TATTERSALLS

PACKED RING SEES STARS MAKE A BIG IMPACT

The influence **Sea The Stars** had big-time impact when Tattersalls’ December Sale of mares and fillies opened in snow-dusted Newmarket yesterday.

Twelve months after Christopher Tsui’s brilliant racehorse – touted by some as the greatest – was retired to the Aga Khan’s Giltown Stud he remains among the revered and when a well-bred mare carrying one of his foals came to the ring, she easily topped the day’s takings.

Soinlovewithyou, the first mare to be offered in Britain carrying a Sea The Stars foal, made 950,000gns, outperforming other contenders for the session-topping role with the same authority her mate showed when winning eight of nine races.

This bumper sale could not prevent the day’s average dropping 13% to 55,158gns and there were falls in the clearance rate, to 72%, and aggregate, which was down 19% at 8,888,500gns, despite an additional six horses being offered.

The median provided a healthier element, for it rose 37% to 26,000gns, but on a negative note several bloodstock agents described their disappointment at pre-sale sales,

which have knocked several high-profile fillies or mares out of the equation.

Without pointing fingers at any individuals, it is agents who dive in to buy these horses, so perhaps the criticism should be directed at their own kind, but the views of several make interesting reading

Hugo Lascelles, who bought the session-topping mare said: *“When you first look at the catalogue there are half a dozen to get stuck into, but they’ve been withdrawn.”*

However, rarity value works well for some vendors, for Lascelles said of his high-profile purchase: *“I didn’t value her at that and had to pay more than I expected – that’s probably because there are not many to go at.”*

Bloodstock agent Charlie Gordon-Watson described the catalogue as, *“Disappointing, because the best mares have been withdrawn,”* a comment with which Hugo Merry concurred. He said: *“We’ve got good orders, but we’re struggling to fill because of a lack of quality at the top end and a shortage of nice, middle-market mares with commercial covers for domestic breeders.”*

Market forces will always prevail, and other vendors said they accepted the situation as part and parcel of the trade, but it is unlikely we will see record prices being created during the next three days.

Returning to **Soinlovewithyou (Lot 1417)**, the five-year-old daughter of **Sadler’s Wells** is a half-sister to top-class racehorse and now sire **Duke Of Marmalade** and she proved worth the wait. Parading in front of a packed

audience – one that hushed when auctioneer Philip Myerscough offered her to the ring – and she was soon fought over by a plethora of buyers.

Among them was Ted Voute, Charlie Gordon-Watson, Seamus Burns, Ibrahim Araci and underbidder Tim Stakemire from Australia, but it was British agent Lascelles trumped them all.

He said of the mare, a Gr.3 winner who came to the ring from Lady Carolyn Warren's Highclere Stud: *"She's been bought to go to an owner/breeder in Kentucky and will be covered by one of the best sires over there. The new owners may well retain the foal. They are racing people and they could bring it back here to race.*

"Sea The Stars is well respected in the USA and he was a factor in our decision to go for this mare, but her half-brother was a very good horse who could become a top stallion."

Another mare carrying to Sea The Stars, 13-year-old **Buffalo Berry (Lot 1432)**, made 150,000gns to a bid from agent Richard Frisby. A four-time-winning daughter of **Sri Pekan**, the mare has been represented by four winners, notably **Chattahoochee War (War Chant)**, a Gr.3 winner in the States and placed in the Gr.1 Secretariat Stakes.

JAPANESE BUYERS IN THE LIMELIGHT

No fewer than eight representatives from Japanese stud farms gave up the opportunity to witness their nation's big Cup race on Sunday in order to travel to Tattersalls.

Among them was Tetsuya Yoshida of Shadai Farm, who made his presence felt when the **Medicean**-covered grey mare **Limelight (Lot 1296)** came to the ring from Prince Faisal Salman's Denford Stud near Hungerford in Berkshire. An offer of 300,000gns proved too much for New Zealand underbidder Guy Mulcaster, who was seated with Malaysian clients, and enabled Yoshida to gain a daughter of **Last Second**, a 120,000gns yearling, who won the Gr.2 (then) Nassau Stakes and was placed in the Gr.1 Coronation Stakes.

