**KNOCKMULLEN HOUSE STUD • Fee €5,000**

With a strike rate of over 30 per cent winners to runners in both 2023 and 2024, **Advertise** has made a promising start to his career at stud, having taken up stallion duties in 2020 after two seasons on the track in which he gathered a host of top level victories.

The son of **Showcasing** won on his debut at two before earning Gr.2 success in the July Stakes two starts later, returning the half-length victor in the Gr.1 Phoenix Stakes and signing off the season when second to **Too Darn Hot (Dubawi)** in the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes. At three, he landed the Gr.1 Commonwealth Cup, seeing off fellow sires **Ten Sovereigns (No Nay Never)** and **Hello Youmzain (Kodiac)**, before settling for second in the Gr.1 July Cup and recording victory at Deauville on his penultimate start, in the Gr.1 Prix Maurice de Gheest.

His success as a sire is highlighted by last year's Gr.2 Gimcrack Stakes hero **Cool Hoof Luke**, as well as Andrew Balding's Listed and Gr.3 winner **Al Shabab Storm** and the Gr.3 Musidora Stakes victrix **Secret Satire**, also sent out by the Kingsclere yard.

His dam **Furbelow (Pivotal)** is a full-sister to the US Listed winner **Red Diadem** and a half-sister to the winning dam of the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes victor **Saayerr (Acclamation)**, while his third dam **Heart Of Joy (Lypheor)** is a Gr.2 winner.

## AESOP'S FABLES

*No Nay Never – How's She Cuttin' (Shinko Forest)*

**STARFIELD STUD • €6,500**

New to County Westmeath's Starfield Stud for 2025 is **No Nay Never's** Gr.2-winning juvenile and dual Gr.1-placed son **Aesop's Fables**, who is making his debut as a stallion this year.

Bred and owned during his racing career by the Coolmore partners, **Aesop's Fables** made a winning debut as a two-year-old for trainer Aidan O'Brien in a 5½f maiden contest at Navan, before following that effort up with a comfortable win in the Gr.2 Futurity Stakes over 7f at the Curragh and running well into fourth in both the Gr.1 National Stakes over the same course and distance and the Gr.1 Dewhurst Stakes over 7f at Newmarket. He then went on to be placed twice at the highest level during his three-year-old campaign, including when finishing third, beaten only a length, behind the four-time Gr.1 winner **Highfield Princess (Night Of Thunder)** in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp and third the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint at Santa Anita over similar distances.

He is one of six winners who have been produced by the seven-time winner and Listed-placed **How's She Cuttin' (Shinko Forest)**, a list that also includes the 2016 Champion Three-Year-Old Sprinter in Ireland, Gr.3 Phoenix Sprint Stakes and Listed Windsor Castle Stakes winner and treble Gr.1-placed sire **Washington DC (Zoffany)**.

**AL HAKEEM***Siyouni – Jadhaba (Galileo)***HARAS DE BOUQUETOT • Fee €5,000**

Al Shaqab Racing homebred **Al Hakeem** has returned to the land on which he was born and raised to make his debut as a stallion at Haras de Bouquetot in Normandy this year.

He is the latest son of the outstanding **Siyouni** to earn a place at stud and could look particularly good value at €5,000 as one of the highest-rated runners produced by the super sire. Trained throughout his career by Jean-Claude Rouget, he defeated the subsequent Gr.1 winner **Simca Mille (Tamayuz)** on his second start at two and had future Stakes performers in behind when making a winning reappearance at three. A four-length winner of the Listed Prix de Suresnes on his next start, **Al Hakeem** went on to win the Gr.2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano and finish fourth in both the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club and Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe before the conclusion of his Classic year. Although restricted to just one start as a four-year-old, he confirmed all of his ability remained intact when winning the Gr.3 Prix Gontaut-Biron at Deauville in August of 2024 as a five-year-old, on what proved to be his final racecourse appearance.

The pick of four winners out of the dual winner and Gr.3 Prix Penelope third **Jadhaba (Galileo)**, his second dam is the multiple North American Gr.2 winner **Naissance Royale (Giant's Causeway)**. **Al Hakeem** retired as the winner of five of his ten starts and more than £600,000 in prizemoney.

