A'ALI

Society Rock – Motion Lass (Motivator)
NEWSELLS PARK STUD • Fee £5,000

The four-time Gr.2 winner **A'Ali** will stand his third season at Newsells Park Stud for £5,000 in 2024.

A £135,000 Goffs UK Breeze-Up purchase by Stroud Coleman Bloodstock, the son of **Society Rock** was awarded a Timeform rating of 98+ on debut at Ripon, despite finishing second. He made amends for that in no uncertain terms by landing the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes and Gr.2 Prix Robert Papin on his next two starts. Stretched by the combination of soft ground and the step up to 1200m when fifth in the Gr.1 Prix Morny, he ran out a decisive winner of the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes when returned to the minimum trip. As a three-year-old, he defeated his elders in both the Gr.3 Sprint Stakes at Sandown and the Curragh's Gr.2 Sapphire Stakes, before a fourth-place finish in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes.

Out of a half-sister to the Gr.3 Darley Stakes-winning sire **Enforcer** (**Efisio**; stood in Saudi Arabia as **Alfaisali**), who finished placed in both the Gr.1 Preis von Europa and Gr.1 Coronation Cup, **A'Ali's** first foals reached highs of 68,000gns, 67,000gns and 55,000gns in the sales ring last year, with a European average of £22,264 and median of £13,650 recorded for the sale of 15 of the 18 offered lots (83 per cent). Purchasers included Lynn Lodge Stud, Yeomanstown Stud, Stroud Coleman Bloodstock and Ballyhane Stud.

ACLAIM


Acclamation – Aris (Danroad)
MANTON PARK • Fee £8,000

Having left The National Stud at the end of 2022, **Aclaim** has been an exciting addition to the Manton Park roster.

His first crop included Gr.1 1,000 Guineas heroine **Cachet**, making him the first and only son of **Acclamation** to sire a British Classic winner. He also produced the Listed winners **Royal Aclaim** and **Purosangue**, who secured last year's Rockingham Stakes and made £125,000 at the 2023 Goffs UK Breeze-Up Sale. His progeny twice fetched over 200,000qns in 2022.

During his career, he won on seven separate occasions, at two, three and four, with the biggest win coming on his last ever appearance, in the Gr.1 Prix de la Foret. He was also placed in the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest, between two Gr.2 wins over 7f. Having won on a variety of going, and over 6f, 7f and 1m, he was the epitome of versatility.

He is out of the Listed-placed **Aris** (**Danroad**), a half-sister to the Gr.1 Irish 1,000 Guineas winner and Gr.1 Moyglare Stud Stakes winner **Again** (**Danehill Dancer**; dam of the Listed winner and dual Gr.1-placed **Delphinia** and the Listed-winning sire **Indian Maharaja**) and the Gr.3-placed **Arkadina** (**Danehill**; dam of the Gr.3 victrix **Guilty Twelve** and the Listed winner **Iltemas**). He is also from the family of the multiple Gr.1 winner and influential sire **Montjeu** (**Sadler's Wells**).

ADVERTISE

Showcasing – Furbelow (Pivotal)
MANTON PARK • Fee £10,000

Entering his fifth season at stud, the triple Gr.1 victor **Advertise** saw his progeny placed twice at Listed level in 2023, with his daughter **Serious Notions** third in the Listed Ingabelle Stakes and his son **Matters Most** runner-up in Ripon's Champion Two-Year-Old Trophy.

Advertise's yearlings have fetched an average of more than £43,000 over the last two years, while his son out of **Garden Row** made 125,000gns at last year's Tattersalls Craven Breeze-Up Sale.

His time on the racecourse not only encompassed three Gr.1 successes, in the Phoenix Stakes, Commonwealth Cup and Prix Maurice de Gheest, it also saw runner-up spots in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes (behind sire **Calyx**), the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes (where he finished behind the subsequent three-time Gr.1 winner and sire **Too Darn Hot**) and the Gr.1 July Cup, where he lost out to the unbeaten two-year-old and sire **Ten Sovereigns**.

His dam is a full-sister to the Listed winner **Red Diadem** (**Pivotal**) and a half-sister to the Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes fourth **Adorn** (**Kyllachy**). His third dam is the illustrious Gr.1 1,000 Guineas and Gr.1 Irish 1,000 Guineas runner-up **Heart Of Joy** (**Lypheor**), who also finished third in the Gr.1 Coronation Stakes and won the Gr.2 Palomar Handicap.



AMARON

Shamardal – Amandalini (Bertolini)
GESTÜT ETZEAN • Fee €4,500

Amaron (**Shamardal**) was a consistent, ultra-tough and classy Gr.1-winning miler who landed Pattern races in five consecutive seasons and is showing signs of passing on those attributes to his stock, judged by the exploits of his first five crops to reach racing age.

On the racecourse, the Andreas Löwe-trained **Amaron** was quick to show his hand, making a winning debut in a Cologne Listed race in July of his juvenile season and following up in the Gr.3 Zukunfts-Rennen at Baden-Baden a month later. As a three-year-old, he won Group races in both Germany and Italy and went within half a length of lifting the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains in France. French success, at Gr.3 level, did come at Saint-Cloud the following season, while his final start, in the Gr.2 Badener Meile in June 2015, brought him the eighth Pattern victory of a long career.

He has proved to be a strong addition to the German stallion ranks and enjoyed a fine 2023, becoming Champion Sire of Two-Year-Olds in Germany and producing five different black-type performers, headed by the Gr.3 winner **Aggenstein** and the Listed victrix **Valpolicella**.

By **Shamardal**, the sire of **Blue Point** and **Pinatubo** among many others, he is out of a half-sister to the US Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 runner-up **Persianlux** (**Persian Bold**).



ANGEL BLEU

Dark Angel – Cercle De La Vie (Galileo) **SUMBE •** Fee **€9.000**

Retired from racing after his four-year-old campaign closed with a run in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes, **Angel Bleu** stands for €9,000 at Sumbe's Haras de Montfort et Preaux.

His juvenile career encompassed a number of highlights and ended with him being crowned as France's Joint Champion Two-Year-Old. After posting two minor wins, his breakthrough effort saw him take second in Ascot's Listed Pat Eddery Stakes before racking up successes in Goodwood's Gr.2 Vintage Stakes, Longchamp's Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere and Saint-Cloud's Gr.1 Criterium International.

After running creditably in defeat in a three-year-old campaign that included outings in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes and the Gr.1 Sussex Stakes, **Angel Bleu** returned to the winner's enclosure at four, with victories in the Listed Spring Trophy Stakes and Gr.2 Celebration Mile.

By Dark Angel, he is out of the Galileo mare Cercle De La Vie, a full-sister to the seven-time Gr.1 winner and sire Highland Reel. Cercle De La Vie also counts the Gr.1 Caulfield Cup winner Cape Of Good Hope, the Gr.2 Hardwicke Stakes hero Idaho and the Gr.3 Ballysax Stakes victor Nobel Prize as full-brothers.

His second dam **Hveger** (**Danehill**) was placed at Gr.1 and Gr.2 level, while his great grandam is the Gr.1 Australian Oaks-winning **Circles Of Gold** (**Marscay**).




AWTAAD

Cape Cross – Asheerah (Shamardal)

DERRINSTOWN STUD • Fee €5,000

Classic winner **Awtaad** had a fine season at stud last year, siring two individual Gr.1 winners in the shape of Prix d'Ispahan victor **Anmaat**, as well as Del Mar Oaks and American Oaks heroine **Anisette**. Furthermore, his son **Al Qareem** added the Gr.3 Cumberland Lodge Stakes to his CV, after his Gr.2 Prix Chaudenay triumph in 2022, whilst **Diamil** landed a second career Gr.3 by winning the JRA Plate at Randwick. In his four crops of racing age so far, he has been responsible for siring 16 Stakes performers, a list which also includes Gr.3 Desmond Stakes winner **Create Belief**.

A son of top sire **Cape Cross**, Shadwell homebred **Awtaad** was trained by Kevin Prendergast to win five of his nine starts, a tally which began with a two-length maiden win as a two-year-old. He then won on his first three starts the following season, where he landed the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas in fine style, comfortably beating Newmarket Classic winner **Galileo Gold**. **Awtaad** then finished third behind that rival in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes, before winning the Gr.2 Boomerang Stakes at Leopardstown on his penultimate start. He is a half-brother to the Listed winner and Gr.3-placed **Mehnah** (**Frankel**) and the Gr.3-placed winner **Alghabrah** (**Tamayuz**), out of the Listed-placed winner **Asheerah** (**Shamardal**).



BANGKOK

Australia – Tanaghum (Darshaan)

CHAPEL STUD • Fee £3,000

The impeccably-bred **Bangkok** was a sound, durable and classy performer on the racecourse, and he won or finished placed in eight Stakes races. This is his third season at stud.

The winner of black-type races in his three, four and five-year-old seasons, he proved his versatility by winning on turf and all-weather, as well as in three different countries around the Arabian Gulf. After winning the Gr.3 Classic Trial on his second outing at three, he had a tilt at the Gr.1 Derby before finishing second in the Gr.2 King Edward VII Stakes at Royal Ascot. His longevity is underlined by the fact that his two Pattern victories, in the Classic Trial and the Gr.2 York Stakes, were achieved more than two years apart.