Last Second has bettered that in the breeding sheds, for while Limelight failed to win, her siblings include Gr.1 Poule d'Essai Des Poulains winner and sire **Aussie Rules**, plus high-ranking filly **Approach**, who produced this year's Gr.1 Irish Derby runner-up **Midas Touch**.

Fumihiko Nakajima of Northern Farms availed himself of another star item when paying 375,000gns for Islanmore Stud's mare **Belle Allure (Lot 1328)**, a daughter of **Numerous**, who won at Gr.3 level in France for Rupert Pritchard-Gordon and matched that when sent to race in the States from Christophe Clement's barn.

That international element ran through the family – Belle Allure's illustrious half-brother **Jukebox Jury** was successful across Europe and in Canada – and added to the appeal for the buyer and other bidders from Japan who waded their catalogues. Nakajima said: *"It's a very good pedigree and she's a good mare – the family have shown they can win in many countries. We will take her home to Japan and the [Giant's Causeway] foal will be*

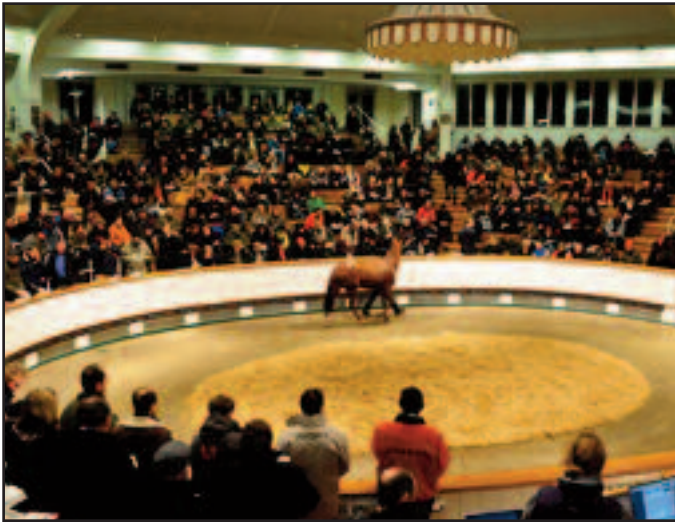

A prized asset from the Highclere Stud draft, **Pollenator (Lot 1416)**, was also given an export-to-Japan sticker when knocked down for 180,000gns to Shadai Corporation, a partnership involving the three Yoshida brothers and which manages the family’s stallions.

Pollenator, whose next stop will be at the Shiraoi Farm on Hokkaido, won last season’s Gr.2 May Hill Stakes, beating the subsequent top-level winner **Hibaayeb**. Bred by Tullamaine Castle Stud, she was acquired by John Warren for 50,000gns as a yearling, so yesterday’s sale was a happy occasion for her owners, the Royal Ascot Racing Club.

MOYNS PARK SAYS HELLO TO BYE

A bid to upgrade their mares saw Moyns Park Stud, based in Halstead in Essex, splash 280,000gns on three-year-old filly **Walk On Bye (Lot 1469)**.

Sold from Tommy Stack’s Thomastown Castle Stables, from whence she won the Gr.3 Anglesey Stakes and was placed in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes, she was sired by former Champion **Danehill Dancer** and foaled by top racemare **Pipalong**, who was sold at this venue nine years ago for 600,000gns when taken into the Coolmore fold. Her daughter, who was bred by Tower Bloodstock, has been racing in the colours of M V Magnier.

Grant Pritchard-Gordon and buyers from Japan’s Eishin Farm were among those who attempted to gain Walk On Bye, but she was knocked down to Anthony Smyth, stud groom at Moyns Park, which is owned by John and Pascal Gardiner.

