ANGEL BLEU

Dark Angel – Cercle De La Vie (Galileo) **SUMBE •** Fee **€9.000**

Retired from racing after his four-year-old campaign closed with a run in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes, **Angel Bleu** stands for €9,000 at Sumbe's Haras de Montfort et Preaux.

His juvenile career encompassed a number of highlights and ended with him being crowned as France's Joint Champion Two-Year-Old. After posting two minor wins, his breakthrough effort saw him take second in Ascot's Listed Pat Eddery Stakes before racking up successes in Goodwood's Gr.2 Vintage Stakes, Longchamp's Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere and Saint-Cloud's Gr.1 Criterium International.

After running creditably in defeat in a three-year-old campaign that included outings in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes and the Gr.1 Sussex Stakes, **Angel Bleu** returned to the winner's enclosure at four, with victories in the Listed Spring Trophy Stakes and Gr.2 Celebration Mile.

By Dark Angel, he is out of the Galileo mare Cercle De La Vie, a full-sister to the seven-time Gr.1 winner and sire Highland Reel. Cercle De La Vie also counts the Gr.1 Caulfield Cup winner Cape Of Good Hope, the Gr.2 Hardwicke Stakes hero Idaho and the Gr.3 Ballysax Stakes victor Nobel Prize as full-brothers.

His second dam **Hveger** (**Danehill**) was placed at Gr.1 and Gr.2 level, while his great grandam is the Gr.1 Australian Oaks-winning **Circles Of Gold** (**Marscay**).



BELBEK

Showcasing – Bee Queen (Makfi)

SUMBE • Fee €7,000

Home-bred by Nurlan Bizakov, **Belbek** (**Showcasing**) is an exciting acquisition to the stallion ranks for 2024. A descendant of one of the most exceptional broodmares of the last 50 years in the shape of **Hasili** (**Kahyasi**), who produced no less than five different Gr.1 winners on top of the Gr.2 hero and Champion Sire **Dansili**, he himself was a Champion Two-Year-Old who proved both his class and toughness throughout his two busy campaigns on the track.

Trained by Andre Fabre, **Belbek** was so precocious that his maestro handler deemed him ready for the racecourse in the early April of his juvenile season. Having got off the mark at the second attempt, he then landed the first French Pattern race on the two-year-old calendar, the Gr.3 Prix du Bois in June, before, three and a half months later, crowning his career with success in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere.

Arguably his best form came in three autumn starts during his Classic year: a close fifth in the Gr.1 Prix du Moulin, a third in the Gr.2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein, and finally, when proving how well he saw out 1600m when beating Gr.1 winner **The Revenant (Dubawi)** to land the Gr.3 Prix Perth on his final start.

He is the second foal of a half-sister to the Gr.3 winner **Sangarius** (**Kingman**) and his third dam is none other than the outstanding **Banks Hill** (**Danehill**), who won three Gr.1s before producing the Gr.1 heroine **Romantica** (**Galileo**).



CAPRI

Galileo – Dialafara (Anabaa)

WILLOW WOOD FARM • Fee £2,500

Dual Classic winner **Capri** has made the move from Grange Stud to Willow Wood Farm in Cheshire for the 2024 season.

The son of **Galileo** had an outstanding career on the racecourse, winning the Gr.2 Beresford Stakes and finishing second in the Gr.1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud as a two-year-old, before landing vintage renewals of the Gr.1 Irish Derby and Gr.1 St Leger as a three-year-old, where he defeated some of the best horses of his generation, including fellow Gr.1 winners and sires **Cracksman**, **Wings Of Eagles**, **Waldgeist**, **Crystal Ocean** and **Stradivarius**. He finished his racing career with earnings of over £1.5m and five victories at Stakes level.

Capri is the third foal and one of seven winners out of the winning Aga Khan-bred Anabaa mare Dialafara, making him a full-brother to four Stakes winners between both codes, including Brazil, who beat Gaelic Warrior (Maxios) to win the Gr.3 (then) Fred Winter Juvenile Handicap Hurdle at the Cheltenham Festival. On the Flat, his full-siblings include the Gr.3 winner and sire Cypress Creek, the Gr.3 victrix and dual Gr.1-placed Passion and the Listed winner and Gr.3 runner-up Tower Of London, as well as the dam of the undefeated Gr.1 Fillies' Mile winner Commissioning (Kingman). His oldest crop are currently three.



DRAGON SYMBOL

Cable Bay – Arcamist (Arcano)

WHITSBURY MANOR STUD • Fee £8,000

Whitsbury Manor Stud has a new addition to its roster this season in the shape of high-class sprinter **Dragon Symbol**.

Having won each of his first four starts in impressive style early in his three-year-old campaign, the son of **Cable Bay** then finished a narrow second in the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes, before finishing first past the post in the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup at Royal Ascot. Three more placed efforts followed; he finished second in the Gr.1 July Cup, where he beat defending champion **Oxted** and Gr.1 winners **Art Power**, **Creative Force**, **Emaraaty Ana** and **Supremacy**, and he filled the same spot in the Gr.2 King George Stakes over the minimum trip, where he comfortably got the better of Gr.1 winners **Glass Slippers** and **Battaash**. He then finished a fine third in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes, ahead of another Gr.1 winner in **Golden Pal**, cementing his place as one of the leading sprinters of his generation.