**ARREST***Frankel – Nisriyna (Intikhab)***BOARDSMILL STUD • Fee Private**

Taking up stallion duties at County Meath's Boardsmill Stud for his first covering season this year is **Frankel's** Stakes-winning and dual Gr.1-placed five-year-old **Arrest**.

Bred not too far from his new home in County Kildare by Swordlestown Little, he was sourced for €440,000 by Juddmonte at the Goffs November Foal Sale and was sent into training in Newmarket with John and Thady Gosden. He got off the mark at the second attempt during his juvenile campaign with a win in a maiden contest over 1m at Sandown, before following that up with a win in a novice contest at Ffos Las and a close second in the Gr.1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud, beaten only a head by **Dubai Mile (Roaring Lion; sire)**. He then returned for his Classic campaign with an impressive six and a half-length win in the Gr.3 Chester Vase, before winning the Gr.3 Geoffrey Freer Stakes at Newbury over 1m5½f and finishing the season with a second behind **Continuous (Heart's Cry)** in the Gr.1 St Leger Stakes at Doncaster, which helped him to be crowned the Champion Three-Year-Old Stayer in Great Britain in 2023.

He is a half-brother the Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Hong Kong Gold Cup-placed **Dinozzo (Lilbourne Lad)**. They are out of the unraced **Intikhab** mare **Nisriyna**, a half-sister to the dual Gr.3 winner and Gr.1 Nassau Stakes and Gr.1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud-placed **Narniyn (Dubawi)**.

New to the National Stud for the 2025 covering season is **Bradsell**, who is available at a fee of £10,000.

At two, the son of **Tasleet** won the Gr.2 Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot on just his second start, beating subsequent Gr.1 winner and sire **Blackbeard (No Nay Never)**, as well as the Gr.1-placed and sire **Persian Force (Mehmas)**. At three, he finished third in the Gr.3 Commonwealth Cup Trial Stakes and the Gr.2 Sandy Lane Stakes, before becoming the first three-year-old to win the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes in 15 years. In doing so, he defeated the multiple Gr.1 winner **Highfield Princess (Night Of Thunder)**. He returned with success in the Listed Prix du Cercle at Deauville the following year, before winning the Gr.1 Nunthorpe Stakes at York, with Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Sprint winner **Starlust (Zoustar)**, King's Stand Stakes winner **Asfoora (Flying Artie)**, Gr.1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp winner **Makarova (Acclamation)** and the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Juvenile Turf Sprint winner **Big Evs (Blue Point)** all in behind. He then went on to win the Gr.1 Flying Five Stakes at the Curragh and in doing so, was the fastest winner of the race since it moved to there in 2002.

He is out of the Listed Radley Stakes winner **Russian Punch (Archipenko)**.

Multiple Italian champion **Cantocorale** will make his debut at Azienda Agricola Antezate in Lombardy this year.

The seven-year-old son of **Helmet** was a star performer in Italy over five seasons. A useful sort as a two-year-old, he progressed the following year to win a pair of Listed races and the Gr.3 Premio Ribot, beating a host of international Group race winners in the latter contest. That earned him the title of Champion Three-Year-Old Miler in Italy and he further earned championship honours at four when triumphing three times at Gr.2 level over 1800m - 2000m, again with multiple Group winners in behind each time.

Although unable to win again the following year, he was still crowned Champion Older Male in Italy in 2023, notably finishing third to the Gr.1 winner **Skalleti (Kendargent)** in the Gr.2 Premio Presidente della Repubblica.

**Cantocorale** is a half-brother to the Japanese Gr.3 winner **Territorial (Teofilo)** and out of an unraced **Street Cry** half-sister to the Gr.3 Prix du Lys winner **Claremont (Sadler's Wells)**. The second dam is the Gr.1 Prix Vermeille heroine **Mezzo Soprano (Darshaan)** and the family extends to the outstanding Canadian champion **Glorious Song (Halo)**, dam of the Gr.2 winner and champion sire **Rahy (Blushing Groom)** and the multiple international Gr.1 winner and successful sire **Singspiel (In The Wings)**.

