# A'ALI

### Society Rock – Motion Lass (Motivator) NEWSELLS PARK STUD • Fee £5,000

The four-time Gr.2 winner **A'Ali** will stand his fourth season at Newsells Park Stud for £5,000.

Purchased for £135,000 as a two-year-old at the Goffs Breeze-Up Sale in 2019, the now eight-year-old son of Society Rock was beaten just a neck into second on his debut as a juvenile in a 5f contest at Ripon in June. He quickly made amends for that defeat when returning later that month to win the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes at Royal Ascot, followed by wins in the Gr.2 Prix Robert Papin at Deauville and Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes at Doncaster later that season. He then returned as a three-year-old to win the Gr.3 Sprint Stakes at Sandown and the Gr.2 Sapphire Stakes at the Curragh, followed by a fourth-placed effort behind the multiple Gr.1-winning sprinter Battaash (Dark Angel) in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes at York. With Group wins in Britain, Ireland and France, the globetrotting sprinter signed off his racing career with one run as a four-year-old, when he finished a close third in the Gr.2 Meydan Sprint.

Out of a half-sister to the Gr.3 Darley Stakes winner and dual Gr.1-placed sire **Enforcer** (**Efisio**; stood in Saudi Arabia as **Alfaisali**), **A'Ali'**s first crop of yearlings reached a high of 200,000gns in the sales ring last year, with a European average of £31,842 and a median of £16,657.

# AL HAKEEM

Siyouni – Jadhaba (Galileo) HARAS DE BOUQUETOT • Fee €5,000

Al Shaqab Racing homebred **Al Hakeem** has returned to the land on which he was born and raised to make his debut as a stallion at Haras de Bouquetot in Normandy this year.

He is the latest son of the outstanding **Siyouni** to earn a place at stud and could look particularly good value at €5,000 as one of the highest-rated runners produced by the super sire. Trained throughout his career by Jean-Claude Rouget, he defeated the subsequent Gr.1 winner Simca Mille (Tamayuz) on his second start at two and had future Stakes performers in behind when making a winning reappearance at three. A four-length winner of the Listed Prix de Suresnes on his next start, Al Hakeem went on to win the Gr.2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano and finish fourth in both the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club and Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe before the conclusion of his Classic year. Although restricted to just one start as a four-year-old, he confirmed all of his ability remained intact when winning the Gr.3 Prix Gontaut-Biron at Deauville in August of 2024 as a five-yearold, on what proved to be his final racecourse appearance.

The pick of four winners out of the dual winner and Gr.3 Prix Penelope third **Jadhaba** (**Galileo**), his second dam is the multiple North American Gr.2 winner **Naissance Royale** (**Giant's Causeway**). **Al Hakeem** retired as the winner of five of his ten starts and more than £600,000 in prizemoney.

# **ALWUKAIR**

Dream Ahead – Macheera (Machiavellian) FINCA LA SERRETA • Fee €2,400

Following a seven-year spell at Haras de Bouquetot in France, the Gr.1-winning miler and Classic-placed **Al Wukair** (**Dream Ahead**) has relocated to Finca La Serreta in Spain ahead of the 2025 breeding season. A grandson of the Gr.1 Prix de Diane heroine **Caerlina** (**Caerleon**), he is offered to breeders this year at a fee of  $\in$ 2,400.

A 200,000gns purchase at Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, **Al Wukair** was trained by Andre Fabre for Al Shaqab Racing. He was unbeaten in two starts as a two-yearold, including the Listed Prix Isonomy, and went on to defeat the French Champion Two-Year-Old Colt **National Defense** (**Invincible Spirit**) when capturing the Gr.3 Prix Djebel on his comeback as a three-year-old.

An excellent third behind **Churchill** (**Galileo**) in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas at Newmarket on his next start, **Al Wukair** was partnered by Frankie Dettori when beating a high-class field in the Gr.1 Prix Jacques le Marois at Deauville in August of the same year. He retired at the conclusion of that season.

**Al Wukair** made a strong impression with his initial twoyear-old runners in 2021, ending the year as the leading firstcrop sire in France. **Khamma** emerged from that first crop to win at Listed level as a three-year-old, and both the Germantrained **Princess Badee** and the US-based **La Mehana** were winners at Gr.3 level for the sire in 2024.



# **ANGEL BLEU**

Dark Angel – Cercle De La Vie (Galileo) SUMBE • Fee €8,000

A six-year-old son of recently anointed British/Irish Champion Sire **Dark Angel**, **Angel Bleu** is standing his second season under the Sumbe banner at Haras de Montfort et Preaux.

The Ralph Beckett trainee was crowned Joint French Champion Two-Year-Old in 2021 following a remarkable campaign that began in April and ended in October. A trio of minor victories preceded success in Goodwood's Gr.2 Vintage Stakes, with wins in the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere and Gr.1 Criterium International occurring later in the year.

After running creditably in defeat as a three-year-old in races such as the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes, **Angel Bleu** returned to the winner's enclosure at four with victories in the Listed Spring Trophy Stakes and Gr.2 Celebration Mile. He proved an immensely popular addition to the French stallion ranks in 2024, covering over 90 mares.

He is out of the **Galileo** mare **Cercle De La Vie**, a full-sister to the seven-time Gr.1 winner and sire **Highland Reel**, the Australian Gr.1 winner and sire **Cape Of Good Hope** and the Gr.2 Hardwicke Stakes hero and Gr.1-placed sire **Idaho**, amongst others. The second dam, **Hveger** (**Danehill**), was placed at Gr.1 level in Australia, while the Gr.1 Australian Oaks-winning great-grandam, **Circles Of Gold** (**Marscay**), is also responsible for the Gr.1-winning sires **Elvstroem** (**Danehill**) and **Haradasun** (**Fusaichi Pegasus**).



# ARMOR


### No Nay Never – Hestia (High Chaparral) HARAS DE BOUQUETOT • Fee €5,000

With the demand for sons of **No Nay Never** at an all-time high, Haras de Bouquetot's **Armor** provides a good option for breeders at  $\in$ 5,000, particularly after a strong showing in the sales ring from his first crop of yearlings.

A high-class two-year-old for Richard Hannon, **Armor** was precocious enough to beat **El Caballo** (**Havana Gold**) over 5f on his debut and finished fifth in the Listed Windsor Castle Stakes at Royal Ascot on his second start. A win in the Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes at Goodwood followed swiftly afterwards, and he went on to finish fourth in the Gr.1 Prix Morny, second in the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes and third in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes before retiring at the end of the season.

**Armor** has covered at least 70 mares for the past two seasons, and his yearlings realised up to  $\in$ 85,000 last year, including the costliest youngster by a first-season sire at the Arqana v.2 Yearling Sale at Deauville in August. These are impressive returns for yearlings conceived at a fee of  $\in$ 5,000.

He is out of the **High Chaparral** mare **Hestia**, who won over 1600m as a three-year-old in France and was fourth in the Listed Prix Isola Bella. The Listed-placed third dam, **Tadorne (Inchinor**), produced the Gr.2 winner and sire **Pinson (Halling**), while the further family includes the dual Gr.3 winner and sire **Native Khan (Azamour**), who finished third in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas behind **Frankel (Galileo**).

# ARREST

Frankel – Nisriyna (Intikhab) BOARDSMILL STUD • Fee Private

Taking up stallion duties at County Meath's Boardsmill Stud for his first covering season this year is **Frankel**'s Stakeswinning and dual Gr.1-placed five-year-old **Arrest**.

Bred not too far from his new home in County Kildare by Swordlestown Little, he was sourced for €440,000 by Juddmonte at the Goffs November Foal Sale and was sent into training in Newmarket with John and Thady Gosden. He got off the mark at the second attempt during his juvenile campaign with a win in a maiden contest over 1m at Sandown, before following that up with a win in a novice contest at Ffos Las and a close second in the Gr.1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud, beaten only a head by Dubai Mile (Roaring Lion; sire). He then returned for his Classic campaign with an impressive six and a half-length win in the Gr.3 Chester Vase, before winning the Gr.3 Geoffrey Freer Stakes at Newbury over 1m51/2f and finishing the season with a second behind Continuous (Heart's Cry) in the Gr.1 St Leger Stakes at Doncaster, which helped him to be crowned the Champion Three-Year-Old Stayer in Great Britain in 2023.

He is a half-brother the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Hong Kong Gold Cup-placed **Dinozzo** (Lilbourne Lad). They are out of the unraced **Intikhab** mare **Nisriyna**, a half-sister to the dual Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Nassau Stakes and Gr.1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud-placed **Narniyn** (**Dubawi**).

# AWTAAD

Cape Cross – Asheerah (Shamardal) DERRINSTOWN STUD • Fee €7,500

The Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas hero and Shadwell homebred **Awtaad** will begin his ninth season at Derrinstown Stud, with his fee increased to  $\epsilon$ 7,500.

The son of **Cape Cross** got off the mark at the second time of asking at Leopardstown as a two-year-old. The following year, he returned with a five-length success in the Madrid Handicap at the Curragh before he was stepped up in grade and won the Listed Tetrarch Stakes, which was the same route that Coolmore's four-time Gr.1 winner and sire **Paddington** (**Siyouni**) took before he progressed to win Ireland's first Classic of the season. As the impressive two and a half-length winner of the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas, **Awtaad** defeated the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas winner and sire **Galileo Gold** (**Paco Boy**), with Ballydoyle's three-time Gr.1 winner and sire **Air Force Blue** (**War Front**) back in seventh. He then finished third in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes at Royal Ascot, with his final victory in the Gr.2 Boomerang Stakes at Leopardstown.

**Awtaad** is responsible for 11 individual Stakes winners, including five Group winners to date in the Gr.1 Champion Stakes winner **Anmaat**, the three-time Gr.1 winner **Anisette**, the Gr.2 Prix Chaudenay winner **Al Qareem** and Gr.3 winners **Diamil** and **Create Belief**. He is a half-brother to the Listed winner **Mehnah** (**Frankel**).



## BANDE

Authorized – Logica (Priolo) HARAS DU MAZET • Fee €2,500

Top-level Japanese performer **Bande** will stand for a fee of €2,500 in 2025.

The 15-year-old stallion was bred by Kildaragh Stud in Ireland and was sold by Ecurie des Monceaux to Masamichi Hayashi for  $\in$ 140,000 at the Arqana August Yearling Sale in 2011. He was relocated to Japan for his racing career, where he notched up four wins, the best of those a five-length triumph in the Listed Sapporo Nikkei Open as a four-year-old. His best form came in the Gr.1 Kikuka Sho (Japanese St Leger), where he finished third. That renewal of the race was won by the now top Japanese stallion **Epiphaneia** (**Symboli Kris S**). **Bande** was also placed in the Gr.2 Hanshin Daishoten Stakes at four.

