3 Prix Perth winner **Facteur Cheval**, Australian Gr.3-winning juvenile **Krakarib**, the Listed winner and Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup runner-up **Flaming Rib**, the Keeneland Stakes-winning sprinter **Ruthin**, and Listed winners **Snooze N You Lose** and **Championofmyheart**.

He has sired 46 individual winners of 83 races for earnings close to \in 1.5m and will be standing this spring at his most competitive fee to date.

Galiway – Kensea (Kendargent)

HARAS DE BEAUMONT • Fee €12,000 LF

Once part of the Head family's famous Haras du Quesnay, Haras de Beaumont is a new venture for father-daughter team Kamel and Pauline Chehboub, who, along with Stud Managers Mathieu and Émilie Alex, are standing their dual Gr.1-winning French champion **Sealiway** for his first season at stud in 2023.

The son of **Galiway**, and grandson of **Galileo**, was campaigned by the Chehboubs and his breeder Guy Pariente. He won three times, including the Listed Prix des Jouvenceaux et des Jouvencelles, in his debut season before capping it off with an eight-length triumph in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere on Arc day, which saw him crowned French Champion Two-Year-Old of 2020. At three, he was second to **St Mark's Basilica** in the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club and, having returned to Longchamp for its showpiece event, finished fifth in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, before going on to take the Gr.1 Champion Stakes at Ascot, where he defeated the likes of **Mac Swiney**, **Mishriff** and **Adayar**. He was also further Gr.1-placed at four.

Sealiway is out of the **Kendargent** mare **Kensea**, winner of the Listed Prix Herod, a 1400m contest for two-year-olds at Chantilly. The second dam **Sea Island** is a daughter of **Gold Away** and herself won five races at two in France.



SHAMALGAN

Footstepsinthesand – Genevale (Unfuwain)

HARAS DE MONTAIGU • Fee €5,000 LF

Following **Dabirsim** in the move from Haras de Grandcamp to Haras de Montaigu is Gr.1 winner and Gr.1 sire **Shamalgan**.

An €80,000 yearling, the son of **Footstepsinthesand** was exported to the Czech Republic, but did most of his racing in France. He was third in the Gr.3 Prix de Conde at two, came third behind **Lope De Vega** in the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains at three and won the Gr.2 Oettingen-Rennen at Baden-Baden at four. Having changed hands, his five-year-old season yielded a second-place finish in the Gr.3 Prix de la Porte Maillot, but, after changing hands again, his six-year-old season was more successful, as he won the Listed Grand Prix de Bordeaux and the Gr.1 (then) Premio Vittorio di Capua. He retired to stud Haras du Lion in 2014, but returned to training as a nine-year-old and won the Grand Prix de Prague. He resumed stud duties in the Czech Republic before being bought by Normandie Pur-Sang to stand at Haras de Grandcamp.

Despite an atypical career, **Shamalgan** is a Classic sire, his daughter **Toskana Belle** prevailing in the Gr.1 Preis der Diana last season, and other Stakes performers by him include Listed Criterium de Bequet runner-up **Anima Rock**, Listed Prix de Grand Camp second **Aude** and Gr.2 AQPS winner **Fan Of Sea**.

STATE OF REST

Starspangledbanner – Repose (Quiet American)

RATHBARRY STUD • Fee €25,000

Rathbarry Stud, in conjunction with Newgate Farm Australia and Partners, is standing the globetrotting star **State Of Rest**, who won four Gr.1s, including three consecutively on three different continents, for his first season at stud in 2023.

A debut winner in June of his juvenile season, the son of **Starspangledbanner** finished just over a length third to **Chindit** in the Gr.2 Champagne Stakes, before culminating his season by finishing fifth to **Mac Swiney** in the Gr.1 Futurity Trophy. The Joseph O'Brien-trained colt came into his own at three, landing the Gr.1 Saratoga Derby, before completing a top-flight double in the Gr.1 Cox Plate, conceding 16lbs to runner-up **Anamoe**, who went on to land the contest 12 months later. He was back with a bang at four, scoring in the Gr.1 Prix Ganay, with **Sealiway** in third. He then finished a strong third behind **Alenquer** and **High Definition** in the Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup, before beating **Bay Bridge** in the Gr.1 Prince of Wales's Stakes.