**CHARYN***Dark Angel – Futoon (Kodiac)***SUMBE • Fee €35,000**

One of the stars of the 2024 Flat season, Sumble's **Charyn** (**Dark Angel**) has been introduced at a fee of €35,000 as he begins stallion duties at Montfort et Preaux this year. Blessed with the soundness and durability that are hallmarks of his sire, he rates an exciting addition to the stallion ranks.

The key contributor to **Dark Angel's** maiden British/Irish Sires' Championship, **Charyn** came home first in five of his eight starts last year, including the Gr.1 Queen Anne Stakes, Gr.1 Prix Jacques le Marois and Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Stakes, earning the title of Cartier Older Horse of the Year in the process. He had also been a top-class performer for trainer Roger Varian at two and three years, winning the 1200m Gr.2 Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte as a juvenile and finishing third in both the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes and Gr.1 Sussex Stakes during his Classic season.

Bred by Grangemore Stud, the 250,000gns Tattersalls October Yearling Sale graduate has a pedigree to match his illustrious racing CV. He is a full-brother to the Gr.2-winning two-year-old **Wings Of War** and out of the multiple Listed-placed sprinter **Futoon (Kodiac)**, while the further family includes the Gr.2 Mill Reef Stakes winner **Galeota (Mujadil)**, the Gr.3 Sirenia Stakes-winning half-brothers **Brown Sugar (Tamayuz)** and **Burnt Sugar (Lope De Vega)**, plus the Gr.3 Prix Six Perfections winner **Oscula (Galileo Gold)**.

Darley sire **Cloth Of Stars** has relocated to Haras de Montaigu for the 2025 breeding season and will begin life at his new stud at a reduced fee of €4,000.

An impeccably bred son of **Sea The Stars**, **Cloth Of Stars** was trained by Andre Fabre to win the Gr.3 Prix des Chenes at two and five more times in Pattern company at three and four, his most notable success coming in the 2017 Gr.1 Prix Ganay. He was also placed in consecutive renewals of the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe behind **Enable (Nathaniel)**.

His first crop appeared during the 2022 season and included the dual Listed winner and multiple Gr.2-placed **Birr Castle** and the useful Flat handicapper and Gr.3-placed hurdler **Laafi**. Better was to come with the sire's second crop, which includes five black-type earners and counting, most notably the Gr.3 Ballysax Stakes winner **Dallas Star**. Andre Fabre's unbeaten maiden winner **Indalimos** is among the three-year-olds that promise to add weight to the sire's reputation this season.

**Cloth Of Stars** is out of the **Kingmambo** mare **Strawberry Fledge**, a full-sister to the Gr.1 Oaks winner **Light Shift** (dam of the dual Gr.1 winner and sire **Ulysses**) and a half-sister to the Gr.1 Tattersalls Gold Cup winner **Shiva (Hector Protector)**. This is the family of the Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Turf winner and Gr.1 Derby second **Main Sequence (Aldebaran)**.

A performer in both codes, **Diplomat** was bred by Gestüt Röttgen and raced under the ownership of Eckhard Sauren, having been picked up for €55,000 at the BBAG Premier Yearling Sale.

Under the tutelage of Mario Hofer, he notched up a number of placed efforts in Group company at four. They came not least in Baden-Baden's Gr.2 Oettingen-Rennen, where he finished third to the subsequent Gr.1 Prix du Moulin de Longchamp winner and sire **Vadamos (Monsun)**.

At five, he delivered a three-length triumph in Capannelle's Gr.2 Premio Presidente della Repubblica, while at seven, then in the care of Jean-Pierre Carvalho, he added Cologne's Gr.2 Meilen Trophy to his CV. The son of **Teofilo** ran three times over obstacles in France for Carina Fey, winning his 3600m jumps debut at Auteuil.