Dragon Symbol is out of the winning **Arcano** mare **Arcamist**, who is closely related to the Listed winner **Oasis Dancer** (**Oasis Dream**), and a half-sister to the Champion Scandinavian Miler **Smart Enough** (**Cadeaux Genereux**). They are out of the talented Gr.1 Prix Saint-Alary-placed winner **Good Enough** (**Mukaddamah**).

DUBAI MILE

Roaring Lion – Beach Bunny (High Chaparral)
MANTON PARK STUD • Fee £7,500

New to Manton Park in 2024 is the impeccably-bred Gr.1-winning juvenile **Dubai Mile**.

Hailing from the only crop of the four-time Gr.1 winner Roaring Lion, Dubai Mile was highly-progressive in five juvenile starts, with novice victories at Windsor and Kempton preceding a runner-up finish in behind The Foxes (Australia) in the Gr.2 Royal Lodge Stakes. Sent to France for the Gr.1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud, he battled close home to edge ahead of the dual Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 St Leger runner-up Arrest (Frankel), with subsequent Gr.3 Kilternan Stakes winner and Gr.1 Irish Derby runner-up Adelaide River (Australia) back in third.

Bred by the late Lady O'Reilly's Skymarc Farm, he is a half-brother to the Listed winners Naadirr (Oasis Dream) and Beach Belle (Invincible Spirit; dam of the Gr.2 Shannon Stakes winner Surf Dancer). His dam Beach Bunny (High Chaparral), who won the Listed Dance Design Stakes and was narrowly denied by Dar Re Mi (Singspiel) in the Gr.1 Pretty Polly Stakes, is out of Miss Hawai (Peintre Celebre), an unraced half-sister to the Gr.1 1,000 Guineas heroine Miss France (Dansili). Dubai Mile's third dam is the Wildenstein-owned Gr.1 Prix Marcel Boussac winner Miss Tahiti (Tirol), who was placed a further three times at the highest level.

EL CABALLO


Havana Gold – Showstoppa (Showcasing)

CULWORTH GROUNDS FARM • Fee £6,000

There is a significant new stallion farm in Britain this year, as Culworth Grounds in Northamptonshire will stand the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes winner **El Caballo**.

Runner-up on debut to subsequent Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes winner and sire **Armor** (**No Nay Never**), the high-class son of **Havana Gold** then ran up a sequence of six consecutive victories, which culminated in victory in the Sandy Lane Stakes, and included wins in both the Listed Spring Cup Stakes and the valuable Three-Year-Old All-Weather Championships Stakes. A high draw thwarted his chance in the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup on his final start of the season, though he returned to the track as a four-year-old, with his best effort a third-place finish in the Gr.3 John of Gaunt Stakes over 7f, a race in which he was continually denied a clear run.

Just the second son of **Havana Gold** to retire to stud - the other being Whitsbury Manor Stud's **Havana Grey** - **El Caballo**'s career-high rating of 112 puts him just one pound behind his contemporary. A full-brother to last year's Gr.2 Lowther Stakes third **Symbology**, he is a half-brother to the Italian Listed winner **Avengers Queen** (**Brazen Beau**), out of **Showstoppa** (**Showcasing**), a four-time winning half-sister to the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes winner and sire **Temple Meads** (**Avondale**) and the Gr.3 Firth of Clyde Stakes-placed **Sneak Preview** (**Monsieur Bond**).



EL KABEIR

Scat Daddy – Great Venue (Unbridled's Song)

RAZZA DELL'ORSO • Fee €6,000

Proven sire **El Kabeir** has made the short move to Razza dell'Orso in central Italy this year, having stood his first season in that country in 2023 and his first five years at Yeomanstown Stud in Ireland.

The son of **Scat Daddy** was a high-class dirt miler on the racecourse in the US, winning the Gr.2 Kentucky Jockey Club Stakes at the end of his two-year-old campaign, before easily landing the Gr.3 Jerome Stakes in his first week as a three-year-old and then winning the Gr.3 Gotham Stakes in March. He followed that effort up with a fine third behind triple Gr.1 winner and future sire **Frosted** (**Tapit**) in the Gr.1 Wood Memorial Stakes three weeks later.

El Kabeir is responsible for 11 Stakes performers from his first three crops of racing age, including last year's Gr.2 Duke of York Stakes winner Azure Blue, Gr.2 Gran Criterium winner Don Chicco, Listed winner, Gr.2 Superlative Stakes runner-up and Gr.1 Derby fourth Masekela, Listed Two-Year-Old Trophy winner Dragon Leader and the Gr.1 Fillies' Mileplaced Bright Diamond. From a well related family, he is out of the Unbridled's Song mare Great Venue, who is a daughter of the Stakes victrix and eight-time winner Rose Colored Lady (Formal Dinner) and a half-sister to multiple US Stakes winners, headed by the dual Gr.2 victor and Gr.1 Hopeful Stakes-placed sire Too Much Bling (Rubiano).