His unraced dam **Repose** (**Quiet American**) has also produced dual Gr.3 scorer **Tranquily Lady** (**Australia**), recently bought by Godolphin for 2,700,000gns at the Tattersalls December Mare Sale. His third dam is the five-time Gr.1-winning US champion **It's In The Air** (**Mr Prospector**).

STRADIVARIUS

Sea The Stars – Private Life (Bering)
THE NATIONAL STUD • Fee £10,000 LF

Patrons of the National Stud in Newmarket in 2023 have the opportunity to breed to not only one of the most popular horses in recent years, but one of the outstanding stayers of the modern era, **Stradivarius**.

A bastion of consistency and soundness, the son of **Sea The Stars** racked up a huge fan base in his seven seasons of racing, in which he finished out of the first three just five times in 35 starts. His 20 wins, 18 of which were Group races and seven at Gr.1 level, yielded prize money earnings of over £3.4m, not including two Weatherbys Hamilton Stayers' Million bonuses, and an official rating of 125. He won the Gr.1 Goodwood Cup four times and the Gr.1 Gold Cup, Gr.2 Yorkshire Cup and Gr.2 Lonsdale Cup three times.

A stayer with a turn of foot, **Stradivarius** goes against the modern trend somewhat, but those who value toughness and durability have been given an extra incentive to avail of his services by his owner-breeder Bjorn Nielsen. The breeder of any Gr.1 winner in Britain, France or Ireland from his first crop will receive a £250,000 bonus, while the breeders of any Gr.2 or Gr.3 winners will each be rewarded with £100,000. Additionally, the breeders of his first ten two-year-old winners, in any of those three countries plus Germany, will each receive a bonus of £25,000.

Zoffany – Small Sacrifice (Sadler's Wells)

HARAS DE BOUQUETOT • Fee €6,000 LF

As well as **Galileo Gold, Thunder Moon**, a Gr.1-winning two-year-old by **Zoffany**, joins the roster at Haras de Bouquetot for the 2023 breeding season and has been introduced at a fee of €6,000.

Trained by Joseph O'Brien and bred by the O'Briens' Whisperview Trading Ltd, **Thunder Moon** made a winning debut over seven furlongs at the Curragh and won the Gr.1 Vincent O'Brien National Stakes on just his second start over the same course and distance a little over a month later. He was third to **St Mark's Basilica** in the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes on his third and final start at two and posted his best Timeform rating at three when second in the Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat.

He is out of the Moyglare Stud Farm's **Sadler's Wells** mare **Small Sacrifice**, a daughter the dam of the Listed winner **Table Rock** (**Fastnet Rock**). **Small Sacrifice** shares her grandam, the Gr.1 Irish 1,000 Guineas heroine **Trusted Partner** (**Affirmed**), with last year's European Champion Stayer and multiple Gr.1 winner **Kyprios**, the dual Gr.1 Irish St Leger winner **Search For A Song** (both by **Galileo**) and the dual Gr.1 winner and Irish National Stud-based sire **Free Eagle** (**High Chaparral**).

TORQUATOR TASSO


Adlerflug – Tijuana (Toylsome)

GESTÜT AUENQUELLE • Fee €20,000 1st Oct SLF

Torquator Tasso may have been an unconsidered 72/1 outsider when he won Europe's most prestigious race, the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, in 2021, but his performances both before and after that triumph, as well as his pedigree and the achievements of his Gr.1-winning younger half-brother, **Tunnes** (**Guiliani**), all suggest that he has a fine chance of replacing his much-missed sire **Adlerflug** (**In The Wings**) as one of the continent's top stallions.

Despite having cost just €24,000 as a yearling, he has a fine pedigree, featuring **Alya** and her full-sister **Allegretta**, dam of another Arc victor and supermare **Urban Sea**, on opposite sides of his ancestry. **Urban Sea** produced two all-time greats in **Galileo** and **Sea The Stars**. **Adlerflug** was an exceptional stallion, siring a number of top-class colts including **lquitos**, **Ito** and the Arc runner-up **In Swoop** not to mention the Gr.2 scorer **Tusked Wings**, who is a half-brother to **Torquator Tasso**'s dam, **Tijuana** (**Toylsome**).

His own Arc win aside, **Torquator Tasso**'s racing record was pretty impressive. Second to **In Swoop** in the Gr.1 Deutsches Derby, he got to within a head of becoming a dual Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Baden hero and arguably only a wide draw stopped him from registering a second Arc success rather than having to settle for third place.