He is a son of **Authorized**, whose progeny have excelled over Jumps, with highlights including Grand National Handicap Chase heroes **Tiger Roll** and **I Am Maximus**, as well as the multiple Gr.1-winning hurdler **Nichols Canyon**, Gr.1 Lawlor's of Naas Novice Hurdle winner **Readin Tommy Wrong** and the high-class mare **Echoes In Rain**.

**Bande** is a half-brother to the multiple Gr.1 winner **Doctor Dino** (**Muhtathir**), who has become one of the leading National Hunt stallions in France, siring the likes of **State Man** and **Sharjah** to name just two.

### BANGKOK

Australia – Tanaghum (Darshaan) CHAPEL STUD • Fee £3,000

Beginning his fourth season at Chapel Stud is the Gr.2 York Stakes winner **Bangkok**, who will be available to breeders for a fee of £3,000 this year.

The son of **Australia** won or finished placed in nine Stakes races. As the winner of black-type races in his three, four and five-year-old campaigns, he showed his versatility with success on both turf and the all-weather. As a winner of the Gr.3 Classic Trial on his second start as a three-year-old, he finished runner-up to the subsequent Gr.1 winner and sire Japan (Galileo) in the Gr.2 King Edward VII Stakes at Royal Ascot. He also won the Listed Winter Derby Trial Stakes at Lingfield over two consecutive years.

He is a half-brother to four Stakes winners, which are headed up by the Gr.1 winner Matterhorn (Raven's Pass) and the dual Gr.2 winner and Gr.1-placed The Foxes (Churchill). He is also a half-brother to Mujarah (Marju; dam of the World Champion Three-Year-Old Miler and sire Ribchester). Bangkok's second dam, the Gr.1 Irish 1,000 Guineas winner and Champion Three-Year-Old Mehthaaf (Nureyev), produced the Italian Gr.2 winner Najah (Nashwan), and his third dam Elle Seule (Exclusive Native) produced the Gr.1 July Cup winner and Champion Sprinter Elnadim (Danzig).

He will have his first runners this year.

# **BATED BREATH**

### Dansili – Tantina (Distant View) BANSTEAD MANOR STUD • Fee £8,000

Proven sire **Bated Breath** will be standing at Juddmonte's Banstead Manor Stud for a 13th year this season.

The high-class sprinter won his first three starts in impressive style, but began to show his best form as a fouryear-old. He got the better of the subsequent Gr.1 winner and sire Society Rock (Rock Of Gibraltar) in a conditions race at Haydock, before he landed the Listed Leisure Stakes at Windsor later that month. On his next two starts, he was runner-up to the five-time Gr.1 winner and fellow sire Dream Ahead (Diktat) in the Gr.1 July Cup Stakes and Gr.1 Sprint Cup. The following month, he finished second in Woodbine's Gr.1 Nearctic Stakes. He landed the Gr.2 Temple Stakes the following spring, before he was placed in Gr.1 company again, in both the King's Stand Stakes and the Sprint Cup.

He is a half-brother to the Gr.1 Dubai Duty Free winner Cityscape (Selkirk) and the three-time winner Scuffle (Daylami; dam of the Gr.1 St Leger Stakes winner Logician). He is the sire of multiple Group performers, including the Gr.1 Matriarch Stakes heroine Viadera, Royal Ascot winner and sire Space Traveller and Daahyeh. Bated Breath's yearlings continue to be in good demand at the sales, with his 2024 yearling average over £34,000.

### Lope De Vega – Danaskaya (Danehill) BEARSTONE STUD • Fee £5,500

At Bearstone Stud, the son of **Lope De Vega** will stand his ninth season for a fee of £5,500.

**Belardo** won on debut and followed up with success in the Listed Washington Singer Stakes. He signed off a fruitful twoyear-old campaign in winning the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes, with the subsequent Group winners and sires **Kodi Bear** (**Kodiac**) and **Estidhkaar** (**Dark Angel**) behind him. The following year he was third in the Gr.2 Challenge Stakes at Newmarket when finishing behind the Gr.3 John of Gaunt Stakes winner and sire **Cable Bay** (**Invincible Spirit**), and the Gr.3 Prix de Meautry winner and sire **Coulsty** (**Kodiac**).

**Belardo** then finished runner-up in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes at Ascot, with the subsequent Gr.1 winners and sires **Gleneagles** (**Galileo**) and **Territories** (**Invincible Spirit**) behind. As a four-year-old, he won the Listed Doncaster Mile Stakes, the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes, and was second in the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes, with subsequent Gr.1 Sussex Stakes winner and sire **Lightning Spear** (**Pivotal**) back in third.

**Belardo** is responsible for 13 Stakes winners to date, including the Gr.1 Frank E Kilroe Mile Stakes winner **Gold Phoenix**. He is a half-brother to the dual Gr.3 winner **Berling** (**Montjeu**), out of the Gr.1-placed and Champion Two-Year-Old Filly **Danaskaya** (**Danehill**).

# BELBEK

Showcasing – Bee Queen (Makfi) SUMBE • Fee €6,000

A first homebred Gr.1 winner for Nurlan Bizakov's Sumbe operation when landing the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere in 2022, **Belbek** (**Showcasing**) took up stallion duties last year and covered more than 60 mares. His fee has been trimmed to  $\in$ 6,000 from  $\notin$ 7,000 ahead of the new season.

Trained by Andre Fabre, **Belbek** was so precocious that his trainer deemed him ready for the racecourse in the early April of his juvenile season. Going on to shed his maiden tag at the second attempt, he later won the Gr.3 Prix du Bois in June and the Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere in October to finish the year as the highest-rated French two-year-old colt.

Having held his form throughout the year at two, he went on to repeat the feat at three. Placed in a Classic trial in the April of his 2023 campaign, **Belbek** returned from a spell on the sidelines to win the 1600m Gr.3 Prix Perth in October, with fine efforts in the Gr.1 Prix du Moulin and Gr.2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein also featuring on his record.

The second foal out of a **Makfi** half-sister to the Gr.3 winner and sire **Sangarius** (**Kingman**), **Belbek**'s third dam is the outstanding triple Gr.1 winner **Banks Hill** (**Danehill**; dam of the Gr.1 Prix Jean Romanet winner **Romantica**). The next dam is the incomparable **Hasili** (**Kahyasi**), who produced five different Gr.1 winners on top of the Gr.2 winner and exceptional sire **Dansili** (**Danehill**).

# **BOBBY'S KITTEN**

*Kitten's Joy* – Celestial Woods (Forestry) LANWADES STUD • Fee £5,000

The Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint winner Bobby's Kitten will begin his ninth season at Lanwades Stud for a fee of £5,000.

A winner of six races at two, three and five, as well as Graded Stakes at two and three, **Bobby's Kitten** was trained in the US by Chad Brown. He won two of his first four starts as a juvenile and finished third in the other two, including behind **Outstrip** (**Choisir**) in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf. His victory the following year in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint saw him beat No Nay Never (Scat Daddy; sire). He raced on and landed the Listed Cork Stakes as a five-yearold by eight and a half lengths for new trainer Dermot Weld.

He is a full-brother to the Gr.2 American Turf Stakes and Gr.2 Racing Hall of Fame Stakes winner Camelot Kitten out of the three-time winner Celestial Woods (Forestry). The second dam Celestial Bliss (Relaunch) produced five winners and is the grandam of the three-time Argentinian Gr.1 winner Sixtie's Song (Sixties Icon).

So far at stud, he has sired triple Gr.2 and Gr.3 winner Sandrine, the Gr.2-placed winner Monaasib, the US Gr.3-placed winner Kity Kitana, the Saudi 2,000 Guineas winner **Almotahed**, and the Champion 2yo colt in Hungary Airport and the Champion 2yo filly in Hungary Dark Blue Sky, who both won Hungary's biggest juvenile race, which is a local Gr.2.

# BOUTTEMONT

Acclamation – Basilia (Fastnet Rock) RATHBARRY STUD • Fee €5,000

Beginning his second season at Rathbarry Stud is the Gr.3 Prix de Meautry victor Bouttemont, who is available to breeders for a fee of €5,000.

Purchased for €125,000 at the Argana August Yearling Sale, he was the first son of **Acclamation** to retire to stud in Ireland since Mehmas in 2017. As a two-year-old, he got off the mark at the second time of asking at Longchamp. He then returned to the winner's enclosure at Deauville the following year, before recording back-to-back wins at the beginning of the 2022 season. He added further Stakes success to his CV when winning the Listed Prix Hampton in a time of 56.18 seconds and was unlucky not to get a clear run in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp, where he was beaten four just lengths. He ended his career by finishing runner-up in the Gr.3 Mercury Stakes at Dundalk.

He is a half-brother to two other winners out of the Fastnet Rock winning mare Basilia, who is a half-sister to the two-time Gr.3 winner and triple Gr.1-placed Baghadur (Zanzibari; also known as Joyful Trinity in Hong Kong).

Bouttemont covered 81 mares in his first season, including 13 black-type performers, 11 black-type producers and half-sisters to Gr.1 winners Mad Cool and Zafisio, amongst others.

# BRADSELL

 Tasleet – Russian Punch (Archipenko)

 NATIONAL STUD • Fee £10,000

New to the National Stud for the 2025 covering season is **Bradsell**, who is available at a fee of  $\pm 10,000$ .

At two, the son of **Tasleet** won the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot on just his second start, beating subsequent Gr.1 winner and sire **Blackbeard** (No Nay Never), as well as the Gr.1-placed and sire Persian Force (Mehmas). At three, he finished third in the Gr.3 Commonwealth Cup Trial Stakes and the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes, before becoming the first three-year-old to win the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes in 15 years. In doing so, he defeated the multiple Gr.1 winner Highfield Princess (Night Of Thunder). He returned with success in the Listed Prix du Cercle at Deauville the following year, before winning the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes at York, with Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Starlust (Zoustar), King's Stand Stakes winner Asfoora (Flying Artie), Gr.1 Prix l'Abbaye de Longchamp winner Makarova de (Acclamation) and the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint winner **Big Evs** (**Blue Point**) all in behind. He then went on to win the Gr.1 Flying Five Stakes at the Curragh and in doing so, was the fastest winner of the race since it moved to there in 2002.

He is out of the Listed Radley Stakes winner **Russian Punch** (**Archipenko**).