The now 14-year-old is out of the Gr.3 Grosser Preis von Berlin heroine **Desidera (Shaadi)** and is a half-brother to both the Listed winner and Gr.1 Deutsches Derby runner-up **Dickens (Kallisto)** and the Listed victor **Daressalam (Singspiel)**. He is also a half-brother to the winning dams of the NH Gr.3 winner and Gr.1-placed **Sancta Simona (Saddex)**, the Listed winner **Mozart (Dream Ahead)** and the winner and Gr.2-placed **Desirao (Acatenango)**.

**DUBAI MILE***Roaring Lion – Beach Bunny (High Chaparral)***COOLAGOWN STUD • Fee €4,000**

Following a single season at Manton Park Stud, the Gr.1-winning juvenile and **Roaring Lion's** sole stallion son, **Dubai Mile**, has moved to Coolagown Stud in County Cork for 2025. His fee has been reduced from £7,500 to €4,000.

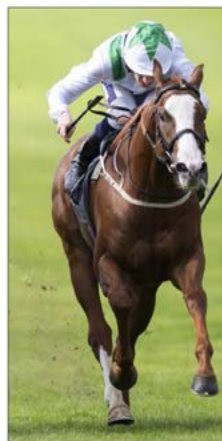
Inexpensively sourced but nonetheless extremely well-related, **Dubai Mile** was trained by Charlie and Mark Johnston during an excellent two-year-old season. He won novice contests over 1m at Windsor and Kempton before finishing a narrow second in the Gr.2 Royal Lodge Stakes at Newmarket, then relished the step up to 2000m when winning the Gr.1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud from future Gr.1 St Leger runner-up and fellow sire **Arrest (Frankel)**.

An excellent fifth in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas when dropped back to 1m on his three-year-old return, **Dubai Mile** was unplaced in the Gr.1 Derby and fourth in the Gr.2 King Edward VII Stakes before a minor injury curtailed his racing career. He covered a relatively modest book of mares in his debut season last year but has been promised support from his new stud and original racing owner, Ahmad Al Shaikh.

Bred by the late Lady O'Reilly's Skymarc Farm, **Dubai Mile** is out of the Listed-winning and Gr.1-placed **High Chaparral** mare **Beach Bunny**, making him a half-brother to the Listed winners **Naadirr (Oasis Dream)** and **Beach Belle (Invincible Spirit)**; dam of the Australian Gr.2 winner **Surf Dancer**.

**ELDAR ELDAROV***Dubawi – All At Sea (Sea The Stars)***CHAPEL STUD • Fee £5,000**

Joining Chapel Stud's stallion roster for his debut covering season is **Dubawi's** dual Classic-winning son **Eldar Eldarov**.

Trained during his racing career with Roger Varian, he ran a total of ten times on the track, winning five of those starts and earning over £1,000,000 in prize money. After making an impressive winning debut as a two-year-old when running out a five-length winner of a maiden contest over 1m½f at Nottingham, he returned the following season with a triumph in a novice contest at Newcastle, before making it three wins in a row when stepped up in trip to land the Gr.2 Queen's Vase over 1m6f at Royal Ascot. He then became a Classic winner when comfortably landing the Gr.1 St Leger Stakes at Doncaster from **New London (Dubawi)** and **Giavelotto (Mastercraftsman)**. It was a season which saw him crowned the Champion Three-Year-Old Stayer in Europe. He made his last start on the track the following season at the Curragh, where he ended his Classic career with a three and a half-length defeat of Aidan O'Brien's eight-time Gr.1 winner **Kyprios (Galileo)** in the Gr.1 Irish St Leger.

Bred by Miss Kirsten Rausing, he is a half-brother to the Gr.3 winner **Kingswood (Roaring Lion)**. They are out of the treble Listed winner **All At Sea (Sea The Stars)** and this is the immediate family of the champion and six-time Gr.1 winner **Alpinista (Frankel)**.

He is out of the two-year-old winner **In Dubai (Giant's Causeway)**, whose dual Gr.1-winning half-sister **Nahrain (Selkirk)** has gone on to produce the Gr.1 1,000 Guineas heroine **Elmalka (Kingman)** and the triple Gr.1 winner and sire **Benbatl (Dubawi)**. Blessed with a potent blend of precocity and pedigree, **Go Bears Go** is a young sire to note.