Smyth, who joined the farm 22 months ago, having been manager at Car Colston Hall Stud, said: “She’s a Gr.3 winner, out of a champion racemare and with the kind of pedigree we want. Her full-sister made 125,000gns at the yearling sales.

“We’ve got four mares at home, this will be the fifth and we will be retiring a couple of fillies who are in training. If we can buy one more mare this week, with a cover, that will be part of our attempts to upgrade the broodmare band.”

CALIFORNIA BECKONS FOR MIDDLE CLUB

Bob McCreery of Somerset’s Stowell Hill Stud reaped a 280,000gns windfall when parting with **Middle Club (Lot 1477)**, offered from the yard of her trainer, Richard Hannon.

A very smart juvenile, when her racing record included a victory in the Gr.3 Prix d'Aumale, Middle Club failed to score this year, but her overall earnings still topped £174,000. Geoffrey Howson, Anthony Stroud and representatives of Japan's Eishin Farm all offered to take her home, but Reilly McDonald of Eaton Sales had the decisive bid.

McDonald said: "She'll be going to California, although the trainer is as yet undecided. To my eye she was as clean as a whistle and she vetted that way. She's very well balanced and will probably race on turf for owners who will breed from her one day."

Also bound for the USA is juvenile **Singapore Lilly (Lot 1479)**, who followed Middle Club into the ring and was bought by Gordian Troeller for 210,000gns. Jim Cassidy will be Singapore Lilly's new trainer, said Troeller, whose purchase has been a busy this year, running nine times and winning twice, including a Listed event at Haydock in September.

CONNAUGHTON REWRITES ANGELS STORY

Owner/breeder John Connaughton gave a 235,000gns tip for the chances of **Dunboyne Express** winning a major race next season when he bought that colt's half-sister.

Connaughton, who left the bidding to his friend Ted Naughton, was renewing acquaintance with **Angels Story (Lot 1424)**, for he bred her out of **Love Excelling**, then sold her for 230,000gns at the October Sale in 2006. However, he retained her younger half-brother Dunboyne Express (**Shamardal**), who won his first two races this season for Kevin Prendergast's stable. The unbeaten run was ended in the Gr.1 Racing Post Trophy, but he was beaten little more than five lengths by winner **Casamento**.

Naughton said: "We think he's a very good horse, and he's entered in the Guineas and Irish Derby. We sold this mare, but it's good to buy her back."

Angels Story, who won two races, came to the ring from Jim Bolger's Redmonstown Stud carrying a foal by young sire **Intense Focus**, a son of Giant's Causeway standing at John O'Connor's Ballylinch Stud. Her dam was bought by Connaughton at this sale six years ago for 220,000gns when she was offered by her breeders, Trevor and Libby Harris's Lordship Stud.

Another member of the Redmonstown draft, **Failete Isteach (Lot 1426)**, a full-sister to young sire **Soldier Of Fortune**, winner of the Gr.1 Irish Derby and Gr.1 Coronation Cup, and also to Gr.3 winner **Heliostatic**, made 340,000gns when signed for by Eamonn Reilly of BBA Ireland.

The unraced daughter of Sea The Stars's half-brother, **Galileo**, also brought an Intense Focus cover to the ring.

The cross of Sadler's Wells and a **Darshaan** mare has been rightly revered for the past couple of decades, so there was plenty of appeal for **Entre Nous (Lot 1431)** from the Castlebridge Consignment, which followed the Redmonstown team into the ring.

Sired by Coolmore's multiple champion, she was foaled by **Dayanata**, a full-sister to Darshaan and half-sister to six-star mare **Darara**, and she came to the ring with a desirable **Invincible Spirit** cover.

Still only five, and with a Duke Of Marmalade foal on the ground, Entre Nous had more plusses than minuses, and it took a bid of 240,000gns by Dwayne Woods to settle her future.

NOTHING HUMDRUM ABOUT DRAM'S MARE

A foal who made 100,000gns last week was upstaged by his mum who more than doubled that valuation.