# **BUNGLE INTHEJUNGLE**

Exceed And Excel – Licence To Thrill (Wolfhound) RATHASKER STUD • Fee €7,500

After another good year in the sales ring and on the track, **Bungle Inthejungle** remains available to Irish breeders at Rathasker Stud, where he has stood since retiring in 2015, for a fee of  $\in$ 7,500

One of the only sons of **Exceed And Excel** left at stud in the Northern Hemisphere, he has proven similar to his esteemed sire in becoming a reliable source of juvenile runners and winners. A busy two-year-old himself, he made nine starts at two, winning four of them, including the Gr.3 Cornwallis Stakes and the Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes, both over the minimum trip. Passing on his own precocity, he earned his first victory in May after making an April debut, he is the sire of 93 individual two-year-old winners, ten of whom are Stakes winners. He is also an excellent source of speed, with most of his best progeny excelling over sprint trips. His best progeny to date include the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes winner Winter Power, the Gr.2 Lowther Stakes winner Living In The Past and the two-time Gr.3 winner Givemethebeatbovs. also placed in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes as a juvenile at the Curragh. His sire son Rumble Inthejungle emulated him in winning the Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes.

He is a half-brother to the Gr.1 Golden Shaheen winner **Muarrab** (**Oasis Dream**) and a full-brother to the Listed winner **Waveband**.

# CANTOCORALE

*Helmet* – Conservatoire (Street Cry) AZIENDA AGRICOLA ANTEZZATE SRL • Fee €3,000

Multiple Italian champion **Cantocorale** will make his debut at Azienda Agricola Antezzate in Lombardy this year.

The seven-year-old son of **Helmet** was a star performer in Italy over five seasons. A useful sort as a two-year-old, he progressed the following year to win a pair of Listed races and the Gr.3 Premio Ribot, beating a host of international Group race winners in the latter contest. That earned him the title of Champion Three-Year-Old Miler in Italy and he further earned championship honours at four when triumphing three times at Gr.2 level over 1800m - 2000m, again with multiple Group winners in behind each time.

Although unable to win again the following year, he was still crowned Champion Older Male in Italy in 2023, notably finishing third to the Gr.1 winner **Skalleti** (**Kendargent**) in the Gr.2 Premio Presidente della Repubblica.

**Cantocorale** is a half-brother to the Japanese Gr.3 winner **Territorial** (**Teofilo**) and out of an unraced **Street Cry** halfsister to the Gr.3 Prix du Lys winner **Claremont** (**Sadler's Wells**). The second dam is the Gr.1 Prix Vermeille heroine **Mezzo Soprano** (**Darshaan**) and the family extends to the outstanding Canadian champion **Glorious Song** (**Halo**), dam of the Gr.2 winner and champion sire **Rahy** (**Blushing Groom**) and the multiple international Gr.1 winner and successful sire **Singspiel** (**In The Wings**).

# CATURRA

Mehmas – Shoshoni Wind (Sleeping Indian) OVERBURY STUD • Fee £5,000

The Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes winner **Caturra** will stand his third season at Overbury Stud for a fee of £5,000.

He was Britain's most profitable freshman sire at the foal sales, after **Baaeed**, in 2024. His median price was exactly the same as his sire's first foal median. Quite something considering that horse is **Mehmas**. Buyers included Richard Brown, Joe Foley and Eddie O'Leary.

**Caturra** was a 110,000gns Tattersalls October Yearling Sale Book 2 purchase by Blandford Bloodstock from Tally-Ho Stud and shed his maiden tag at the second time of asking at Bath. He went on to win the Listed Rose Bowl Stakes at Newbury, then defeated the Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes victor and Gr.1placed sire **Armor** (**No Nay Never**) in the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes over 5f at Doncaster – running a particularly fast time, faster than recent winners **Big Evs** and **Aesterius**, and all the other Flying Childers winners at stud, including his Overbury roster mate **Ardad**. As a three-year-old, he finished runnerup in the Gr.3 Prix Sigy, before taking on his elders in the Gr.2 King George Stakes, where he finished third, behind the subsequent dual Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Stakes winner **Khaadem** (**Dark Angel**). and in a faster time than Battaash won the previous year's running.

He is from the family of the Gr.1 Prix Vermeille and Gr.1 Yorkshire Oaks heroine and champion **My Emma** (**Marju**) and the dual Gr.1 winner **AI Riffa** (**Wootton Bassett**).

Coincidence... or prophecy? His first foals exactly matched MEHMAS's first-crop foal median.

**Century Dream** will stand his fourth season at Norton Grove Stud for an unchanged fee of  $\pm 3,000$ , with his first crop now two-year-olds.

There are few stallions in the £3,000 or under bracket that can compete with March Hare Stud's **Charming Thought** when it comes to racing record, pedigree and proven accomplishments at stud.

The 13-year-old is the highest-rated son of **Oasis Dream** currently standing in Britain and had the same sire's champion **Muhaarar** back in third when winning the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes for Charlie Appleby. A 625,000gns Tattersalls Book 1 purchase as a yearling, he is one of seven winners out of the Listed heroine **Annabelle's Charm** (**Indian Ridge**) and hails from the family of Gr.1-winning sires **Starborough** (**Soviet Star**), **Ballingarry** and **Aristotle** (both by **Sadler's Wells**).

The Listed-placed winner **Different Illusion** and unbeaten sales race hero **Lightning Warrior** are among the other horses to have demonstrated that **Charming Thought** can deliver high-quality offspring at an inexpensive fee, and he has plenty more exciting progeny still to come.

Darley sire **Cloth Of Stars** has relocated to Haras de Montaigu for the 2025 breeding season and will begin life at his new stud at a reduced fee of €4,000.

An impeccably bred son of **Sea The Stars**, **Cloth Of Stars** was trained by Andre Fabre to win the Gr.3 Prix des Chenes at two and five more times in Pattern company at three and four, his most notable success coming in the 2017 Gr.1 Prix Ganay. He was also placed in consecutive renewals of the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe behind **Enable** (**Nathaniel**).

His first crop appeared during the 2022 season and included the dual Listed winner and multiple Gr.2-placed **Birr Castle** and the useful Flat handicapper and Gr.3-placed hurdler **Laafi**. Better was to come with the sire's second crop, which includes five black-type earners and counting, most notably the Gr.3 Ballysax Stakes winner **Dallas Star**. Andre Fabre's unbeaten maiden winner **Indalimos** is among the three-year-olds that promise to add weight to the sire's reputation this season.

**Cloth Of Stars** is out of the **Kingmambo** mare **Strawberry Fledge**, a full-sister to the Gr.1 Oaks winner **Light Shift** (dam of the dual Gr.1 winner and sire **Ulysses**) and a half-sister to the Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup winner **Shiva** (**Hector Protector**). This is the family of the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf winner and Gr.1 Derby second **Main Sequence** (Aldebaran).

After a break, he finished second at Chester before being placed third in the Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes. He then won two races on the bounce, namely the valuable £300,000 Weatherbys 2YO Stakes at Doncaster and the Listed Two Year Old Trophy at Redcar, which was his first Stakes success. The following year he defeated the top-class sprinter and fellow new sire **Bradsell** (**Tasleet**) in the Commonwealth Cup Trial Stakes. He was also placed third in the Gr.3 Hackwood Stakes at Newbury and fourth in the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville.

He is out of the **Dream Ahead** mare **Killermont Street**, a half-sister to the Gr.3 Cornwallis Stakes winner **Ponty Acclaim** (**Acclamation**). They are out of **Leopard Creek** (**Weldnaas**), who is a full-sister to the Listed-winning and Champion Older Male Sprinter **Astonished** and a half-sister to the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed **Bishop's Court** (**Clantime**).



Bred by Peter and Sarah Fortune and initially in training with Richard Hannon Senior, **Coulsty** made a winning debut as a juvenile over 5f at Leicester. The training licence was then switched to Richard Hannon and **Coulsty** began his three-year-old season with a win in the Listed King Charles II Stakes over 7f at Newmarket, before going on to win the Gr.3 Prix de Meautry over 1200m at Deauville. As a four-year-old he added another Stakes win to his name in the form of the Listed King Richard III Stakes over 7f at Leicester, before finishing a close second behind **Adaay** (**Kodiac**; sire) in the Gr.2 Hungerford Stakes at Newbury.

He is already the sire of nine Flat Stakes winners and placed horses, including the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup Stakes winner **Shantisara** and Gr.3 Princess Margaret Stakes winner **Santosha**. His yearlings in 2024 reached a high of  $\in$ 80,000, 20 times his covering fee at that time.

He is out of the three-time winner **Hazium** (**In The Wings**) and this is the family of the Gr.1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Stakes and dual Gr.1 Eclipse Stakes winner and Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe-placed sire **Mtoto** (**Busted**).


Teofilo – Desidera (Shaadi) MARCH HARE STUD • Fee £1,500

A performer in both codes, **Diplomat** was bred by Gestüt Röttgen and raced under the ownership of Eckhard Sauren, having been picked up for €55,000 at the BBAG Premier Yearling Sale.

Under the tutelage of Mario Hofer, he notched up a number of placed efforts in Group company at four. They came not least in Baden-Baden's Gr.2 Oettingen-Rennen, where he finished third to the subsequent Gr.1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp winner and sire **Vadamos** (**Monsun**).

At five, he delivered a three-length triumph in Capannelle's Gr.2 Premio Presidente della Repubblica, while at seven, then in the care of Jean-Pierre Carvalho, he added Cologne's Gr.2 Meilen Trophy to his CV. The son of **Teofilo** ran three times over obstacles in France for Carina Fey, winning his 3600m jumps debut at Auteuil.

The now 14-year-old is out of the Gr.3 Grosser Preis von Berlin heroine **Desidera** (**Shaadi**) and is a half-brother to both the Listed winner and Gr.1 Deutsches Derby runner-up **Dickens** (**Kallisto**) and the Listed victor **Daressalam** (**Singspiel**). He is also a half-brother to the winning dams of the NH Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed **Sancta Simona** (**Saddex**), the Listed winner **Mozart** (**Dream Ahead**) and the winner and Gr.2-placed **Desirao** (**Acatenango**).



# **DRAGON SYMBOL**

Cable Bay – Arcamist (Arcano) WHITSBURY MANOR STUD • Fee £8,000

Standing his second season at Whitsbury Manor Stud is **Dragon Symbol**, who is available to breeders at a fee of  $\pounds 8,000$ .

Purchased for 67,000gns at Book 3 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, the son of **Cable Bay** won his first three starts on the all-weather and showed his versatility when winning a conditions race on the turf at Hamilton Park on his next start. Three weeks later he finished runner-up in the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes and was first past the post in the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup, before later being demoted to second. On two of his next four starts, he was further placed in Gr.1 company, in both the July Cup Stakes and Nunthorpe Stakes. The following year he finished second in the Nifty Fifty Achilles Stakes, before returning to the winner's enclosure in another conditions event at Hamilton.