He was runner-up on two more occasions in Group company, the Gr.2 Lennox Stakes and the Gr.2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein, with the Gr.1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere winner and sire **Belbek (Showcasing)** beaten a neck into third.

**Isaac Shelby** is the first son of **Night Of Thunder** to retire to stud and is a half-brother to one other winner. He is out of the unraced mare **Kentucky Belle (Heliostatic)**, a half-sister to the Gr.2 Mac Diarmida Handicap winner **Ramazutti (Honor Grades)**.

Bred by Haras de la Morsangliere and Ecurie des Charmes, **Look De Vega** was a seven-length debut winner over 1800m at Fontainebleau in the November of his juvenile campaign. He made a winning reappearance over 2000m at Longchamp the following May and was then immediately pitched into Gr.1 company in the Prix du Jockey Club over 100m further.

Always handily placed, the Carlos and Yann Lerner-trained colt pressed on shortly after turning for home and soon lengthened clear to win by two lengths. The strong visual impression was backed up by the clock, with **Look De Vega** posting a rapid 11.5s split from 400m to 200m out, despite the sticky underfoot conditions. He was retired two starts later after defeat in the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe.

**Look De Vega** will now attempt to emulate his sire and grandsire (**Shamardal**), who both won the Prix du Jockey Club before earning champion first-season sire honours. He is out of a half-sister to the Gr.2 Lancashire Oaks winner **The Black Princess (Iffraaj)** and from the family of the Gr.1 Prix du Jockey Club winner and sire **Lawman (Invincible Spirit)** and the Gr.1 Prix de Diane winner **Latice (Inchinor)**.

Of his racing exploits, it is the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas triumph for which **Magna Grecia** (*Invincible Spirit*) is perhaps most remembered, seeing off **King Of Change** (*Farhh*; sire) by two and a half lengths, **Madhmoon** (*Dawn Approach*; sire) and **Ten Sovereigns** (*No Nay Never*; sire) both finishing further down the field. He also, however, claimed the Gr.1 Vertem Futurity Trophy Stakes at two, fellow sire **Phoenix Of Spain** (*Lope De Vega*) his runner-up that day.

It is five years since **Magna Grecia** began stud duties at Coolmore, but he will stand under a new banner this year at March Hare Stud, Suffolk.

The nine-year-old's first crop of two-year-olds recorded a 20 per cent strike rate in 2023, with 12 winners from 59 runners, while last year saw his overall strike rate increase to 31 per cent, or 34 winners from 110 runners. Francois Monfort's **Myconian** led the charge at two, the now four-year-old victorious in Deauville's Listed Prix Yacowlef, the same year Mario Hofer's **Thekingofmyheart** came home second in a Düsseldorf Listed race. Down Under, **Magna Memory** has run in a series of New Zealand Listed contests, finishing third in Pukekohe's Champagne Stakes last year.

Out of the Gr.3 Silver Flash Stakes victrix **Cabaret** (*Galileo*), he is a half-brother to the multiple Gr.1 victor and sire **St Mark's Basilica** (*Siyouni*).

The 2018 Gr.1 Derby winner **Masar** (*New Approach*) has left Dalham Hall Stud and will continue his stallion career at Michael Hickey's Sunnyhill Stud. The move has echoes of the path taken by former Darley sire **Doyen**, who enjoyed a long stint at the County Kildare stud before retiring in 2022.

**Masar** is a son of the Gr.2-winning dual UAE Classic heroine **Khawlah** (*Cape Cross*), a half-sister to the Gr.2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano victor **Vancouverite** (*Dansili*). The third dam is the Gr.1 Oaks-placed **Melikah** (*Lammtarra*), a half-sister to **Sea The Stars** (*Cape Cross*) and **Galileo** (*Sadler's Wells*), and therefore a daughter of the Gr.1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe heroine **Urban Sea** (*Miswaki*).