HEROSTAR


Walk In The Park – Star Face (Saint Des Saints)
HARAS DE LA VALLEE VERTE • Fee €3,000

New to Haras de la Vallee Verte for 2024 is **Herostar** who, for €3,000, offers breeders the chance to access a full-brother to two of the most exciting National Hunt horses of recent times, **Douvan** and **Jonbon**.

This illustrious family stems from the **Saint Des Saints** mare **Star Face**, whose matings with Grange Stud's **Walk In The Park** have reaped massive rewards. Her first foal, born in 2010, was **Douvan** who, after joining Willie Mullins, triumphed in no fewer than eight Gr.1s over both hurdles and fences. A dual Cheltenham victor, he recorded victories in both the Gr.1 Supreme Novices' Hurdle and the Gr.1 Arkle Challenge Trophy Chase.

Star Face's next mating to **Walk In The Park** produced **Jonbon** in 2016, who has so far racked up top-level success in the Gr.1 Henry VIII Novices' Chase, Gr.1 Celebration Chase, Gr.1 Tingle Creek Chase, Gr.1 Maghull Novices' Chase and the Gr.1 Top Novices' Hurdle for trainer Nicky Henderson.

The mare's only other visit to **Walk In The Park** yielded **Herostar**, born in 2018. Although unraced, he remained an entire and now offers breeders a link to those two aforementioned high-class geldings. His sire continues to be in rich demand at the sales, while **Saint Des Saints** is a top-class National Hunt broodmare sire, evidenced by the likes of Gr.1 winners **El Fabiolo**, **Envoi Allen** and **Appreciate It**.



LAND FORCE

No Nay Never – Theann (Rock Of Gibraltar) **HEDGEHOLME STUD •** Fee £2,500

Hedgeholme Stud will be the new home of **Land Force** for the 2024 breeding season, where he will stand for £2,500.

On the track, the son of **No Nay Never** was a precocious two-year-old and, after shedding his maiden tag over 6f at the Curragh, comfortably landed the Listed Tipperary Stakes by two lengths. His next assignment came in the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes at Goodwood over 6f, where he defeated **Marie's Diamond** (**Footstepsinthesand**) to earn a maiden Group victory. Other juvenile efforts included a third in the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes at Royal Ascot over the minimum trip and a creditable fourth when stepped up to the highest level in the Gr.1 Prix Morny.

Out of the Gr.3-winning **Rock Of Gibraltar** mare **Theann**, he is a half-brother to the dual US Gr.1 heroine **Photo Call** (**Galileo**), from the high-class family of Gr.1 winners **Halfway To Heaven**, **Magical**, **Rhododendron** and **Auguste Rodin**, as well as the sire **Verglas**.

Land Force had good statistics with his first two-year-olds last season and sired 21 individual winners from 66 runners, at a winners to runners percentage of 32 per cent. His leading progeny so far include the Listed-placed Velox, 6f Goodwood handicap winner Serried Ranks, the unbeaten debutant winner Natural Force and the Newmarket novice victor Watcha Matey.

LUSAIL

Mehmas – Diaminda (Diamond Green)

HARAS DE BOUQUETOT • Fee €6,000

The Richard Hannon-trained **Lusail** retired from racing after a four-year-old season that saw runs in a string of Group and Listed contests, including the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes at Newbury and the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes at Royal Ascot.

Racing six times at two, the son of **Mehmas** recorded four victories, beginning with a strike at York over 6f on debut. After winning over 7f at the Newmarket July course, he earned consecutive Group wins in the Gr.2 July Stakes, where he defeated the likes of the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1-placed **Asymmetric** (**Showcasing**), the subsequent Gr.1 winner **Ebro River** (**Galileo Gold**), and the Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes, with the likes of subsequent dual Group winner **Twilight Jet** (**Twilight Son**) and that year's Gr.2 Coventry Stakes victor **Berkshire Shadow** (**Dark Angel**) in behind.

His three-year-old campaign began with a second in the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes, before being beaten just a head by the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas winner **Coroebus** (**Dubawi**) in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes at Royal Ascot. On his next start, **Lusail** finished placed again at the highest level when third in the Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat, beating home the likes of five-time Gr.1 winner **Modern Games** (**Dubawi**).

The five-year-old sire is out of the winning **Diamond Green** mare **Diaminda**, a half-sister to the Gr.1 Golden Jubilee Stakes winner **Fayr Jag** (**Fayruz**).