He is a half-brother to four Group or Listed winners, headed by the Gr.1 victor **Matterhorn** (**Raven's Pass**) and the dual Gr.2 winner **The Foxes** (**Churchill**). He is also a half-brother to the dam of the World Champion Three-Year-Old Miler and sire **Ribchester** (**Iffraaj**). His second dam, the Classic heroine **Mehthaaf** (**Nureyev**), was also a Champion Three-Year-Old before producing a Gr.2 winner, while his third dam, **Elle Seule** (**Exclusive Native**), won at Gr.2 level before producing nine other winners, including the two-time Champion Sprinter **Elnadim** (**Danzig**), the Gr.3 Nell Gwyn Stakes winner **Khulood** (**Storm Cat**) and the dam of two-time Gr.1 winner **Occupandiste**.

BATED BREATH

Dansili – Tantina (Distant View)

BANSTEAD MANOR STUD • Fee £10,000

Proven sire **Bated Breath** is standing at Juddmonte's Banstead Manor Stud for a 12th successive season.

The ultra-fast son of **Dansili** won his first three starts in impressive style, however, it was at four where he really shone. He got the better of future Gr.1 winner and sire **Society Rock** to win a conditions race in May, before landing the Listed Leisure Stakes at Windsor later that month. Four weeks later, he finished fifth in the Gr.1 Golden Jubilee Stakes and then stepped up to finish a close second behind **Dream Ahead** in the Gr.1 July Cup. He then finished just a nose behind that same rival in the Gr.1 Sprint Cup, and a month after that, finished a neck second in the Gr.1 Nearctic Stakes at Woodbine. He landed the Gr.2 Temple Stakes the following spring, before placing in Gr.1 company again, in both the King's Stand Stakes and the Sprint Cup.

A half-brother to Gr.1 winner and sire **Cityscape** and the sire of multiple Group performers, including Gr.1 heroine **Viadera** and Royal Ascot winners **Space Traveller** and **Daahyeh**, **Bated Breath**'s yearlings continue to fetch good prices at the sales, with his 2023 yearling average of £48,301 well above his covering fee. He is also responsible for a figure of 60 per cent winners to runners and a figure of ten per cent black-type horses to runners.

Lope De Vega – Danaskaya (Danehill)
BEARSTONE STUD • Fee £5,500

European Champion Two-Year-Old Colt **Belardo** (**Lope De Vega**) embarks on his second season at Bearstone Stud, following a successful six-year spell at Kildangan Stud, Ireland.

Winner of the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes as a two-year-old, runner-up in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes at three, and a Gr.1 winner again in the Lockinge Stakes at four, **Belardo** sired his first top-level winner last year when **Gold Phoenix** landed the Gr.1 Frank E Kilroe Mile at Santa Anita. A member of the sire's talented 2018-foaled first-crop, **Gold Phoenix** was building on the earlier triumphs of **Isabella Giles** in the Gr.2 Rockfel Stakes, **Lullaby Moon** in the Gr.3 Prix Miesque and **Elysium** in the Gr.3 Weld Park Stakes, while **Belardo** was also crowned Champion first-season sire in New Zealand whilst shuttling to Haunui Farm. Other notable runners include the Gr.2 San Clemente Stakes winner and Gr.1 Del Mar Oaks runner-up **Bellabel** and the Australasian Gr.3 winners **Belardo Boy** and **Verona**.

Belardo continues to prove commercially appealing, his yearling half-sister to last season's Gr.3 Prix de Conde winner **Shiffrin** realising €100,000 at the Arqana v2 Yearling Sale in August. He is a son of the juvenile winner and Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes third **Danaskaya** (**Danehill**) and a half-brother to the dual Scandinavian Gr.3 winner **Berling** (**Montjeu**).

BELBEK

Showcasing – Bee Queen (Makfi)

SUMBE • Fee €7,000

Home-bred by Nurlan Bizakov, **Belbek** (**Showcasing**) is an exciting acquisition to the stallion ranks for 2024. A descendant of one of the most exceptional broodmares of the last 50 years in the shape of **Hasili** (**Kahyasi**), who produced no less than five different Gr.1 winners on top of the Gr.2 hero and Champion Sire **Dansili**, he himself was a Champion Two-Year-Old who proved both his class and toughness throughout his two busy campaigns on the track.

Trained by Andre Fabre, **Belbek** was so precocious that his maestro handler deemed him ready for the racecourse in the early April of his juvenile season. Having got off the mark at the second attempt, he then landed the first French Pattern race on the two-year-old calendar, the Gr.3 Prix du Bois in June, before, three and a half months later, crowning his career with success in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere.

Arguably his best form came in three autumn starts during his Classic year: a close fifth in the Gr.1 Prix du Moulin, a third in the Gr.2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein, and finally, when proving how well he saw out 1600m when beating Gr.1 winner **The Revenant** (**Dubawi**) to land the Gr.3 Prix Perth on his final start.

He is the second foal of a half-sister to the Gr.3 winner **Sangarius** (**Kingman**) and his third dam is none other than the outstanding **Banks Hill** (**Danehill**), who won three Gr.1s before producing the Gr.1 heroine **Romantica** (**Galileo**).



BOBBY'S KITTEN

Kitten's Joy – Celestial Woods (Forestry)

LANWADES STUD • Fee £5,000

A son of US Champion Sire **Kitten's Joy**, who has sired the likes of Gr.1 heroes **Roaring Lion**, **Hawkbill** and **Kameko**, the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint victor **Bobby's Kitten** will see his fifth crop hit the track this year. Already the sire of the triple Gr.2 and Gr.3 winner **Sandrine**, Gr.2-placed winner **Monaasib** and the dual Gr.3-placed winner in the US **Kitty Kitana**, the 13-year-old offers European breeders an outcross sprinter/miler stallion at good value. In 2023, his winners included champion juveniles in Saudi Arabia (**Almotahed**) and Hungary (**Dark Blue Sky**).

A winner of six races at two, three and five years, as well as Graded Stakes at two and three, **Bobby's Kitten** was trained in the US by Chad Brown, winning two of his four starts as a juvenile and finishing third in the other two, including behind **Outstrip** in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. His victory at three in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint saw him beat Champion Two-Year-Old Sire **No Nay Never**. He raced on at five, landing the Listed Cork Stakes by eight and a half lengths for new trainer Dermot Weld.

He is a full-brother to the dual Gr.2 winner **Camelot Kitten** (successful sire in Brazil) and is out of the winning **Forestry** mare **Celestial Woods**, herself a half-sister to the dam of the Champion Stayer in Argentina and multiple Gr.1 victor **Sixties Song** and multiple Group winner **Celestial Candy**.

BUNGLE INTHEJUNGLE

Exceed And Excel – Licence To Thrill (Wolfhound)

RATHASKER STUD • Fee €7,500

Bungle IntheJungle starts the 2024 season buoyed by black-type success of his son **Givemethebeatboys**, who won last year's Gr.3 Marble Hill Stakes at the Curragh before finishing third in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes. His progeny also recorded three Listed wins last year, with victories from **II Sindacalista, Manhattan Jungle** and **Supereroe**.

The success of **Givemethebeatboys** follows top-level success in previous years, not least from his daughter **Winter Power**, who secured the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes in 2021. Other successes have come from **Rumble IntheJungle** (sire), who was third in the 2018 Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes, and the 2019 Gr.2 Lowther Stakes winner **Living In The Past**.

The son of **Exceed And Excel** racked up two Gr.3 successes in his two-year-old campaign, namely the Molecomb Stakes at Goodwood and the Cornwallis Stakes at Ascot, where he beat sire **Garswood** (**Dutch Art**). He contested the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes and Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes in his three-year-old campaign, and he narrowly missed the placings when fourth in the Gr.3 Sprint Stakes at Sandown. He is a full-brother to a Listed winner and a half-brother to the Gr.1 victor **Muarrab** (**Oasis Dream**) His second dam, **Crime Of Passion** (**Dragonara Palace**), won the Gr.3 Cherry Hinton Stakes and was placed in the Gr.1 (then) Prix Robert Papin.



CATURRA

Mehmas – Shoshoni Wind (Sleeping Indian)

OVERBURY STUD • Fee £5,000

The Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes hero **Caturra** will stand his second season at Overbury Stud for a reduced fee of £5,000.

A 110,000gns yearling purchase by Blandford Bloodstock from Tally-Ho Stud, who stand his high-flying sire **Mehmas**, **Caturra** shed his maiden tag at the second time of asking at Bath and, on the back of a midfield finish in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes, he won the Listed Rose Bowl Stakes at Newbury. A narrow victory in the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes, where he defeated the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed sire **Armor** (**No Nay Never**), was followed by a close-up fifth-place finish in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes. At three, he finished runner-up in the Gr.3 Prix Sigy and, taking on his elders, finished third in the Gr.2 King George Stakes at Goodwood's Glorious meeting.

He is a half-brother to the twice Listed-placed **Sir Arthur Dayne** (**Sir Prancealot**), out of the Listed Empress Stakes runner-up **Shoshoni Wind** (**Sleeping Indian**). This is the immediate family of the Gr.1 St Leger and Gr.1 Gold cup winner and sire **Classic Cliche** (**Salse**) and the Gr.1 Prix Vermeille and Gr.1 Yorkshire Oaks winner **My Emma** (**Marju**), as well as the Gr.1 National Stakes winner **Al Riffa** (**Wootton Bassett**) and last year's Gr.2 Beresford Stakes winner **Deepone** (**Study Of Man**).