Inbred 3X4 to **Urban Sea**, **Masar** won the Gr.3 Solario Stakes as a two-year-old. He returned to win the Gr.3 Craven Stakes and finish third in the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas the following spring, before enjoying his signature success in the Derby, with the likes of **Roaring Lion** (*Kitten's Joy*), **Saxon Warrior** (*Deep Impact*) and **Kew Gardens** (*Galileo*) in behind.

His first crop debuted in 2023 and included the Listed UAE 1,000 Guineas third **Yamamah**, the 98-rated handicapper **Mount Atlas** and Andre Fabre's useful dual French winner **Will Scarlet**. The sire has also created a buzz with his first jumps runners, notably the Gr.2-placed juvenile hurdler **Stencil**, and he is a welcome addition to the NH ranks.

He won a 6f Doncaster maiden on his two-year-old debut and was fourth behind subsequent Gr.1 2,000 Guineas winner **Chaldean (Frankel)** in the Gr.3 Acomb Stakes over 7f.

Dropped back to 6f the following year, he made rapid progress through the handicap ranks before winning the Listed Prix Moonlight Cloud and Gr.3 Prix de Meautry at Deauville. Better was to follow as a four-year-old, when he won the Gr.2 Duke of York Stakes and Gr.1 July Cup, in addition to finishing third in the Gr.1 Queen Elizabeth II Jubilee Stakes at Royal Ascot.

**Mill Stream** is a half-brother to the Gr.2 Richmond Stakes winner and Gr.1-placed sire **Asymmetric (Showcasing)**. They are out of the dual sprint winner **Swirral Edge (Hellvelyn)**, a half-sister to the Listed Westow Stakes winner **Fashion Queen (Aqlaam)**. The further family includes the Gr.2 Flying Childers Stakes winner **Wunders Dream (Averti)** and the Hong Kong champion **Industrialist (Rudimentary)**.

Fresh from a scintillating victory in the Gr.2 Finale Juvenile Hurdle at Chepstow in December, **Zarak's** four-year-old son **Nietzsche Has** is a hugely exciting addition to the roster at Haras de Montaigu in Normandy.

A year on from **Jigme (Motivator)** dominating the French three-year-old hurdling division and then retiring to stallion duties, his trainer Marcel Rolland executed a near identical-plan with **Nietzsche Has** in 2024. Purchased for €240,000 by Guy Petit at the 2023 Arqana Summer Sale, he made a winning debut in the Prix Rush Hurdle at Auteuil last March and went on to win the Listed Prix Go Ahead and Gr.3 Prix Aguado in quick succession. Although beaten on his next two starts, **Nietzsche Has** confirmed himself as one of the best three-year-old hurdlers in France when second in the Gr.1 Prix Cambacères and signed off his racing career with an impressive eight-length triumph at Chepstow.

His retirement reflects the renewed interest in NH stallions that have proven their ability to jump. One of the most notable recent examples of that trend is the 2019 Gr.1 Prix Cambacères winner and highly promising sire **Nirvana Du Berlais (Martaline)**, who is a full-brother to **Nice To Meet You**, the dam of **Nietzsche Has**. The mare is also responsible for the dual Listed-winning chaser and Gr.1 Grand Steeple-Chase de Paris fourth **Niko Has (Great Pretender)**.

Following an encouraging fourth behind **Lazzat (Territories)** in the Gr.3 Prix Paul de Moussac, **Puchkine** produced his signature performance in the Prix Jean Prat.

Always prominently positioned, he took over with 400m left to travel and soon bounded clear to win by two and a half lengths. The time was just 0.20 seconds outside the race record set by **Too Darn Hot (Dubawi)**, and his beaten rivals included seven Group winners and that season's Gr.1 Poule d'Essai des Poulaches runner-up. He was bought into by the Chehboubs immediately after his Prix Jean Prat victory, a race with a proven track record of producing future stallions.

**Puchkine** is a half-brother to the Listed-placed winner **Slevka (Shalaa)** and out of the unraced **So You Think** mare **Vadyska**. This is the extended family of the Gr.1 Fillies' Mile heroine **Lyric Of Light (Street Cry)**.

Following nine seasons at Shade Oak Stud in Shropshire, **Telescope** has crossed the Irish Sea to join Foxwood Farm in County Cork ahead of the 2025 breeding season.