He is a half-brother to the Listed-placed winner **Symbol Of Honour** (Havana Grey) out of the Arcano winning mare **Arcamist**. She is a half-sister to the Listed winners **Oasis Dancer** (**Oasis Dream**) and **Smart Enough** (**Cadeaux Genereux**), out of the Listed winner and Gr.1 (then) Prix Saint-Alary third **Good Enough** (**Mukaddamah**).

He covered a full book of 140 mares in his first season and will welcome his first foals this year.

The five-time Gr.1 winner **Dream Ahead** will stand for a fee of £6,500 in 2025.

After winning his debut by nine lengths at Nottingham, the son of **Diktat** was stepped up to Gr.1 company on his second start to win the Prix Morny and rounded off a stellar two-yearold campaign by adding the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes before the season end. The following year he had the measure of the Gr.2 Temple Stakes winner and sire **Bated Breath** (**Dansili**) when winning the Gr.1 July Cup at Newmarket.

Dream Ahead then went on to win the Gr.1 Sprint Cup at Haydock, with **Bated Breath** taking second once again. Following a single season at Manton Park Stud, the Gr.1winning juvenile and Roaring Lion's sole stallion son, Dubai Mile, has moved to Coolagown Stud in County Cork for 2025. His fee has been reduced from £7,500 to €4,000.

Inexpensively sourced but nonetheless extremely wellrelated, **Dubai Mile** was trained by Charlie and Mark Johnston during an excellent two-year-old season. He won novice contests over 1m at Windsor and Kempton before finishing a narrow second in the Gr.2 Royal Lodge Stakes at Newmarket, then relished the step up to 2000m when winning the Gr.1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud from future Gr.1 St Leger runner-up and fellow sire Arrest (Frankel).

An excellent fifth in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas when dropped back to 1m on his three-year-old return, Dubai Mile was unplaced in the Gr.1 Derby and fourth in the Gr.2 King Edward VII Stakes before a minor injury curtailed his racing career. He covered a relatively modest book of mares in his debut season last year but has been promised support from his new stud and original racing owner, Ahmad Al Shaikh.

Bred by the late Lady O'Reilly's Skymarc Farm, Dubai Mile is out of the Listed-winning and Gr.1-placed High Chaparral mare **Beach Bunny**, making him a half-brother to the Listed winners Naadirr (Oasis Dream) and Beach Belle (Invincible Spirit; dam of the Australian Gr.2 winner Surf Dancer).

# **EL CABALLO**

Havana Gold – Showstoppa (Showcasing) CULWORTH GROUNDS FARM • Fee £5,000

The Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes hero El Caballo will stand his second season at Culworth Grounds Farm for a reduced fee of £5,000.

A £30,000 Goffs UK Premier Yearling Sale graduate, he finished runner-up to the subsequent Gr.3 Molecomb Stakes winner and sire Armor (No Nay Never) on his debut, before winning a novice event next time out. The son of Havana Gold ran up a sequence of six consecutive victories, which culminated in victory in the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes, and included wins in both the Listed Spring Cup Stakes and the valuable Three-Year-Old All-Weather Championships Stakes. As a four-year-old, he finished third in the Gr.3 John of Gaunt Stakes at Haydock, a race in which he was denied a clear run on several occasions.

As the only other stallion to stand at stud by Havana Gold, the other being Whitsbury Manor Stud's Havana Grey, his career-high rating of 112 puts him just one pound behind his contemporary. He is a half-brother to the 2023 Gr.2 Lowther Stakes third Symbology and the Italian Listed winner Avengers Queen (Brazen Beau). They are out of Showstoppa (Showcasing), the four-time winning halfsister to the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes winner Temple Meads (Avonbridge) and the Gr.3 Firth of Clyde Stakes-placed Sneak Preview (Monsieur Bond).

The son of **Dubawi** won by five lengths on his only start at two for Roger Varian before then winning his first two starts at three, including the Gr.2 Queen's Vase at Royal Ascot. He then went on to win the Gr.1 St Leger by two lengths and followed up in the Irish equivalent the following year, where he beat star stayer **Kyprios** (**Galileo**) by three and a half lengths. He ended his career with over £1m in prize money, beating other Stakes winners such as **Haskoy** (**Golden Horn**), **New London** (**Dubawi**), **Giavellotto** (**Mastercraftsman**) and **Courage Mon Ami** (**Frankel**).

A £480,000 breeze-up purchase, he is sure to prove popular with breeders, especially when you consider his blue-blooded family. Bred by Kirsten Rausing, he is a halfbrother to the Gr.3 winner **Kingswood** (**Roaring Lion**), out of the multiple Listed winner **All At Sea** (**Sea The Stars**), a daughter of the multiple Gr.1 heroine and successful broodmare **Albanova** (**Alzao**). This is the family of a vast array of Stakes winners, headed by **Algometer**, **Alpinista** and **Alborada**.

With a tremendous racing record and outstanding pedigree, **Erevann** was extraordinarily well received when making his debut at Haras de Bonneval in 2024, but breeders can continue to avail of his services at a fee of  $\in$ 8,000 this year.

A son of the exceptional sire of sires **Dubawi** and out of **Siyouni**'s three-time Gr.1 heroine **Ervedya**, **Erevann** brought a pedigree of rare quality when entering training with Jean-Claude Rouget. He won his only start at two over 1600m at Deauville - defeating the future Gr.1 winners **Tribalist (Farhh)** and **Simca Mille (Tamayuz)** in the process - and also made a winning comeback in the spring of his three-year-old campaign.

He continued to mix it at a high level as a four-year-old, proving his stamina for 1950m when third in the Gr.2 Prix Dollar.

Retired at the end of the 2023 season, **Erevann** went on to cover 168 mares last year, making him the third-busiest Flat sire in France. With his illustrious parentage and a pedigree free of **Sadler's Wells** blood, this competitively priced sire is sure to garner much attention again this time around.

A 150,000gns breeze-up buy, **Go Bears Go** demonstrated immediate promise for trainer David Loughnane when making a winning debut over 5f at Ascot in the May of his two-year-old season. He soon returned to the same track for the Royal Meeting, finishing a head second to **Perfect Power (Ardad)** in the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes, and then won the Gr.2 Railway Stakes when upped to 6f on his third start.

**Go Bears Go** underlined his status as a high-class juvenile when third in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes and second in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint, before proving he had trained on at three by winning both the Gr.3 Pavilion Stakes at Ascot and the Gr.3 Phoenix Sprint Stakes at the Curragh. A spell in the US would follow, but he ultimately ended his career back at the same stable at which he started.

He is out of the two-year-old winner In Dubai (Giant's Causeway), whose dual Gr.1-winning half-sister Nahrain (Selkirk) has gone on to produce the Gr.1 1,000 Guineas heroine Elmalka (Kingman) and the triple Gr.1 winner and sire Benbatl (Dubawi). Blessed with a potent blend of precocity and pedigree, Go Bears Go is a young sire to note.

Sumbe's Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup hero **Golden Horde** made a steady start with his first crop of two-year-olds in 2024 and is available at a fee of  $\notin$ 4,000 this year. The son of **Lethal Force** is standing his fifth season at Haras de Montfort et Preaux and enjoyed a major pedigree update last year.

Trained by Clive Cox, **Golden Horde** won the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes and was placed twice in Gr.1 company during a productive juvenile campaign. He went on to win the Commonwealth Cup at Royal Ascot without a prep run, staying on powerfully to beat American Gr.1 winner **Kimari** (**Munnings**) by a length and a half, and arguably ran to an even higher level when third in the Gr.1 July Cup and Gr.1 Sprint Cup against his elders later in his three-year-old year.

Following a strong showing at the 2023 yearling sales, **Golden Horde** welcomed his first winner when **Moorea** won at Aix-les-Bains last July. Better was to follow with Sumbe homebred **Dos Mukasan**, twice a winner from three starts and fourth in the Gr.3 Prix Thomas Bryon, and the sire ended the year with a creditable total of seven individual winners from a relatively small pool of runners.

Also responsible for Listed winners by **Dutch Art** and **Mehmas**, **Golden Horde**'s dam **Entreat** (**Pivotal**) became a dual Gr.1 producer when **Camille Pissarro** (**Wootton Bassett**) won the Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere in October.

World Champion sprinter **Harry Angel** (**Dark Angel**) has generated some impressive statistics since his first runners emerged during the 2022 season.

He continued to deliver the goods with his most recent crop of two-year-olds, producing the Italian Gr.3 winner **Hanting** and the £500k Goffs sales race winner **Diligently**.

Bred by CBS Bloodstock, **Harry Angel** broke his maiden in the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes as a two-year-old and was rated the best sprinter in the world after winning the Gr.1 July Cup and Gr.1 Haydock Sprint Cup at three. Also a Gr.2 winner and Gr.1-placed at four, he is a half-brother to fellow Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes winner **Pierre Lapin** (**Cappella Sansevero**).

Gr.1 Man O'War Stakes winner **Highland Chief** is a new addition to the French stallion ranks for 2025 and has been introduced to breeders at a fee of  $\in 2,500$ .

A Jim and Fitri Hay homebred, the son of **Gleneagles** was sent into training with Paul and Oliver Cole, and won on his juvenile debut over 5f at Newbury. He was then stepped up to 7f and was placed third in a high-class renewal of the Listed Chesham Stakes at Royal Ascot, where he found only future sires Pinatubo (Shamardal) and Lope Y Fernandez (Lope De Vega) too good. He won a 1m2f Ascot handicap at three, before finishing runner-up to top-class rivals Mogul (Galileo; sire) and Pyledriver (Harbour Watch; sire) in the Gr.3 Gordon Stakes and the Gr.2 Great Voltigeur Stakes respectively. He ended that season with a third-place finish in the Gr.3 Cumberland Lodge Stakes at York. Switched to the yard of Graham Motion as a fiveyear-old, he earned a top-level breakthrough in the Man O'War Stakes at Belmont Park, with Charlie Appleby's talented gelding Yibir (Dubawi) in behind that day, and also won the Gr.3 Sycamore Stakes at Keeneland. A versatile performer, he can boast victories at trips ranging from 5f to 1m4f. He is out of the Gr.3 Give Thanks Stakes victrix Pink Symphony (Montjeu) and hails from the prestigious Blue Note (Habitat) dam line. This suggests he can pass on speed and ability to Flat-bred mares.

Zafonic – Pastorale (Nureyev) DALHAM HALL STUD • Fee £10,000

**Iffraaj** might be the elder statesman amongst the Darley stallion contingent, but the 24-year-old proved that he is still a force to be reckoned with by adding two new individual Gr.1 winners to his record during the 2024 Flat season.