CENTURY DREAM

Cape Cross – Salacia (Echo Of Light)
NORTON GROVE STUD • Fee £3,000

Talented miler **Century Dream** will stand his third season at Norton Grove Stud this year at an unchanged fee of £3,000, with his first crop now yearlings. Trained by Simon and Ed Crisford, his racing career spanned six seasons, during which he won ten races, including the Gr.2 Celebration Mile and the Gr.3 Diomed Stakes on two occasions. He also won as a juvenile before being placed in a further eight Group races over a mile, including in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes behind **Roaring Lion**. He beat horses such as Classic winner **Victor Ludorum** and multiple Gr.1 winners **Zaaki**, **Laurens**, **Addeybb** and **Rhododendron** during his career and accumulated earnings of over £545,000.

Bred by Rabbah Bloodstock Limited, he is by the top-class older miler and hugely successful sire of sires **Cape Cross** and is a half-brother to the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes hero and Classic-placed sire **King Of Change (Farhh)**, out of the winning **Echo Of Light** mare **Salacia**. She is a half-sister to several winners out of the Gr.3 winner and Gr.2-placed **Neptune's Bride (Bering)**, a half-sister to the Gr.2 scorer **Sea Dart (Diesis)**. Described as an "incredibly tough and consistent performer" by trainer Simon Crisford, he looks to be an exciting stallion on the roster at Norton Grove Stud with his first runners potentially just a year away.



CLOTH OF STARS

Sea The Stars – Strawberry Fledge (Kingmambo)

HARAS DU LOGIS • Fee €5,000

The high-class middle-distance performer Cloth Of Stars (Sea The Stars) had his first runners in 2022, and that initial crop was headed by Birr Castle, who last year registered two Listed victories and was placed in Gr.2 company behind the unbeaten European Champion Ace Impact (Cracksman). His 2021-born crop has already unearthed a pair of blacktype performers in **Dallas Star** and **Maymay**, while he has made a rapid impression in the hurdling sphere, with Max Of Stars and Apaniiwa both achieving Listed places.

Trained by Andre Fabre, **Cloth Of Stars** landed his first two starts as a two-year-old, including the Gr.3 Prix des Chenes, before finishing second in the Gr.1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud. A Gr.2 winner at three, he landed the Gr.1 Prix Ganay over 2100m at four and achieved career highs when placed in consecutive renewals of the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe.

He is bred on the same cross as two other exceptional sons of Sea The Stars: Baaeed and Hukum. His dam is a fullsister to the Gr.1 Oaks heroine **Light Shift** (dam of the dual Gr.1 winner and sire **Ulysses**) and a half-sister to the Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup victrix Shiva (Hector Protector), the dual Gr.2 scorer Limnos (Hector Protector) and the Listed winner and Gr.2-placed Burning Sunset (Caerleon). His third dam Northern Trick (Northern Dancer) won the Gr.1 Prix Vermeille and finished runner-up in the Arc.

Kodiac – Hazium (In The Wings)

RATHASKER STUD • Fee €5,500

Responsible for seven black-type performers so far, including the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup Stakes heroine Shantisara, the Group-winning sprinter Coulsty will stand for an upgraded €5,500 fee at Rathasker Stud this season.

His other leading progeny include the Gr.3 Princess Margaret Stakes victrix and Gr.2-placed Santosha, the Stakes winners Glenall, Sopran Aragorn and Suicide Squad, the Gr.3-placed Coulthard and the Listed-placed Coul Queen. His stock have also been in demand in the sales ring: the aforementioned **Shantisara** realised \$1.3m at the 2023 Fasig-Tipton November Sale, while he had yearlings sell for sums of €82,000, 65,000gns and 60,000gns last year.

On the track, the son of **Kodiac**, who descends from the family of the three-time Gr.1 winner and sire Mtoto (Busted), was a precocious juvenile and, after winning by five lengths on debut at Leicester over 5f, placed third in the Listed Prix Francois Boutin. He reappeared at three to win the Listed King Charles II Stakes at Newmarket over 7f and earned the biggest victory of his career later that season in the Gr.3 Prix de Meautry over 1200m at Deauville. As a four-year-old, he finished runner-up to Adaay (Kodiac; sire) in the Gr.2 Hungerford Stakes at Newbury over 7f, with the sire Cable Bay (Invincible Spirit) back in fourth.





Hat Trick – Rumored (Royal Academy)
HARAS DE MONTAIGU • Fee €4.000

Having stood his first two seasons at Gestüt Karlshof, before spending the next seven at Haras de Grandcamp, the dual Gr.1-winning juvenile **Dabirsim** will stand his second season at Haras de Montaigu in 2024.

A grandson of **Sunday Silence**, **Dabirsim**'s second career got off to the perfect start, with two Stakes-winning juveniles in his debut crop. **Different League**'s victory in the Gr.3 Albany Stakes, which was followed by placed efforts in the Gr.1 Prix Morny and Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes, announced her sire's capabilities. This, coupled with the exploits of Listed Prix Zeddaan winner **Coeur De Beaute**, who added the Gr.3 Prix Imprudence at three before her runner-up finish in the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, saw the **Hat Trick** horse's fee rise to €30,000. In 2023, the high-class **Horizon Dore** flew the flag for his sire, with victories in the Gr.3 Prix du Prince d'Orange and Gr.2 Prix Dollar, as well as a third-placed finish in the Gr.1 Champion Stakes, earning him a Timeform rating of 123. Given his sharp turn of foot and ability to handle testing conditions, **Horizon Dore** could make his mark at the highest level this year.

Dabirsim shares his grandam, the Gr.1 (then) Oaks d'Italia heroine **Bright Generation** (**Rainbow Quest**), with the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes-winning sire **Arizona** (**No Nay Never**), and hails from the family of the Gr.1 Irish Oaks and Gr.1 Yorkshire Oaks heroine **Sea Of Class** (**Sea The Stars**).



DAWN APPROACH

New Approach – Hymn Of The Dawn (Phone Trick)

REDMONDSTOWN STUD • Fee €5,000

The Classic-winning racehorse and Classic-producing sire **Dawn Approach** will once again stand for a €5,000 fee this season.

Top-class on the track, the son of **New Approach** was an unbeaten European Champion Two-Year-Old and, following initial victories at the Curragh over 5f and Naas over 6f, he notched up Stakes success in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes, defeating 21 rivals, the Gr.1 National Stakes, in which he pulled four and three-quarter lengths clear of his nearest pursuer, and finally in the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes, where he was eased down to a two and three-quarter-length triumph. At three, the Jim Bolger-trained chesnut impressively drew clear in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas to win by five lengths and, following a tilt at the Gr.1 Derby, returned to the 1m trip to land the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes at Royal Ascot, holding off the dual Gr.1 winner and sire **Toronado** (**High Chaparral**).

Dawn Approach has also tasted success as a sire and is responsible for the likes of the high-class **Poetic Flare**, who emulated his sire in winning the 2,000 Guineas and the St James's Palace Stakes and now stands at stud in Japan, the Australian Gr.1-winning sprinter **Paulele** and the Gr.2 Champions Juvenile Stakes winner and Derby runner-up **Madhmoon**, who stands at stud in France.


Soldier Hollow – Divya (Platini)

German Horse of the Year in 2017, **Dschingis Secret** relocated from Haras de Saint Arnoult to the nearby Haras de Montaigu for 2022, ahead of his first two-year-old crop hitting the track. His daughter **Dschingis Star** was runner-up in last year's Gr.3 Prix Minerve and his son **Dschingis King** was third Deauville's Listed Prix Michel Houyvet.

The Gr.1-winning son of leading German sire **Soldier Hollow** also comes from a solid German family and is a full-brother to four Group winners, including the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Deutsches Derby runner-up and sire **Destino**.

Trained by Markus Klug, he was placed over 1600m as a juvenile and ran well to be placed three times in Stakes company at three, including when third by half a length to Isfahan (Lord Of England) in the Gr.1 Deutsches Derby, before winning the Gr.3 St Leger Italiano. He then went from strength to strength, taking out two Gr.2s before his crowning moment in the Gr.1 Grosser Preis von Berlin, beating Hawkbill (Kitten's Joy). 
Roaring Lion – Beach Bunny (High Chaparral)

New to Manton Park in 2024 is the impeccably-bred Gr.1winning juvenile **Dubai Mile**.

Hailing from the only crop of the four-time Gr.1 winner Roaring Lion, Dubai Mile was highly-progressive in five juvenile starts, with novice victories at Windsor and Kempton preceding a runner-up finish in behind **The Foxes** (**Australia**) in the Gr.2 Royal Lodge Stakes. His dam Beach Bunny (High Chaparral), who won the Listed Dance Design Stakes and was narrowly denied by Dar Re Mi (Singspiel) in the Gr.1 Pretty Polly Stakes, is out of Miss Hawai (Peintre Celebre), an unraced half-sister to the Gr.1 1,000 Guineas heroine Miss France (Dansili). Dubai Mile's third dam is the Wildenstein-owned Gr.1 Prix Marcel Boussac winner Miss Tahiti (Tirol), who was placed a further three times at the highest level.


Havana Gold – Showstoppa (Showcasing)

CULWORTH GROUNDS FARM • Fee £6,000

There is a significant new stallion farm in Britain this year, as Culworth Grounds in Northamptonshire will stand the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes winner El Caballo.

Runner-up on debut to subsequent Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes winner and sire Armor (No Nay Never), the high-class son of Havana Gold then ran up a sequence of six consecutive victories, which culminated in victory in the Sandy Lane Stakes, and included wins in both the Listed Spring Cup Stakes and the valuable Three-Year-Old All-Weather Championships Stakes. A high draw thwarted his chance in the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup on his final start of the season, though he returned to the track as a four-year-old, with his best effort a third-place finish in the Gr.3 John of Gaunt Stakes over 7f, a race in which he was continually denied a clear run.