**Telescope** is out of a half-sister to the Gr.1 Dubai World Cup winner and sire **Moon Ballad (Singspiel)** and was a Gr.1 winner in all but name during four seasons with Sir Michael Stoute. He won twice at Gr.2 level, most notably a seven-length demolition job in the Hardwicke Stakes, as well as finishing second in the Gr.1 King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Stakes and third in the Gr.1 Juddmonte International.

Commencing covering duties in 2016, he was well supported by British breeders in his early seasons at Shade Oak Stud and still has plenty of well-bred young stock to come through. His first NH runners arrived during the 2020/21 campaign and it has not taken long for the sire to make an impressive impact.

**Slade Steel** won the Gr.1 Supreme Novices' Hurdle at the 2024 Cheltenham Festival; **Ferns Lock** has established himself as one of the leading hunter chasers in Ireland; **Some Scope** landed the Rowland Meyrick Chase (Premier Handicap) at Wetherby earlier this season and **Harvard Guy** is a dual Listed winner and Gr.3-placed over hurdles. **Telescope** looks a natural fit for the Irish NH breeding scene and can build on the early success he has enjoyed in Britain.

**Dark Angel's** Gr.1 2,000 Guineas runner-up and dual Listed winner **Tip Two Win** has been loaned to Nickey and Niamh Murphy's Killisk Farm in Enniscorthy this year from March Hare Stud, offering value at a fee of €2,500.

**Tip Two Win** is out of **Freddie's Girl**, a daughter of **More Than Ready** who shares her grandam with the Listed-winning and Gr.1-placed sire **Due Diligence (War Front)**. Winner of the Listed Flying Scotsman Stakes and runner-up in the Gr.3 Tattersalls Stakes domestically as a juvenile, he then spent the winter in Qatar, where he won two races, including the valuable (Local Gr.2) Al Biddah Mile.

That win set him up for a tilt at the Gr.1 2,000 Guineas, in which he defied an SP of 50/1 to finish second to **Saxon Warrior (Deep Impact)**. This was an outstanding renewal of the Newmarket Classic, with the future Gr.1 Derby winner **Masar (New Approach)** in third, four-time Gr.1 winner **Roaring Lion (Kitten's Joy)** in fifth, and Gr.1 Breeders' Cup Mile hero **Expert Eye (Acclamation)** back in the field.

Also fourth in the Gr.1 St James's Palace Stakes, **Tip Two Win** was retired at the end of 2020 and spent four seasons at March Hare Stud in Surrey. He has not covered a great deal of mares so far, but as a Classic-placed son of the reigning British and Irish champion sire, he looks like an irresistible option to those breeding on a budget at his reduced fee.

Following eight seasons at Cheveley Park Stud, the dual Gr.1-winning sprinter **Twilight Son** has moved to Annshoon Stud in County Kilkenny for 2025. His fee has been reduced from £6,000 to €5,000

The now 13-year-old son of **Kyllachy** was trained by Henry Candy and won six of his ten career starts, only finishing outside of the frame on three occasions. He won both of his starts during his juvenile campaign and maintained that unbeaten record for another three starts in his three-year-old season, which included a triumph in the Gr.1 Haydock Sprint Cup over 6f, before being beaten only two lengths by **Muhaarar (Oasis Dream; sire)** in the Gr.1 British Champions Sprint Stakes at Ascot. He then added another Gr.1 success to his name the following season when winning the Diamond Jubilee Stakes at Royal Ascot.

In 2023, his yearlings averaged £160,000 and last year they averaged £82,253, both figures far above his covering fee. He is already the sire of three Stakes winners, including the dual Gr.3 winner and dual Gr.2-placed **Twilight Jet** and the Gr.3 Athasi Stakes winner **Twilight Spinner**, as well as the Gr.1 King's Stand Stakes-placed **Twilight Calls**.

**Twilight Son** is a half-brother to several other winners, including the Stakes winners **Music Master (Piccolo)**, **Spring Fling (Assertive)** and **Run To Freedom (Muhaarar)**.