Danelissima (Lot 1274), a daughter of **Danehill** with a **New Approach** cover, was pursued by John Warren, seated with the Duke of Roxburghe, and Charlie Gordon-Watson, whose 220,000gns bid was soon followed by the sound of Todd Watt's hammer. Gordon-Watson had also bought the foal, a filly by New Approach, who like his dam was offered by Richard and Sally Aston's Goldford Stud on behalf of Dram Bloodstock.

Gordon-Watson said: "She's been bought to go to Galileo. There are not many available Danehill mares and I bought the foal last week - it's nice to keep it in house."

Nine-year-old Danelissima won the Gr.3 Noblesse Stakes and was placed in the Gr.2 Lancashire Oaks. Her foals have included Stakes-placed **Fergus McIver**

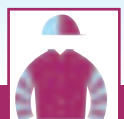

(Sadler's Wells), while her relatives include her full-sister **Daneleta**, dam of sire **Intense Focus**.

GAL GLITTERS FOR PACKENHAMS

When three-year-old filly **Crystal Gal (Lot 1383)** was knocked down for 150,000gns she was destined to visit one stud and one stallion.

Her new owners are Anthony and Victoria Packenham who raced Derby winner **Sir Percy** and, while they plan sending their new acquisition to the stallion at his Lanwades lair, her short-term future involves joining Lucy Wadham's Newmarket stables.

Crystal Gal, whose dam, **Park Crystal**, was a half-sister to Gr.1 Irish 1,000 Guineas winner **Classic Park**, won a race last year for Kevin Prendergast's stable and later picked up a place at Gr.3 level, but if Wadham can add winning form at Stakes level, so much the better.

Wadham, who has a fine record with jumpers, said: *"I liked her form and I liked the filly. We're spoilt to train nice flat horses for the Packenhams - now we'll try to gain some more black type next spring."*

Twelve months ago a similar plan was hatched by the same owner/trainer team for a 200,000gns **Monsun** filly called **Bolivia**, who sadly suffered a minor fracture in May and missed the turf season. *"She's now back in work and could run in the next couple of weeks in a Listed race on the all-weather,"* said Wadham.

Of her new purchase, Victoria Packenham said: *"It's known Sadler's Wells [Galileo's sire] goes well with Darshaan [Sir Percy's paternal grandsire], but there was nothing I didn't like about the filly. She's scopey, still only three and sometimes they develop strength from three to four. We were looking for something to race and I felt she was the nicest in the catalogue within our price range."*

INDIA

ADMIRALOFTHEFLEET TO STAND AT KUNIGAL STUD FARM

The six-year-old son of **Danehill**, **Admiralofthefleet**, whose promising career was cut short by an injury during the Dubai Racing Carnival two years ago, has been nursed back to health and will stand as a stallion in India at Kunigal Stud Farm.

India's leading owner Dr Vijay Mallya, who also runs the hugely successful Kunigal Stud Farm, had bought **Admiralofthefleet** from Coolmore after he had won three races, including two Group races, the Gr.2 Royal Lodge as a juvenile and a Gr.3 Dee Stakes. However, he broke down after two starts at the Dubai Carnival and there were doubts whether he would still have a stud career. The veterinary efforts have paid off and after one year of stud duty abroad in Ireland, where he covered 10 mares and got seven of them in foal, he has arrived in India and is at the quarantine station at Chennai before he arrives at the Kunigal Stud Farm to join the most productive sire of the farm, **Burden Of Proof (Fairy King)**.

India boasts of a number of stallions by Danehill at various stud farms. **Midtown** covered one season before he died and has already had a 1-2 in a juvenile race from his first two runners. The leading nurseries of the country, the Poonawalla Stud Farm and Usha Stud Farm stand **Ace** and **Multidimensional** respectively, and sons of Danehill have been the popular with Indian breeders.