MAC SWINEY

New Approach – Halla Na Saoire (Teofilo) IRISH NATIONAL STUD • Fee €8,000

A new recruit to the Irish National Stud for 2024 is the Classic winner Mac Swiney, who will cover his first mares at a fee of

The son of **New Approach** broke his maiden at the second attempt over 7f at the Curragh in July of 2020, before beating the likes of Jessica Harrington's Cadillac (Lope De Vega) and Aidan O'Brien's subsequent Gr.1 winner Van Gogh (American Pharoah) in August's Gr.2 Futurity Stakes over the same course and distance. He finished his two-year-old season with a hard-fought victory in the Gr.1 Futurity Trophy Stakes over 1m at Doncaster, defeating the likes of the triple Gr.1 winner State Of Rest (Starspangledbanner) in the process. At three, **Mac Swiney** added a second Gr.1 victory to his resume when he outbattled his high-class stablemate Poetic Flare (Dawn Approach) in the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas, etching his name in Classic history in the process A fourth-place finish in the Gr.1 Derby followed, before a fine effort in the Gr.1 Champion Stakes, where he ran third behind Sealiway (Galiway).

A Jim Bolger homebred, he is out of an unraced full-sister to the Gr.2 Derby Trial Stakes winner and Gr.1 Irish Derbyplaced sire Light Heavy (Teofilo), and a half-sister to the winning dam of Bolger's Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes hero and sire Parish Hall (Teofilo).

MARIE'S DIAMOND

Footstepsinthesand – Sindiyma (Kalanisi)

DIAMOND STUD BELLEWSTOWN • Fee €6,000

Marie's Diamond will be the first stallion to stand at Ciarán De Barra's Diamond Stud Bellewstown.

The son of **Footstepsinthesand** won three times as a juvenile, spearheaded by a win in the Gr.3 Anglesey Stakes when he defeated subsequent Gr.1 scorer Viadera, in the fastest time posted by a colt since 1995. This win was flanked by narrow defeats in both the Gr.2 Railway Stakes and the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes. He also finished fourth in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes at Newmarket and showed an affinity for the Rowley Mile course throughout his career, particularly when he defeated his nine rivals in record time in the Listed Paradise Stakes. True to form, the hard-knocking colt was in action just 11 days later when taking third place behind **Circus Maximus** in the 2020 renewal of the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes at Royal Ascot, finishing ahead of Gr.1 winners Accidental Agent (Delegator) and Mohaather (Showcasing).

His dam Sindiyma is a full-sister to the Listed winner Sindirana, herself the dam of dual Listed victor Sirrin (Sea The Stars) and the grandam of the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1placed Sonaiyla (Dark Angel). His third dam, Sinntara (Lashkari), won a Listed race at the Curragh before producing nine winners from 11 runners. They are headed by the Gr.1 Derby, Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and Gr.1 Irish Derby hero, champion and sire Sinndar.

MATTMU

Indesatchel – Katie Boo (Namid)

NORTON GROVE STUD • Fee £2,000

Transferring from Bearstone Stud for the 2024 season, **Mattmu** has, from small numbers, already produced the 95-rated **Favourite Child**, who finished second in the Listed Criterium de Vitesse, as well as the 85-rated sprinter **Mattice** and the six-time winner **Matty Too**.

On the track, **Mattmu**'s career saw four wins at two, including his headline success in the Gr.2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte, which came just a month after he had taken the Listed Rockingham Stakes at York. Trained by Tim Easterby, he began his three-year-old campaign with a narrow defeat in the Gr.2 Duke of York Stakes, before he travelled to Ireland in August, where he won the Gr.3 Phoenix Sprint Stakes. This victory preceded a third-place finish in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes at York, while his four-year-old campaign featured a third-place finish in the Gr.3 Abernant Stakes, before he signed off his racing career with victory in Ripon's Great St Wilfrid Handicap.

He is one of three winners out of **Katie Boo** (**Namid**), a half-sister to the Listed winner **Maldron Prom** (**Kheleyf**; raced as **Super Alloy** in Macau) and the Listed-placed **Penthouse Serenade** (**Val Royal**), out of Listed-third **Misty Peak** (**Sri Pekan**). His third dam is the unraced **Miss Declared** (**Alleged**), who also produced Listed-placed **Golly Gosh** (**Danehill**).

MAYSON

Invincible Spirit – Mayleaf (Pivotal)

OAK LODGE & SPRINGFIELD HOUSE STUD • Fee €4,250

After 11 seasons at Cheveley Park, **Mayson** has been sold to his breeder, David Armstrong. The Gr.1 July Cup victor, responsible for dual Gr.1-wininng **Oxted**, will take up duties at Springfield House Stud this season.

Breaking his maiden on his second attempt at two, the son of **Invincible Spirit** was twice placed in Listed contests at three. This included claiming a runner-up spot in the Listed Wentworth Stakes, before his four-year-old season opened with another Listed placing, when he finished third in the Cammidge Trophy at Doncaster. It was at four that he recorded his career highlights, beginning with back-to-back victories in the Listed (then) Abernant Stakes, by three and a half lengths, and the Gr.3 Palace House Stakes a month later. His Gr.1 success came later that season, before he ended his time on the racecourse with a second in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye, beaten just a neck.

In addition to **Oxted**, other highlights of **Mayson**'s stallion career include the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes winner and Gr.1-placed **Rohaan** and the Gr.3 EBF Athasi Stakes victrix and Gr.2-placed **Honey Girl**, while he has sired ten Stakes winners and 29 black-type performers overall.