Just the second son of Havana Gold to retire to stud - the other being Whitsbury Manor Stud's Havana Grey - El Caballo's career-high rating of 112 puts him just one pound behind his contemporary. A full-brother to last year's Gr.2 Lowther Stakes third **Symbology**, he is a half-brother to the Italian Listed winner Avengers Queen (Brazen Beau), out of Showstoppa (Showcasing), a four-time winning halfsister to the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes winner and sire Temple Meads (Avondale) and the Gr.3 Firth of Clyde Stakes-placed Sneak Preview (Monsieur Bond).



EL KABEIR

Scat Daddy – Great Venue (Unbridled's Song)

RAZZA DELL'ORSO • Fee €6,000

Proven sire El Kabeir has made the short move to Razza dell'Orso in central Italy this year, having stood his first season in that country in 2023 and his first five years at Yeomanstown Stud in Ireland.

The son of **Scat Daddy** was a high-class dirt miler on the racecourse in the US, winning the Gr.2 Kentucky Jockey Club Stakes at the end of his two-year-old campaign, before easily landing the Gr.3 Jerome Stakes in his first week as a threeyear-old and then winning the Gr.3 Gotham Stakes in March. He followed that effort up with a fine third behind triple Gr.1 winner and future sire Frosted (Tapit) in the Gr.1 Wood Memorial Stakes three weeks later.

El Kabeir is responsible for 11 Stakes performers from his first three crops of racing age, including last year's Gr.2 Duke of York Stakes winner Azure Blue, Gr.2 Gran Criterium winner **Don Chicco**, Listed winner, Gr.2 Superlative Stakes runner-up and Gr.1 Derby fourth Masekela, Listed Two-Year-Old Trophy winner **Dragon Leader** and the Gr.1 Fillies' Mile-placed **Bright Diamond**. From a well related family, he is out of the **Unbridled's Song** mare **Great Venue**, who is a daughter of the Stakes victrix and eight-time winner Rose Colored Lady (Formal Dinner) and a half-sister to multiple US Stakes winners, headed by the dual Gr.2 victor and Gr.1 Hopeful Stakes-placed sire Too Much Bling (Rubiano).

A winner in Spain and Gr.2-placed in France as a two-yearold, the son of **Acclamation** won the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes on his final start for Mauricio Delcher Sanchez at three, before landing the same race for Barry Hills as a five-yearold. Other highlights included a win in the Gr.3 Palace House Stakes, as well as a narrow second in the Gr.1 July Cup. He went on to develop a strong reputation as an affordable speed influence during a ten-year stint at Newsells Park Stud, providing the triple Gr.1 hero The Tin Man, the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint heroine **Belvoir Bay** and the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1-placed Equilateral, amongst 20 Stakes winners. After six years at Hill 'n' Dale Farms in Kentucky, **Flintshire** moved to Haras de Montaigu for the 2022 covering season. He has enjoyed some fine results of late: his dual Gr.3 winner **Surge Capacity** landed the Gr.1 Matriarch Stakes in California in December, while he produced three winners in a four-day spell in early February. Also, **Freddy Flintshire** was Gr.1 hurdle-placed at Saratoga last July.

Trained by Andre Fabre, **Flintshire** proved himself a topclass performer from the outset, landing the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris on just his fourth start. Twice runner-up in Europe's most prestigious race, the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, he was that continent's Champion Older Horse of 2014. He also had some superb results in the US, where he was Champion Turf Male in 2016 and won three more Gr.1 races, and in the Far East, where he landed the Gr.1 Hong Kong Vase.

He hails from an exceptional Juddmonte family. Out of the Gr.2 heroine and Gr.1 Prix de Diane runner-up **Dance Routine** (**Sadler's Wells**), he is a full-brother to the dual Listed winner **Dance Moves** and a half-brother to the dam of the dual Gr.2-winner and sire **Headman** (**Kingman**). His grandam **Apogee** (**Shirley Heights**) was successful at Gr.3 level and produced the Listed-winning dam of the dual Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe heroine **Enable** (**Nathaniel**).

Dubawi – Ouija Board (Cape Cross)

OVERBURY STUD • Fee £2,000


Commencing his sixth season at stud, the Gr.1 Coronation Cup runner-up saw his son **Asian Daze** secure two victories in Ireland last year, while his daughter **Miss Dolly Rocker** became a dual winner in the UK. In 2023, his daughter out of **Rosita Bay** sold for £37,000 at the Goffs UK January Sale.

His second dam, **Selection Board** (**Welsh Pageant**), is a full-sister to the Gr.1 Arlington Million Stakes winner **Teleprompter**.

Lethal Force – Entreat (Pivotal) **SUMBE** • Fee **€6,000**

Gr.1-winning sprinter Golden Horde has been well received in his first few years at stud. His yearling colt out of **La Bouille** sold for €65,000 at Book 2 of last year's Argana August Yearling Sale, serving as a case in point that the sire offers excellent value.

A son of dual Gr.1 winner **Lethal Force**, he was guick off the mark at two, winning his second start by four and a half lengths. He gained his first Group success when triumphing in the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes, before recording two placed efforts behind Earthlight (Shamardal), in the Gr.1 Prix Morny and the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes, and was beaten only a neck in the latter. Even better was to come at three, when he made his seasonal debut in the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup. He took the lead at the halfway stage and powered home to score by a length and a half. He rounded off his career with two more placed efforts in top-class company, finishing third in both the Gr.1 July Cup and the Gr.1 Sprint Cup.

He is a half-brother to the Listed winners **Exhort** (**Dutch** Art) and Line Of Departure (Mehmas), out of the winning **Pivotal** mare **Entreat**, herself a half-sister to the multiple Group winner **Producer** (**Dutch Art**), who is a half-sister to the five-time Gr.1-winning Serena's Song (Rahy), the dam of Gr.1 Coronation Stakes winner Sophisticat and two Gr.2 winners.

Cape Cross – Fleche D'Or (Dubai Destination)

OVERBURY STUD • Fee £10,000

Golden Horn relocated to Overbury Stud last season, having spent the previous seven years at Dalham Hall Stud. His progeny racked up a stellar set of Group victories in 2023.

Bred by Anthony Oppenheimer, the son of Cape Cross won his only start at two before winning four Gr.1 races at three, including the Derby and Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. He finished the year as Champion Three-Year-Old Colt in Europe.

He is the sire of last year's Gr.2 Queen's Vase hero Gregory, Gr.2 Derby Italiano victor Goldenas, Gr.2 Champions Long Distance Cup winner **Trawlerman** and Gr.3-winning fouryear-old Caius Chorister. He had previously produced the Gr.2 winner and dual Gr.1-placed Botanik, and the Listed winner Haskoy, who finished second in the Gr.1 St Leger before being demoted. His best progeny in the National Hunt sphere include Gr.2 Leamington Novices' Hurdle winner Stag Horn, Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 Tolworth Novices' Hurdle third **Nemean Lion** and Gr.3 Gerry Feilden Handicap Hurdle winner First Street.

He is from a family saturated in black type, being out of Fleche D'Or (Dubai Destination), a half-sister to the Gr.1 Coronation Stakes heroine Rebecca Sharp (Machiavellian), the Gr.3 winner Mystic Knight (Caerleon) and the Listed winner and dual Gr.2-placed Hidden Hope (Daylami; dam of the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 Oaks-placed Frankly Darling).

Two more Gr.1-placed efforts followed at three, in the St James's Palace Stakes and the Prix Jean Prat. He then won the Gr.3 Diomed Stakes at four, before finishing third in the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes and beating **Soft Falling Rain** to win the Gr.2 Hungerford Stakes. He would go on to place in another four Group races, including in the Gr.1 July Cup, whilst he also won the Gr.3 Criterion Stakes.

His yearlings have fetched up to 115,000gns and he is the sire of multiple Stakes performers, headed by the Gr.2 victrix **Plainchant** (490,000gns 2022 Tattersalls December Mare Sale), US Gr.3 winner and Gr.2-placed **Gregorian Chant** and Gr.3 winner **Queen Jo Jo**, who placed in both the Gr.2 Lowther Stakes and Gr.2 City of York Stakes. A full-brother to the Listed-placed winner and Gr.1 1,000 Guineas fourth **Manderley** and a half-brother to the Australian Stakes winner **Naval Warfare** (**Born To Sea**), he is from the family of the Gr.2 Celebration Mile winner and dual Gr.1-placed **Premio Loco**.

DALHAM HALL STUD • Fee £10,000

Dual Gr.1 winner and Champion Sprinter **Harry Angel** has had an impressive start to his stallion career.

From two crops of racing age, the son of **Dark Angel** is already responsible for siring a Gr.1 winner, courtesy of Spring Champion Stakes hero **Tom Kitten**. He has sired a further 14 Stakes performers, including Gr.2 winner **Stretan Angel**, the Gr.3 winner and dual Gr.2-placed **Marshman** and the Gr.3-winning sprinter **Al Dasim**. He had the best strike rate of any stallion with 20+ juvenile winners in 2023, siring 50 per cent winners to runners.