Best known as the sire of four-time Gr.1-winning European champion miler **Ribchester** and unbeaten Gr.1-winning champion two-year-old and sire **Wootton Bassett**, the son of **Zafonic** enjoyed renewed success at the highest level when **Audience** sprung a surprise in the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes at Newbury last May and **Grail Seeker** triumphed in the Gr.1 Tarzino Trophy in New Zealand. The last-named became the sire's 13th individual winner at the highest level and has already won another Gr.1 since the turn of the year.

A Darley homebred who raced predominantly in the silks of Sheikh Ahmed Al Maktoum, **Iffraaj** progressed through the handicap ranks to win the Gr.2 Park Stakes as a four-yearold. He lost out in a photo-finish in the following season's 6f Gr.1 July Cup before ending his career with another brace of Gr.2 wins, including a second success in the Park Stakes.

A full-brother to the Gr.3 winner **Kareymah** and a halfbrother to the Gr.3 winner **Farraaj** (**Dubai Destination**), he is out of a winning half-sister to the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes winner and celebrated sire **Cape Cross** (**Green Desert**).



# **ISAAC SHELBY**

**Night Of Thunder** – Kentucky Belle (Heliostatic) NEWSELLS PARK STUD • Fee £7,000

The Gr.2 Superlative Stakes winner Isaac Shelby is new to Newsells Park Stud in 2025 and will stand for a fee of £7,000.

A winner at two on debut at Newbury, he went on to win the Gr.2 Superlative Stakes by the narrowest of margins. A year older and stronger, he returned to Newbury, where he added the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes, with last season's threetime Gr.1 winner, champion and new sire Charyn (Dark Angel) finishing second. It was an eye-catching performance, enough to attract big spenders Wathnan Racing, for whom he raced for the remainder of his career.

He then travelled to France and was beaten a short neck in a deep Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains field, where he had the subsequent Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat winner and sire Good Guess (Kodiac) behind him. He was runner-up on two more occasions in Group company, the Gr.2 Lennox Stakes and the Gr.2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein, with the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere winner and sire Belbek (Showcasing) beaten a neck into third.

Isaac Shelby is the first son of Night Of Thunder to retire to stud and is a half-brother to one other winner. He is out of the unraced mare Kentucky Belle (Heliostatic), a half-sister to the Gr.2 Mac Diarmida Handicap winner Ramazutti (Honor Grades).

Few stallions at a fee of €10k or under are able to match Japan when it comes to pedigree and performance, so his first-crop runners are awaited with great anticipation this year.

The son of Galileo was the winner of the Gr.2 Beresford Stakes as a juvenile and a narrow third in the Gr.1 Derby at three, following an interrupted preparation. He would go on to dominate much of the rest of the 2019 season, winning the Gr.2 King Edward VII Stakes, Gr.1 Grand Prix de Paris and Gr.1 Juddmonte International Stakes, before concluding his campaign with a fourth in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe.

Although he did not win again in Gr.1 company, he remained a force at the highest level for the rest of his career, winning twice in Pattern company as a five-year-old.

Considered a coup for German breeding when joining Etzean due to his feted bloodline, Japan is a full-brother to the dual Gr.1 winner and sire **Mogul** and the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1 Oaks second Secret Gesture. They are out of the Listedplaced Shastye (Danehill), a half-sister to the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner and sire Sagamix (Linamix) and the juvenile Gr.1 winner and sire Sagacity (Highest Honor).

Japan covered a classy initial book of mares, and his first yearlings sold for up to €140,000. They are housed with many top trainers and promise to give him a strong start.

One of a select number of sons of the influential sire of sires **Scat Daddy** currently standing in Europe, US Gr.3 winner **Legends Of War** offers breeders an exciting economy option at Groomsbridge Stud in Norfolk.

Top lot at the 2018 Tattersalls Craven Breeze-Up Sale, where he realised 900,000gns to Stephen Hillen, **Legends Of War** went on to win a 6f Yarmouth novice by four lengths on his debut. He maintained a smart level of form throughout his juvenile season, also winning a Newbury novice and finishing second in the Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes. Switched from the Newmarket stable of John Gosden to the California barn of Doug O'Neill ahead of his three-year-old campaign, he gained his most high-profile victory in the Gr.3 (then) Franklin-Simpson Stakes over 61/2f at Kentucky Downs.

Among the first sons of **Scat Daddy** to stand in Britain when retired in time for the 2021 breeding season, **Legends Of War** was represented by a handful of first-crop runners last year and celebrated his first winner when **Titos Plemm** triumphed over 1400m in Italy in November.

A fast and precocious sprinter yet related to middledistance luminaries such as **Helene Charisma** (Air Chief Marshal) and Pyledriver (Harbour Watch), Legends Of War possesses a compelling profile for an affordable stallion.

He was further placed in the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes and the Gr.1 Sussex Stakes, before winning the Celebration Mile for the second consecutive year. In his final season on the track he won the Gr.1 Sussex Stakes, beating the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Mile winner and sire Expert Eye (Acclamation) in the process.

Lightning Spear's first crop of runners had a 75 per cent strike rate of winners to runners. He is also the sire of a collection of Stakes performers, plus six-time winner Atlantic Gamble, four-time winners Royal Velvet and Charlie's Choice and the three-time winners Umming N' Ahing and Destiny's Spirit, amongst others.

The Classic-placed **Lone Eagle** will begin his second season at stud for a fee of €2,000.

Purchased for 500,000gns at Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, the son of **Galileo** was beaten a head on his debut, but soon got off the mark on his second start when prevailing over 1m at Goodwood. He then won a 1m Doncaster handicap before going on to win the Gr.3 Zetland Stakes at Newmarket. The following year he defeated the top-class **Yibir** (**Dubawi**) in the Listed Cocked Hat Stakes at Newmarket and ran a fine race in the Gr.1 Irish Derby, where he finished just a neck behind the three-time Gr.1 winner and sire **Hurricane Lane** (**Frankel**). As a four-year-old he was placed in the Listed Tapster Stakes, and at five he finished runner-up in the Gr.3 Ormonde Stakes and third in the Listed Chester Stakes.

He is out of the Listed Ladies Marathon Stakes winner and Gr.3 Dowager Stakes third **Modernstone** (**Duke Of Marmalade**), who is a half-sister to the Listed Prix Isola Bella winner **Chasing Stars** (**Observatory**). They are out of the unraced **Post Modern** (**Nureyev**), a full-sister to the Gr.1 Fillies' Mile and Gr.1 Oaks winner and Champion Two-Year-Old Filly **Reams Of Verse**.

Lone Eagle will welcome his first foals this year.


# LOPE Y FERNANDEZ

Beginning his fourth season at the National Stud is European Champion Three-Year-Old Sprinter **Lope Y Fernandez** for a reduced fee of £7,500.

The son of **Lope De Vega** made a winning debut for the Ballydoyle team and the Coolmore partners at the Curragh, before finishing runner-up to the European Champion Two-Year-Old **Pinatubo** (**Shamardal**) in the Listed Chesham Stakes at Royal Ascot. After finishing third in the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes on his next start, he returned back to the winner's enclosure after success in the Gr.3 Round Tower Stakes. As a three-year-old he was placed in the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas, Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat, Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest and the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Mile. The following year he won the Listed Heritage Stakes, before producing another Gr.1-placed effort in the Queen Anne Stakes when runner-up to **Palace Pier (Kingman**).

The half-brother to the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes and Gr.2 Oettingen-Rennen winner **Dark Vision** (**Dream Ahead**) has made a promising start to life at stud, covering over 400 mares in his first three seasons, with four of his yearlings realising prices such as  $\in$ 175,000, 140,000gns and  $\in$ 125,000. He will have his first runners this year.

### Mehmas – Diaminda (Diamond Green) HARAS DE BOUQUETOT • Fee €5,000

The exceptionally fast sprinter/miler **Lusail** will stand his second season at Haras de Bouquetot for  $\in$ 5,000 this year.

A son of another high-class two-year-old turned successful sire in **Mehmas**, he made his debut in the May of his two-year-old season where he got off the mark at the first attempt. He went on to win the 6f Gr.2 July Stakes two months later and followed that up with a win in the 6f Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes in August. He finished his juvenile season as the winner of four of his six starts and having also been placed once.

He trained on at three and despite not getting his head in front at Group level, he arguably improved his form, getting to within a head of winning the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes over 1m before stepping down a furlong in trip to finish third in the Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat, where he got the better of five-time Gr.1 winner **Modern Games**.

Described as a "tough and consistent horse who excelled at the highest level at three" by Benoit Jeffroy, and as "one of the most straightforward and relaxed speed machines that I have ever trained" by Richard Hannon, **Lusail** is out of the juvenile winner **Diaminda** (**Diamond Green**) and descends from a fine family, headed by the Gr.1 Golden Jubilee Stakes winner **Fayr Jag** (**Fayruz**).

# **MAGNA GRECIA**

Invincible Spirit – Cabaret (Galileo) MARCH HARE STUD • Fee £5,500

Of his racing exploits, it is the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas triumph for which **Magna Grecia** (**Invincible Spirit**) is perhaps most remembered, seeing off **King Of Change** (**Farhh**; sire) by two and a half lengths, **Madhmoon** (**Dawn Approach**; sire) and **Ten Sovereigns** (**No Nay Never**; sire) both finishing further down the field. He also, however, claimed the Gr.1 Vertem Futurity Trophy Stakes at two, fellow sire **Phoenix Of Spain** (**Lope De Vega**) his runner-up that day.

It is five years since **Magna Grecia** began stud duties at Coolmore, but he will stand under a new banner this year at March Hare Stud, Suffolk.

The nine-year-old's first crop of two-year-olds recorded a 20 per cent strike rate in 2023, with 12 winners from 59 runners, while last year saw his overall strike rate increase to 31 per cent, or 34 winners from 110 runners. Francois Monfort's **Myconian** led the charge at two, the now four-year-old victorious in Deauville's Listed Prix Yacowlef, the same year Mario Hofer's **Thekingofmyheart** came home second in a Düsseldorf Listed race. Down Under, **Magna Memory** has run in a series of New Zealand Listed contests, finishing third in Pukekohe's Champagne Stakes last year.

Out of the Gr.3 Silver Flash Stakes victrix **Cabaret** (**Galileo**), he is a half-brother to the multiple Gr.1 victor and sire **St Mark's Basilica** (**Siyouni**).

# **MAKE BELIEVE**

Makfi – Rosie's Posy (Suave Dancer) BALLYLINCH STUD • Fee €8,000

Ballylinch Stud's Classic-winning and Classic-producing sire **Make Believe** enters his tenth year at stud at a career-low fee of  $\in$  8,000. He appears to offer exceptional value following another highly productive campaign in 2024.