Speightstown – It's Midnight Shamardal NORTON GROVE STUD • Fee £2,500

New to Norton Grove Stud for 2024 is the UAE Gr.3 winner **Midnight Sands**, an impeccably-bred son of the sire of sires **Speightstown**, who retired last year as the winner of six of his 17 starts for career earnings in excess of £300,000.

A €90,000 private purchase at the Arqana May Breeze-Up Sale, **Midnight Sands** initially went into training in Britain and was highly-regarded enough to run in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot on just his second start. However, it was only after joining multiple UAE Champion Trainer Doug Watson, and having his attention switched to dirt, that the now eight-year-old really found his niche. He opened his account by four lengths in a 1200m maiden at Meydan as a three-year-old, and went on to win his next four starts and rocket up the ratings. A brief sojourn in the US followed, before he returned to the care of Watson to win the 1600m Gr.3 Burj Nahaar on 'Super Saturday' at Meydan in March 2021, defeating no less than eight current or future Graded winners in the process.

One of just two sons of the highly influential dirt and turf stallion **Speightstown** at stud in Britain, **Midnight Sands** is a half-brother to the US Gr.3 winner **Tusk** (**Tapit**), out of the Listed Prix Coronation winner **It's Midnight** (**Shamardal**).

Make Believe – Contradict (Raven's Pass)

SUMBE • Fee €17,500

Three-time Gr.1 winner and Classic hero **Mishriff** (**Make Believe**) will cover his first book of mares under the Sumbe banner at Montfort et Preaux in Normandy this year.

A ten-length winner at two, he enjoyed a stellar three-year-old campaign, winning three Stakes races, headed by the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club where he comfortably accounted for Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains winner **Victor Ludorum**. He then landed both the world's richest race, the Saudi Cup, on dirt, and the Gr.1 Dubai Sheema Classic, back on turf, at the start of a four-year-old career which also featured a famous victory in the Gr.1 Juddmonte International Stakes and two more Gr.1 placings. At five, he finished placed in both the Gr.1 Eclipse Stakes and (for the second year running) the Gr.1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes before filling the runner-up berth behind **Baaeed** in the Juddmonte International.

Out of the winning Raven's Pass mare Contradict, he is a half-brother to the Listed winner Orbaan (Invincible Spirit) and the multiple Gr.3-placed winner Momkin (Bated Breath). His grandam is the Gr.3 winner Acts Of Grace (Bahri), a half-sister to the Gr.1-winning sprinter and sire Invincible Spirit (Green Desert) and fellow sire Kodiac (Danehill), out of the Gr.1 Prix de Diane winner Rafha (Kris).



MODERN GAMES

Dubawi – Modern Ideals (New Approach)

DALHAM HALL STUD • Fee £30,000

With a box a few doors down from his sire, **Modern Games** retires as **Dubawi**'s most prolific Gr.1 winner. His career saw five top-level successes in four countries.

He won four times as a juvenile and his successes included a comfortable two and a half-length victory in the Gr.3 Tattersalls Stakes over 7f at Newmarket, which preceded a foray to the US, where he triumphed in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf at Del Mar on his final start at two.

His three-year-old campaign kicked off with victory in the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains, before he returned to France to finish third in the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club. After a second-place finish to **Baaeed** (**Sea The Stars**) in the Gr.1 Sussex Stakes, he ran away with the Gr.1 Woodbine Mile by five and a quarter lengths, before ending the season with a runner-up spot in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes and a victory in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Mile. His four-year-old campaign was headlined by a Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes victory, while he also finished second in the Gr.1 Maker's Mark Mile.

Out of the **New Approach** mare **Modern Ideals**, he is a half-brother to the dual Gr.1 heroine **Mawj** (**Exceed And Excel**), who won last year's Gr.1 1,000 Guineas, and the Listed winner **Modern News** (**Shamardal**). His immediate family also includes the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere winner and sire **Ultra** (**Manduro**).

Frankel – Handassa (Dubawi)

BEECH HOUSE STUD • Fee £15,000

Last year's Champion Older Horse in Europe, **Mostahdaf** retired with ten victories to his name, including a four-length success in the Gr.1 Prince of Wales's Stakes, two months before his Gr.1 Juddmonte International Stakes triumph.

Trained by John and Thady Gosden, **Mostahdaf** was unraced at two. He took two Listed contests and the Gr.3 Darley Stakes at three, while his four-year-old campaign saw success in the Gr.3 Gordon Richards Stakes and Gr.3 September Stakes, along with runner-up spots in the Gr.2 Hardwicke Stakes and Gr.3 Brigadier Gerard Stakes. Before his two Gr.1 wins, **Mostahdaf** began his five-year-old season with victory in the highly valuable Gr.3 Neom Turf Cup.