Harry Angel broke his maiden tag in the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes on his second start as a juvenile, before winning the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes in impressive style at three. He then finished second on his Gr.1 debut in the Commonwealth Cup, behind Caravaggio and ahead of four-time Gr.1 winner Blue Point, before reversing that form to win the Gr.1 July Cup, and following that effort up with a four-length victory in the Gr.1 Sprint Cup. His son **Wootton Bassett** sits at the top of the sire's Gr.1 progeny achievements, standing at Coolmore for €200,000 in 2024. On the racecourse, meanwhile, the Gr.1-placed **My Prospero** recently delivered **Iffraaj** with Gr.2 success when he ran to victory in the 2022 Prix Eugene Adam, while **Audience** ran to success in last year's Gr.3 Criterion Stakes at Newmarket. He is also responsible for the Gr.1 winner and sire **Ribchester** and the Gr.2 winner and sire **Hot Streak**.

Victorious on his second and final outing at two, **Iffraaj** ran once at three. He was the winner of four races as a four-year-old, including the Gr.2 Park Stakes over 7f at Doncaster. A five-year-old campaign saw him claim the runner-up spot in the Gr.1 July Cup, before he signed off with back-to-back Gr.2 successes, with victory in the Lennox Stakes and once again the Park Stakes.

Standing for his fifth season at Yeomanstown Stud, the topclass sprinter **Invincible Army** enjoyed a fine year with his first runners last season, with his daughter **Kitty Rose** winning the Listed Ingabelle Stakes before finishing second in the Gr.3 Silken Glider Stakes at the Curragh.

Trained by James Tate, the son of **Invincible Spirit** broke his maiden as a two-year-old, running away from the field to win by five lengths over 6f. Later that season, he won the Gr.3 Sirenia Stakes at Kempton before confirming his promise at three, when he won the Gr.3 Pavilion Stakes at Ascot, defeating **Eqtidaar** (also by **Invincible Spirit**, and now a sire) in the process. He won three further Stakes races at four, including the Gr.2 Duke of York Stakes, before going on to finish third in the Gr.1 Flying Five Stakes, where he beat Gr.1 heroine **Mabs Cross** and fellow sire **Soldier's Call**.

In the sales ring, **Invincible Army**'s yearlings caught plenty of attention last year, with his half-brother to Gr.1 heroine **Lezoo**, out of Gr.3 victrix **Roger Sez**, realising 145,000gns. Out of the Gr.1 Falmouth Stakes heroine **Rajeem** (**Diktat**), he is a full-brother to the Listed winner and Gr.3-placed **New York City**. The family also includes the Gr.1 Prix Morny heroine **Hoh Magic** (**Cadeaux Genereux**) and the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1-placed sire **Crimson Beau** (**High Line**).

Galileo – Shastye (Danehill)

Group-winning two-year-old and dual Gr.1 winner Japan retired to stud in 2022. The son of **Galileo** is a full-brother to dual Gr.1 winner Mogul, Gr.3 winner Sir Isaac Newton and Gr.2 scorer and Gr.1-placed Secret Gesture, and is the highest-rated offspring out of **Shastye** (**Danehill**).

Trained by Aidan O'Brien, he won the Gr.2 Beresford Stakes on his third start. He was only beaten by half a length when finishing third in the Gr.1 Derby, then registered a four and a half-length victory in the Gr.2 King Edward VII Stakes, before landing two Gr.1s on the bounce in the Grand Prix de Paris and the Juddmonte International Stakes, beating Champion Crystal Ocean (Sea The Stars). He finished that season with a fourth place in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. He raced on at four and five, collecting the Gr.3 Ormonde Stakes and Gr.3 Meld Stakes, as well as being placed a further six times in Gr.1 company.

Bred by Newsells Park Stud, he was purchased by MV Magnier for 1,300,000gns at Tattersalls October Yearling Sale Book 1. Rated 122, he was one point ahead of his brother **Mogul**, who also won the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris as well as taking the Gr.1 Hong Kong Vase before retiring to Coolmore's Beeches Stud. His second dam Saganeca (Sagace) was the Champion Older Mare in Italy and produced the Gr.1-winning sires Sagamix (Linamix) and Sagacity (Highest Honor).

On the track, the son of **No Nay Never** was a precocious two-year-old and, after shedding his maiden tag over 6f at the Curragh, comfortably landed the Listed Tipperary Stakes by two lengths. His next assignment came in the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes at Goodwood over 6f, where he defeated Marie's Diamond (Footstepsinthesand) to earn a maiden Group victory. Other juvenile efforts included a third in the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes at Royal Ascot over the minimum trip and a creditable fourth when stepped up to the highest level in the Gr.1 Prix Morny.

Out of the Gr.3-winning Rock Of Gibraltar mare Theann, he is a half-brother to the dual US Gr.1 heroine Photo Call (Galileo), from the high-class family of Gr.1 winners Halfway To Heaven, Magical, Rhododendron and Auguste Rodin, as well as the sire Verglas.

Beginning his third season at The National Stud is the multiple Gr.1-placed Lope Y Fernandez, who will be available to breeders for a fee of £8,500 this year. An impressive individual, he had MV Magnier reaching for €900,000 at the Argana August Yearling Sale.

High-class on the track, the son of Lope De Vega was a stylish debut winner at the Curragh for Ballydoyle and the Coolmore partners, before finding only the European Champion Two-Year-Old Pinatubo (Shamardal) too good in the Listed Chesham Stakes at Royal Ascot. After a thirdplace finish in the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes, he regained the winning thread in the Gr.3 Round Tower Stakes over 6f at the Curragh. At three, he earned podium finishes in all of the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas, Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat, Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest and the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Mile, while he returned at four to land the Listed Heritage Stakes and earn another Gr.1-placed effort, this time in the Queen Anne Stakes when runner-up to Palace Pier (Kingman).

The half-brother to **Dark Vision** (**Dream Ahead**) has made a promising start to life at stud and his first foals were well received last year. Five of his offerings sold for more than 30,000gns at the Tattersalls December Foal Sale, led by a pair of colts that realised 100,000gns and 78,000gns respectively.

New Approach – Halla Na Saoire (Teofilo)

IRISH NATIONAL STUD • Fee €8,000

A new recruit to the Irish National Stud for 2024 is the Classic winner **Mac Swiney**, who will cover his first mares at a fee of €8,000.

The son of **New Approach** broke his maiden at the second attempt over 7f at the Curragh in July of 2020, before beating the likes of Jessica Harrington's Cadillac (Lope De Vega) and Aidan O'Brien's subsequent Gr.1 winner Van Gogh (American Pharoah) in August's Gr.2 Futurity Stakes over the same course and distance. He finished his two-year-old season with a hard-fought victory in the Gr.1 Futurity Trophy Stakes over 1m at Doncaster, defeating the likes of the triple Gr.1 winner State Of Rest (Starspangledbanner) in the process. At three, Mac Swiney added a second Gr.1 victory to his resume when he outbattled his high-class stablemate Poetic Flare (Dawn Approach) in the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas, etching his name in Classic history in the process A fourth-place finish in the Gr.1 Derby followed, before a fine effort in the Gr.1 Champion Stakes, where he ran third behind Sealiway (Galiway).

A Jim Bolger homebred, he is out of an unraced full-sister to the Gr.2 Derby Trial Stakes winner and Gr.1 Irish Derby-placed sire **Light Heavy** (**Teofilo**), and a half-sister to the winning dam of Bolger's Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes hero and sire **Parish Hall** (**Teofilo**).

Make Believe has seen eight more of his Group and Listed progeny win on the racecourse, headed by the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed Believe In Love. His other standard bearers include fellow Gr.3 winners Rose Of Kildare, Noticeable Grace, Self Belief and Ocean Fantasy, who has also placed in Gr.2 company.

In the past five years, his yearlings have been knocked down for an average of over €29,000, while his breeze-up graduates have yielded an average of over €44,000, spearheaded by the sale of his filly out of **Suraat**, who was knocked down for €170,000 to Nick Bell and Middleham Park Racing at last year's Tattersalls Goresbridge Breeze-Up Sale.

The son of **Makfi** has a strong pedigree, as he is closely related to the US Gr.1 winner **Dubawi Heights** and his dam is a half-sister to the Gr.1-winning sprinter **Tante Rose**. His performances on the track bore out those bloodlines: he won four of his seven starts and landed the Gr.1 Prix de la Foret over 7f, having previously proved his ability to stay a mile with a three-length romp in the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains.

Marie's Diamond will be the first stallion to stand at Ciarán De Barra's Diamond Stud Bellewstown.

The son of **Footstepsinthesand** won three times as a juvenile, spearheaded by a win in the Gr.3 Anglesey Stakes when he defeated subsequent Gr.1 scorer **Viadera**, in the fastest time posted by a colt since 1995. This win was flanked by narrow defeats in both the Gr.2 Railway Stakes and the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes. He also finished fourth in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes at Newmarket and showed an affinity for the Rowley Mile course throughout his career, particularly when he defeated his nine rivals in record time in the Listed Paradise Stakes. True to form, the hard-knocking colt was in action just 11 days later when taking third place behind **Circus Maximus** in the 2020 renewal of the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes at Royal Ascot, finishing ahead of Gr.1 winners **Accidental Agent** (**Delegator**) and **Mohaather** (**Showcasing**).

His dam **Sindiyma** is a full-sister to the Listed winner **Sindirana**, herself the dam of dual Listed victor **Sirrin** (**Sea The Stars**) and the grandam of the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed **Sonaiyla** (**Dark Angel**). His third dam, **Sinntara** (**Lashkari**), won a Listed race at the Curragh before producing nine winners from 11 runners. They are headed by the Gr.1 Derby, Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and Gr.1 Irish Derby hero, champion and sire **Sinndar**.