Best known as the sire of Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club winner and now sire **Mishriff** from his first crop, **Make Believe** enjoyed his best-ever season with juveniles last year. The Waldemar Hickst-trained **Lazio** is unbeaten in three outings, including a Listed race in Germany and the Gr.2 Premio Gran Criterium in Italy (which he won by eight lengths), while Endo Botti's **Klaynn** won the Gr.2 Premio Dormello on the same San Siro card to also take her record to three wins from three starts.

Trained by Andre Fabre for Prince A A Faisal, **Make Believe** was unbeaten in two runs as a two-year-old and won the 1600m Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains on his second start at three, beating current studmate **New Bay** (**Dubawi**) by three lengths. He also won the Gr.1 Prix de la Foret when dropped to 1400m later that year.

He is a half-brother to the dual US Gr.1 heroine and multiple Stakes producer **Dubawi Heights** (**Dubawi**) and out of **Rosie's Posy** (**Suave Dancer**), a winning half-sister to the Gr.1 Sprint Cup winner **Tante Rose** (**Barathea**).

# **MASTER CARPENTER**

Mastercraftsman – Fringe (In The Wings) MARCH HARE STUD • Fee £1,500

**Master Carpenter** was a remarkably tough, talented and versatile performer on the track, and the early evidence is that he is transmitting similar qualities to his progeny.

A 5f debut winner as a juvenile and from the family of multiple Gr.1-winning sire **Pinatubo** (**Shamardal**), he displayed rapid progression early on in his three-year-old campaign. He finished third behind **Kingman** (**Invincible Spirit**) in the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes and went on to win the Listed Heron Stakes at Sandown by seven lengths and the 1800m Gr.3 Prix Daphnis at Chantilly, as well as taking third in the Gr.2 Prix Eugene Adam over 2000m.

Having improved by more than a stone from two to three, **Master Carpenter** would enjoy another stellar campaign as a four-year-old, winning the prestigious John Smith's Cup Handicap at York and taking second in the Gr.3 Rose of Lancaster Stakes. He earned further Group placings at five and was winning races all the way up to the age of seven.

The only Flat-orientated son of **Mastercraftsman** standing in Britain, he has had five winners so far at a superb 56 per cent winners to runners strike rate. His best runner to date is **The Craftymaster**, a seven-time winner from 21 starts, who provides tangible proof that **Master Carpenter** can deliver the goods when afforded the opportunity.

Standing his second season at Norton Grove Stud **Mattmu** has already produced the Listed Criterium de Vitesse second **Favourite Child**, as well as the six-time winner **Matty Too**, and is available to breeders at a fee of  $\pounds$ 2,000 in 2025.

The son of **Indesatchel** won four times as a two-yearold, including the Gr.2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte, where he defeated the dual Gr.3 winner and sire **Goken** (**Kendargent**), which came just a month after he had won the Listed Rockingham Stakes at York. Trained by Tim Easterby, he began his three-year-old season with a narrow defeat in the Gr.2 Duke of York Stakes, before he travelled over to Ireland in August and won the Gr.3 Phoenix Sprint Stakes at the Curragh. He was further placed in the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes at York and the Gr.3 Abernant Stakes at Newmarket. He signed off his racing career with victory at Ripon in the Great St Wilfrid Handicap.

He is one of four winners out of **Katie Boo** (**Namid**), a halfsister to the Listed winner **Maldron Prom** (**Kheleyf**; also known as **Super Alloy** in Macau) and the Listed-placed **Penthouse Serenade** (**Val Royal**), out of Listed third **Misty Peak** (**Sri Pekan**). His third dam is the unraced **Miss Declared** (**Alleged**), who also produced the Listed-placed **Golly Gosh** (**Danehill**).

# NANDO PARRADO

Kodiac- Chibola (Roy) IRISH NATIONAL STUD • Fee €6,000

Sons of **Kodiac** have continually punched above their weight at stud and **Nando Parrado** has been well supported to do the same with his first juveniles this term. His fee has remained at  $\in 6,000$  since retiring in 2022.

A brilliant two-year-old, he was retained by renowned talent scout Paul McCartan of Ballyphilip Stud as a yearling, the respected judge having purchased him for 165,000gns as a foal. He lined up in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes with just one run under his belt, but showed his inexperience was no barrier in galloping to a smart length victory over **Qaader** (**Night Of Thunder**). Placed efforts followed in the Gr.1 Prix Morny and the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere, which resulted in a lofty official rating of 111 at the end of his juvenile campaign.

He ran with credit as a three-year-old in top company, but it was as a juvenile where he really shone and the same is expected from his offspring. He has proven popular at stud, 61 yearlings sold out of 68 offered, with highlights including a colt at Book 2 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale who realised 50,000gns when purchased by James Toller.

**Nando Parrado** is out of the Argentinian mare **Chibola** (**Roy**), who was a Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed in her native country and is a full-sister to the Argentinian Gr.1 winner and sire **Chollo**. He is one of four winners out of his dam, including two other Stakes-placed horses.

# **NAVAL CROWN**

Dubawi – Come Alive (Dansili) KILDANGAN STUD • Fee €9,000

Fresh from seeing his first foals sell for up to €60,000 (twice) during the autumn sales last year, the Gr.1-winning sprinter **Naval Crown** has had his fee trimmed to €9,000 ahead of the 2025 breeding season.

A Gr.3-placed winner at up to 1m at two, the son of **Dubawi** was a Listed winner and fourth in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas at that trip early on in his three-year-old campaign, but only truly blossomed when reinvented as a sprinter as a four-year-old. He won the 7f Gr.2 Al Fahidi Fort on his first start of that season before producing the best result of his career when winning the Gr.1 Platinum Jubilee Stakes over 6f at Royal Ascot, beating a stellar field that featured no less than 11 Gr.1 winners, such as **Alcohol Free, Campanelle, Highfield Princess, Kinross** and **Minzaal**. He was also second in the Gr.1 July Cup before retiring at the end of that year.



Proven Gr.1-producer **Olympic Glory** begins his 11th season at Haras de Bouquetot this year.

A son of top-class sprinter Choisir, he was an exceptional performer on the racecourse, getting off the mark on debut at two and then finishing second in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes behind Dawn Approach just 11 days later. He then won the Gr.2 Superlative Stakes when stepped up to 7f on his next start, followed by the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes at Glorious Goodwood and then the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere. He continued his high-class form into his three-year-old season, winning the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes and Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes either side of finishing second in the Gr.1 Prix Jacques le Marois and Gr.1 Prix du Moulin, and he concluded his career by winning the Gr.1 Lockinge Stakes and Gr.1 Prix de la Foret at four, the latter of which was in a race record time. Now 15, he has continued that winning formula into his career at stud, siring Gr.1 Coronation Stakes and Gr.1 Prix Rothschild heroine Watch Me and Gr.1 Prix Jean Romanet winner Grand Glory, as well as Gr.1 Prix de Royallieu runner-up Jannah Flower amongst many other high-level performers. One of four winners out of the Alzao mare Acidanthera, he descends from a female line that includes the Gr.2 Queen Mary Stakes winner Amaranda.

# **PERFECT POWER**

Ardad – Sagely (Frozen Power) DALHAM HALL STUD • Fee £7,500

**Perfect Power**'s first crop of foals hit the ground in 2024 to rave reviews and he is sure to prove immensely popular this year following a reduction in his fee from £10,000 to £7,500.

A son of **Ardad** and grandson of **Kodiac**, **Perfect Power** was an exceptional two-year-old talent who won the Gr.2 Norfolk Stakes, Gr.1 Prix Morny and Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes. He confirmed his stamina for 7f when winning the Gr.3 Greenham Stakes on his return at three, before dropping back down to sprinting to win the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup at Royal Ascot that summer.

From a sire line that is renowned for its precocious quality, **Perfect Power** is the only horse ever to have secured three Gr.1 victories over 6f at such an early stage in his career. His first foals made a strong impression at the Tattersalls December Foal Sale last year, selling for figures including £130,000, £78,000 and £72,000.

He is a half-brother to the Listed Chesham Stakes third Golden Mind (Galileo Gold) and out of Sagely (Frozen Power), a winning half-sister to the Listed-placed Sagaciously (Lawman; dam of the Listed winner Epic Poet). The third dam Saga D'Ouilly (Linamix) is a full-sister to the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner and sire Sagamix and a half-sister to the Gr.1-winning juvenile and sire Sagacity (Highest Honor).



# **PHOENIX OF SPAIN**

Lope De Vega – Lucky Clio (Key Of Luck) IRISH NATIONAL STUD • Fee €10,000

Following a promising year with his first crop of three-yearolds, **Phoenix Of Spain** is available at €10,000 for the second season in a row.

A 220,000gns Tattersalls October Book 1 yearling purchase, he was trained by Charlie Hills and boasts the Gr.3 Acomb Stakes at York amongst his consistent and high-class juvenile performances, in which he mixed it with top company. He was just a head behind **Magna Grecia** in the Gr.1 Futurity Trophy and second to **Too Darn Hot** in the Gr.2 Champagne Stakes. He enacted revenge on the latter the following May, winning the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas in commanding style, leading from start to finish to win by three lengths.

His first crop was filled with promise, headed by the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes winner **Haatem**, who narrowly missed out on emulating his sire in the Irish 2,000 Guineas, going down by a head to his stablemate **Rosallion** (**Blue Point**). **Haatem** can also count the Gr.3 Craven Stakes and the Gr.3 Jersey Stakes amongst his four wins, as well as a podium finish in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas at Newmarket and is one of 50 winners to date and four Stakes horses for his sire.

He is a son of **Lope De Vega**, who had a record-breaking season last year, out of a half-sister to the dual Gr.2 winner and sire **Special Kaldoun**. His dam has produced nine winners, also including a trio of Stakes-placed progeny.

Beginning his seventh season at the National Stud is the Gr.2 winner **Rajasinghe**, who has already proven to upgrade his progeny by an average of 12lbs on their dams rating.

An £85,000 purchase at the Goffs Premier Yearling Sale at Doncaster, he went into training with Richard Spencer and ran out an impressive four-length winner over 6f at Newcastle on debut, before going on to land the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot in a record time on his next start. He rounded off his two-year-old campaign with a third-placed effort in the Gr.2 July Stakes over 6f at Newmarket, where he finished behind the champion two-year-old and multiple Gr.1 winner **U S Navy Flag (War Front**; sire) and ahead of the Gr.2 winner and Gr.1-placed **Invincible Army (Invincible Spirit**; sire).