Originally owned by Michael Tabor, Mrs John Magnier and the Niarchos family, **Admiralofthefleet** was bred by Quay Bloodstock and the Niarchos Family. He was trained by Aidan O'Brien before being bought by Dr Vijay Mallya and sent to Dubai under the care of Mick De Kock.

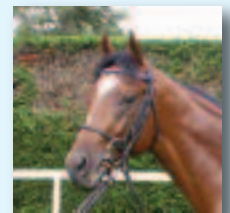

RACING NEWS

RECENT STATES ACTION FOR EX-EUROPEANS

The Europeans didn't get a Stakes win in the two-day Hollywood Park festival of turn racing but they certainly made their presence felt. Closest to a victory was **SEBASTIAN FLYTE** (2007 c. by **Observatory** – Aravonian by Night Shift), who was only caught close home by **Haimish Hy** and was beaten just a neck in the Gr.1 Hollywood Derby. The colt made his first eight starts in Britain and Ireland and established himself as a smart performer. Although he only won once, a maiden at Gowran at two, he was also second in the Gr.3 Sommerville Tattersall Stakes, and third in the Gr.3 Round Tower Stakes and Listed Nijinsky Stakes, the latter on his final European performance in mid-June this year. He made his US debut in a one mile allowance optional claiming event at Del Mar in September and launched his Stateside career with a half-length win. His only other outing saw him finish fourth in the Gr.2 Oak Tree Derby on 16th October.

Sebastian Flyte is a half-brother to the Gr.3 Ballyogan Stakes winner **Age Of Chivalry**. His dam is a winning daughter of **Age Of Reality**, who is a full-sister to the Italian Listed winner **Whatcombe** and half-sister to the four time Group winner **Chancellor**.

The veteran **PROUDINSKY** (2003 h. by **Silvano** – Proudeyes by Dashing Blade) produced an excellent effort in a very strong renewal of the Gr.2 Citation Handicap, to take second to the Gr.1-winning **Victor's Cry**. Remarkably,

the Gr.2 San Gabriel Handicap on 27th December last year. He had started his career in his native Germany, where he was a maiden winner and was second in a Listed race at three. However, he has done most of his racing in the US, taking the Gr.3 Bay Meadows Derby at three, and adding back-to-back renewals of the Gr.2 Mervyn Muniz Jr Memorial Handicap at five and six. He also ran the Champion Three-Year-Old **Big Brown** to a neck in the \$500,000 Monmouth Stakes in 2008 and was third in the Gr.1 Citation in 2007.

Proudinsky is a half-brother to German Gr.3 winner **Proudance**. His dam, **Proudeyes**, is a three-parts-sister to the international Stakes performer **Proudwings**, winner of the Gr.2 Prix du Muguet, Gr.2 (now Gr.1) Falmouth Stakes and Gr.3 Premio Sergio Cumani.

The Gr.3 Generous Stakes, a one mile turf test for two-year-olds, saw **MOMENT OF WEAKNESS** (2008 c. by **Big Bad Bob** – Kristal's Dream by Night Shift) and **SURREY STAR** (2008 c. by **Dubawi** – Turning Light by Fantastic Light) take second and third to **Comma to the Top**. The latter scored by a length and three quarters with just a nose separating the Europeans.

Moment of Weakness had won two of his four starts in Ireland and finished second in the Listed Rochestown Stakes at Cork. Shipped to the US, he ran second in September's Angel Island Stakes but was unplaced in the Gr.3 Bourbon Stakes at Keeneland.

His dam, **Kristal's Dream**, a winner at two, is a half-sister to the Irish Listed-placed filly **Blaze Brightly** (by Moment of Weakness's sire, Big Bad Bob). The grandam is **Kristal's Paradise**, a triple winner who was several times black-type placed, most notably when third in the Gr.3 Premio Roma Vecchia.