Out of the Listed-winning **Handassa** (**Dubawi**), **Mostahdaf** is a half-brother to the Gr.1 Falmouth Stakes and Gr.1 Sun Chariot Stakes victrix **Nazeef** (**Invincible Spirit**). His unraced second dam, **Starstone** (**Diktat**), produced four further winners, including the Gr.2-winning and Gr.1-placed **Desert Stone** (**Fastnet Rock**) and **Desert Stone**'s full-brother, the Listed-placed **Euginio**.

Mostahdaf's third dam **Star** (**Most Welcome**) was the 2005 UK Broodmare of the Year, having combined with **Bahamian Bounty** to produce the Gr.1 July Cup-winning sire **Pastoral Pursuits** and the Gr.1 Sprint Cup winner and sire **Goodricke**.



MUHAARAR

Oasis Dream – Tahrir (Linamix)

HARAS DU PETIT TELLIER • Fee €14,000

Following a fine 2023, **Muhaarar** has moved from Haras des Faunes, where he stood for two seasons, to Haras du Petit Tellier, and has seen his fee almost double from €7,500 to €14.000.

2023 started well for the son of **Oasis Dream** when the gelded **A Dream To Share** triumphed in the Gr.2 Future Stars INH Flat Race, the Gr.1 Champion Bumper and the Gr.1 Champion INH Flat Race within the National Hunt sphere.

Then, on the Flat, **Marhaba Ya Sanafi** gave him a first Classic victory when landing the Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains in May. Other standout results included **Israr** defeating Derby winner **Adayar** in the Gr.2 Princess of Wales's Stakes, sprinter **Run To Freedom** finishing runner-up in the Gr.1 July Cup and **Burdett Road**, who has turned into a talented juvenile hurdler, winning the Gr.2 Prestbury Juvenile Hurdle following his Royal Ascot success in the Golden Gates Handicap. **Muhaarar**'s other Gr.1 winner, **Eshaada**, led home a 1-2 for her sire in the 2021 British Champions Fillies & Mares Stakes, also at Ascot.

During his own racing career, the 12-year-old stallion won the Gr.1 British Champions Sprint Stakes, Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest, Gr.1 July Cup and Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup. He is a half-brother to three black-type performers, out of the Listed-placed **Tahrir** (**Linamix**).

Muharaar was a magic racehorse, certainly among the five best sprinters I have seen in my lifetime (another would be his sire Oasis Dream). Today I consider him a proven sire who often transmits class, versatility and durability in a package. I used him when he stood in the UK and got his stakes winning filly Sicilian Defense. Now that he stands in Normandy at a more than reasonable fee it would be madness not to use him. MUTASAABEQ

Invincible Spirit – Ghanaati (Giant's Causeway)

NATIONAL STUD • Fee £6,500

The National Stud's stallion ranks have been boosted by the arrival of triple Gr.2 winner **Mutasaabeq**, a well-bred son of the leading sire of sires **Invincible Spirit**.

The winner of a 7f Newmarket novice on his only appearance at two, **Mutasaabeq** went on to finish seventh in the 2021 Gr.1 2,000 Guineas behind **Poetic Flare** (**Dawn Approach**), but it was not until the following year that he truly blossomed. Something of a Rowley Mile specialist, he made a big-race breakthrough when making all in the Gr.2 Joel Stakes over 1m at Newmarket in September 2022, before repeating the tactics to beat the European Champion Two-Year-Old and Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas winner **Native Trail** (**Oasis Dream**) in the Gr.2 Sandown Mile (relocated to Newmarket) at the beginning of last season. A repeat success in the Joel Stakes followed on his final start.

Mutasabeq's status as a formerly 120-rated multiple Group race winner is only part of his appeal, however, as the Shadwell homebred hails from a family of almost unrivalled excellence. He is the best runner out of the 2009 Gr.1 1,000 Guineas heroine **Ghanaati** (**Giant's Causeway**), a half-sister to the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed sire **Mawatheeq** (**Danzig**) and the Listed winner and Gr.1 Oaks third **Rumoush** (**Rahy**). His third dam is the outstanding **Height Of Fashion** (**Bustino**; dam of **Nashwan**, **Nayef** and **Unfuwain**).



NATIVE TRAIL

Oasis Dream – Needleleaf (Observatory)

KILDANGAN STUD • Fee €17,500

New to the Darley stallion ranks for 2024 is the three-time Gr.1 winner **Native Trail**. Trained by Charlie Appleby, the son of top-class sire **Oasis Dream** was an undefeated Champion Two-Year-Old; a campaign which yielded four victories, including the Gr.1 National Stakes by three and a half lengths and Europe's premier juvenile race, the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes, by two lengths. He subsequently made it five from five by winning the Gr.3 Craven Stakes on his seasonal debut at three before being narrowly beaten into second in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas. He bounced back to winning ways by landing the Irish equivalent three weeks later in an ultra-fast time.

He proved his versatility on his next start when stepped up to 1m2f in a quality renewal of the Gr.1 Eclipse Stakes when finishing third, just half a length behind the dual Gr.1 hero **Vadeni** and a head behind multiple Gr.1 winner **Mishriff**.