Duke Of Marmalade – Capriolla (In The Wings)

NORTON GROVE STUD • Fee £2,000

After first retiring to Haras du Grand Courgeon, Gr.1 Melbourne Cup second **Marmelo** moved to his current Yorkshire home in 2022.

He began his racing career as a three-year-old, when he was placed in a series of Listed and Group contests, including the Gr.2 Prix Chaudenay. The Hughie Morrison charge reappeared at four, claiming victory in the Gr.3 Prix de Barbeville and second in the Gr.2 Prix Maurice de Nieuil. His subsequent start saw success in the Gr.2 Prix Kergorlay, when he romped home one and a quarter lengths clear. The globetrotter recorded another Gr.2 second at five, before a Listed success at York, another Gr.2 success in France and his signature second in the Melbourne Cup. Returning to Europe for his six-year-old campaign, he racked up a Gr.2 second and two Group victories, winning the Gr.3 John Porter Stakes and the Prix Kergorlay for a second time. His second Prix Kergorlay victory was his final start.

He is a half-brother to the Gr.3 victor **Vent De Force** (**Hurricane Run**) and the Italian Gr.3 steeplechase winner **Atalan** (**Azamour**). His second dam, **Seren Quest** (**Rainbow Quest**), also produced Gr.3 victor **Saddler's Quest** (**Saddlers' Hall**) and two Listed winners, while his third dam, **Serenesse** (**Habat**), is an Italian Listed winner.



MASAR

New Approach – Khawlah (Cape Cross)

DALHAM HALL STUD • Fee £10,000

The 2018 Gr.1 Derby winner **Masar** will stand at '10k and under' for the first time in 2024.

The son of **New Approach** boasts a rare mix of precocity, stamina and pedigree, being inbred 3 x 4 to the brilliant racemare and outstanding producer **Urban Sea** (**Miswaki**), dam of **Galileo** (**Sadler's Wells**) and **Sea The Stars** (**Cape Cross**), and quick enough to win first time out over 6f as a juvenile. Other highlights at two included a win in the Gr.3 Solario Stakes over 7f, defeating the future Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas winner **Romanised** (**Holy Roman Emperor**), and a third in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere. He continued to demonstrate his versatility at three, winning the Gr.3 Craven Stakes and taking third in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas over 1m, before enjoying his finest hour when beating the likes of **Roaring Lion** (**Kitten's Joy**) and **Saxon Warrior** (**Deep Impact**) in the Gr.1 Derby over 1m4f at Epsom.

Commencing stallion duties at Dalham Hall Stud in 2020, Masar's promising first crop appeared last year and featured Will Scarlet, runner-up to the subsequent Gr.3 winner Zabiari (Wootton Bassett) before winning at Longchamp, Golden West, who gained automatic entry for the Gr.1 Derby when winning at Epsom in October, plus the unbeaten trio Path To Dubai, Bajan Blue and Prince Rasam.

MASSAAT

Teofilo – Madany (Acclamation)
MICKLEY STUD • Fee £3.000

The first crop of two-year-olds by the Classic-placed Gr.2 winner Massaat (Teofilo) hit the track in 2022 and it was not long before he was able to call himself a Stakes stallion, Mascapone following up a comfortable maiden success with a third-placed finish in the Listed Pat Eddery Stakes at Ascot in July. His other standard bearer from his initial cohort was Coco Jamboo, who won the prestigious and valuable Jersey Lily Nursery and went on to fetch 160,000gns at the Tattersalls December Mare Sale the following year. On the track in 2023, his son Mas Rapido made waves in California, including when finishing second in the US black type John Shear Stakes. At public auction last year, Massaat's yearlings fetched up to 26,000gns while the top price achieved by one of his foals was 20,000gns.

A Shadwell homebred, **Massaat** won on his second start at two and then finished second to **Air Force Blue** in the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes. He returned at three to run second to **Galileo Gold** in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, but didn't stay in the Gr.1 Derby. Dropped back to 7f the following year, he was an impressive winner of the Gr.2 Hungerford Stakes and was also placed in the Gr.1 Prix du Moulin and Gr.2 Challenge Stakes. After 11 seasons at Cheveley Park, Mayson has been sold to his breeder, David Armstrong. The Gr.1 July Cup victor, responsible for dual Gr.1-wining **Oxted**, will take up duties at Springfield House Stud this season.

Breaking his maiden on his second attempt at two, the son of **Invincible Spirit** was twice placed in Listed contests at three. This included claiming a runner-up spot in the Listed Wentworth Stakes, before his four-year-old season opened with another Listed placing, when he finished third in the Cammidge Trophy at Doncaster. It was at four that he recorded his career highlights, beginning with back-to-back victories in the Listed (then) Abernant Stakes, by three and a half lengths, and the Gr.3 Palace House Stakes a month later. His Gr.1 success came later that season, before he ended his time on the racecourse with a second in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye, beaten just a neck.

In addition to **Oxted**, other highlights of **Mayson**'s stallion career include the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes winner and Gr.1placed Rohaan and the Gr.3 EBF Athasi Stakes victrix and Gr.2-placed Honey Girl, while he has sired ten Stakes winners and 29 black-type performers overall.

New to Norton Grove Stud for 2024 is the UAE Gr.3 winner **Midnight Sands**, an impeccably-bred son of the sire of sires **Speightstown**, who retired last year as the winner of six of his 17 starts for career earnings in excess of £300,000.

A €90,000 private purchase at the Arqana May Breeze-Up Sale, **Midnight Sands** initially went into training in Britain and was highly-regarded enough to run in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot on just his second start. However, it was only after joining multiple UAE Champion Trainer Doug Watson, and having his attention switched to dirt, that the now eight-year-old really found his niche. He opened his account by four lengths in a 1200m maiden at Meydan as a three-year-old, and went on to win his next four starts and rocket up the ratings. A brief sojourn in the US followed, before he returned to the care of Watson to win the 1600m Gr.3 Burj Nahaar on 'Super Saturday' at Meydan in March 2021, defeating no less than eight current or future Graded winners in the process.

One of just two sons of the highly influential dirt and turf stallion **Speightstown** at stud in Britain, **Midnight Sands** is a half-brother to the US Gr.3 winner **Tusk** (**Tapit**), out of the Listed Prix Coronation winner **It's Midnight** (**Shamardal**).

The National Stud's stallion ranks have been boosted by the arrival of triple Gr.2 winner **Mutasaabeq**, a well-bred son of the leading sire of sires **Invincible Spirit**.

The winner of a 7f Newmarket novice on his only appearance at two, **Mutasaabeq** went on to finish seventh in the 2021 Gr.1 2,000 Guineas behind **Poetic Flare** (**Dawn Approach**), but it was not until the following year that he truly blossomed. Something of a Rowley Mile specialist, he made a big-race breakthrough when making all in the Gr.2 Joel Stakes over 1m at Newmarket in September 2022, before repeating the tactics to beat the European Champion Two-Year-Old and Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas winner **Native Trail** (**Oasis Dream**) in the Gr.2 Sandown Mile (relocated to Newmarket) at the beginning of last season. A repeat success in the Joel Stakes followed on his final start.

Mutasaabeq's status as a formerly 120-rated multiple Group race winner is only part of his appeal, however, as the Shadwell homebred hails from a family of almost unrivalled excellence. He is the best runner out of the 2009 Gr.1 1,000 Guineas heroine **Ghanaati** (**Giant's Causeway**), a half-sister to the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed sire **Mawatheeq** (**Danzig**) and the Listed winner and Gr.1 Oaks third **Rumoush** (**Rahy**). His third dam is the outstanding **Height Of Fashion** (**Bustino**; dam of **Nashwan**, **Nayef** and **Unfuwain**).



NANDO PARRADO

Kodiac – Chibola (Roy)

IRISH NATIONAL STUD • Fee €6,000

Classy juvenile **Nando Parrado** will stand for an unchanged fee during his third year of stallion duties at the Irish National Stud. Highlights from his first crop of foals are half-siblings to the Gr.2 winner **Jack Darcy** (**Gleneagles**) and the Gr.3 heroine **Lola Showgirl** (**Night Of Thunder**), plus half-siblings to the Listed victors **Dream Eater** (**Night Shift**) and **Wealth Of Love** (**Dragon Pulse**).

A 165,000gns foal, he was sent into training with Clive Cox and broke his maiden at Royal Ascot in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes over 6f on his second start. He proved that this was no fluke, finishing second in the Gr.1 Prix Morny before stepping up in trip to finish runner-up again, this time in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere at Longchamp. He was rated higher than both his sire, and a second son of **Kodiac**, **Ardad**, who has already produced the likes of the triple Gr.1 winner **Perfect Power**.

Fresh from covering 119 mares in his first season at Kildangan Stud in Ireland, the Gr.1-winning sprinter **Naval Crown** will be available to breeders for a fee of €10,000 this year.

A smart performer at two, the son of **Dubawi** finished third in two Gr.3 contests, including when running Go Athletico and Sealiway to a length and a neck in the Gr.3 Prix La Rochette. He began his three-year-old season by winning the Listed Meydan Classic, before finishing a neck second to **Tactical** in the Listed European Free Handicap at Newmarket. He followed up by finishing a creditable fourth in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas and then second in the Gr.3 Jersey Stakes behind Creative Force. The colt had a positive start to his four-year-old career, winning the Gr.2 Al Fahidi Fort and finishing fourth in the Gr.1 Al Quoz Sprint, before returning to British soil, where he produced the finest result of his career. This came in the Gr.1 Platinum Jubilee Stakes at Royal Ascot. where he beat no less than 11 Gr.1 winners, including Highfield Princess, Kinross, Alcohol Free, Campanelle and Minzaal. He followed up by finishing second to the aforementioned Alcohol Free in the Gr.1 July Cup.