**Waiting All Night** got his sire off the mark with his first crop of two-year-olds in 2022 when he won at the first attempt in a maiden over 5f at Wolverhampton in May, before going on to run with credit in both the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot and Gr.2 July Stakes at Newmarket. He has enjoyed a strong 44 per cent winners to runners ratio since.

Elusive Quality – Ascutney (Lord At War) KILDANGAN STUD • Fee €7,500

The Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Classic winner **Raven's Pass** boasts an eight per cent Stakes winners to runners strike-rate and has produced four Gr.1 winners and dozens of black-type horses since taking up stallion duties in 2009.

His top-level winners are **Royal Marine**, **Tower Of London**, **Romantic Proposal** and **Matterhorn**, while other standout performers for the sire include the Gr.1-placed Gr.2 winners **Lemista**, **Big Duke** and **Steeler**. He is a half-brother to the US Gr.3 winner **Gigawatt (Wild Again**) and one of five winners out of the US Gr.3 winner **Ascutney** (Lord At War). The mare also features as grandam in the pedigrees of the 2019 Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches winner **Castle Lady** (Shamardal) and her UAE Listed-winning half-brother **Top Score** (Hard Spun).


# **RIVER TIBER**

Wootton Bassett – Transcendence (Arcano) HARAS DE LA HUDERIE • Fee €5,500

New for 2025

Top-class juvenile and Classic-placed three-year-old **River Tiber** is another new addition to the French stallion ranks for 2025.

The son of Wootton Bassett was a 480,000gns purchase by MV Magnier and White Birch Farm at Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, and was sent into training at Ballydoyle for the Coolmore partners and Peter Brant. An impressive ten-length debut winner over 51/2f at Navan, he won again at Naas before defeating 19 rivals in the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes over 6f at Royal Ascot. Behind him that day was the subsequent Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes winner and sire Bucanero Fuerte (also by Wootton Bassett), the top-class sprinter Givemethebeatboys (Bungle Inthejungle) and the multiple Classic-placed Haatem (Phoenix Of Spain). He then returned from a two-month absence to be placed third in the Gr.1 Prix Morny and was also third in the Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes at Newmarket just over a month later. He reappeared as a three-year-old in the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas at the Curragh, where he was again placed third, beaten just a length and a half by the eventual winner Rosallion (Blue Point). He hails from the family of the Gr.1 winner and sire Sudirman, Classic heroine Mother Earth and the Gr.3 winner and sire Dandy Man.



ROMANISED

Holy Roman Emperor – Romantic Venture (Indian Ridge) HARAS DE BOUQUETOT • Fee €7,000

**Romanised** (**Holy Roman Emperor**) finished third amongst French first-season sires by winners in 2024, producing nine individual winners for combined earnings in excess of €300,000. It was an excellent start for the 2018 Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas winner, who will continue at a fee of €7,000 this year.

The many highlights for the sire included a five-length conditions win by **Zia Agnese** at Chantilly and a promising Deauville success for the Andre Fabre-trained **Reine De Medecis**, while the potentially useful **Gast A Gast** ensured a flying start to the new campaign when taking a Deauville maiden in January. Not only is the sire producing tough and precocious two-year-olds, but also horses that look set to go on to better things during their Classic year.

That was certainly the case for **Romanised**, who was prepared by Ken Condon to make a winning debut in the April of his juvenile campaign before progressing to win the Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas the following season. Also winner of the Gr.1 Prix Jacques le Marois at four and at Gr.2 level at five, he is the pick of three Stakes winners out of **Romantic Venture** (**Indian Ridge**), a winning half-sister to the multiple Gr.1 winner and Hong Kong Horse of the Year **Designs On Rome** (also by **Holy Roman Emperor**).

It is an exciting year for March Hare Stud's Roseman as his first two-year-olds are due to hit racecourses this season. The Listed-winning and Gr.1-placed son of Kingman continues to offer exceptional value at a fee of £4,000.

The World Champion Miler Palace Pier (Kingman) was back in third, one of five Gr.1 winners that **Roseman** defeated during his career.

Roseman combines an impressive racing CV with impeccable pedigree credentials. He is a half-brother to the Gr.1 Futurity Trophy third **Baradar** (**Muhaarar**) and his dam is a full-sister to the dual Gr.1-winning champion Immortal Verse (dam of Gr.1 winners Tenebrism and Henri Matisse).

Bred by Drumlin Bloodstock, the now five-year-old son of **Zoffany** was purchased for €550,000 by Oliver St Lawrence Bloodstock from the Mocklershill consignement at the Argana May Breeze-Up Sale. He then entered training with Roger Varian and ran out an impressive six length winner on his second start as a juvenile in a 6f novice contest at Haydock. That effort resulted in him being sent off the 4/5 favourite on his next start in the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes over 6f at Newbury, where he duly obliged, winning comfortably by three and a half lengths, with the subsequent champion miler and treble Gr.1 winner Charyn (Dark Angel; sire) in third and the multiple Stakes winner and Gr.1-placed Shoudvebeenaring (Havana Grey; sire) back in fourth.

Sakheer is a half-brother to four other winners, the best of whom is the Gr.2 Kilboy Estate Stakes winner and Gr.1 (then) Beverly D Stakes-placed Lemista (Raven's Pass). Champion First-Crop Sire **Sergei Prokofiev** will stand for an upgraded fee of £8,000 this season.

A \$1.1m yearling purchase by MV Magnier, the son of **Scat Daddy** was sent into training at Ballydoyle and performed well at two. He broke his maiden tag by an impressive seven and half lengths on his second start over 5f at Navan in April, before being similarly impressive when winning the Listed Rochestown Stakes over 5f at Navan by four lengths. He then travelled over to Royal Ascot to contest the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes, where he was beaten just over a length by the now Coolmore stallion **Calyx** (**Kingman**) when third in this 6f contest. The colt returned to winning ways when dropped back to the 5f trip later in the season, comfortably claiming the Gr.3 Cornwallis Stakes at Newmarket. He then reappeared as a three-year-old to earn a third Stakes victory in the Listed Cork Stakes over 5½f at Navan.

He sired 27 juvenile winners in Europe from his first crop last year, five more than his nearest challenger **Pinatubo**. These were led by the Gr.3 Marble Hill Stakes winner and Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint runner-up **Arizona Blaze**, and the Listed National Stakes victrix **Enchanting Empress**. His yearlings were sold for up to 170,000gns last year and he has covered a full book of mares in every season at stud so far.

The son of **Gleneagles** retired to stud in 2021 after a career that saw him win the Listed Windsor Castle Stakes at two. Bred by Coolmore, he was trained at Ballydovle and ran in the colours of Mrs John Magnier, his ownership also including Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith.

The now eight-year-old began his career when finishing fifth on debut in the Listed Marble Hill Stakes. He came home the runner-up on his next start before ending his twoyear-old campaign with the aforementioned Windsor Castle triumph. There was no victory at three, though he raced in the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup, Gr.1 July Cup and Gr.2 Sapphire Stakes against the likes of subsequent sires Golden Horde (Lethal Force), Lope Y Fernandez (Lope De Vega), Hello Youmzain (Kodiac) and A'Ali (Society Rock).

He is out of the winner and Gr.3 Round Tower Stakes runner-up Remember You (Invincible Spirit), while his third dam Miss Mistletoes (The Minstrel), who won twice and was placed at Listed level, produced both the Gr.3 Somerville Tattersall Stakes winner and Gr.1 Criterium International-placed sire Governor Brown (Kingmambo) and the dual Listed victor and sire Hataab (Woodman).

# **STRADIVARIUS**

Sea The Stars – Private Life (Bering) THE NATIONAL STUD • Fee £10,000

The National Stud is home to the incredibly popular and exceptionally talented stayer Stradivarius, who is now entering his third season at stud.

Bred and owned by Bjorn Nielsen and trained in Newmarket by John and Thady Gosden, the now elevenyear-old son of Sea The Stars was incredibly sound and consistent throughout the seven seasons in which we saw him on the track, during which time he ran 35 times and only finished outside of the frame on five occasions. He won a total of 20 times, with 18 of those successes coming at Group level, more than any other European horse has ever achieved. He was triumphant at the highest level a total of seven times, with four wins in the Gr.2 Goodwood Cup and three in the Gr.1 Gold Cup, which helped him to amass career earnings of over £3.4m.

Stradivarius is a half-brother to five other winners, including the 2007 Joint Champion Three-Year-Old in Germany, dual Gr.3 winner and Gr.2 Euro Cup-placed Persian Storm (Monsun). They are out of the dual Listed-placed Private Life (Bering), a half-sister to the Listed-winning dam of the dual Gr.1 winner Protectionist (Monsun). He has covered over 220 mares in his first two seasons and his first yearlings will pass through the ring this year.



### **SUPREMACY**

Mehmas – Triggers Broom (Arcano) YEOMANSTOWN STUD • Fee €8,000

The Gr.1 Middle Park Stakes winner **Supremacy** will stand his fourth season at Yeomanstown Stud in 2025 for a fee of  $\in 8,000$ .

The son of **Mehmas** won two of his first three starts, including the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes at Goodwood, in which he emulated his sire and crossed the line in a faster time than fellow future Gr.1-winning Richmond Stakes graduates **Vandeek**, **Golden Horde** and **Shalaa** (all sires). Supremacy is out of the placed Arcano mare Triggers Broom, a half-sister to the dual Hong Kong Gr.1 Champions Mile winner and sire Xtension (Xaar), as well as Beatrix Potter (Cadeaux Genereux; dam of the dual Gr.1-winning Champion Three-Year-Old Sprinter and sire Harry Angel and the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes winner Pierre Lapin).

Six of his first yearlings were sold for six-figure sums last year, led by a 270,000gns filly at Book 1 of the Tattersalls October Yearling Sale, as well as a 220,000gns colt sold at the same sale. His two-year-olds have entered training with the likes of Karl Burke, Wesley Ward, Clive Cox and Andrew Balding.


### **THUNDER MOON**

Zoffany – Small Sacrifice (Sadler's Wells) HARAS DE BOUQUETOT • Fee €5,000

The Gr.1 National Stakes winner **Thunder Moon** will commence his third season at Haras de Bouquetot at a slightly reduced fee of  $\in$ 5,000. A seven-year-old son of **Zoffany**, he has covered books of 50 and 47 in his first two campaigns and his maiden crop of foals sold for up to  $\in$ 68,000 in the sales ring last year.

Bred by Aidan and Anne-Marie O'Brien under their Whisperview Trading Ltd banner, **Thunder Moon** won a 7f Curragh maiden on his debut for their son Joseph. He was immediately pitched into Gr.1 company in the National Stakes and displayed a sharp turn of foot to comfortably beat a field containing five future Gr.1 winners, including **St Mark's Basilica** (**Siyouni**), **Master Of The Seas** (**Dubawi**) and **Mac Swiney** (**New Approach**). He trained on to finish second in the Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat at three and was Gr.3-placed in the Gladness Stakes as a four-year-old.