From a top-class family, **Native Trail** is a valuable addition to an already high-class roster at Kildangan Stud. His dam **Needleleaf** (**Observatory**) is a full-sister to the Gr.1 Sprint Cup heroine **African Rose** (dam of the Gr.3 winner and dual Gr.2-placed **Fair Eva**) and the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Prix Marcel Boussac runner-up **Helleborine** (dam of the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes winner and sire **Calyx**). This is also the family of fellow Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes winner and sire **Distant Music**.


YORTON FARM STUD • Fee £4,000

Having spent the previous six years at Dalham Hall Stud, four-time Gr.1 winner **Postponed** is an exciting addition to the burgeoning National Hunt roster at Yorton Farm Stud in Powys on the Welsh border.

Trained by Luca Cumani and Roger Varian in a career that spanned five years of racing, the son of **Dubawi** was a winning two-year-old over 7f, before going on to be crowned European Champion and earn almost £5m with wins in the Gr.1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Stakes, Gr.1 Dubai Sheema Classic, Gr.1 Coronation Cup and Gr.1 Juddmonte International.

From three crops of racing age, his progeny on the Flat so far include the Gr.3 Nell Gwyn Stakes runner-up **Almohandesah** and the progressive filly **Oh So Grand**, who has won on five occasions and looks set for Stakes company. He is also compiling a fine record with his progney over Jumps, where he has sired the Listed-placed hurdler **Zestful**, unbeaten hurdler **My Chiquita** and the Listed-placed bumper winner **Familiar Dreams**.

Postponed is a half-brother to the Gr.1 (then) Premio Lydia Tesio winner **God Given** (**Nathaniel**), out of **Ever Rigg**, a winning daughter of **Dubai Destination** and the Gr.1 Moyglare Stud Stakes heroine **Bianca Nera** (**Salse**).



SHAQUILLE

Charm Spirit – Magic (Galileo)

DULLINGHAM PARK STUD • Fee £15,000

The top-class sprinter **Shaquille** will cover his first mares at the newly-established Dullingham Park Stud for a fee of £15,000 this season.

The son of **Charm Spirit** won a 7f York novice on debut and, after trying his hand in the Gr.3 Acomb Stakes, went on to win twice more over 6f as a juvenile. However, it was at three that **Shaquille** truly made his mark, progressing from a comfortable two and three quarter-length 6f handicap win at Newmarket to decisively land the Listed Carnarvon Stakes at Newbury, with Gr.2 winners Aesop's Fables (No Nay **Never**) and **Noble Style** (**Kingman**) in behind. He then lined up in the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup over 6f at Royal Ascot and, after missing the break, produced a late surge to run down the Gr.1-winning juvenile Little Big Bear (No Nay Never) and earn a maiden success at the highest level. Julie Camacho's charge did not have to wait long for his second Gr.1 success as, less than a month later, he similarly missed the break but nevertheless careered to victory in the July Cup at Newmarket, defeating Gr.1 winners Kinross (Kingman), Art Power (Dark Angel) and Khaadem (Dark Angel) in the process.

Showcasing – Dijarvo (Iceman)

DULLINGHAM PARK STUD • Fee £8,500

Another new recruit to Dullingham Park Stud is **Soldier's Call**, who has transferred to the British farm from Ballyhane Stud in Ireland for the 2024 breeding season.

The son of **Showcasing** was a precocious two-year-old and racked up victories in the Listed Windsor Castle Stakes at Royal Ascot, Gr.3 Prix d'Arenberg and Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes, all over the minimum trip. He also contested the Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye as a juvenile, where he finished a fine third, in front of the top-class sprinters **Battaash** (**Dark Angel**), **Havana Grey** (**Havana Gold**) and **Sioux Nation** (**Scat Daddy**).

At three, he contested the calendar's major sprint races and finished third, beaten only by **Blue Point** (**Shamardal**) and **Battaash**, in the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes, and runner-up in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes, beating home the likes of dual Gr.1 winner **Ten Sovereigns** (**No Nay Never**).

As a stallion, **Soldier's Call** recorded 26 individual winners from his first crop of runners last year, which included the Gr.3 Prix Eclipse victrix and Gr.2-placed **Dawn Charger**. Other notable progeny include the Gr.3-placed **Dorothy Lawrence** and the Listed-placed pair **World Of Darcy** and **King Collector**, as well as the debut winner and Listed Windsor Castle Stakes fourth **Up The Manor**. He was the third leading First-Crop Sire in Europe by way of winners in 2023.

Teofilo – Reckoning (Danehill Dancer)

ALNE PARK STUD • Fee £4,000

Dual Gr.1 hero Subjectivist will begin his stallion career at Alne Park Stud in Warwickshire this season at a fee of £4,000, joining NH sires **Dink**, **Ocovango** and **Midnights Legacy**.