He is the first foal out of the Stakes-winning **Dansili** mare **Come Alive**, who is a daughter of the Gr.2-placed juvenile **Portrayal** (**Saint Ballado**). His extended family includes the Gr.2 winner and sire **Wareed**.

Pearl Secret (Compton Place) retired to stud at the end of the 2016 season and, having initially been stationed at Chapel Stud, he moved to Norton Grove Stud where he is about to start his fourth covering season.

He is the sire of 44 per cent winners to runners, including the 97-rated sprinter **Designer** and **Tears Of A Clown**, who secured a third-placed success in the Listed St Hugh's Stakes at Newbury last August.

His pedigree means that he offers a rare opportunity to use a stallion with no **Northern Dancer** blood in its first four generations. He is out of the **Rossini** mare **Our Little Secret**, who won six races including the Listed City Wall Stakes and produced four other winners, including the dam of the Listed heroine **Cuban Mistress** (**Havana Grey**) plus the unraced dam of the Gr.3-placed **Ehraz** (**Showcasing**). It is a family all about speed, running back to the prolific Stakes-winning siblings **Palacegate Episode**, **Palacegate Jack** and **Another Episode**, and the dual Gr.1-winning sire **Dutch Art**.

On the track **Pearl Secret** scored on his juvenile debut and went on to prove his talent and durability over five more seasons, winning the Gr.2 Temple Stakes as well as two Listed races. He was also placed in the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes at Royal Ascot.

The son of **Ardad**, and grandson of **Kodiac**, was one of Europe's leading two-year-olds in 2021. His first big win came at Royal Ascot when getting up on the line to deny **Go Bears Go** in the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes and, although he was below par at Goodwood next time out, he bounced back to win the Gr.1 Prix Morny under Christophe Soumillon, who would become his regular partner. Signing off his debut season a month later, he added his second top-flight win in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes at Newmarket. Sent down the Classic route at three, he won the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes, but finished mid-division in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, before returning to sprinting and winning the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup, his second victory at the Royal Meeting.

He is out of **Sagely** (**Frozen Power**), a half-sister to the Listed-placed **Sagaciously** (**Lawman**; dam of the Listed winner and Gr.3-placed **Epic Poet**). The third dam **Saga D'Ouilly** (**Linamix**) is a half-sister to the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner and sire **Sagamix** and the Gr.1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud winner and sire **Sagacity**, and this is also the family of Gr.1 winners and sires **Sageburg**, **Japan** and **Mogul.**

Although this was his last victory on the track, he maintained high-class form throughout the season and placed in all of the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes, Gr.1 Prix Morny, where he was beaten just half a length by Blackbeard, and the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes, as well as a fourth-placed finish in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint at Keeneland to conclude his career.

With his son **Haatem** victorious in last year's Gr.2 Vintage Stakes at Goodwood, **Phoenix Of Spain** will enter his fifth year at stud in Kildare buoyed by black-type success from his progeny.

His yearlings sold for an average of £24,787 in 2023, far outweighing his stud fee, and alongside **Haatem**, whose two-year-old season also saw him come home second in the Gr.2 Superlative Stakes at Newmarket, the Irish National Stud's resident has produced 16 individual winners and a 42 per cent winners to runners strike rate.

After winning the Gr.3 Acomb Stakes at two, on only his third start, he ended his two-year-old season with a runner-up spot in the Gr.2 Champagne Stakes, before being seen off by a head in the Gr.1 Vertem Futurity Trophy Stakes, losing to subsequent Gr.1 2,000 Guineas victor **Magna Grecia** (**Invincible Spirit**). On his first appearance as a three-year-old, the Charles Hills charge won the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas by three lengths, ahead of sires **Too Darn Hot** (**Dubawi**) and **Magna Grecia**, who he left in fifth.

A half-brother to the Gr.3-placed **Central Square** (**Azamour**) and **Kingsdesire** (**King's Best**), his grandam produced the multiple Gr.2 and Gr.3 winner **Special Kaldoun** (**Alzao**).

Now entering his fourth season at Chapel Stud, after seven years in France, **Planteur**'s standing as a Flat sire has been cemented by the achievements of **Trueshan**, who last year added a second Gr.1 Prix du Cadran victory to his name. **Trueshan** had already racked up two victories in the Gr.2 Champions Long Distance Cup, won the Gr.1 Goodwood Cup in 2021 and comfortably secured the Gr.2 Doncaster Cup in 2023.

The highest earning son of **Danehill Dancer** is also a more than capable Jumps stallion. This was confirmed late last year when his son **Gran Diose** was the runner-up in a Gr.1 Chase at Auteuil, building on form that included back-to-back Gr.2 wins at the end of 2022.

Planteur amassed over £2.2m from his 12 Stakes victories and places. His career highlight was a Gr.1 Prix Ganay victory and runner-up spots in the Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris, the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club and the Gr.1 Prix d'Ispahan (twice), as well as a third in the Gr.1 Dubai World Cup.

He is a half-brother to the dual Listed scorer **Pilote D'Essai** (**Oasis Dream**) and to the dam of Classic winner and sire **Persian King (Kingman**). His dam is a half-sister to Champion Older Horse and sire **Policy Maker (Sadler's Wells)** and he is from the family of the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club and Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner and sire **Peintre Celebre**.

THE NATIONAL STUD • Fee £3,000

'From small acorns mighty oaks grow,' is the saying and, after the exceptional start that **Rajasinghe** made with his compact first crop on the racecourse in 2021, his progeny have continued to provide the sire with success over the last two years.

Standing at a fee of just £3,000, he covered his biggest book to date in 2023, while his yearlings sold for up to £27,000, with an average three times the size of his fee.

Back in 2022, **Waiting All Night** got his sire off the mark at the first attempt in a Wolverhampton maiden in early May and went on to run with credit in both the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes and the Gr.2 July Stakes, prior to finishing second in the Listed Pat Eddery Stakes at Ascot in July.

Last year, **Two Tribes** caught the eye, taking home earnings of over £30,000, while over the past two seasons **Spioradalta** also proved his worth, earning over £40,000, including through victories at Nottingham and Chester last year.

By dual Royal Ascot hero **Choisir**, responsible for top sire **Starspangledbanner**, who was also a Royal Ascot winner, **Rajasinghe** is out of the Listed-placed **Soviet Star** mare **Bunditten**. His second dam, **Felicita** (**Catrail**), is a dual Listed winner.

He himself won the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes in a record time at the Royal Meeting in 2017.



RAVEN'S PASS

Elusive Quality – Ascutney (Lord At War) KILDANGAN STUD • Fee €7,500

Boasting an eight per cent Stakes winners to runners strike rate, **Raven's Pass** has been responsible for four Gr.1 winners and 65 black-type horses.

Notable successes from his progeny include Royal Marine's victory in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere, Tower of London's Gr.1 Sprinters Stakes victory, and the Gr.1 wins of Romantic Proposal and Matterhorn. Last year saw his son, **Son Of Corballis**, land the Listed Tipperary Stakes.

With three consecutive victories during his two-year-old campaign, including in the Gr.3 Solario Stakes and Listed Winkfield Stakes, Raven's Pass was placed third in the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes on his final outing that year. Having reappeared to finish runner-up in the Gr.3 Craven Stakes, he was placed second in a series of Gr.1 contests, including the St James's Palace Stakes, the Prix Jean Prat and the Sussex Stakes. He returned to Goodwood to win the Gr.2 Celebration Mile, before rounding off his career with two Gr.1 victories, in the Queen Elizabeth II Stakes and Breeders' Cup Classic.

A \$1.1m yearling purchase by MV Magnier, the son of **Scat** Daddy was sent into training at Ballydoyle and performed well at two. He broke his maiden tag by an impressive seven and half lengths on his second start over 5f at Navan, before being similarly impressive when winning the Listed Rochestown Stakes over 5f at Navan by four lengths. He then travelled over to Royal Ascot to contest the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes, where he was beaten just over a length by the now Coolmore stallion Calyx (Kingman) when third in this 6f contest. The colt returned to form when dropped back to the 5f trip later in the season, comfortably claiming the Gr.3 Cornwallis Stakes at Newmarket. Sergei Prokofiev reappeared as a three-year-old to earn a third Stakes victory in the Listed Cork Stakes over 51/2f at Navan.

He was the sire of two colts that commanded winning bids of 220,000gns at last year's Tattersalls October Yearling Sale Book 1, while he was also represented by a €160,000 colt at the Goffs Orby Sale Book 1 and a 115,000gns colt at Tattersalls' Book 2. Those four six-figure yearlings complemented the success of his foals in 2022.

He would go on to finish second in the Gr.1 Prix Jacques le Marois and third in the Gr.2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein that season. As a four-year-old, he won the Gr.2 Prix d'Harcourt, beating future Gr.1 winners and sires **Way To Paris** and **Sottsass**, before he finished third in the Gr.1 Prix Ganay.

He is a half-brother to the triple Listed winner **Green Sweet** (**Smart Strike**) and the Listed-placed **Situveux** (**Siyouni**), out of the dual Listed winner and Gr.3-placed **Only Green** (**Green Desert**). Showcasing – Dijarvo (Iceman)

DULLINGHAM PARK • Fee £8,500

Soldier's Call has moved from Ireland to Dullingham Park, near Newmarket, for the 2024 breeding season.