A half-brother to the Listed winner **Table Rock** (**Fastnet Rock**), **Thunder Moon** is among three winners out of the unraced **Small Sacrifice** (**Sadler's Wells**). This exceptional family extends within two more generations to the Gr.1 Irish 1,000 Guineas winner and influential matriarch **Trusted Partner** (**Affirmed**; dam of **Dress To Thrill** and grandam of **Kyprios**, **Free Eagle** and **Search For A Song**).



### **TIP TWO WIN**

Dark Angel – Freddie's Girl (More Than Ready) KILLISK FARM • Fee €2,500

**Dark Angel**'s Gr.1 2,000 Guineas runner-up and dual Listed winner **Tip Two Win** has been loaned to Nickey and Niamh Murphy's Killisk Farm in Enniscorthy this year from March Hare Stud, offering value at a fee of €2,500.

**Tip Two Win** is out of **Freddie's Girl**, a daughter of **More Than Ready** who shares her grandam with the Listedwinning and Gr.1-placed sire **Due Diligence** (**War Front**). Winner of the Listed Flying Scotsman Stakes and runner-up in the Gr.3 Tattersalls Stakes domestically as a juvenile, he then spent the winter in Qatar, where he won two races, including the valuable (Local Gr.2) Al Biddah Mile.

That win set him up for a tilt at the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, in which he defied an SP of 50/1 to finish second to **Saxon Warrior** (**Deep Impact**). This was an outstanding renewal of the Newmarket Classic, with the future Gr.1 Derby winner **Masar** (**New Approach**) in third, four-time Gr.1 winner **Roaring Lion** (**Kitten's Joy**) in fifth, and Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Mile hero **Expert Eye** (**Acclamation**) back in the field.

Also fourth in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes, **Tip Two Win** was retired at the end of 2020 and spent four seasons at March Hare Stud in Surrey. He has not covered a great deal of mares so far, but as a Classic-placed son of the reigning British and Irish champion sire, he looks like an irresistible option to those breeding on a budget at his reduced fee.

### **TRIPLE TIME**

Frankel – Reem Three (Mark Of Esteem) DALHAM HALL STUD • Fee £10,000

The best son of **Frankel** over a mile, **Triple Time** won the Listed Ascendant Stakes in a record time as a two-year-old, secured Gr.3 honours in the Superior Mile during a light campaign at three and beat the likes of **Inspiral (Frankel)**, **Modern Games (Dubawi)**, **Angel Bleu (Dark Angel)** and **Native Trail (Oasis Dream)** when winning the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes at four.

Retired to Dalham Hall Stud following the conclusion of the 2023 season, the Sheikh Mohammed Obaid Al Maktoum-homebred covered a large three-figure book of mares in his debut season and already has his first foals on the ground. His partners last year included the Gr.1 Sun Chariot Stakes winner **Fonteyn** (**Farhh**) and **Dubawi**'s Gr.2winning half-sister **Emirates Queen** (**Street Cry**).

Triple Time is blessed with an outstanding blue-blooded pedigree, being a half or three-parts brother to five Stakes winners, including the Gr.1 Prix Jean Romanet heroine Ajman Princess (Teofilo; dam of the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup winner Inisherin). Also a half-brother to the unraced Rosaline (New Approach), dam of last season's Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas winner Rosallion (Blue Point), he is out of the Listed-placed Mark Of Esteem mare Reem Three, whose half-brother Afsare (Dubawi) won the Gr.2 Celebration Mile and was placed in Gr.1 company.



### **TWILIGHT SON**

**Kyllachy** – Twilight Mistress (Bin Ajwaad) **ANNSHOON STUD** • Fee €5,000

Following eight seasons at Cheveley Park Stud, the dual Gr.1-winning sprinter **Twilight Son** has moved to Annshoon Stud in County Kilkenny for 2025. His fee has been reduced from  $\pounds6,000$  to €5,000

The now 13-year-old son of **Kyllachy** was trained by Henry Candy and won six of his ten career starts, only finishing outside of the frame on three occasions. He won both of his starts during his juvenile campaign and maintained that unbeaten record for another three starts in his three-yearold season, which included a triumph in the Gr.1 Haydock Sprint Cup over 6f, before being beaten only two lengths by **Muhaarar** (**Oasis Dream**; sire) in the Gr.1 British Champions Sprint Stakes at Ascot. He then added another Gr.1 success to his name the following season when winning the Diamond Jubilee Stakes at Royal Ascot.

In 2023, his yearlings averaged £160,000 and last year they averaged £82,253, both figures far above his covering fee. He is already the sire of three Stakes winners, including the dual Gr.3 winner and dual Gr.2-placed **Twilight Jet** and the Gr.3 Athasi Stakes winner **Twilight Spinner**, as well as the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes-placed **Twilight Calls**.

Twilight Son is a half-brother to several other winners, including the Stakes winners Music Master (Piccolo), Spring Fling (Assertive) and Run To Freedom (Muhaarar).

**Ulysses** cemented his reputation as a sensibly priced source of Gr.1 talent during 2024. The 12-year-old son of **Galileo** was represented by his best performer to date, the Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup winner **White Birch**, as well as the Gr.2 Huxley Stakes winner **Passenger** and the Gr.3 winners **Mighty Ulysses**, **Holloway Boy** and **Wendla**. Despite the successes, he is available at a reduced fee of £8,000 in 2025.

In addition to his established performers, **Ulysses** has much to look forward to from last year's juveniles. **Elsie's Ruan** made a winning debut before finishing third in the Gr.3 Sweet Solera Stakes, **Protest** followed up a first-timeout success at Chelmsford with a creditable fourth in the Listed Montrose Fillies' Stakes and **Regal Ulixes** went into many notebooks when winning the often informative Haynes, Hanson & Clark Novice Stakes at Newbury. **Surprised, Stark Warning** and **Chilly Breeze** were other highly promising maiden or novice winners for the sire.

A gradual improver who lifted the Gr.1 Eclipse Stakes and Gr.1 Juddmonte International Stakes as a four-year-old, **Ulysses** boasts a pedigree of supreme quality. He is out of the Gr.1 Oaks heroine **Light Shift** (**Kingmambo**), a half-sister to the Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup winner **Shiva** and the Gr.2-winning sire **Limnos** (both by **Hector Protector**).

By Zoffany and out of the Listed-placed winner How's She Cuttin' (Shinko Forest), racing for the Ballydoyle team and the Coolmore partners, he won over 5f and was Listedplaced before winning the Listed Windsor Castle Stakes at Royal Ascot. On his next start he finished runner-up to his stablemate, the three-time Gr.1 victor and sire Air Force Blue (War Front), in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes. He returned at three with success in the Listed Patton Stakes and the Listed Power Stakes, before finishing second in the Gr.3 Lacken Stakes with the subsequent Gr.1 winner and sire Aclaim (Acclamation) in third. He also placed in the Gr.2 (then) Flying Five Stakes and the Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp as a three-year-old. As a four-year-old, he added the Gr.3 Phoenix Sprint Stakes to his record. He was unlucky not to win as a five-year-old, producing high-class efforts in defeat, the best of which was a head second to Battaash (Dark Angel) in the Gr.2 Temple Stakes.

He is a half-brother to the Gr.2 Futurity Stakes winner, dual Gr.1-placed and new sire Aesop's Fables (No Nay Never).

The Gr.1-winning miler Without Parole will stand his fifth season at Newsells Park Stud for £8,000.

A winner on his sole start as a two-year-old, the son of Frankel returned for his three-year-old campaign with an impressive six-length win in a novice contest over 1m at Yarmouth, before taking the step up to Stakes level on his next start with a win in the Listed Heron Stakes at Sandown. He was then sent off the 9/4 winner of the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes at Royal Ascot, where he had the measure of Aidan O'Brien and Coolmore's Gr.2 Superlative Stakes winner and Gr.1 Irish 2,000 Guineas-placed Gustav Klimt (Galileo; sire). He was subsequently moved to the yard of Chad C Brown in the US, who trained him to finish third in the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita as a four-year-old behind his stablemate and multiple Gr.1 winner Uni (More Than **Ready**). He was then placed in two more Gr.1 races at five.

A half-brother to the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Dirt Mile winner Tamarkuz (Speightstown), Without Parole's first crop of two-year-olds hit the track last year. He enjoyed 12 winners from 35 runners in 2024, a 34 per cent winners to runners ratio, with the best of those being the Gavin Cromwelltrained Fiery Lucy, who was placed twice in Gr.3 company at the Curragh, and the Ralph Beckett-trained Sea To Sky, who finished third in the Listed Radley Stakes at Newbury.


### WOODED

#### Wootton Bassett – Frida La Blonde (Elusive City) HARAS DE BOUQUETOT • Fee €7,000

**Wooded** has made a flying start to his stallion career, covering more than 200 mares in his first two seasons whilst maintaining a fertility rate above 97 per cent. Those impressive numbers were backed up in the sales ring when his first yearlings sold for up to  $\in$ 140,000 in 2023, and the good work continued on the racecourse last season when he finished second in the French first-season sires' table.

A son of the outstanding **Wootton Bassett**, **Wooded** was a winner and Gr.3-placed as a two-year-old for trainer Francis-Henri Graffard. He won the 1200m Gr.3 Prix Texanita by three and a half lengths on his comeback the following year before running well to be fourth in the 1400m Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat. **Wooded** is a full-brother to the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes winner and sire **Bucanero Fuerte** and among four winners produced by the **Elusive City** mare **Frida La Blonde**, whose **Dubawi** filly topped the 2023 Arqana August Yearling Sale at €2,400,000. **Frida La Blonde** is a full-sister to the dual Listed winner **Fred Lalloupet** and out of the Listed winner and Gr.2- and Classic-placed **Firm Friend** (**Affirmed**).


Sea The Stars – Olga Prekrasa (Kingmambo) HARAS DE BOUQUETOT • Fee €10,000

The Gr.1 Prix Jean Prat winner **Zelzal** (**Sea The Stars**) will continue at  $\leq 10,000$  as he embarks upon his eighth season at Haras de Bouquetot.

An impressive set of results last year saw him post his maiden top 15 finish in the French stallion table. He is a half-brother to the Gr.3 Prix Chloe winner **Ibiza** (**Redoute's Choice**) and out of the winning **Kingmambo** mare **Olga Prekrasa**. The third dam is the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Prix Vermeille third **State Crystal** (**High Estate**).