The son of **Teofilo** was precocious enough to break his maiden tag by seven lengths in July of his two-year-old season, before finishing second in the Listed Stonehenge Stakes over 1m the following month. However, it was as a three-year-old when he really began to shine, making all to win the Listed Glasgow Stakes, the Gr.3 March Stakes and the Gr.1 Prix Royal-Oak on his final start of the year. He then took another step forward at four, landing the Gr.2 Dubai Gold Cup by a wide margin, and, after another break, the Gr.1 Gold Cup at Royal Ascot by five lengths, comfortably defeating Stradivarius (Sea The Stars), who had won the previous three renewals of the race. He was unsurprisingly crowned Champion Older Stayer in Europe in 2021 and finished his career with five victories at Stakes level, whilst his six career wins resulted in a cumulative winning distance of over 36 lengths.

From a fine family, Subjectivist is a half-brother to the dual Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 St Leger runner-up Sir Ron Priestley (Australia), out of the multiple Listed-placed winner Reckoning (Danehill Dancer), whilst he is also related to successful National Hunt sire Sholokhov.


Mastercraftsman – Arosa (Sadler's Wells)

MANTON PARK STUD • Fee £5,000

Having spent the last two season's at Haras de Montaigu, **Technician** will join the roster at Manton Park for 2024.

Bred by David and Diane Nagle's Barronstown Stud, the Mastercraftsman horse comfortably shed his maiden tag at the second time of asking, having finished third behind subsequent three-time Gr.1 winner and sire Space Blues (**Dubawi**) on his racecourse debut. After a luckless second in Sandown's Gr.3 Classic Trial, he made his Stakes breakthrough in the 2000m Listed Prix Ridgway and, stepped up further in trip, ran on strongly to land the Gr.3 Geoffrey Freer Stakes. Having contested the Gr.1 St Leger, his cross-Channel exploits in October of his Classic season were his tour de force, as he backed up his victory in the Gr.2 Prix Chaudenay with a strong staying performance to land the Gr.1 Prix Royal-Oak in testing conditions.

From a famed Aga Khan family, he is a half-brother to the Gr.3 Atalanta Stakes third Water Hole (Oasis Dream), out of the US Stakes winner Arosa (Sadler's Wells). She is a fullsister to the dual Gr.2-winning sire Crimson Tide, and closely-related to the US Gr.2 winner Pharatta (Fairy King; grandam of the Gr.1 Prix d'Ispahan and Gr.1 Prix du Moulin winner and sire Recoletos). Technician's grandam Sharata (Darshaan) is an unraced half-sister to the Gr.1 Derby and Gr.1 Irish Derby winner and sire Shahrastani (Nijinsky).



TRIPLE TIME

Frankel – Reem Three (Mark Of Esteem)

DALHAM HALL STUD • Fee £10,000

Another Gr.1 winner new to this year's Darley stallion ranks is the Queen Anne Stakes hero **Triple Time**. The son of **Frankel** beat the winners of 16 Gr.1 contests to win Royal Ascot's opener last year, including **Inspiral**, **Modern Games** and **Native Trail**, a performance that earned him a Timeform rating of 124.

Owned and bred by Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum and trained by Kevin Ryan, **Triple Time** was precocious on the racecourse, breaking his maiden tag by nine and a half lengths in August of his two-year-old campaign before winning the Listed Ascendant Stakes in record time on his next start the following month. He then defied a long absence to land the Gr.3 Superior Mile Stakes at three, before his top-level triumph at four.

A winner on almost all types of going, the versatile son of **Frankel** is from a family littered with black type. Out of the Listed-placed winner **Reem Three** (**Mark Of Esteem**), he is a half-brother to six Stakes performers, headed by the Gr.1 Prix Jean Romanet heroine **Ajman Princess** (**Teofilo**), the Gr.2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein winner **Ostilio** (**New Approach**) and the Gr.3 winner and Gr.2-placed **Cape Byron** (**Shamardal**). He is also a half-brother to the dam of 2023 Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere winner **Rosallion** (**Blue Point**).

Churchill – Vaderana (Monsun)

HARAS DE BONNEVAL • Fee €18,000

A son of **Churchill**, **Vadeni**'s racing career saw him progress from a promising juvenile campaign to claim two Gr.1 victories at three. Then, on very soft ground which was a long way from ideal, he showed great reserves of both talent and toughness to come up just a neck short when beating 18 of his 19 rivals while trying 2400m for the first and only time in Europe's Championship race, the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe.

Following two wins and a Gr.3 third from three juvenile starts, **Vadeni** reappeared the following spring with another Gr.3 placing in the Prix de Fontainebleau. Victory in the Gr.3 Prix de Guiche followed, before his breakthrough success, when taking the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club by a record five lengths.

Vadeni then stepped up again to beat the older horses, headed by **Mishriff** (**Make Believe**), in the Gr.1 Eclipse Stakes, before taking third in the Gr.1 Irish Champion Stakes and suffering that agonising near miss in the Arc.

A half-brother to five winners, his second dam **Vadawina** (**Unfuwain**) is a half-sister to the Gr.1 victrix **Vazira** (**Sea The Stars**) who took the Gr.1 Prix Saint-Alary and Gr.3 Prix Cleopatre before producing five different Stakes horses, headed by the Gr.2 winner **Vadamar** (**Dalakhani**) and the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed **The Pentagon** (**Galileo**).