A son of **Showcasing** and the French Listed winner **Dijarvo** (**Iceman**), as a two-year-old he notched victories in the Listed Windsor Castle Stakes, Gr.3 Prix d'Arenberg and Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes, all over 5f. He also finished third in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye against older horses, in front of the likes of **Battaash** (**Dark Angel**) and **Havana Grey** (**Havana Gold**). At three, he finished third, beaten only by **Blue Point** (**Shamardal**) and **Battaash**, in the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes, and second in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes, beating home the dual Gr.1 winner **Ten Sovereigns** (**No Nay Never**).

As a stallion, last year he recorded 26 individual winners from his initial crop of runners, placing him third in the European First-Crop Sire table. His best progeny include the Gr.3 Prix Eclipse victrix and Gr.2-placed **Dawn Charger**, the Gr.3-placed **Dorothy Lawrence** and the easy Yarmouth debut winner **Born To Rock**. All three have wintered well and strengthened, according to their trainers. The top price that he achieved at the 2023 yearling sales was 190,000gns and 2024, a year in which he will be represented by 105 juveniles, has already started strongly, with three more maiden winners in the month of January.

Patrons of The National Stud in Newmarket in 2024 have the opportunity to breed to not only one of the most popular horses in recent years, but one of the outstanding stayers of the modern era, **Stradivarius**.

A bastion of consistency and soundness, the son of **Sea The Stars** racked up a huge fan base in his seven seasons of racing, in which he finished out of the first three just five times in 35 starts. Mehmas – Triggers Broom (Arcano)

YEOMANSTOWN STUD • Fee €10,000

The Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes winner **Supremacy** will stand his third season at Yeomanstown Stud in 2024, fresh from some eye-catching sales results with his first batch of foals.

One of three sons of the record-breaking **Mehmas** standing in Ireland this year, **Supremacy** was beaten on racecourse debut at Windsor but swept all before him for the remainder of his two-year-old campaign. He had four lengths in hand when emulating his sire by winning the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes at Goodwood, crossing the line in a faster time than fellow Gr.1-winning Richmond Stakes graduates **Vandeek, Golden Horde** and **Shalaa**, before defeating the Gr.1 winners **Lucky Vega** and **Minzaal** when a dominant winner of the Middle Park Stakes at Newmarket. Retired to covering duties ahead of the 2022 breeding season, his first foals (conceived at a fee of €12,500) met with positive reviews last year and sold for as much as €180,000 at the Goffs November Foal Sale.

Mastercraftsman – Arosa (Sadler's Wells)

Having spent the last two season's at Haras de Montaigu, **Technician** will join the roster at Manton Park for 2024.

Bred by David and Diane Nagle's Barronstown Stud, the Mastercraftsman horse comfortably shed his maiden tag at the second time of asking, having finished third behind subsequent three-time Gr.1 winner and sire Space Blues (**Dubawi**) on his racecourse debut. Having contested the Gr.1 St Leger, his cross-Channel exploits in October of his Classic season were his tour de force, as he backed up his victory in the Gr.2 Prix Chaudenay with a strong staying performance to land the Gr.1 Prix Royal-Oak in testing conditions.

From a famed Aga Khan family, he is a half-brother to the Gr.3 Atalanta Stakes third Water Hole (Oasis Dream), out of the US Stakes winner Arosa (Sadler's Wells). She is a fullsister to the dual Gr.2-winning sire Crimson Tide, and closely-related to the US Gr.2 winner Pharatta (Fairy King; grandam of the Gr.1 Prix d'Ispahan and Gr.1 Prix du Moulin winner and sire **Recoletos**). **Technician**'s grandam **Sharata** (Darshaan) is an unraced half-sister to the Gr.1 Derby and Gr.1 Irish Derby winner and sire Shahrastani (Nijinsky).

Classic-placed Gr.1 winner Territories remains at Dalham Hall Stud this year at an unchanged fee. By sire of sires Invincible Spirit, he enjoyed a fine 2023, producing 18 Group and Stakes performers, topped by the Gr.1 Sprint Cup victor **Regional** plus four other Pattern winners, headed by the Gr.2 winners **Navajo Peak** and **Que Tempesta**. His best progeny from previous years were the dual Gr.1 victrix **Rougir**, who was bought for €3m halfway through her racing career, and the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Derby-placed Hoo Ya Mal, who sold for £1.2m in June 2022.

ZENITH STALLION STATION • Fee €5,000

One of just three stallion sons of the great **Deep Impact** based in Britain or Ireland, **Tosen Stardom** will stand his second season as part of the Zenith Stallion Station operation, based at Lemongrove Stud in County Westmeath, for a reduced fee of €5,000 in 2024.

An unbeaten two-year-old and dual Gr.3 winner in his native Japan, **Tosen Stardom** later won twice in Gr.1 company at up to 1m2f in Australia, before beginning his stallion career at Woodside Park Stud in Victoria. His early Southern Hemisphere crops have already yielded dozens of winners, notably the Stakes performers **Shuriken** and **Nightsun**, but the developing influence of **Deep Impact**'s sons at stud in Europe suggests that he can prove even more successful in this part of the world. Another Gr.1 winner new to this year's Darley stallion ranks is the Queen Anne Stakes hero **Triple Time**. The son of **Frankel** beat the winners of 16 Gr.1 contests to win Royal Ascot's opener last year, including **Inspiral**, **Modern Games** and **Native Trail**, a performance that earned him a Timeform rating of 124.

Owned and bred by Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum and trained by Kevin Ryan, **Triple Time** was precocious on the racecourse, breaking his maiden tag by nine and a half lengths in August of his two-year-old campaign before winning the Listed Ascendant Stakes in record time on his next start the following month. He then defied a long absence to land the Gr.3 Superior Mile Stakes at three, before his top-level triumph at four.

A winner on almost all types of going, the versatile son of **Frankel** is from a family littered with black type. Out of the Listed-placed winner **Reem Three** (**Mark Of Esteem**), he is a half-brother to six Stakes performers, headed by the Gr.1 Prix Jean Romanet heroine **Ajman Princess** (**Teofilo**), the Gr.2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein winner **Ostilio** (**New Approach**) and the Gr.3 winner and Gr.2-placed **Cape Byron** (**Shamardal**). He is also a half-brother to the dam of 2023 Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere winner **Rosallion** (**Blue Point**).


Kyllachy – Twilight Mistress (Bin Ajwaad)

Twilight Son has established himself as a sire of note, both in the sales ring and on the track. His yearling sale statistics have been consistently healthy throughout his first five crops, to the extent that his 187 progeny to have found new owners at that stage have done so at an average £28,700, while last year one of his daughters fetched the small matter of £360,000 at the Goffs UK Breeze-Up Sale.

That Doncaster purchase justified her price tag when, named **Beautiful Diamond**, she was placed in the Gr.2 Queen Mary Stakes and prevailed at Listed level, demonstrating plenty of speed on each occasion. **Vetiver**, **Twilight Jet** and **Wicklow** were other **Twilight Son** black-type winners last term. In previous seasons, **Twilight Calls** had notched a second place for him in the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes, as well as narrowly missing out on a Gr.2 Temple Stakes victory, **Aria Importante** won no less than four Pattern races, **Twilight Jet** was successful in Gr.3 company on two separate occasions and **Twilight Spinner** landed the Gr.3 Athasi Stakes.

Twilight Son is by Champion Sprinter **Kyllachy** and is a half-brother to the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Sprint Cup-placed **Music Master (Piccolo)**, out of the three-time winner **Twilight Mistress (Bin Ajwaad)**. His racecourse achievements were topped by Gr.1 triumphs in the Sprint Cup and the Diamond Jubilee Stakes.

Flying two-year-old **Ubettabelieveit** joined the roster at Mickley Stud in 2022, so will be having his first yearlings this year. This top-class juvenile is by a leading two-year-old sire in **Kodiac**, who has long been a sought-after source of precocity and has had an excellent time recently with his sons at stud, including Ardad, Coulsty and Kodi Bear. Like Ardad, **Ubettabelieveit** won the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes.

Trained by Nigel Tinkler, Ubettabelieveit notched a decisive victory in the Listed National Stakes prior to landing the Flying Childers, beating Gr.1 winner Winter Power and Group winners Sacred, Steel Bull and Ventura Tormenta. He ended the season in America with a close third in the Gr.2 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint. Tinkler said: "Ubettabelieveit has got such a fantastic turn of speed and a great attitude."

Ulysses was the sire of seven black-type horses in 2023, five of whom won Stakes races. They are led by the Gr.3 Ballysax Stakes winner and Gr.1 Derby-placed White Birch, the Gr.3 Winter Hill Stakes winner and Gr.2-placed Passenger, Gr.3 Sovereign Stakes victor **Mighty Ulysses** and the Dundalk Listed winner Piz Badile, who finished runner-up in the 2022 Gr.1 Irish Derby. He was also the sire of a half-brother to Inspiral (Frankel), who sold for 160,000gns at Book 1 of last year's Tattersalls October Yearling Sale.

On the track, the son of **Galileo** was crowned Champion Older Horse in Europe and Great Britain in 2017. after prevailing in that year's Gr.1 Eclipse Stakes and Gr.1 Juddmonte International Stakes, where he defeated the dual Classic winner Churchill (Galileo) by two lengths.



Wells Farhh Go is one of a host of stallions with Galileo as their damsire, such as Ghaiyyath, St Mark's Basilica, Night Of Thunder, Magna Grecia, Saxon Warrior, Sottsass and Galileo Gold.