Surrey Star was making his ninth start of the season. He won his maiden at Epsom in June on his third outing, then ran unplaced in the Gr.2 Vintage Stakes, third in the Gr.3 Solario Stakes and Listed Stardom Stakes, second in the Gr.3 Somerville Tattersall Stakes and unplaced in the Gr.3 Horris Hill Stakes. He is out of the Gr.3 Kolner Herbs Stuten-Meile and Listed Jean Harzheim-Rennen winner **Turning Light**. His grandam, the Gr.2 German 1,000 Guineas third, **Turning Leaf**, is a daughter of Listed winner **Tamacana**.

In the Gr.3 Miesque Stakes for two-year-old fillies, the Irish-bred **CLONEYLASS** (b.f. 2008 by **Verglas** – Consensus by Common Grounds) finished third. This was her second US Stakes placing in two tries, as she had made a promising Stateside debut on 14th October, taking third in the Jessamine Stakes at Keeneland. She had broken her maiden at Bellewstown on 2nd July, on her third start, and then earned black-type with a second in the Listed Tipperary Stakes.

Her dam **Consensus** won four times and is out of **Kilbride Lass**, a half-sister to **Phoenix Reach**, winner of the Gr.1 Sheema Classic, Gr.1 Hong Kong Gold Vase, and Gr.1 Canadian International Stakes.

One filly who has been overdue a victory was **DUBAWI HEIGHTS** (b.f 2007 by **Dubawi** – Rosie's Posy by Suave Dancer), who put the record straight at Hollywood Park on Sunday. Starting at odds-on in a six-runner maiden over an extended mile of the turf course, she raced prominently before outbattling the Irish-bred **Tashzara (Intikhab)**, winning by three quarters of a length, the pair eight lengths clear of the remainder. Still trained by Simon Callaghan who is now based in the US, the filly had six runs in Britain last season, picking up a third in the Gr.2 Rockfel Stakes, a close second in the valuable Watership Down Stud Sales Stakes, and a second to **Lillie Langtry** in the Tattersalls Timeform Fillies 800. Knocked down to

Cormac McCormack for 75,000gns at last year's Tattersalls December Sale, she reappeared at Del Mar on 6th September, finishing unplaced, then was second in an Oak Tree at Hollywood Park maiden on 10th October.

Her dam **Rosie's Posy** is a winning half-sister to the Gr.1-winning sprinter **Tante Rose** and to the Gr.3-placed Listed winner **Bay Tree**. The grandam **My Branch** was a dual Listed winner and was placed in the Gr.1 1,000 Guineas and Gr.1 Cheveley Park Stakes.

STRIKING DANCER (2006 f. by **Smart Strike** – Dancing Shoes by Danehill) earned herself a black-type victory when an upset winner of February's Gr.2 La Canada Stakes at Santa Anita. Fourth in the Gr.1 Santa Margarita Invitational Handicap next time, she added more black-type with a third in the Gr.3 Doubledogdare Stakes at Keeneland on 16th April. That effort was followed by a fourth in the Gr.3 Glen Falls Handicap and an unplaced finish in the Gr.1 Spinster Stakes, before she gained another victory in an allowance contest over an extended mile at Churchill Downs on 3rd November. On Thanksgiving Day, 25th November, she gained more Graded Stakes credits with a third in the Gr.3 Falls City Handicap on very sloppy going.

She is out of the Irish-bred **Dancing Shoes**. That daughter of **Danehill** was unplaced on her only start but is a three-parts-sister to the Gr.2 Cherry Hinton Stakes third **Sundari** and to **Zarani Sidi Anna**, who was second in the Gr.3 Nell Gwyn Stakes, third in the Gr.1 Milady Handicap and Gr.1 Coronation Stakes, and went on to become the grandam of the Listed Rous Stakes winner **Tangerine Trees**.

The grandam, **Emmaline**, a daughter of **Affirmed**, was a Stakes winner in the US. She is a three-parts-sister to **Hatim**, a Listed scorer in Britain who went on to capture the Gr.1 San Antonio Handicap, to the Champion US Older Horse and sire **Bates Motel** and to the Gr.3 Horris Hill Stakes winner **Super Asset**.
